ARIZONA NOTES & NUMBERS

» Arizona opens their first season under the direction of head coach Brent Brennan this Saturday at Arizona Stadium as they welcome the New Mexico Lobos to Tucson.

» Saturday's game will be nationally televised on ESPN with play-by-play from Brian Custer. He is joined by analyst Rod Gilmore and sideline reporter Lauren Sisler on the call.

» The Wildcats are 85-30-5 all-time in season openers, and 92-22-5 all-time in home openers. They have posted back-to-back season opening wins over NAU (2023) and San Diego State (2022) but have gone just 1-3 in their last four home openers.

» Arizona and New Mexico have faced each other 67 times previously, with the Wildcats holding a definitive 44-20-3 lead in the all-time series. Arizona has opened their season against UNM one time previously, a 6-0 road win over the Lobos to kick off the 1911 season.

» The Wildcats enter the year ranked No. 21 in both the Associated Press Preseason Top 25 and the USA Today Coaches Poll. It marks the first time since 2015 that Arizona began the year ranked in the AP Top 25.

» Five Arizona standouts were selected to the 2024 Preseason All-Big 12 Team: WR Tetairoa McMillan, OL Jonah Savaiinaea, K Tyler Loop, LB Jacob Manu, and DB Tacario Davis.

» The Wildcats won seven games to close out the 2023 season, concluding with their 38-24 win over Oklahoma in the Alamo Bowl. Carrying over into this season, Arizona's seven-game win streak is the second longest active win streak in FBS, behind only defending the national champions Michigan (W15).

INTERVIEW REQUESTS

The Arizona Athletics Communication Services office will make every attempt to fulfill phone interview requests for media members. Interview requests for head coach Brent Brennan, Arizona players, and Arizona Football staff members should be directed to **Jeff Bowe** (jeffb1@arizona.edu). Please submit requests well in advance to allow time for an interview to be scheduled. However, some requests may not be granted based on academic schedules and other team responsibilities. All in-season player availability will be on Tuesdays.

WEEKLY PRESS CONFERENCES

Head Coach Brent Brennan is available twice weekly at press conferences each Monday and Thursday of game weeks during the regular season. Press conferences begin at approximately **11:20 AM MST** in the east concourse press conference room. A live web stream and archive of the press conferences are both available on the Arizona Athletics YouTube channel, accessible at [YouTube.com/@ArizonaWildcats](https://www.youtube.com/@ArizonaWildcats).

PRACTICES

The first 30 minutes of in-season practices are open to media on Tuesdays and Wednesdays only. All interviews with Coach Brennan and student-athletes will take place on Monday (coach), Tuesday (offensive players), Wednesday (defensive players), and Thursday (coach) afternoons in the east concourse press conference room. Contact **Jeff Bowe** or **Brett Gleason** for more specific information on the weekly availability throughout the season.

POSTGAME INTERVIEWS

Arizona has a closed locker room policy after games. There is no player availability on the field immediately after the game. Head coach Brent Brennan will address the assembled media only after his postgame radio show responsibilities have been completed both at home and on the road. At home games, Coach Brennan will hold a postgame press conference in the east concourse press conference room. Selected offensive and defensive players will also be available after games. For road games, each locker room situation will dictate postgame protocol. Please direct any specific requests for players to **Jeff Bowe** and **Brett Gleason** with the UA Communication Services staff.

FACILITIES ACCESS FOR MEDIA

The team locker room, practice sites, sports medicine center and strength and conditioning center are off limits to media unless special arrangements have been made through **Jeff Bowe**.

PHOTO/VIDEO USAGE

Usage of imagery, audio and video taken at Arizona Athletics events is restricted to editorial purposes; these guidelines are covered in materials issued to reporters, editors and photographers upon receipt of credentials and/or access. They include guidelines on live Internet reporting, notably live description of statistics and/or play-by-play and uses of visual imagery — rules strengthened for televised games.

CREDENTIALS

Credentials will be issued to professional members of media outlets that regularly cover Arizona Athletics and to regional, national or visiting professional journalists. SEASON OPENER: No. 21 Arizona opens the 2024 season against unranked New Mexico at Arizona Stadium. Kickoff is scheduled for 7:30 p.m. MST on ESPN. Brian Custer (PXP), Rod Gilmore (Analyst), and Lauren Sisler (Sideline) are the announcers. Arizona enters the 2024 season ranked No. 21 in the Coaches and AP Top 25 after winning seven straight games to close last season. The Wildcats capped the season with a 38-24 win over No. 12 Oklahoma in the Valero Alamo Bowl. Arizona hosts New Mexico for the first time since Dec. 19, 2015. The No. 21 Wildcats open their 121st season of football in Southern Arizona with an old fashion rivalry game against New Mexico out of the Mountain West.

