FS has series wins over CSU, UNLV, SJSU, USU and BSU and is 5-4 on the road this season.

LOBO NOTES

FRESH PERSPECTIVE

- The Lobos revamped their roster with 12 freshmen and a total of 15 newcomers.
- Of the freshmen, UNM added four pitchers, three outfielders, three utility players and two infielders.
- UNM also added three transfers in junior catcher/ infielder Sydney Carithers, junior pitcher Emily Brouse and sophomore outfielder Taylor Morgan. Of the transfers, Carithers leads with 48 starts - 15 at catcher and 33 at third, playing in 50.

FRESHMEN IMPACT

- Nine freshmen have earned a spot in the starting lineup this season and six freshmen (De-Nae Vasquez-Dickson, Katherine Brunner, McKenna Guest, Hayden Luderer, Karly Smith and Macie Andrews) have played in over 20 games.
- Of the freshmen, Brunner has played in 48 games with 43 starts- 24 as the designated player, 12 games at third and seven at second. Vasquez-Dickson has started in 43 games with 26 in center, 12 in left and five in right and played in 50 games, and Luderer with 15 starts and playing in 29 games with eight starts in center, six in right and one in left. Smith has played in 24 games with nine starts, seven as the designated player and two in right. Gabrielle Briones has started in five games, two at third, two at second and one as the designated player with an appearance in 18 games and Macie Andrews has started 12 games, nine in left and three in right, and played in 29 games.
- McKenna Guest leads the Lobos' pitching staff with 23 starts and 38 appearances and a team-high 142.1 innings, Brooke Umali has made four starts and 18 appearances, throwing 28.0 innings and Kenzie Jones has appeared in 10 games with one start and 11.2 innings.
- Vasquez-Dickson has played in 98.0% of the games, 93.7% of the innings and started in 84.3% of the games. Brunner has played in 94.1% of the games, starting in 84.3%, and playing in 85.7% of the innings.
- In the circle, Guest has started 45.1% of the games, made an appearance in 74.5% of the games and pitched in 45.1% of the innings. The RHP has accounted for 55.4% of UNM's strikeouts this season with 87 of UNM's 157.
- UNM started five freshmen against UConn, in the March 19 game against UTEP and the first game at Nevada, 11 games with four freshmen starting and 23 games with three freshmen starting.
- Brunner is tied for third on the team in RBI (17) and tied for fourth in home runs (two), while Vasquez-Dickson leads in sac bunts (15), is third in home runs (three), fifth in RBI (16), fourth in runs scored (17), third in stolen bases (five) and fifth in total bases (41), and Smith is tied for fifth in walks (eight). Vasquez-Dickson leads the MW in sac bunts and is fourth in the NCAA in sac bunts per game (.30) and third in number of sac bunts.

KEY CONTRIBUTOR

- Keyannah Chavez leads in slugging percentage (.634), on-base percentage (.455), total bases (78), triples (five) and walks (17). Chavez is second in batting average (.374), home runs (six), runs scored (28), hits (46), RBI (22), tied for second in sac flies (two) and third in sac bunts (five).
- Chavez is tied for the lead in triples in the Mountain West and leads against MW opponents with three. She is 20th in the NCAA in triples.
- The sophomore is 17-37 (.459) as the leadoff in an inning, 38-67 (.567) in successfully advancing runners, 4-8 (.500) with runners on third and less than two outs, and of her 22 RBI, 11 are with two outs.
- She's had 13 multiple-hit games (10 games with two hits and three games with three), besting her total from her freshman season, and six multiple RBI games (five games with two RBI and a game with four), with the four the most RBI in a game by a Lobo this season.
- Chavez has surpassed her season total from her freshman season in total bases with 78 (from 52) and RBI at 22 (from 19) and has increased her batting average (.315 to .374),

on-base percentage (.410 to .455) and slugging percentage (.364 to .634) from her freshman season to this season. She has also hit five triples and six home runs after not having either last season.

- She hit back-to-back home runs with a two-run home run against New Mexico State that tied the game at two and another two-run home run in Friday's game against Utah State that gave UNM the 8-6 lead.
- In MW play this season, Chavez has improved her batting average (.246 to .318), slugging percentage (.279 to .545) and on-base percentage (.378 to .436) from her freshman season last year to this year.

