

LOBO NOTES

WHAT'S TRENDING

- Presley Devey has scored the game-winning goal in three matches (UCR, Oregon, San Diego), Ellie Robinson in one (vs. UTEP) and Nicole Anderson in one (Nevada).
 - Natalie DeGagne has recorded an assist in three matches and has a point in four matches this season with a goal in the season opener.
- The Lobos have used six different lineup variations this season.
- Four Lobos have played over 90% of the minutes this season: Kennedy Brown (735'), Fiona Jenkins (751'), DeGagne (744') and Callie Droitsch (809') with five playing over 700 minutes.
- Six Lobos have started all nine matches this season: Devey, DeGagne, Nicole Anderson, Brown, Jenkins, and Droitsch.
- UNM had four field players play the fulltime against UCSB: Jenkins, Morgan Juran, Taryn Robles and Natalie DeGagne, with Droitsch also going the length of the match in net. Robles, Brown and Juran played the full 90 against UTEP, as did Droitsch and Jenkins, Ashley Moody, DeGagne, Brown and Juran played the full 90 at NAU with Droitsch playing the full 90 in net. In the last match against Nevada, UNM had three players play the full 90 in defenders Robles, Jenkins and Ashley Moody.

THE WINNING RECIPE

- In four of UNM's wins, the Lobos scored first in the match and have held a lead at the break. Only in the UTEP match did the Lobos have to come from behind.
- In addition, the Lobos have outshot opponents 49-16 in the first 45 minutes and 44-29 in the second 45 minutes for a 93-45 edge (18.6-9.0 average) in shots in the wins.
- When it comes to shots on goal, the Lobos have outshot their opponents 39-14 in that category.
- UNM led for 79:08 in the match against UCR, 84:12 in the match against Oregon, 84:38 against San Diego and 85:49 against Nevada, for a total of 333:47.
- In both the Oregon and San Diego matches, the Lobos scored in the first six minutes with Alysa Whelchel scoring at 5:48 against the Ducks and Presley Devey scoring at 5:22 against USD. Devey also added another goal against Oregon at 9:10, a goal against UC Riverside at 10:52 and scored two in the first six minutes against Nevada, meaning six goals scored in the first 11 minutes of the matches.
- Callie Droitsch allowed two goals during the six-match unbeaten streak with four clean sheets, making 15 saves, including a career-best six in the match against NAU.
- In UNM's wins, Devey has scored six goals with one assist for 13 points, Nicole Anderson has scored four goals and Alysa Whelchel and Ellie Robinson have each scored one.
- UNM has already matched its win total from last season with at least nine matches left to play.

WAVE ON WAVE

- In UNM's win against Nevada on Sunday, the goals came in waves with a pair of goals being scored within minutes of each other in both the first and second half.
- Presley Devey got the scoring started at the 4:11 mark, with Morgan Juran finding Devey towards the arc at the top of the box, who turned to her right and sent a shot to the top right of the net off of her left foot. It was Juran's first career assist and the fastest goal scored this season by a Lobo, topping the goal Devey scored at the 5:22 mark on Sept. 1 against San Diego.

- Devey made it two goals less than two minutes later (5:59) off of a Nevada turnover, with the Lobo forward finding space and firing from distance, getting a little bit of luck as the ball hit off the left post, hitting the back of the Wolf Pack goalie and going into the back of the net to make it 2-0 in the first six minutes.
- The goals came in pairs again in the second half as Nicole Anderson recorded her first brace at 54:46, starting with a free kick by Callie Droitsch, who sent it past midfield and eventually was won by Alysa Whelchel, who passed it ahead to Anderson who was breaking towards the middle of the field and the goal, with the Lobo getting a right foot on it and sliding it bottom left and past the outstretched hand of the Nevada keeper to make it 4-0.
- A cross from Fiona Jenkins to Devey in the box at 56:16 led to Devey being taken down and the Lobos being awarded a penalty kick with Devey stepping up to take it. She notched the hat trick with a shot to the bottom right of the net for her team-high sixth goal of the season.

