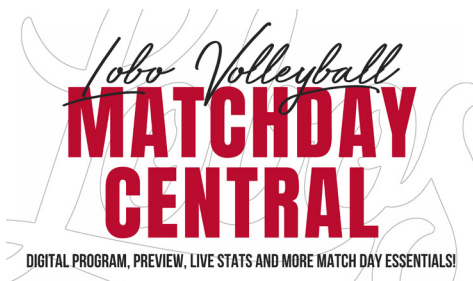

JON NEWMAN-GONCHAR

HEAD COACH

-Led the Lobos to their best finish since 2015 in MW play in 2023, finishing tied for fourth with a 10-8 mark in conference matchups.

-77 wins at UNM. 50th win came in a sweep of Colorado State on Nov. 10, 2022.

- Winning record in each of the last three years (37-22, 62.7%). 20 wins in 2021 were most for the program since 2013.

-Back-to-back-to-back MW Championship participants (2021-23). First UNM team to reach the MW Semifinals since 1999; first MW Tournament win since 2006.

- Swept CSU at Fort Collins for the 2nd time in program history.

- Swept the season series with Boise State for the first time since 2014.

- First time in program history winning in Laramie and Fort Collins in the same year

- 2 wins over Power 5 schools (first match as the Lobo head coach against Rutgers, a sweep on Aug. 30, 2019 and a four-set win over Kansas State on Sept. 21, 2019)

- 18 MW Player of the Week selections (8 Offensive, 6 Defensive, 4 Freshman)

- Swept the MW weekly awards on November 14, the 2nd time all-time that UNM has swept the awards both times occurring under Coach Newman-Gonchar

- Led the MW in digs, digs per set and in opp. hitting % in 2022

- In conference matches in 2022, led the MW in digs (1146) and digs per set (16.14), 2nd in the MW in opponent hitting % (.188) and blocks (175) and blocks per set (2.46).

- 7 All-Conference selections (2 in 2023, 2 in 2022, 1 in Spring 2021, 2 in 2021, 1 honorable mention in 2019)

-10 semesters in a row over in which the team posts a 3.4 GPA or better 5-time AVCA All-Academic Award

-Reached 65th in the RPI on Oct. 3, 2022, the highest RPI under Coach Newman-Gonchar

Jon Newman-Gonchar became the 10th head volleyball coach at the University of New Mexico on Jan. 21, 2019.

The Lobos have sustained success under Newman-Gonchar and have made the MW Tournament each of the past two years that it has been held. The Lobos have achieved a winning record in each of the last 3 years (56-34, 62.2%) with 20 wins in 2021 the most for the program since 2013. Finishing 2023 at 19-12 overall and 10-8 in MW play, Newman-Gonchar moved up to No. 3 among UNM coaches (tenured five or more seasons) in winning percentage (.530) and No. 2 in conference win percentage (.453) since the Lobos joined the Mountain West.

This past season, the Lobos led the MW in digs, digs per set and in opp. hitting %, and in conference matches, led the MW in digs (1146) and digs per set (16.14), 2nd in the MW in opponent hitting % (.188) and blocks (175) and blocks per set (2.46). UNM finished 54th in the NCAA in total digs (1830) and 64th in digs per set (15.64).

The Lobo head coach has served under renowned volleyball coaches such as Arkansas's Jason Watson, Iowa State's Christy Johnson-Lynch and former Loyola Marymount coach, USA Women's National Team assistant and current Georgia head coach Tom Black. Newman-Gonchar took over at the helm of the Lobos after serving as the associate head coach at the University of Arkansas for the previous three seasons. In his last season in Fayetteville, a pair of Razorbacks earned AVCA All-South Region honors, giving Arkansas

at least one All-Region honor in each of his three seasons with the program. The year prior, the Razorbacks went 19-11.

"I'm excited to welcome Jon and have him be our head volleyball coach," said Eddie Nuñez, Director of Athletics. "We wanted someone with a wide breadth of experience and someone that will bring excitement and championships to Lobo Volleyball. Jon has been at all levels of Division I and he has tremendous national team experience. We look forward to having Jon and his wife Morgan join the Lobo family."

Prior to Arkansas, Newman-Gonchar was an assistant coach at Iowa State in Ames. With the Cyclones, the program went 56-31 overall, including 32-16 in Big 12 play. Iowa State defeated five ranked teams over those three seasons, finished as high as second in the Big 12, and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament twice. Individually, Newman-Gonchar coached his student-athletes to four AVCA All-America certificates, six AVCA All-Region honors and 18 All-Big 12 selections including a trio of Big 12 Libero of the Year honors and the 2015 Big 12 Freshman of the Year. In his three seasons at Iowa State, he worked directly with the team's setters and middle blockers.

Newman-Gonchar has also had assistant coaching stops at Loyola Marymount (2010-12) and UC San Diego with both the men's and women's teams (2007-09) and Louisiana-Lafayette (2006). He also has been an assistant coach with the Thompson Rivers University men's volleyball team in British Columbia, and he was a volunteer assistant coach at his alma mater Northern Arizona.