GUEST APPEARANCE

- Freshman McKenna Guest has been a frequent presence in the circle for the Lobos, appearing in a team-high 38 games, starting a team-high 23 games and throwing nine complete games.
- The RHP has thrown a team-high 142.1 innings, 73.1 more innings than the next Lobo pitcher, and has a team-best 87 strikeouts, accounting for 55.4% of UNM's total strikeouts and 59 more than the next Lobo pitcher. Guest has also been the pitcher on record in 10 of UNM's wins and earned her first save in the win against Marist.
- Guest struck out a season-high nine at UTEP and followed that up two days later with seven strikeouts in the first game against Marist.
- She is averaging 4.3 strikeouts per game, 3.2 innings per appearance and a 1.3 k/ bb rate behind 28 games with at least one strikeout and 23 games with multiple strikeouts, including five games with five or more.
- Nationally, Guest has thrown the 81st-most innings in the NCAA and the 11th most by a freshman pitcher. Her 23 starts are tied for the 64th most by a pitcher and is tied for the fifth most by a freshman pitcher and her 38 appearances are the fourth most by a pitcher and the most by a freshman in the NCAA.
- In the March 19 game against UTEP, Guest took a no-hitter into one out of the seventh inning, retired nine consecutive Miners between the fourth and seventh innings and finished with six strikeouts, no walks allowed, two hits and one run in the win. Guest and the Lobo defense retired the side in order in the first, third, fifth and sixth.
- In Saturday's win against UNLV, Guest threw a season-high 8.0 innings and 148 pitches. Guest retired the side in order in second and third innings with two strikeouts in the second and another strikeout in the third. Between the first and third innings, Guest retired seven consecutive Rebels. She later retired the side in order in the eighth with a final strikeout. Of the 36 batters faced, the Lobo allowed one run on four hits and struck out five, and of her 148 pitches, 73 went for strikes.
- In her first collegiate appearance, Guest entered in the fourth inning with bases loaded and struck out the first two batters she faced. She then limited the Tigers to one hit in both the sixth and seventh innings to keep the Lobos within reach, recording a strikeout in each inning. Guest finished with 4.0 innings pitched, no runs or walk allowed with four hits and four strikeouts.
- The Pattonville, Texas native followed the first weekend up with a complete game in the first game at UTEP and of her nine strikeouts, she struck out the side in the sixth. Guest retired the side in order in both the fifth and sixth.
- In the win against SFA, Guest went 7.0 innings and allowed three runs (two earned) on five hits, with five scoreless innings including the last three of the game. She retired the side in order in both the sixth and seventh innings and recorded outs against the final nine batters she faced.

YEATTS GOES YARD

- Chloe Yeatts hit home runs in consecutive games for the third time this season with a solo home run in Saturday's game and a three-run home run in Sunday's game at Boise State. The sophomore also hit a solo home run against UTEP and followed that with a two-run home run in the seventh inning against UNLV.
- Yeatts started off her sophomore season with a two-run home run in the season opener against Tennessee State and again with another two-run home run against McNeese, with both in the first inning.
- The Oklahoma native leads the team in home runs with nine and in RBI (32), is tied for the lead in doubles (seven) and is second in slugging percentage (.496), third in total bases (78) and hits (36), and fifth in batting average (.255), and in on-base percentage (.310).
- Yeatts has improved her home run total from her freshman season from five to nine as well as her total in total bases (56 last year), her slugging percentage (.448) and in hits (34 last year) and RBI (31 last year).