GOING BACK THROUGH THE RECORD BOOK

- It took some digging, but the Lobos achieved something that hadn't been done since 2008 on Sunday with Nicole Anderson and Presley Devey scoring multiple goals, the first time UNM had two multiple-goal scorers in a match since Sept. 28, 2008 against Central Arkansas (Kate Wyrick and Zaneta Wyne).
- Additionally, Sunday was the first time the Lobos have scored five goals against Nevada since Oct. 14, 2018 (5-1) and the most goals scored since Sept. 9, 2021 when the Lobos scored six goals against NAU.
- Devey became the first Lobo to record a hat trick since Jadyn Edwards did it against Cal State Bakersfield in 2022.

FIGHT UNTIL THE FINAL WHISTLE

- The Lobos found a different way to win against UTEP, scoring two goals in the final 6:58 to defeat UTEP 2-1 after UTEP opened the scoring in the 68th minute.
- Alysa Whelchel sent it up the field from the midfield area to Ellie Robinson, who stayed
 onside and gathered it outside the left side of the box with Robinson finding Nicole
 Anderson in the middle of the box, passing it between two Miner defenders, allowing
 Anderson to promptly go top left to even the match at one with 83:02 showing on the
 clock.
- The momentum continued to be on the home side as the Lobos went ahead with 1:09 left to play as Logan Nicholson sent a cross from outside the right side of the box, deflecting off of a Miner before it was collected by Robinson, with the Lobo turning and firing a shot off her right foot parallel from the penalty kick marker, finding the back of the net for the first time this season.

SERIES vs. BOISE STATE

- The Lobos are 9-5-2 all-time against the Broncos, 4-4-0 in matches played in Boise.
- BSU won the last meeting between the two teams, a 2-1 decision in Albuquerque, which snapped a three-match win streak for the Lobos. In the 2023 match, UNM had a 23-13 edge in shots and 9-6 in shots on goal with Sophia Roberts scoring in the 68th minute.
 Under Coach Dyche, the Lobos are 4-4-2, but 3-2-0 in Boise.
- The series has been evenly matched in goals scored with BSU holding a narrow 19-18 lead.
- UNM has seven clean sheets against BSU, has been shutout four times and is 7-3 in one-goal matches. Only once in the series has the match ended in a 0-0 draw (2016 at home).

JURAN, JENKINS AND ROBLES WILL DEFEND YOU

- UNM defenders Fiona Jenkins, Morgan Juran and Taryn Robles have been a solid and steady presence on the pitch with Jenkins playing 751 minutes this season and started all nine, 696 minutes for Robles who has started eight matches, and Juran at 717 minutes, who has started the last eight.
- Jenkins has played 90 minutes in seven matches, Juran in five and Robles in four.
- The Lobo defense didn't allow a shot by UC Riverside until the 55th minute and just one shot on goal, and allowed just one shot on goal again against San Diego. UNM allowed just five shots against USD and six against UCSB and New Mexico State.
- During the six-match unbeaten streak, the Lobos held opponents to 52 shots, 17 on goal, and allowed two goals. In the first half of the matches, opponents took a total of 24 shots, while the Lobo offense outscored opponents 4-1. UNM also shutout five of the six opponents in the final 45 minutes.

FRESHMAN JOINS THE DEFENSE FIRM

- Ashley Moody has joined the defense of late, starting the last three matches and playing a total of 329 minutes, including two matches of 90 minutes.
- The freshman made her first appearance against UTEP on Sept. 8 and playing 62 minutes, followed by her first start at Northern Arizona on Sept. 19, where she played the full 90.
- In the last three starts, Moody has played 90, 87 and 90 minutes.

DEVEY DELIVERS

- As noted previously, Presley Devey scored a goal in three-straight matches, with all three being the game-winner.
- Of note, her two goals in the first three matches of the season tied her career best in any of her three seasons (scored two goals last year), and her five points the week of Aug. 22 and Aug. 25 already surpassed her career best in points.
- Devey recorded her first hat trick against Nevada on Sept. 29, finishing with a career-high six points on three shots on goal and did so in 43 minutes of playing time.
- She leads the Lobos in points (13), goals (six) and shots (27), is second in shots on goal (11) and is tied for third in assists (one).
- Devey is averaging 1.44 points per match, 3.00 shots per match, 0.67 goals per match in 502 minutes.
- The Lobo's 13 points this season more than triples her point total from last season and her goal total triples her goals last season, doing so in nine matches, doing so in fewer shots on goal than last season (12 last season, 10 this season).

