OUTLOOK

Head Coach Jon Newman-Gonchar's Lobos are coming off their third-straight winning season and Mountain West Tournament appearance, most recently breaking through with a run to the conference semis after finishing the season tied for fourth in the standings – their best finish since 2015. UNM's five-set win over host UNLV in the First Round of last year's conference tournament was the Lobos' first semifinals appearance under the current format as well as their first win in the conference tournament since 2006.

UNM has elevated to another level of consistency in the past three seasons under Newman-Gonchar, winning 62.2% of its matches overall and 53.7% in conference matchups, with a 25-13 (.658) record at home in that span. Finishing 2023 at 19-12 overall and 10-8 in MW

play, Newman-Gonchar moved up to No. 3 among UNM coaches (tenured five or more seasons) in winning percentage (.530) and No. 2 in conference win percentage (.453) since the Lobos joined the Mountain West.

Last year's Lobos led the conference in opponent hitting percentage (.180) and digs (1,823 total; 15.58 per set) while ranking second in blocks (286 total; 2.44 per set), making it back-to-back years in which they pace the MW in opponent hitting and digs.

But this time around, they'll be doing it without five of last year's starters, bringing in a variety of experienced transfers to bolster a group of returners with expanded roles. UNM's new-look roster features 11 newcomers and six returners – Woods (107 sets played in 2023) and sophomore Libero Giselle Groe (75 sets played) both return after becoming pivotal rotation pieces in 2023.

Among six transfers joining the Lobos for the 2024 season, four already have three or more seasons of D-I experience under their belts and three are playing their fifth collegiate season.

Alongside them, returning letterwinners Lauryn Payne, Madison Blanco and Angela Crosetti all look to play bigger roles this fall, with five true freshmen giving the Lobos depth all over the court. Here's a look at this year's Lobos ahead of their first exhibition against New Mexico Highlands on August 23:

OUTSIDES/OPOSITES

Last fall, the Lobos leaned on the All-Conference outside duo of Kaitlynn Biassou (382 kills, 267 digs, 31 aces) and Uxue Guereca (393 kills, 342 digs, 30 aces) to keep the offense humming – Biassou and Guereca combined for 54% of UNM's kills in their final season before graduating.

The Lobos' only returning outside from last season, Junior Lauryn Payne will look to see her role grow in 2024 after appearing in 119 sets in her first two seasons in Albuquerque. Payne heated up down the stretch in 2023, finishing with multiple kills in seven of the final 11 games after only doing it four times in her first 15 appearances.

Three D-I transfers give UNM new attacking options with real experience - grad transfers Jada Bouyer (Toledo) and Kialah Jefferson (VCU) bring 576 combined set appearances to Albuquerque, coming off a 2023 season in which Bouyer racked up 286 kills to go with 71 total blocks and Jefferson finished with 280 kills and 294 digs. They'll be joined by junior transfer Naomi Chankoumi, who accumulated 250 kills across 121 sets in two seasons at CSU Bakersfield. Chankoumi notched a career-high 12 kills against the Lobos last season at The Pit on August 31, going on to finish the season with the third-most kills on the team (117) while averaging 2.06 kills per set.

A pair of true freshmen - Amanda Tremmeroli (Phoenix, Ariz.) and Seenane Brewer (Lawrence, Kan.) - round things out, with both in the mix to compete for spots in

the rotation.

LIBEROS

The Lobos have no shortage of options to fill out the back row, either - they return both their Liberos from last season in Giselle Groe (25 matches played, 181 digs, 55 assists) and Angela Crosetti (19 matches played, 246 digs, 42 assists) while bringing in an all-conference grad transfer in Falanika Danielson (Temple) and getting junior Madison Blanco (32 sets played in 2022) back after an injury redshirt last season.

Groe made her first appearance as a Libero in UNM's 3-0 sweep on UNLV on Oct. 5 and was the first Libero off the bench for the rest of the season, averaging 2.68 digs per set in conference matches and finishing with double-digit digs in nine of UNM's final 16 matches. Crosetti appeared in 60 sets on the season, earning MW Defensive Player of the Week honors and finishing the season with a team-high 4.10 digs per set.