SHAKING UP THE LINEUP

- In the 51 games this season, the Lobos have used 46 different lineup combinations. UNM has used the same batting order in the McNeese and Chattanooga games the first weekend, the same lineup in the Montana and Toledo games, the same lineup against SJSU on March 17 and in the UNLV game on March 22, both SDSU games and the same lineup in the first two Utah State games.
- The Lobos have used three different players in the leadoff spot, five in the second spot, four in the third spot, seven in the cleanup, 11 in the fifth spot, 10 in the sixth spot, 11 in the seventh spot, 11 in the eighth spot and five in the ninth spot in the lineup.
- Rachael Hathoot has led off in 40 games, Sydney Carithers has hit ninth in 35 games and DeNae Vasquez-Dickson second in 30 games for the most frequency in the lineup. Elizabeth Baylor has hit seventh in 20 games, Chloe Yeatts cleanup in 19 games, Carithers has batted eighth in 11 games, Keyannah Chavez third in 21 games, Emma Bramson fifth in 16 games, and Katherine Brunner sixth in 16 games for the most appearances in each spot of the order.
- Keyannah Chavez and Ashley Archuleta have made the most movement in the batting order appearing in seven different spots. Chavez has hit the most often third (21 games), followed by leadoff and second (eight games), as well as three games in the cleanup spot, two times in each the sixth and eighth spot and hit fifth in one game. Archuleta has hit third in 15 games, fifth in 11 games, cleanup in seven games, leadoff in three games, seventh in four games, second in four games and one game in sixth.
- In the field, UNM has used five different players in left, six in right field, four at third, three behind the plate, three in center, three at second base and two at first base. UNM has also had 10 different players as the designated player.
- Only Hathoot has started every game at shortstop, while Bramson has started every

game, but has played 36 games at first, four at third, eight as the designated player and three games in right field.

BY THE NUMBERS

- The Lobos have reached double figures in hits five times this season: UNM's win against Tennessee State in the season opener, where the Lobos finished with 12 hits, 15 hits in the win against Marist on Feb. 16, 12 hits in the March 22 game against UNLV, 13 hits in game two against San Diego State and 10 hits in the last game against Utah State.
- UNM is 8-1 when scoring at least six runs, 10-3 when scoring at least five runs, 9-6 when outhitting its opponent, 8-5 in one-run games and 2-2 in extra-inning games.
- If the Lobos can score in the first inning and hold a lead after the first inning, the Lobos are 8-4 when leading after the first, 7-3 after the third, 9-2 after the fourth inning, 12-3 when leading after the fifth and 11-0 when leading after the sixth inning.
- UNM is 44-80 (.550) with a runner on third and less than two outs, going 5-5 in the first game against Marist, 3-3 in the second game against the Red Foxes, 2-2 in the win against Toledo and in the first game at Boise State and 4-4 in Sunday's game against Utah State. UNM also went 3-4 in the win against SFA. In the series at SJSU, the Lobos were a combined 5-5 in the series.
- The Lobos have had their leadoff hitter reach 36.2% of the time (121-334), with all seven reaching in the first game against Marist, 4-6 at McNeese and in the second game against Marist, 5-7 in the game at GCU and 4-6 in Friday and Sunday's game against USU.

VERSATILE EMMA

- Emma Bramson has played a total of four positions this season and a total of six in her three years at UNM.
- Bramson has started all 51 games with eight games as the designated player, four games at third, three games in right and the last 36 games at first. Last season, the Valencia, California native started 39 games at third and five games at second, and as a freshman started 25 at third and 21 games at shortstop.

STEAL YOUR BASE

- UNM is 34-40 on the season in stolen bases with 10 different players recording at least one. UNM successfully stole on its first 24 attempts.
 - Archuleta leads UNM going 7-8 with Bramson 6-6, Rachael Hathoot 4-4 and DeNae Vasquez-Dickson 5-6, Elizabeth Baylor 3-3 and Gabrielle Briones, Katherine Brunner and Hayden Luderer 1-1. Keyannah Chavez is 3-5 and Sydney Carithers is 3-4 on the season.
- Chavez's three stolen bases against Tennessee State were the most for a Lobo in a single game since 2017, when D'Andra DeFlora had three against Santa Clara on 3/11/17.
- UNM's six stolen bases in the season opener were the most in a game since 2018, when UNM had six against Howard on 3/10/18. In addition to Chavez's three, Archuleta had two stolen bases and Brunner had one stolen base.
- The Lobos then stole seven bases against Marist on Feb. 16, the most in a single game for UNM since 2010.
 - Bramson and Baylor each stole two, with Carithers, Vasquez-Dickson and Archuleta each stealing one.