2024 NOTES | MATCH 10: AT BOISE STATE

- Devey is tied for first in the MW in goals and leads in goals per match (needing one fewer game to get six than Denise Castro, who has six goals in 10 matches). Her 13 points are tied for second in the conference, but her 1.44 points per match leads all players in the conference. Her three game-winning goals is the most by any player in the MW.
- Nationally, her three game-winning goals is tied for 19th by any player, her goals per match is 37th in the NCAA, her points per match is 60th and her total goals is 67th.

SOPHOMORE SHOWCASE

- The Lobos feature eight sophomores on the roster and of them, four have started all nine matches, two have started eight and one has started seven.
- Fiona Jenkins, Nicole Anderson, Callie Droitsch (redshirt) and Kennedy Brown (redshirt) have started all nine matches as a sophomore with Jenkins playing 751 minutes, Droitsch playing 809 minutes in net and Brown playing 735 minutes. Anderson has played 543 minutes and has four goals on the season, the second most on the team, and has the second-most points on the team with eight. Whelchel has started eight matches and has three assists and five points, with her assists tied for the most on the team and her points tied for third. Juran has played 717 minutes in her first season with the Lobos and recorded her first career assist against Nevada for her first career points.
 For Samantha Corrie, Whelchel and Droitsch, their first collegiate starts came this season.
- In each match this season, the Lobos have started either six or seven sophomores with six matches with seven sophomores starting. In the NAU match, with freshman Ashley Moody starting, the Lobos had a total of eight underclassmen starting.

PRESLEY'S POINTS PRODUCES MW POTW

- UNM junior forward Presley Devey scored two game-winning goals and contributed on three of the four goals scored by New Mexico, earning the Mountain West Offensive Player of the Week on Aug. 26.
- Devey led the Lobos with two goals and an assist on the week for a team-best five points, including one goal and one assist in the win against Oregon. Her assist on Alysa Whelchel's goal in the sixth minute to open the scoring was her first career assist, and combined with her own goal in the 10th minute, her three points in the match set a career high.
- Sunday's match was Devey's second game-winner on the week, as the Lobo scored the only goal of the match on Thursday against UC Riverside in the 11th minute.

FIRST TIME FOR EVERYTHING

- There have been several firsts for some Lobos this season:
- Alysa Whelchel scored her first career goal against Oregon with Presley Devey contributing on the goal for her first career assist.
- · Kennedy Brown recorded her first point on an assist against San Diego on Sept. 1.
- Callie Droitsch, Samantha Corrie and Taryn Robles all made their first career start in the season opener at New Mexico State.
- Droitsch earned her first win, a shutout against UC Riverside.
- Devey finished with three points in the Oregon match to set a career high, which she later topped against Nevada on Sept. 29 with a career-high three goals for a career-high six points and her first hat trick.
- Ashley Moody made her collegiate debut in the match against UTEP on Sept. 8 and made her first collegiate start in the next match at NAU, playing the full 90 minutes. She has since started the last three matches, twice playing 90 minutes.
- Devey played a career-high 74 minutes in the match at NAU and 59 minutes against UNLV. She needed nine matches to surpass her career high in minutes in a season (465:09 last season, 501:05 and counting this season).
- Ellie Robinson recorded her first game-winning goal against UTEP on Sept. 8 and finished with a career-best three points in the match.
- Alejandra Puerto made her first appearance as a Lobo against UNLV on Sept. 26, playing 27 minutes.
 Nicole Anderson recorded her first brace against Nevada on Sept. 29, scoring in the 29th minute and in the 55th minute for a career high in goals and points for the sophomore.
- After missing the last three seasons due to injury, Fatso Williams made her first appearance as a Lobo in the Sept. 29 match against Nevada, coming in to replace Callie Droitsch in goal for the final 1:26.

HOME WAS GOOD TO THE LOBOS

- UNM finished its five-match homestand at the beginning of the season 4-0-1 at home after defeating UC Riverside on Aug. 22 1-0, Oregon 3-1 on Aug. 25, San Diego 1-0 on Sept. 1, a 0-0 draw against UC Santa Barbara on Sept. 5 and a 2-1 win over UTEP on Sept. 8.
 During the homestand, the Lobos outscored their opponents 7-2, taking a 32-11 advantage in shots on goal and a 82-37 advantage in shots
- During the homestand, the Lobos outscored their opponents 7-2, taking a 32-11 advantage in shots on goal and a 82-37 advantage in shots (16.4 per match/ 7.4 per match).
- The five matches comprise half of UNM's total home matches this season.
- UNM is 49-22-12 at home under Coach Heather Dyche.