A 2020 AAC Libero of the Year during her time at Temple, Danielson joins the Lobos as a fifth-year transfer with 408 set appearances across 108 matches under her belt - she averaged 3.71 digs per set

(1,471 total) across four seasons of play at Temple.

SETTERS

It's shaping up to be quite the battle for the starting setter spot this fall, with rising sophomore Madeleine Miller and incoming grad transfer Sohila Wafeek (UIC).

Miller saw her role grow throughout the season as a true freshman off the bench in 2023, appearing in 61 sets over 23 matches -- she surpassed double-digit assists six times in the Lobos' final 11 games, averaging 3.19 assists per set in matches in which she saw action in three or more sets.

Meanwhile, Wafeek brings a bevy of experience at the position to Albuquerque for her final collegiate season -- the Egyptian national finished her four-year UIC career ninth in program history in assists (3,047) and averaged 8.28 assists per set in 368 set appearances there.

The Lobos' third setter is a local product -- true freshman Marian Hatch of Rio Rancho. The five-year letterwinner for Cleveland HS and four-time All-Metro selection gives UNM a different look at setter after she graduated early to practice with the Lobos in the spring.

MIDDLES

Replacing the contributions of 6-5 senior Athina Dimitriadis, who ranked among the best in program history in blocks and hitting efficiency in her one season as a Lobo in 2023, will be a tall order (no pun intended). But after a breakout year in which she ranked No. 4 in the MW and No. 82 in the nation in blocks per set (1.14), Elizabeth Woods looks poised to lead the Lobos at the net alongside Norwegian transfer sophomore Liepa Lavickyte (Oregon State) and a pair of highly-touted true freshmen in Reagan Miller (Birmingham, Ala.) and Zoe Leonard (Phoenix, Ariz.).

JOHNSON CENTER IS BOOMING

The Lobos have seen an increase in attendance in each season since 2019 -- not counting the 2020-21 season that limited attendance due to the COVID pandemic -- and UNM's average attendance of 841 per home game last season was its highest since 2016 (1,248) and highest of Newman-Gonchar's tenure. Saturday's Senior Day brought in 1,589 fans to the Johnson Center -- the highest-attended Lobo Volleyball game of the season. In 2023 overall (including three games at The Pit), the Lobos' average of 956 fans per game is the highest since 2016 -- including seven games with over 1,000 in attendance.

- 7 All-Conference selections (2 in 2023, 2 in 2022, 1 in Spring 2021, 2 in 2021, 1 honorable mention in 2019)
- 10 semesters in a row over in which the team posts a 3.4 GPA or better
- 5-time AVCA All-Academic Award
- Reached 65th in the RPI on Oct. 3, 2022, the highest RPI under Coach Newman-Gonchar

Jon Newman-Gonchar became the 10th head volleyball coach at the University of New Mexico on Jan. 21, 2019.

The Lobos have sustained success under Newman-Gonchar and have made the MW Tournament each of the past two years that it has been held. The Lobos have achieved a winning record in each of the last 3 years (56-34, 62.2%) with 20 wins in 2021 the most for the program since 2013. Finishing 2023 at 19-12 overall and 10-8 in MW play, Newman-Gonchar moved up to No. 3 among UNM coaches (tenured five or more seasons) in winning percentage (.530) and No. 2 in conference win percentage (.453) since the Lobos joined the Mountain West. This past season, the Lobos led the MW in digs, digs per set and in opp. hitting %, and in conference matches, led the MW in digs (1146) and digs per set (16.14), 2nd in the MW in opponent hitting % (.188) and blocks (175) and blocks per set (2.46). UNM finished 54th in the NCAA in total digs (1830) and 64th in digs per set (15.64).

UNM swept CSU at Fort Collins for the 2nd time in program history and for the first time in program history, won in Laramie and Fort Collins in the same year, which included Coach Newman-Gonchar reaching the 50-win milestone in a sweep at Colorado State on Nov. 10, 2022.