MIDDLE (WO)MEN

- The Lobos are anchored in the middle infield with the stability and experience of Ashley Archuleta (second) and Rachael Hathoot (shortstop).
- This season, Hathoot leads the Lobos in hits (62), runs scored (35) and in batting average (.380), and is second in sac bunts (six), on-base percentage (.425), and in total bases (75), and third in slugging percentage (.460) and tied for third in doubles (five). She is 32-72 (.444) as the leadoff hitter in an inning and 33-66 (.500) in advancing runners. The Lobo is fourth in the MW in hits, ninth in batting average and second in assists (113). Nationally, Hathoot is 45th in the NCAA in hits.
- Hathoot has also recorded a hit in 28 of the last 30 games. She has a team-high 18 multiple-hit games (16 with two hits, two games with three).
- Of her season highlights was the walk-off home run to give UNM the 2-1 win over UNLV to start the eighth inning.
- Archuleta leads the Lobos in stolen bases (seven), is tied for the team lead in doubles (seven), third in on-base percentage (.326) and runs scored (18), fourth in batting average (.256), total bases (48), and in slugging percentage (.372), and tied for third in RBI (17). She went a career-best 4-4 in the March 22 game against UNLV.
- To date, Archuleta has started in 143 games with 138 starts at second.
 - The Rio Rancho, New Mexico native is coming off of her best season as a Lobo in terms of home runs (three), triples (five), batting average (.331), slugging percentage (.508) and RBI (25).
 - She finished the season on a 10-game hitting streak and had 13 games with multiple hits and eight games with multiple RBI.
 - In MW games, was second in hits (31), fifth in batting average (.437), sixth in slugging % (.676), 10th in on-base % (.481)
- Hathoot has started all 51 games this season and all 50 games last season at shortstop, and has started all 173 games during her UNM career. The redshirt senior has shown her versatility, playing 42 games at second and four as a catcher her sophomore season (2021) and 26 games at third her freshman season. Hathoot missed 2022 due to injury.
 - She is also coming off her best season as a Lobo with 59 hits, nine doubles, seven triples, 31 RBI, 91 total bases, 12 walks, 38 runs scored, a .396 batting average, .452 on-base percentage and .611 slugging percentage.
 - She was 23-53 (.434) with runners in scoring position, 19-37 (.514) as the leadoff and 4-8 with bases loaded last season.
 - Her seven triples tied for the third most in a single season in program history, last done in 1998. It also ranked fifth in the NCAA and her 0.14 triples per game ranked seventh.
 - Hathoot led the team in batting average, slugging percentage, on-base percentage, doubles, triples, runs scored and total bases and she tied for the team high in RBI
 - Her 59 hits were more than her freshman and sophomore season combined, as were her 91 total bases.
 - Hathoot had a career-best 15-game hit streak and career-best 20-game streak of reaching base and led the team with 18 multiple hit games, five games with three hits while also having seven multiple RBI games.

GUEST OF HONOR

- After a strong week in the circle, New Mexico freshman pitcher McKenna Guest was named MW Freshman of the Week by the conference on March 25. The Texas native went 2-0 on the week, throwing 16.2 innings and appearing in three of the four games with two complete games. Guest finished with a 1.26 ERA and struck out 13, which included throwing a season-high 8.0 innings and 148 pitches in the win against UNLV. Opponents hit .138 in her three appearances, with Guest getting the ball for 16.2 of UNM's 29.0 innings and accounting for all 13 of UNM's strikeouts on the week. Further, in UNM's two wins on the week, she held a 0.93 ERA with 11 strikeouts and a .120 opponent batting average while throwing all 15.0 innings.
- Among her highlights on the week, Guest carried a no-hitter through one out in the seventh inning against UTEP on Tuesday, finishing with six strikeouts and no walks, one run allowed on two hits. She retired the Miners in order in the first inning, which included her first strikeout of the game, and added two more strikeouts in the second. The freshman again retired the side in order in the third, needing just seven pitches. Additionally, the Lobo retired nine consecutive Miners between the fourth and seventh innings. During that stretch, the right-hander struck out one in the fourth on three pitches and added a strikeout in the sixth. She closed the game with a final strikeout in the seventh en route to the complete-game win.
- Later in the week, Guest threw 8.0 innings in the game two win against UNLV, retiring the side in order in the second, which included two strikeouts, and the third, adding another strikeout. Between the first and third innings, Guest retired seven consecutive Rebels. The Lobo also demonstrated her defensive versatility, catching a liner back to the circle in the sixth inning with runners on first and second for the third out to keep the game tied at one, and in the seventh, left bases loaded after fielding a grounder back to the circle and throwing home for the third out. Guest retired the side in order in the top of the eighth, recording the second out on a grounder to the pitcher and striking out a Rebel on a 3-2 count for the final out. The freshman finished with five strikeouts and one run allowed on four hits for her second win of the week and second complete game.
- In addition, Guest entered in relief in Friday's game in the sixth inning, getting the two Rebels she faced in the inning out to leave two stranded and followed that up by striking out two in the seventh.
- Guest is the first Lobo to win a weekly conference award this season.