ROSTER RUNDOWN

- UNM brought in a total of 13 new players with eight freshmen and five transfers.
- Lobo Soccer rounded out the roster with five transfers, adding two forwards, a midfielder and two defenders. Joining the Lobos ahead of the 2024 season were Hayden Crowley (Washington), Logan Nicholson (New Hampshire), Samantha Corrie (Nebraska), Aléjandra Puerto (Fairmont State) and Morgan Juran (Elon).
- Between the five transfers, they've played in a combined 7748:43 minutes with 126 matches played and 85 starts prior to coming to UNM. They've accounted for 13 goals and nine assists for 35 points.
- Nicholson joined the program with the most minutes logged at 3112 and has started in 34 matches and appeared in 49. Second on the
 minutes amongst the group is Puerto, who played 2832 minutes and leads the group with 13 goals and seven assists for 33 points, which she
 accumulated in 35 matches and 33 starts throughout two years. In her lone year at Elon, Juran appeared in 1250 minutes with 14 starts and
 playing in all 17 matches, and Crowley played in 21 matches with four starts and 514 minutes in two seasons at Washington.
- Of the newcomers, Juran made her first start with the Lobos against UC Riverside and started eight matches while playing in all nine, Corrie has started seven matches and Nicholson has appeared in all nine matches. Puerto made her first appearance in the MW opener against UNLV.
- In addition, eight freshmen start their collegiate careers at UNM this season in Ashley Moody, Mackie McNulty, Ayla Dils, Gabby Beaudry, Savanah Sanchez, Sherry Diep, Macie Harris and Molly Adams. Moody has played in the last four matches, making her first start at NAU and starting in the last three.
- Of the eight, two come from Colorado (Moody and Beaudry), two from Washington (McNulty and Harris), two from New Mexico (Dils and Sanchez) and two from California (Diep and Adams).
- From Albuquerque, Dils comes from a family of Lobos with her mom and dad graduates of UNM. Her father, Alan Dils, played tennis at UNM from 1984-89 and later coached the program from 1996-2014. He is currently the all-time winningest coach in program history and was a five-time MW Coach of the Year.
- Also from Albuquerque, Sanchez won state championships in 2021, 2022 and 2023 and scored 170 goals and was credited with 67 assists for 407 points throughout her high school career. Her goals led all of New Mexico going back as far as 2002 and is second in New Mexico history in assists.

TALENTED TRIO

- Natalie DeGagne, Sophia Roberts and Alli Davis were picked for the 2024 Mountain West Women's Soccer Watch List comprised of three players from each school that is expected to lead their respective programs.
- Davis returns for her third season starting in the net, after starting all 36 matches in the last two seasons and made a career-best 75 saves last season.
- Roberts (team-high four goals) and DeGagne (three goals tied for second) were two of UNM's top-three goal scorers from a season ago with DeGagne and Roberts tied for the team lead in points in 2023 at nine.
- DeGagne led the Lobos with 48 shots, 17 shots on goal and finished tied for the team high in assists at three.



SOPHIA RETURNS

- Sophia Roberts returns as the top goal scorer from last season with four goals and tied for the team lead in points at nine. Her nine points triples her point total from the 2022 season (three points on one goal and one assist).
- The Lobo forward finished the season strong, scoring four goals in October with nine points, including a season-and career-high three in the second to last match against Wyoming.
- Eleven of Roberts' 30 shots were on goal and the Lobo averaged 1.76 shots and 0.53 points per match.
- In her three seasons at UNM, Roberts has started in all but five matches (the USD match last season, missed the matches against UCSB, UTEP and NAU, and didn't start against Nevada) and has played a total of 2773:48 minutes. She's played in 42 matches with 40 starts and has 13 career points behind five goals and three assists.
- Roberts opened the 2024 season with an assist on Natalie DeGagne's goal at New Mexico State in the 28'.

ALL ABOUT ALLI

- Keeper Alli Davis has started 36 matches for the Lobos and has 10 career shutouts with two combined shutouts to date.
- Three times in her career she's made eight saves, including twice last season (Texas Tech and Colorado) and against Utah State in 2022.
- To date, she carries a 79.9% save percentage and has 143 career saves (3.98 per match).
- Her first season in the net, Davis broke the UNM record for consecutive shutout minutes with 597.51, as well as the program record with six consecutive shutouts and in ties in a season with eight.
- Last season, she had nine matches with five or more saves.
- She has twice been named MW Defensive Player of the Week (Oct. 24, 2022 and first week of the season in 2023) and was MW Freshman of the Week on Oct. 24, 2022.