UNM finished the Fall 2021 regular season 20-9, 11-7 in conference, the first time with 20 wins since 2013 and the 11 conference wins the most since 2014. It also signified the first winning record for the program since 2015, and with 12 sweeps and 10 home wins, the most sweeps in a season since 2017 and the most home wins for the program since 2015.

In his first year at UNM, the Lobos got stronger as the season went on, finishing the season winning five of the last seven matches. In the classroom, the Lobos

posted two of the highest GPAs recorded in program history during the 2019-20 academic year, posting a program-best 3.77 in the fall semester and an equally impressive 3.74 in the spring. As a result, the team was named to the USMC/AVCA (American Volleyball Coaches Association) Team Academic Honor Roll, one of 46 teams to earn the additional distinction.

The Lobo head coach has served under renowned volleyball coaches such as Arkansas's Jason Watson, Iowa State's Christy Johnson-Lynch and former Loyola Marymount coach, USA Women's National Team assistant and current Georgia head coach Tom Black.

Newman-Gonchar took over at the helm of the Lobos after serving as the associate head coach at the University of Arkansas for the previous three seasons. In his last season in Fayetteville, a pair of Razorbacks earned AVCA All-South Region honors, giving Arkansas at least one All-Region honor in each of his three seasons with the program. The year prior, the Razorbacks went 19-11. "I'm excited to welcome Jon and have him be our head volleyball coach," said Eddie Nuñez, Director of Athletics. "We wanted someone with a wide breadth of experience and someone that will bring excitement and championships to Lobo Volleyball. Jon has been at all levels of Division I and he has tremendous national team experience. We look forward to having Jon and his wife Morgan join the Lobo family."

Prior to Arkansas, Newman-Gonchar was an assistant coach at Iowa State in Ames. With the Cyclones, the program went 56-31 overall, including 32-16 in Big 12 play. Iowa State defeated five ranked teams over those three seasons, finished as high as second in the Big 12, and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament twice.

Individually, Newman-Gonchar coached his student-athletes to four AVCA All-America certificates, six AVCA All-Region honors and 18 All-Big 12 selections including a trio of Big 12 Libero of the Year honors and the 2015 Big 12 Freshman of the Year. In his three seasons at Iowa State, he worked directly with the team's setters and middle blockers.

Newman-Gonchar has also had assistant coaching stops at Loyola Marymount (2010-12) and UC San Diego with both the men's and women's teams (2007-09) and Louisiana-Lafayette (2006). He also has been an assistant coach with the Thompson Rivers University men's volleyball team in British Columbia, and he was a volunteer assistant coach at his alma mater Northern Arizona.

A native of Claremont, Calif., Newman-Gonchar earned his bachelor's degree in health sciences in December 2005 from Northern Arizona. He and his wife Morgan have two children, Hudson and Grayson.



APRIL SANCHEZ

ASSOCIATE HEAD COACH / RECRUITING COORDINATOR

April Sanchez joined Jon Newman-Gonchar's staff at UNM as an assistant coach in June 2019 and was promoted to associate head coach in March 2023.

"April has been a key contributor to the rise of Lobo Volleyball, and every piece of this program has been impacted positively by her incredible work ethic and insights," commented Newman-Gonchar at the time of her promotion. "I am thrilled to be able to name her my associate head coach."

"UNM Volleyball is the lucky recipient of yet another great coach and an even better person wanting

to come help make us better," said Newman-Gonchar. "We are incredibly grateful that April chose to come to UNM and thrilled for not only our student-athletes, but the broader Albuquerque community. Our region just gained another fantastic volleyball ambassador for our great sport in the community."

With the Lobos, Sanchez serves as UNM's defensive coordinator, overseeing defensive efforts, as well as working with liberos and defensive specialists. Off the court, she serves as a community coordinator, directing and coordinating UNM's summer camps, and planning and organizing UNM's volunteer work in the community.