WILD WEST RIVALRY: The Cats defeated the Lobos in that 2015 meeting, 45-37, to complete a 7-6 season with a New Mexico Bowl victory. Arizona holds 44-20-3 record against New Mexico all time. The Wildcats possess the longest winning streak in the series of 10 games from 1947-1956. New Mexico defeated Arizona four straight from 1962-1965 for its longest winning streak in match up history. Arizona is 23-10-1 overall at home and 21-10-2 all-time on the road against New Mexico. Arizona has won five of the last seven meetings with New Mexico but dropped their most recent home matchup 29-27 on Sept. 15, 2007. These two programs have a rivalry dating back 1908 when Arizona took down New Mexico 10-5 on Nov. 26 in Albuquerque. From 1938 to 1990 when the winner of the game took ownership of the Kit Carson Rifle. The gun is a Springfield Model 1866 rifle that is rumored to have once belonged to the famous frontier scout, Kit Carson. Game scores from each game are carved into the stock of the rifle. Prior to the 1997 Insight.com Bowl, the two schools announced that they would retire the rifle, and it has not been used during any subsequent meetings.

REMEMBER THE ALAMO: The Wildcats win over Oklahoma in the Alamo Bowl was their first win since the 2015 New Mexico Bowl win over the Lobos (W, 45-37). Arizona clinched a seven-game winning streak to close the 2023 season, matching the longest single-season winning streak in program history (2x; last, 1998). Arizona earned five wins over ranked teams in 2023, the most ranked wins in a single season in program history. Arizona's 14-point win over Oklahoma in the 2023 Alamo Bowl was its largest margin of victory in a bowl game since defeating Boston College by 23 points in the 2013 AdvoCare V100 Bowl. The margin of victory marked the third largest in a bowl game in school history. Returning wide receiver Tetairoa McMillan (160 yards) and alumnus Jacob Cowing (152 yards) each tallied games over 100 yards receiving, making the Alamo Bowl the first bowl game in Arizona history with a pair of 100-yard receivers. Quarterback Noah Fifita threw for 354 yards marking the second most in a bowl game in program history (1st; Matt Scott, 382 yards, 2012 New Mexico Bowl). Cowing earned Offensive MVP and safety Gunner Maldonado earned Defensive MVP..

NEW ERA: Arizona's new Head Coach Brent Brennan takes the helm of the Wildcats after seven seasons as the Head Coach of San Jose State. Brennan, 51, is an experienced leader in college football who enjoyed two stints coaching under legendary Arizona head coach Dick Tomey, the winningest coach in program history. The San José native first learned under Tomey with the Wildcats as a graduate assistant in 2000, and again from 2005-09 at SJSU as an assistant coach. The ties between Brennan and the University of Arizona run deep, with Brent's brother Bradley playing five years as a wide out in Tucson under Tomey, and Brent's wife Courtney being an alumna of the University. Among a multitude of accomplishments at San José State, Brennan became the first head coach in SJSU history to lead the Spartans to three bowl games in a four-year span. He also steered SJSU to back-to-back winning seasons in 2022 and 2023, marking the first time it had been accomplished by the Spartans since the 1991-92 campaigns. The 2023 season at San José State saw Brennan's Spartans charge down the final stretch of the season, winning six consecutive conference games to close out the regular season and earn a bowl berth. During that six-game stretch Brennan's offense averaged over 38 points per game while the defense held opponents to a meager 17.8 points per game. SJSU's offensive efforts were fueled by ball security, turning the ball over just 10 times, the best mark in the Mountain West

and the ninth best in the nation. The trend was continued from the 2022 campaign in which the Spartans led the country with only six turnovers on offense and a +12 turnover margin that led the MWC.

NEW FACES FROM NEW PLACES: The Wildcats return a veteran core of the roster including Noah Fifita, Tetairoa McMillan, Jonah Savaiinaea, Josh Baker, Montana Lemonious-Craig, Rayshon Luke, Leif Magnuson, Wendell Moe (pronounced Moi) Jr., Justin Flowe, Jacob Manu, Gunner Maldonado, Treydan Stukes, Dalton Johnson, Tacario Davis, and Ta'ita'i Uiagalelei to the 2024 roster that has mixed in newcomers to make up the team. Of the 109 players on the roster, the Wilcats return 65 and add 44 newcomers. Of the 43 newcomers, 31 are transfers from junior college (7) or FBS/FCS transfers (24) and 12 true freshmen joining the roster in 2024.