NATALIE NOTES

- UNM midfielder Natalie DeGagne is a veteran on the roster, with the Washington native in her fifth season with the Lobos.
- DeGagne has logged 3985:05, the most of any Lobo on the team, and has played in 68 matches with 43 starts.
- She has started the last 35 matches dating back to Colorado College on Oct. 2, 2022.
- DeGagne's production has increased in the last three seasons and has scored at least one goal in every season, which has held true this season. Last season was DeGagne's best to date behind three goals and three assists for nine points, an improvement from 2022 where she scored two goals and was credited with one assist for five points. Her minutes have also increased in the last two seasons, playing 1463 in 2022 and 1406 in 2023 after playing a combined 370 minutes in 23 matches her first two seasons. The midfielder led the Lobos in shots with 48 and in shots on goal at 17 in 2023, which was more shots (28) and shots on goal (13) than the
- previous three years combined.
- Twice last season DeGagne finished with three points (vs. Colorado State and Wyoming), which were two of the last three matches of the season. She took a career-high 10 shots against Colorado College, with a career-high four on goal.
- DeGagne has contributed at least one point in four of the matches in 2024, opening 2024 with a goal in the season opener at New Mexico State with a goal in the 28' and added an assist in three matches (against UC Riverside, Oregon and San Diego). DeGagne is tied for the team high in assists (three) and is second in shots (21) and tied for third in points (five). She has also played the full
- 90 minutes four times this season (New Mexico State, UC Riverside, UC Santa Barbara and at NAU), 76 minutes against Oregon, 70 minutes against San Diego, 87 against UTEP, 81 against UNLV and 72 against Nevada for 744 (91.9%) on the season. The Lobo is averaging 0.56 points per match, 2.33 shots per match and 0.33 assists per match with four shots in two of the last three matches and four shots in three matches on the season
- She is tied for sixth in the MW in assists per match and tied for eighth in assists.

SEEING DOUBLE

- UNM is one of 21 schools with a set of twins on the roster with Lobo sophomores Allie and Nicole Anderson.
- Other schools with twins on the roster are Lamar (two), North Dakota State (two), Wake Forest (two), Bucknell (one), Colorado (one), Davidson (one), Elon (one), Florida Atlantic (one), Grand Canyon (one), Maryland (one), Northwestern State (one), Ohio State (one), South Dakota State (one), Southeastern Louisiana (one), Syracuse (one), Texas A&M-Commerce (one), UC Irvine (one), UC San Diego (one), UMass (one) and Wright State (one).
- However, when it comes to sisters, there are over 40 schools with at least one pair of sisters on their roster. Of the teams that the Lobos will play this season, there is a pair of sisters on Abilene Christian, Boise State and New Mexico State.
- Nicole, a forward, changed her number from 25 to four this season and appeared in 17 matches with seven starts her freshman season. She scored her first collegiate goal at Nevada (which was the game-winner) and added two assists at UNLV. Nicole tied for the team high in assists with three, was fourth on the team in points with five, and had the second-most shots on goal with 14 (of 25 total shots). She made her first collegiate start at Fresno State on Sept. 24, 2023 and started the final six matches of the 2023 season.
- Allie, a defender, appeared in 11 matches and made her first collegiate start in the final match of the 2023 season at San Diego State.

PRESEASON PREDICTIONS

- The Lobos were picked fifth in the Mountain West Preseason Women's Soccer Coaches' Poll with 76 points.
- San Diego State was picked as the conference preseason favorite with eight first-place votes, Utah State (107 points, two first-place votes) and Colorado State (two first-place votes) and Boise State, both with 99 points, were picked ahead of UNM.
- Behind the Lobos was a large gap with Nevada (56 points) and Fresno State and UNLV each with 55 points, and from there was further separation with Air Force (37 points), San José State (34 points), Wyoming (32 points) and Colorado College rounding out the preseason picks with 25 points.
- Of note, New Mexico plays all but one team ahead of them in the poll on the road this season with the lone exception the final conference match against San Diego State.