A native of Claremont, Calif., Newman-Gonchar earned his bachelor's degree in health sciences in December 2005 from Northern Arizona. He and his wife Morgan have two children, Hudson and Grayson.

Match Notes

ALL-TIME SERIES

- The Lobos are 36-63 against Colorado State all-time and 37-53 against Wyoming all-time -- they're 3-5 against the Cowgirls in Coach Newman-Gonchar's tenure and 2-6 against the Rams in the same span.
- UNM is 14-26 at home against CSU and 14-28 on the road against Wyoming.
- They've won one of the last five meetings with the Rams and three of the last five against the Cowgirls. UNM's last win over CSU -- a 3-0 sweep in Fort Collins in 2022 -- was Coach Newman-Gonchar's 50th career win. Prior to UNM's win over the Cowgirls in 2021, they'd lost seven straight to Wyoming.
- In 2023, UNM fell to the Rams in straight sets three times and split its two matches with Wyoming, winning at home in four and falling in three in Laramie. They're 1-4 against the Rams in their last five meetings but 3-2 against the Cowgirls in the same span.

LAST WEEK

The Lobos fell to 2-6 in Mountain West play after a pair of hard-fought four-set losses at home to San Jose State and Fresno State. Despite holding late leads in the fourth set of both matches, New Mexico was downed by late runs that extended their losing streak to five matches.

Lauryn Payne had another standout week, leading the Lobos with 33 total kills (4.13 kills/set) -- she's now up to 240 kills on the season, averaging 3.43 kills per set.

Kialah Jefferson continued her strong all-around play, recording 13 kills and 29 digs (3.63 digs/set) in the two matches while recording her 10th double-double of the season against San Jose on Thursday (10 kills, 20 digs). The Lobos averaged 12.38 kills per set and hit .170 as a team last week, with their best performance coming against Fresno where they hit .177 on the match.

Jada Bouyer matched Jefferson's 13 kills, while Liepa Lavickyte (11) and Naomi Chankoumi (10) both finished with double-digits on the week. All 10 of Chankoumi's kills came against San Jose on Thursday.

Madeleine Miller tallied 65 assists across the eight sets (8.13 assists/set), while also contributing 17 digs. Sohila Wafeek added 20 more in four set appearances (5.00/set).

Falanika Danielson led the Lobos' defense in the back row with 41 total digs (5.13 digs per set), surpassing 20 digs for the seventh time this season on Saturday with 25. She also added 2 service aces, bringing her season total to 29 aces.

LAST TIME AROUND

New Mexico Volleyball's MW Tournament run ended one match shy of the championship in their last meeting with the Rams, as the Lobos fell in straight sets (18-25, 18-25, 27-29) to No. 2-seeded Colorado State on Nov. 23, 2023 at Cox Pavilion in Las Vegas. UNM held early leads in the first two sets, but the Rams surged

midway through each to take both by the same score of 18-25. The Lobos battled through three set points in the third after tying things up late, but ultimately fell 27-29 to seal the match.

UNM committed one less attack error than CSU and four less service errors, but was held to 38 kills on .222 hitting as the Rams hit .378 in the winning effort.

LOBOS ON THE BLOCK

Elizabeth Woods, the team's senior middle blocker and lone returning starter from 2023, continues to anchor the Lobos at the net. With a team-high 75 total blocks (12 BS, 63 BA) in 72 sets, Woods has posted five or more blocks in nine matches this season and has hit above .300 in eight matches. Her consistency has been a key part of UNM's defense, and she's added 16 service aces to her repertoire after never attempting a serve in a collegiate match prior to this season. Woods served up five aces to lead UNM in that category last week.

Liepa Lavickyte has been an important contributor since rejoining the starting lineup, tallying 62 total blocks (7 BS, 55 BA) on the season. She's finished with multiple blocks in all but two matches so far this year and currently ranks third among Mountain West active leaders with 1.22 blocks per set on the season.

DANIELSON DIGGIN' IT

Grad transfer Falanika Danielson has been a standout in the back row for the Lobos. After transferring from Temple, Danielson has anchored the defense, accumulating 301 digs at a rate of 4.18 digs per set. She's led the team in digs in 15 of UNM's 18 matches and has reached double-digit digs in 15 matches this season, including seven 20+ dig performances. Her efforts have earned her MW Defensive Player of the Week honors three weeks ago, and

she currently ranks No. 2 in the Mountain West in digs per set heading into the Lobos' upcoming matches.

JOHNSON IS BOOMING

The Lobos have seen an increase in attendance in each season since 2019 — not counting the 2020-21 season that limited attendance due to the COVID pandemic — and UNM's average attendance of 841 per home game last season was its highest since 2016 (1,248) and highest of Newman-Gonchar's tenure. 2023's Senior Day brought in 1,589 fans to the Johnson Center

– the highest-attended Lobo Volleyball game of the season. In 2023 overall (including three games at The Pit), the Lobos' average of 956 fans per game is the highest since 2016 – including seven games with over 1,000 in attendance.

Through eight home matches so far this season, UNM's averaged 844 fans a match, including a season-high 1,387 in attendance on Tuesday against New Mexico State – the second-most attended Lobo Volleyball match in the last eight seasons and sixth-most in the last decade.