Under Sanchez' guidance, the Lobos have led the Mountain West in opponent hitting percentage in each of the last three seasons as they rolled to three straight MW Tournament appearances, pacing the league in total digs and digs per set in both 2022 and 2023 after ranking second in 2021. UNM's 1,830 total digs in 2022 and 1,823 in 2023 were the fifth-

and sixth-most in a single season in program history, and the Lobos have held opponents to an .180 hitting percentage combined across the last three seasons — no other Mountain West team has even held opponents below .190 in the same span.

In her first season as Associate Head Coach, the Lobos finished tied for fourth in the MW standings — their best finish since 2014 — and outlasted UNLV in five sets in the first round of the conference tournament for their first postseason win since 2006.

Sanchez came to UNM having spent the previous four seasons at Idaho State as an assistant coach. With the Bengals, Sanchez was responsible for scouting opponents, film and stat analysis, camp coordination and assisted in recruiting.

In February 2020, Sanchez served as a court assistant as well as a technical assistant at the U.S. Women's National Team Open Tryout held at the U.S. Olympic Training Center. Most recently, Sanchez attended the NCAA Women Coaches Academy in 2018, which is designed for women coaches to increase their individual effectiveness by learning skills and strategies that directly impact personal and team success.

Prior to working at Idaho State, Sanchez served as the head volleyball coach at Colorado Northwestern Community College for two seasons and prior to that, was an assistant coach at CNCC for three years.

Sanchez graduated from Lamar Community College in December 2007, where she had a successful collegiate career in which she was named to the 2007 All-Region IX volleyball team and the 2007 South Region IX volleyball team. In addition, she earned the 2007-08 American Volleyball Coaches Association Team Academic Award.

After graduating from LCC, Sanchez went on to attend Colorado Mesa University where she graduated with a bachelor's degree in history in May 2011.



MATT KUELPMAN

ASSISTANT COACH / OFFENSIVE COORDINATOR

Matt Kuelpman joined the UNM program in March 2023.

In Kuelpman's first season as an assistant coach and offensive coordinator, the Lobos averaged 12.26 kills per set, with Uxue Guereca (393 kills) and Kaitlynn Biassou (382 kills) both recording nearly 400 kills each en route to All-MW honors. UNM finished tied for fourth in the conference standings for the Lobos' third-straight MW Tournament appearance, outlasting UNLV in five sets in the first round to advance to the conference semis. Kuelpman comes to UNM from Weber State, where

he was the assistant coach for the past four seasons and also served as the recruiting coordinator for its 2023 and 2035 classes. During his time with the Wildcats, his responsibilities included coaching the backrow defense and coordinating the offense during matches,

coaching the team's blocking, serving, and defensive strategies, and oversaw the team's travel and camps. While he was with Weber State, the Wildcats improved in digs per set, kills per set and won the Big Sky Championship for the second time in program history. In 2019, Weber State competed in the NIVC tournament and advanced to the quarterfinals after beating MW opponents Boise State and Wyoming.

"Matt brings a rich background in the technical and tactical aspects of high level volleyball," notes Newman-Gonchar. "He comes from a great line of coaches who know what it takes to win on and off the court. We are fired up to have his skill set on staff and can't wait for him to begin."

Weber State had its best season in school history in 2020, going 15-1 and won the first-ever Big Sky regular season title in program history and later won the first conference tournament championship since 1988. The Wildcats repeated as conference champions in 2021, and from 2019 through 2021, the Wildcats won 25-straight matches at home for the longest home winning streak in the nation.



NICK ZIEGELMANN

DIRECTOR OF OPERATIONS / TECHNICAL COORDINATOR

Ziegelmann joins UNM after working outside of college sports for the past five years — he most recently served as Vice President of Business Development at ICON International, a specialized finance company where he worked with finance, marketing and legal teams to coordinate media and procurement for clients. He's also served as Director of New Business after working in sales operations and serving as a national media associate during his time there dating back to October 2019.

"We knew from the very first phone call that Nick had what we were looking for," said Newman-Gonchar on the hire. "He's driven to learn and wants to be the best

servant leader he can — plus he has the interpersonal skills that will allow him to thrive in all the

demands that the job requires."