KB FOTW

- Following a week in which she led the Lobos at the plate, Katherine Brunner was selected as the Mountain West Freshman of the Week on April 22.
- Brunner led the Lobos with a .636 batting average as well as a .615 on-base percentage, behind a team-high seven hits and driving in a

team-best five RBI. In addition, Brunner also tied for the team high in slugging percentage at 1.000.

- The Katy, Texas native recorded a hit in all four games, including three games with two hits, and contributed three RBI in Sunday's win against Utah State, the most for a Lobo in a game on the week. Starting as the designated player in all four games, the freshman was 2-2 when leading off an inning, 4-7 in successfully advancing runners and 2-3 with runners on third and less than two outs.
- Among her highlights on the week, she accounted for the first three UNM runs in Sunday's game, hitting a single to center field that scored two runs in the bottom of the first to give the Lobos the 2-1 lead, and in the bottom of the third, singled to center to plate a run that tied the game at three. In Saturday's game, Brunner hit a sacrifice fly in the fourth inning to bring in UNM's first run, with the Lobos tying the game on the next at-bat in the eventual 3-2 win.
- She started the Utah State series going 2-2 with a double and a home run and drew a walk. Her double led off the fourth inning, which turned into a five-run inning that gave the Lobos the 8-6 lead, and in the next inning, hit a solo home run for the final run of the 9-6 win.
- In the series sweep over Utah State, Brunner finished with five hits, five RBI, a .625 batting average, 1.125 slugging percentage and .600 on-base percentage.

A LITTLE HISTORY LESSON

- The Lobos recorded a sweep of Utah State, making some history in the process.
- It marked the first sweep over the Aggies since 1989 and the first sweep of a Mountain West opponent since 2016 (Colorado State). Further, UNM won the series against USU for the first time since 2021.
- Combined with the win in the series finale in 2023, the now four-game win streak matches the all-time longest win streak against the Aggies, that was last done between April 15, 1988 and April 22, 1989.
- UNM hit five home runs in Friday's game from five different batters, the first time since 2012 that the Lobos finished with five home runs in a game, and the third time UNM has hit multiple home runs in a game this season.
- Dating back to the last 20 years, it is the second-most home runs hit in a game, with six the most hit back on March 22, 2015 against Utah State.
- In Friday's game, the Lobos hit consecutive home runs for the second time this season (Ashley Archuleta and Chloe Yeatts in the fourth inning), joined by back-to-back home runs by Keyannah Chavez and Yeatts in the third inning against UTEP on March 19 and hit multiple home runs in an inning for the third time, with UNM hitting two against UNLV on March 22 in the bottom of the seventh. UNM hit a total of three home runs in the fourth inning of Friday's game.
- The five runs in the fourth inning was the second-most runs scored in an inning this year, only behind seven runs scored in the second inning of the Feb. 18 game against Marist.

TAKE ME HOME COUNTRY ROADS

- On the season, the Lobos travelled to the home states for 19 Lobos in Arizona (two), California (five), Hawai'i (one), Louisiana (one) and Texas (10).