HOME GROWN

- The Lobos feature 10 players from The Land of Enchantment on the 2024 roster.
- Kennedy Brown, Dalis Bruce, Ayla Dils, Alix Hailey, Zaria Katesigwa, Mercedes Morris, Sophia Roberts, Taryn Robles, Savanah Sanchez and Fatso Williams all hail from New Mexico, joined by head coach Heather Dyche, who is a 1997 graduate of Eldorado High School and was a four-vear all-state
- defender, a two-time district Player of the Year and the 1996 Defensive Player of the Year. She also played basketball for the Eagles and was a first-team all-state performer two years.

A DECADE OF GREATNESS

- Head coach Heather Dyche enters her 10th season at the helm of the Lobos.
- She is also on the verge on a milestone at UNM, four wins away from her 100th win.
- Coach is 96-55-30 and 57-28-16 in MW contests with six seasons finishing with 10+ wins and four MW regular season championships and one tournament championship, which includes three consecutive regular season titles (2020, 2021 and 2022). In 2020, the Lobos advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament.
- In addition, she was named the MW Coach of the Year in 2020 and 2021.
- Coach is the second-winningest coach in program history behind Kit Vela (2001-14, 122 wins) and would be just the second Lobo coach to reach 100 wins at UNM.

COACHING STAFF

Heather Dyche joined the Lobo family in 2015 as the fourth head women's soccer coach at The University of New Mexico. The 2024 season marks her 10th season in charge of the Lobos.

CAREER SUMMARY

Dyche was named the Mountain West Coach of the Year in back-to-back seasons, in 2020 and 2021. She has led New Mexico to six Mountain West Tournament appearances, including three championship games. Under her guidance, UNM has won four regular season titles (2018, 2020, 2021, 2022), the 2021 Mountain West Championships title, and made back-to-back NCAA Tournament appearances (2020 & 2021).

Dyche's 96 wins are second-most in UNM history behind Kit Vela, who went 122-105-45 (.529) from 2001-2014. Her seven postseason wins are also second-most behind Vela's 12. Dyche's .613 winning percentage is the best ever by a UNM head coach, as is her postseason winning percentage of .559.

Overall, she has coached 35 All-Mountain West selections (14 First Team, 12 Second Team), 16 All-MW Tournament Players, seven All-Region players, 14 CoSIDA Academic All-District selections, three CoSIDA Academic All-America, 19 Mountain West Players of the Week, 123 Mountain West All-Academic selections and 109 Mountain West Scholar-Athletes. Four student-athletes that she coached signed professional contracts under her tenure.

2023

The Lobos went 5-6-6, 2-5-4 in conference, which included a win over New Mexico State to extend the win streak to four matches and her record against the Aggies to 6-1. In addition, the Lobos opened the season with a 1-1 tie against Texas Tech, extending the unbeaten streak in the series against the Red Raiders to three matches, part of a four-match unbeaten en streak to start the campaign.

2022 - Mountain West Regular-Season Champions - Mountain West Championships Semifinal

Dyche guided the Lobos to a share of their third-consecutive Mountain West regular-season title in 2022, with the team going 7-3-9 overall and 5-1-5 in conference play. The Lobos hosted the Mountain West Championships, falling to San José State in penalty kicks in the semifinals of the tournament. UNM broke the program record for consecutive shutout minutes with 602:51, ending the season with the streak intact. UNM's team goals-against average of .082 was the lowest the program had seen since a mark of .068 during the 2011 season.

2021 - Mountain West Regular-Season Champions - Mountain West Championships Champions - NCAA Championship First Round

The 2021 season followed in the 2020 season's success. The Lobos won their first Mountain West Tournament championship since 2011. Dyche led the Lobos to many records, including a program-high eight-game winning streak and nine-game conference winning streak (dating back to the 2020 season). She guided the team to the second-most single-season wins as they finished the season with 14 wins, also going undefeated in conference play at home. In typical MW Coach of the Year fashion, she coached the Newcomer of the Year and Offensive Player of the Year.

2020 – Mountain West Regular-Season Champions – NCAA Championship Second Round The 2020 season saw records fall as UNM advanced to the second round of the NCAA College Cup and winning its first outright Mountain West title since 2011. The program went 10-2-1 under Dyche as she was named the Mountain West's Coach of the Year. The Lobos blasted their way into the record books by averaging 2.38 goals per game (scoring 31 in just 13 games). The team turned in a 0.90 goals against average, the lowest in seven years, and UNM was nearly unstoppable in the regular season, allowing just three goals in 10 games leading up to the title game. The Lobos of 2020 advanced to the NCAA Tournament after a thrilling 3-2 overtime win over San Diego State in front of a capacity crowd in Albuquerque. UNM then got past Navy in the opening round, winning 4-2 in penalties after tying 1-1 in regulation.