Before that, Ziegelmann worked as a team manager and social media strategist for Washington State's Women's Volleyball team for two years, assisting with video work, practice planning and management of the team's social media channels. The Cougars reached the NCAA Tournament in both seasons, going all the way to the Sweet 16 in 2018.

"I'm excited to join the all-star cast of UNM staff and student athletes to help advance the incredible sport of volleyball," Ziegelmann said. "Thank you to Coach Jon, April [Sanchez], and Matt [Kuelpman] for this fantastic opportunity."

A five-time honor roll member at WSU, Ziegelmann graduated in 2019 with a BS in Economic Sciences, double majoring in Business Administration as well as Sport Management.

"We're thrilled to have Nick on board," Newman-Gonchar said. "His positive impact will be felt immediately — the fall can't get here fast enough!"

THE JOHNSON CENTER

The 2024 season will mark the 25th straight season in which the Johnson Center is Lobo Volleyball's primary home court. Its two-level seating, with bleachers on the floor level opposite the benches and mezzanine seats surrounding the entirety of the court, has allowed Lobo fans to pack the venue for home games consistently while still feeling up close and personal.

The Lobo faithful have piled into Johnson to root for Lobo Volleyball from the program's inception until 1996 when they moved to The Pit, where they averaged 1,026 people per game from 1996-1999. UNM returned to the Johnson Center in 2000, and in the nearly quarter-century since, UNM has had eight of its 15 highest-attended seasons in program history, breaking the program record in total and average attendance in back-to-back seasons in 2009 and 2010 when they went to the NCAA Tournament in both years. In 2010, the Lobos averaged 2,232 fans during its 15 home matches, good for tops in the MW and 12th in the nation in attendance.



More recently in the Jon Newman-Gonchar Era, total and average attendance has risen in each of the last three seasons since the COVID pandemic. UNM finished the 2021 season with 7,481 total attendees for a 575 average, improving to 10,094 total in 2022 (841 average). In 2023, they improved again to 12,433 total with an average of 956 per game — the highest since 2016 (1,248) and highest of Newman-Gonchar's tenure. Senior Day in 2023 brought in 1,589 fans to the Johnson Center — the highest-attended Lobo Volleyball game of the season. With the 2023 home schedule (including three games at The Pit for the Lobo Invitational) now complete, the Lobos' average of 956 fans per game is the highest since 2016 — including seven games with over 1,000 in attendance.



In Johnson Center, the Lobos have exclusive access to the Lobo Team Room. This room features work areas and computers to study, a leather couch for a little relaxation and numerous awards and plaques that decorated the walls to remind the team of its successful past. Outside the team room, UNM's All-Americans are honored as their jerseys are showcased. Across the hall is the Lobo Alumni Wall, which features autographs from former players.

DIRECTIONS:

Johnson Center is located on the southern end of UNM's main campus, just off Central Avenue. Take the Central Avenue exit off of I-25 and head east on Central Avenue. Take a left on Yale and a right on to Redondo Road. Johnson Center will be on the left after the parking garage. There are two parking areas, the parking garage located in front of the Johnson Center and Lot A across the street (Redondo Road) from the Johnson Center.

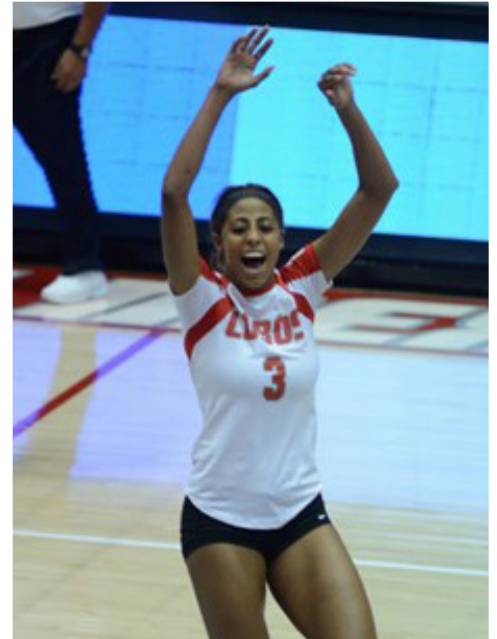