LAST ONE, BEST ONE FOR RACHAEL

- After earning Mountain West All-Conference First Team last season, New Mexico shortstop Rachael Hathoot has been selected by the conference coaches to the All-Mountain West Preseason Team, one of 12 position players and the only Lobo to earn the preseason distinction.
- "Rachael is a top three player in the Mountain West Conference," commented head softball coach Nicole Dickson. "She is talented, competitive and has a high game IQ. She's been a leader and set the tone from day 1. Her mentality, work ethic and drive are consistent, and I believe her best softball is in front of her this season."
- Hathoot enters the season after hitting .414 with a .643 slugging percentage and a .468 on-base percentage in 22 MW games in 2023. Against conference opponents, Hathoot recorded 29 hits, which included five doubles, four triples and a home run for 45 total bases and accounted for 19 runs and 13 RBI.
- The Albuquerque native led the Lobos in runs scored, was second in batting average, slugging percentage, on-base percentage, hits and total bases, tied for the team lead in triples and was third in runs batted in. Hathoot had nine multiple hit games with at least one hit in 18 conference games as well as seven MW games with at least one RBI and three games with multiple RBI.
- Among the MW, Hathoot finished tied for second in triples, fifth in hits, sixth in batting average, ninth in total bases, 11th in slugging percentage, 13th in on-base percentage and tied for 13th in runs scored. In addition, Hathoot turned six double plays, tied for the second most among conference players, and was third in assists (54).

NO LET UP IN NON-CONFERENCE

- Entering her second season at UNM, Coach Dickson put together a schedule that includes seven teams that competed in the NCAA Tournament last season (McNeese, Cal, Louisiana, Marist, Minnesota, GCU, and San Diego State from the MW) with a team that advanced to the Super Regionals, 15 teams that won over 30 games and three teams that won over 40 games last season.
- The Lobos faced three Power 5 teams in Cal (Pac-12), Minnesota (Big Ten) and Texas Tech (Big 12).

LIFE ON THE ROAD

- The Lobos have 14 of 54 total games at home.
- UNM's first 17 games of the season were on the road, taking the Lobos to Louisiana and three times to Texas with the home opener on Feb. 28 against Texas Tech.
- Following the Feb. 28 home game, the Lobos didn't have another home game until March 19 against UTEP and will remain at home with the MW series against UNLV starting on March 22. Among their road tour included a recent prolonged 10-day stay on the road with a tournament in Phoenix and the Lobos heading straight to Honolulu.
- The breakdown of the home games: one in February, four in March, six in April and three in May.

A LOOK BACK AT 2023

- The Lobos made statistical improvements in Coach Nicole Dickson's first year at UNM, both in NCAA rankings and among program single-season stats.
- When it comes to program milestones:
 - The .299 batting average was the best batting average since 2015 and tied the best batting average in the last 11 years. UNM's 231 runs were the most since 2016, the 399 hits were the most since 2015, the 14 triples were the most since 2010, the 214 RBI the most since 2015 as was the .368 on-base percentage. The 40 stolen bases were the most since 2013.
 - UNM pitched 4 shutouts, the most since 2013 and turned 22 double plays, the most since 2015.
- UNM improved from 2022 to 2023 in 8 NCAA statistical categories:
 - The Lobos improved 141 spots in double plays turned per game (finished 27th with .44), improved 88 spots in triples per game (29th at .28), 87 spots in stolen bases per game (192nd at .80), 86 spots in batting average (45th at .299), 49 spots in runs per game (95th at 4.62), 46 spots in on-base percentage (68th at .368), 16 spots in shutouts (189 at 4) and 12 spots in slugging percentage (88th at .422).
- On opening weekend last season, UNM beat No. 19 Oregon State 8-0 in five innings for the first win against a ranked opponent since 2016 and the first run-rule of a ranked opponent since 2012.
- UNM had two players finish in the top 4 in the MW in batting average, with one returner in Rachael Hathoot (second at .396), and Hathoot also finished in the top 5 in the MW in hits (fifth at 59). Both Hathoot and Ashley Archuleta were among the top 2 in triples with Hathoot leading with seven and Archuleta tied for second with five.
- The Lobos had two MW Freshman of the Week and Player of the Week award winners and one MW Pitcher of the Week winner.
- UNM also had two First Team All-Mountain West players in Archuleta and Hathoot, the second for Archuleta and first for Hathoot, and the first time that UNM has had two earn spots on the first team since 2014.