Gwen Maly was one of five players to earn First Team All-Mountain West honors, and she became the first women's soccer player in the history of the Mountain West to be named Mountain West Female Scholar-Athlete of the Year, the highest individual honor bestowed to a student-athlete in the league.

NEW MEXICO SOCCER

The 2019 season saw the Lobos go 11-8-1 overall and finish 6-4-1 in the Mountain West, good for fourth place. The Lobos for the second straight season placed five players on the All-Mountain West squad and it gave UNM 36 wins over the previous three seasons, the second-best three-year win total in school history. One of those wins was a 1-0 season opening win over No. 22 Texas Tech at the UNM Soccer Complex, UNM's first win over a ranked opponent since 2010.

2018 - Mountain West Regular-Season Champions - Mountain West Championships Final

Dyche's 2018 Lobo team set a program record for goals scored with 45 and posted second-best program marks in assists (33) and points (123). In terms of individual player accolades, three standouts received All-Pacific Region honors from the United Soccer Coaches, which was a program record. From the Mountain West, the 2018 team had five honorees, three of which were first team selections. The Lobos won the Mountain West regular season title this season.

2017 - Mountain West Championships Final

The Lobos posted double-digit wins in 2017, going 12-8-2 overall and placing fourth in the Mountain West standings with a league record of 7-2-2. The Lobos advanced their way to the Mountain West Champion-ships title game by virtue of two successful penalty kick shootouts, before falling to San Diego State in the title match.

2016

Dyche led UNM to another winning season in 2016, as the Lobos went 9-7-3 overall and finished 5-5-1 in league play to tie for seventh place.

2015 - Mountain West Championships Semifinal

In her first season, Dyche became the third coach in Lobo women's soccer history to begin her career with double-digit victories by going 10-8-2 in 2015. That record included a 7-3-1 record in Mountain West play and a run to MW Tournament semifinals.

BEYOND UNM

Along with leading the Lobos, Dyche is also a technical advisor for USL team New Mexico United. She is one of only two women in the country involved with men's professional team staffing. She is also the vice president of United Soccer Coaches and set to be named the president of the organization in 2026.

She is on the US Soccer Senior Instructional Staff as one of two women teaching the National A and B license, awarding licenses to candidates. Dyche is currently the only American woman on the FIFA Women's Development Team as a Technical Expert.

Dyche traveled to Brazil to assist the U.S. Women's National Team during the 2016 Summer Olympic Games – assisting with scouting and analyzing opponents. She also served as an assistant coach for the U-18 U.S. Women's National Team's trip to Australia in the summer of 2017. She also was on the U.S. Women's National Team staff for the 2017 World Cup in Canada, 2019 World Cup in France and 2021 World Cup Qualifying in Monterrey, Mexico.

Dyche is also a coach, instructor, and scout with the United States Soccer Federation (USSF). Dyche is an assistant coach for the U14, U15, U16, U17, U18, U19 and U20 US Youth National Teams. She helped lead the U20 team to a victory in the CONCACAF World Cup qualifier in the Dominican Republic. She also serves on the USSF instructional staff, instructing USSF B- and USSF C-licensed national coaching schools across the country.

Dyche's footprint at the elite level spans past the national stage, as she has also assisted for national teams from Antigua, St. Kitts and Nevis and Grenada. Dyche serves on the instructional staff for The Confederation of North, Central American and Caribbean Association Football (CONCACAF), teaching CONCACAF courses and licensing coaches throughout our confederation.

Dyche is a US Youth Region IV ODP head coach. There, she coaches the team at Olympic Development Interregional events and identifies top players in the region to participate in the Olympic Development Program Regional Team.

She is also the co-founder and head coach of LEAD Academy (Leadership and Empowerment through Athletic Development Soccer) – an all-girls soccer leadership training school located here in Albuquerque.

Prior to joining the University of New Mexico, Dyche was a presenter at the National Soccer Coaches Association of America/U.S. Youth National Conference in 2013 and at the U.S. Soccer National Symposium in 2011.