WELCOME TO THE BIG 12: The Arizona Wildcats embark on a new journey in a new conference after joining the Big 12 in Aug. 2024. The Wildcats end an era of Pac-10/12 that began in 1978 and finished with a 277-256-7 record while playing in the Pac-10/12, including a 171-202-6 Conference record over 45 years in the conference. The legendary Dick Tomey led the Wildcats through 13 years of the Pac-10/12 Conference and recorded the most wins of any head coach in program history (95).

10 WINS IN 2023: The Wildcats closed out the 2023 season with 10 wins, reaching the double-digit win total for the first time since 2014 and just the fourth time in school history (2023, 2014, 1998, and 1993 seasons). Arizona tied its longest single season winning streak with seven straight victories to close the 2023 campaign.

POLL POSITION: The Wildcats earned the No. 21 spot in the preseason US LBM Coaches Poll and AP Top 25. It is the first time since 2015 that Arizona was ranked in the preseason polls, marking the highest preseason AP ranking for the Wildcats since 1999, when they were ranked fourth. Arizona is the fifth ranked Big 12 team with Utah (12), Oklahoma State (17), Kansas State (18), and Kansas (22) all ranked in the preseason poll. Arizona currently has two ranked opponents on its 2024 schedule featuring No. 12 Utah and No. 18 Kansas State.

WILDCATS IN THE NFL: Arizona currently has 14 players on NFL rosters heading into the 2024 season. Former offensive lineman Jordan Morgan was selected by the Green Bay Packers in the first round (25th overall) following the 2023 season. He was the first first-round selection since Antoine Cason was picked 27th overall in 2008. He joined a list that includes Cason (2008; 27th, San Diego), Trung Canidate (2000; 31st, St. Louis), Chris McAlister (1999; 10th, Baltimore), John Fina (1992; 27th, Buffalo), Chris Singleton (1990; 8th, New England), Anthony Smith (1990; 11th, Oakland), Rickey Hunley (1984; 7th, Cincinnati), Mike Dawson (1976; 22nd, Arizona), Bill Lueck (1968; 26, Green Bay), and Walt Nelson (1939; 10th, New York Giants) to be selected in the first round of the NFL Draft. Wide receiver Jacob Cowing was picked in the fourth round (135th overall) by the San Francisco 49ers and became the highest wide receiver selected since Mike Thomas in 2009 (4th Rd, 107 overall by Jacksonville) and the first wide receiver since Juron Criner (5th Rd, 168th overall by Oakland) in 2012. Tight End Tanner McLachlan was the third Wildcat selected in the 2024 NFL Draft when the Cincinnati Bengals picked him the 6th round (194 overall). The three draft picks matched the most selected in one draft since 2014 when Ka'Deem Carey (4th Rd, 117 overall), Shaquille Richardson (5th Rd, 157th overall), and Marquis Flowers (6th Rd, 212 overall) were picked in the 2014 NFL Draft.

RECAP

ALBUQUERQUE, N.M. (AP) — At the beginning of the season, Arizona began with much promise after a previous Pac-12 championship appearance and a 3-0 start. The Wildcats were hit with injuries to quarterback Anu Solomon and All-America linebacker Scooby Wright III.

On Saturday, both came back to help Arizona (7-6) hold off pesky New Mexico 45-37 in a wild New Mexico Bowl.

Solomon threw for two touchdowns and rushed for another score against New Mexico (7-6) in a game that saw New Mexico surge late after being down as many of 18 points. Wright had two sacks and 11 solo tackles.

After the game, Wright announced he would enter the NFL draft.

Arizona's high-temp offense needed only 19:08 minutes of possession time to overwhelm New Mexico in the Lobos' first bowl appearance since 2007.

Jared Baker ran for 107 yards and three touchdowns, and Cayleb Jones had 182 yards receiving and a touchdown.

For Arizona, the New Mexico Bowl win comes just a year after Arizona eyed a playoff spot. Rodriguez said a bowl appearance and a victory was just fine for the team.

Meanwhile, New Mexico quarterback Lamar Jordan rushed for three touchdowns and threw a 92-yard touchdown pass to Delane Hart-Johnson before leaving in the third quarter with a knee injury. However, Jordan tossed two key interceptions - one in Arizona's end zone and another deep in New Mexico territory.