FIRST GAME, FIRST WIN

- Coach Dickson became just the second coach to win in their Lobo coaching debut, doing so with the largest margin of victory (+9) when UNM run-ruled Nicholls 12-3 in five on Feb. 9, 2023. Erica Beach was the other head coach to win in her first game (a 10-2, five inning win against Utah Valley on Feb. 12, 2011).

HEAD COACH NICOLE DICKSON



Nicole Dickson enters her second season as head coach of the Lobo softball program in 2023-24. Hired on June 3, 2022, Dickson is the sixth head coach in program history.

The Lobos took significant statistical strides in her first year in Albuquerque, producing numbers that hadn't been achieved in several years. Of note, UNM's .299 batting average was the best since 2015 and tied the best average for the program in the last 11 years. The 399 hits and 231 runs scored were the most since 2015 and 2016, respectively, and the 214 RBI and .368 on-base percentage were the highest since 2015. The team's 14 triples were the most in a single season since 2010 and the Lobos' 40 stolen bases were the most since 2013. Defensively, the Lobos led the MW with 22 double plays, the most turned since 2015 and the four shutouts were the most since 2013.

Additionally, UNM jumped in the NCAA rankings from a season ago in eight categories: batting average (a ranking improvement of 86 spots), triples per game (88 spots), stolen bases per game (87 spots), runs (49 spots), on-base percentage (46 spots), slugging percentage (12 spots), shutouts (16 spots) and double plays turned (141 spots). The Lobos ranked 45th in batting average, 27th in double plays per game, 29th in triples per game, 68th in on-base percentage and 88th in slugging percentage.

It didn't take long to see the potential as with UNM's season-opening win over Nicholls, Dickson became just the second Lobo head coach in program history to win in their coaching debut, doing so with the largest margin of victory (12-3 in five innings). Three games later, Dickson and the Lobos made more history, beating No. 19 Oregon State 8-0 in five innings for UNM's first win over a ranked opponent since 2016 and UNM's first run-rule win over a ranked opponent since 2012.

During the season, Dickson guided the Lobos to their first series win over Nevada since 2015, UNM's 8-0 win over SJSU on March 25 was the first shutout against the Spartans since May 8, 2015, and the 12 runs scored against CSU on April 16 were the most runs the Lobos have scored against the Rams since April 15, 2016. In the March 19th win at Utah State, the Lobos finished with 18 hits, 15 runs and struck out 14 Aggies, with the 18 hits the most since 2018 and the 15 runs were the most since 2019. The 15 runs were the most against the Aggies since April 26, 2014, and the 14 strikeouts by Amber Linton were the most in a game by a Lobo since 2013.

Among the conference, UNM had players in the top four in the MW in batting average (Rachael Hathoot second at .396 and Peyton Robinson fourth at .380), two players in the top 5 in the MW in hits (Robinson fourth at 60 and Hathoot fifth at 59), two players in the top 2 in triples (Hathoot first at seven and Ashley Archuleta tied for second at 5) and had two MW Player of the Week, one Pitcher of the Week and two Freshman of the Week honors.

UNM produced two All-Mountain West First Team members in Archuleta and Hathoot, who each had their best seasons in a Lobo uniform.

Hathoot produced her best season as a Lobo with 59 hits, nine doubles, seven triples, 31 RBI, 91 total bases, 12 walks, 38 runs scored, a .396 batting average, .452 on-base percentage and .611 slugging percentage and her seven triples tied for the third most in a single season in program history, last done in 1998. Her 59 hits were more than her freshman and sophomore seasons combined, as were her total bases. Further, she had a career-best 15-game hit streak and career-best 20-game streak of reaching base, while also leading the team with 18 multiple hit games, five games with three hits and had seven multiple RBI games with a career-high five RBI against NMSU. Among the MW, the Lobo led the MW in triples and assists (114), was second in fielding double plays, second in batting average, fifth in hits, eighth in slugging percentage and total bases and ninth in on-base percentage. Archuleta finished with 43 hits, four doubles, five triples (tied for the ninth most in a single season in program history) and three home runs, 25 RBI and 66 total bases, had a .508 slugging percentage, .331 batting average and .401 on-base percentage. She finished her best season as a Lobo in terms of home runs, triples, batting average, slugging percentage and stolen bases.

In the circle, Amber Linton recorded a MW-best 164 strikeouts and set a program record in strikeouts per game at 7.24, besting her own program record of 6.97 she set in 2022. Her 14 complete games doubled her total from the previous year and she also registered 15 games with five or more strikeouts and three games with 10-plus strikeouts, an improvement over last season as well.

Nationally, Hathoot finished 53rd in the NCAA in batting average, fifth in triples and seventh in triples per game, Archuleta finished 28th in triples and 30th in triples per game, Robinson finished 30th in sacrifice bunts and Linton finished 58th in strikeouts.

"I am excited to have Nicole join the Lobo Family," said Vice President/Director of Athletics Eddie Nuñez at the time of her hire. "She has been highly successful at multiple levels and she has a history of building programs. Her vision for what Lobo Softball can be, and how to build it, is what we need to bring our program to a championship level."

Prior to arriving at UNM, Dickson spent six seasons as the head coach at Stephen F. Austin, with the Ladyjacks surpassing 30 wins in four of five seasons and were on pace for another stellar result in the shortened 2020 season with a 19-4 record. Through her six seasons, Dickson compiled a 169-123 record and was named the 2021 Southland Conference Coach of the Year.

Under her leadership, SFA had 20 all-conference selections, as well as two hitter of the year and pitcher of the year selections, a player of the year and a freshman of the year.

"I am grateful for the opportunity to join UNM Athletics," Dickson stated upon her selection as the new Lobo head coach. "I really value, and aligned with, the core values and vision for the program. Both Eddie Nuñez and Deputy A.D. for External Affairs Dave Williams are all in, and are willing to support the student-athletes to have a quality experience and want to see softball be successful. I loved the community and coaches and the beautiful campus sells itself."

"I am excited to work with the student-athletes and develop a competitive, hard-working culture focused on getting better every day. The goal is to compete for championships and represent the campus and community positively on and off the field."

In her last season at SFA, the Ladyjacks went 18-6 in conference play and 31-27 overall, winning the Southwest Division and advancing to the WAC Tournament final as the No. 2 seed. The Ladyjacks had three players make the All-WAC team with Kassidy Wilbur claiming Pitcher of the Year. Wilbur struck out a conference-best 219 batters, holding the opposition to a .211 batting average while recording a WAC-high 37 appearances and tying the WAC lead in wins with 19. In her 18 complete games, she recorded a conference-high six shutouts.

Prior to that, the Ladyjacks won their second Southland Conference regular season title in 2021 with a 35-12 overall and 25-2 conference record, resulting in Dickson being selected Coach of the Year.

As a result of Dickson's and the Ladyjacks' success, three players were named to the 2021 NFCA All-Region Division I teams, with two first team selections and a third team selection. In addition, under her guidance, SFA had seven named to the all-conference teams that included the Southland Conference's Pitcher of the Year, Hitter of the Year and Player of the Year. Wilbur was also named Southland Conference Pitcher and Player of the Year in the league, the first time a Ladyjack has collected both honors simultaneously, as well as named a JWOS All-American Second Team.

Further, in 2021, the program set three program records. SFA's 25 league wins and just two conference losses were a program best, with the team setting another program record with 18 consecutive wins.

In the shortened 2020 season, Dickson and the Ladyjacks went 19-4 and set a program record with a then-13 consecutive wins with a NCAA Division I best nine true road wins. In the 2019, SFA went 36-23, compiling wins over Power Five programs Illinois, Mississippi State, Indiana and Baylor.

Before taking the helm at SFA, Dickson gained experience as the head coach at Tyler Junior College (2013-16) and a spent a year as the head coach at Paris Junior College (2012-13). Dickson got her start in coaching as a graduate assistant at Hardin-Simmons in 2008 before getting her first coaching job as an assistant coach at Howard College in 2010.

Dickson earned a B.S. in health and physical education from Eastern New Mexico in 2008 and earned a master's in sports management and kinesiology from Hardin-Simmons in 2009.

In addition, Coach Dickson's first win at SFA was against UNM (a 5-1 win on Feb. 17, 2017).