After Jordan's departure, the Lobos then turned to a committee of running backs to get New Mexico back in the game.

Still, Arizona was able to hold star running back Jhurrell Pressley to 75 rushing yards and no touchdowns.

It was New Mexico's first bowl game appearance under Davie, a former Norte Dame head coach who took over the program in 2012. The game at its home-field New Mexico Bowl had excited the city of Albuquerque following the long bowl drought.

Arizona is 9-10-1 in bowl games. New Mexico fell to 3-8-1 in the postseason.

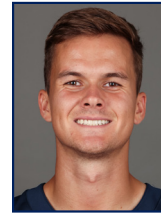

Brent Brennan became the next Head Coach of Arizona Football in January of 2024. Brennan enters his first season following seven seasons leading the San José State University football program where he steered the Spartans to three bowl game appearances and earned 2020 Mountain West Coach of the Year.

Brennan, 51, is an experienced leader in college football who enjoyed two stints coaching under legendary Arizona head coach Dick Tomey, the winningest coach in program history. The San José native first learned under Tomey with the Wildcats as a graduate assistant in 2000, and again from 2005-09 at SJSU as an assistant coach. The ties between Brennan and the University of Arizona run deep, with Brent's brother Bradley playing five years as a wide out in Tucson under Tomey, and Brent's wife Courtney being an alumna of the University.

Among a multitude of accomplishments at San José State, Brennan became the first head coach in SJSU history to lead the Spartans to three bowl games in a four-year span. He also steered SJSU to back-to-back winning seasons in 2022 and 2023, marking the first time it had been accomplished by the Spartans since the 1991-92 campaigns.

Throughout Brennan's lengthy and accomplished career, he helped develop five All-Americans and 19 Professional Football players, including six who enjoyed NFL careers of five-plus seasons.

The 2023 season at San José State saw Brennan's Spartans charge down the final stretch of the season, winning six consecutive conference games to close out the regular season and earn a bowl berth. During that six-game stretch Brennan's offense averaged over 38 points per game while the defense held opponents to a meager 17.8 points per game. SJSU's offensive efforts were fueled by ball security, turning the ball over just 10 times, the best mark in the Mountain West and the ninth best in the nation. The trend was continued from the 2022 campaign in which the Spartans led the country with only six turnovers on offense and a +12 turnover margin that led the MWC.

Across time as a coach and player, Brennan has been part of nine teams that reached bowl games including in each of the last two years at San José State. The highlight of his SJSU tenure was a remarkable 7-1 campaign in 2020 that secured the Spartans their first Mountain West Conference championship and the school's first outright conference championship since topping the Big West in 1990.

Since that impressive 2020 season under Brennan's leadership, the Spartans have posted a 20-10 record against Mountain West competition and went 26-19 overall.

Brennan twice had the opportunity to learn from Dick Tomey, first as a graduate assistant at Arizona in 2000 and again as an assistant coach at San José State from 2005-09. His crossover with Tomey at SJSU included the Spartans impressive 9-4 campaign in 2006 that concluded with a victory over the University of New Mexico in the New Mexico Bowl. That 2006 season orchestrated by Tomey and Brennan still stands as one of just 14 nine-plus win seasons in SJSU history.

A former wide receiver during his playing days, Brennan has long been regarded as an exceptional offensive mind. Players recruited and coached by Brennan litter the San José State receiving record books, while his time at Oregon State from 2001-15 included the mentorship of numerous standouts highlighted by 2013 Biletnikoff Award winner Brandin Cooks.

Prior to his second stint in San José, Brennan logged six seasons coaching wide receivers at Oregon State where he and the offensive staff fielded some of the most dangerous offenses in the country. The Beavers passing attack was explosive and relentless, ranking top 20 nationally in 2011 (19th), 2012 (20th), and 2013 (3rd).

Brennan also logged time with Cal Poly (2001-04) as an assistant coach. He opened his coaching career with Woodside High School in California before securing a trio of one-year graduate assistant positions at Hawai'i (1998), Washington (1999), and Arizona (2000).

His playing career spanned five seasons at UCLA as a wide receiver, where he lettered as part of the Bruins 1993 Rose Bowl team. Brennan earned a degree in history from UCLA in 1996.

Brennan and his wife Courtney are the proud parents to two daughters, Blake and Casey, and one son, Scott.
