LOBO NOTES

WHAT'S TRENDING

- Presley Devey has scored the game-winning goal in four matches (UCR, Oregon, San Diego, Fresno State), Ellie Robinson in one (UTEP), Nicole Anderson in one (Nevada) and Alysa Whelchel in one (Air Force).
- Natalie DeGagne has recorded an assist in three matches and has a point in six matches this season with a goal in the season opener and at Boise State and Air Force.
- The Lobos have used six different lineup variations this season, including the same lineup in the last five and six of the last seven matches.
- Five Lobos have played over 90% of the minutes this season: Kennedy Brown (1175'), Fiona Jenkins (1191'), DeGagne (1174'), Taryn Robles (1143') and Callie Droitsch (1259') with six playing over 1000 minutes.
- Six Lobos have started all 14 matches this season: Devey, DeGagne, Nicole Anderson, Brown, Jenkins, and Droitsch.
- UNM had six players play the full 90 against Boise State: Droitsch, Jenkins, Ashley Moody, DeGagne, Taryn Robles and Brown. Five players went the fulltime at Utah State: Droitsch, Jenkins, Moody, DeGagne and Robles and five played the full 90 at Air Force: Droitsch, Jenkins, Moody, Robles and Brown.

OCTOBER ROAD

The Lobos have six road contests in the month of October, recently completing its longest road stint of the season with trips to Boise State, Utah State, Air Force and Colorado College. The Lobos return to Albuquerque to host Fresno State and San José State this week before heading back on the road to Colorado State and Wyoming. UNM closes the conference schedule at home against San Diego State on Oct. 31, meaning the Lobos have six road matches and three home matches in the final month of the MW schedule.

SERIES vs. SAN JOSÉ STATE

- The Lobos are 3-8-6 all-time against the Spartans, 1-3-2 at home.
- The last three matches have ended in ties (1-1, 0-0, 1-1). The lone home win was back in 2013, a 2-1 final.
- Coach Dyche is 2-6-5 against SJSU, 0-3-2 at home.
- San José State has outscored UNM 22-15 in the series.
- Presley Devey scored an unassisted goal in the 55th minute to give UNM the 1-0 lead last year in San Jose with SJSU tying the match in the 74th minute for the 1-1 final. UNM had the 17-15 advantage in shots with the Spartans having a 6-4 advantage in shots on goal.

- Ashley Moody was named Mountain West Freshman of the Week and Callie Droitsch earned Mountain West Defensive Player of the Week on Monday for their first MW weekly awards.
- Droitsch's accolade came after recorded one shutout and allowed one goal between the two road matches. The redshirt-sophomore made 10 saves on the week, including tying her career high of six saves at Air Force.
- She faced 35 shots on the week, 20 at Air Force and 15 at Colorado College with 11 shots on goal and 14 corner kicks, allowing only one goal for a .909 save percentage. Droitsch made her first save 40 seconds into the Air Force match. Droitsch thwarted another Falcon threat in the 11th minute as a player got free inside the right side of the box with the Lobo keeper using her body to block the shot. Air Force took four shots, three on goal in the first 11 minutes of action to force three Droitsch saves. The Lobo goalkeeper held the Falcons scoreless for the final 65:22 after Air Force took a 1-0

- Moody made two starts on the week, playing the full 180 minutes for the Lobo defense with
- the Lobo defense allowing only one goal.

 The two awards make three MW awards on the season, joining Presley Devey who won MW Offensive Player of the Week on Aug. 26.

THE WINNING RECIPE

- In five of UNM's wins, the Lobos scored first in the match and have held a lead at the break. Only in the UTEP and Air Force matches did the Lobos have to come from behind.
- In addition, the Lobos have outshot opponents 57-27 in the first 45 minutes and 52-43 in the second 45 minutes for a 109-70 edge (15.6-10.0 average) in shots in the six wins and outscored opponents 17-5 in the wins.
- When it comes to shots on goal, the Lobos have outshot their opponents 47-24 in that cate-
- gory.
 UNM led for 79:08 in the match against UCR, 84:12 in the match against Oregon, 84:38 against San Diego, 85:49 against Nevada and 85:39 against Fresno State, for a total of 419:26. In the win at Air Force, UNM led for only 2:36.
- In both the Oregon, San Diego and Fresno State matches, the Lobos scored in the first six minutes with Alysa Whelchel scoring at 5:48 against the Ducks and Presley Devey scoring at 5:22 against USD and in 4:21 against Fresno State. Devey also added another goal against Oregon at 9:10, a goal against UC Riverside at 10:52 and scored two in the first six minutes against Nevada
- Callie Droitsch allowed two goals during the six-match unbeaten streak with four clean sheets, making 15 saves, including a career-best six in the match against NAU.
- In UNM's wins, Devey has scored seven goals with two assists for 16 points, Nicole Anderson has scored four goals, Alysa Whelchel three goals, Natalie DeGagne one, Margaux Clarke one and Ellie Robinson scored one.

WAVE ON WAVE

- · In UNM's win against Nevada, the goals came in waves with a pair of goals being scored within minutes of each other in both the first and second half.
- Presley Devey got the scoring started at the 4:11 mark, with Morgan Juran finding Devey towards the arc at the top of the box, who turned to her right and sent a shot to the top right of the net off of her left foot. It was Juran's first career assist and the fastest goal scored this season by a Lobo, topping the goal Devey scored at the 5:22 mark on Sept. 1 against San Diego. Devey made it two goals less than two minutes later (5:59) off of a Nevada turnover, with the
- Lobo forward finding space and firing from distance, getting a little bit of luck as the ball hit off the left post, hitting the back of the Wolf Pack goalie and going into the back of the net to make it 2-0 in the first six minutes.
- The goals came in pairs again in the second half as Nicole Anderson recorded her first brace at 54:46, starting with a free kick by Callie Droitsch, who sent it past midfield and eventually was won by Alysa Whelchel, who passed it ahead to Anderson who was breaking towards the middle of the field and the goal, with the Lobo getting a right foot on it and sliding it bottom left and past the outstretched hand of the Nevada keeper to make it 4-0.
- A cross from Fiona Jenkins to Devey in the box at 56:16 led to Devey being taken down and the Lobos being awarded a penalty kick with Devey stepping up to take it. She notched the hat trick with a shot to the bottom right of the net for her team-high sixth goal of the season.

GOING BACK THROUGH THE RECORD BOOK

- It took some digging, but the Lobos achieved something that hadn't been done since 2008 against Nevada with Nicole Anderson and Presley Devey scoring multiple goals, the first time UNM had two multiple-goal scorers in a match since Sept. 28, 2008 against Central Arkansas (Kate Wyrick and Zaneta Wyne).
- Additionally, it was the first time the Lobos have scored five goals against Nevada since Oct. 14, 2018 (5-1) and the most goals scored since Sept. 9, 2021 when the Lobos scored six goals against NAU.
- Devey became the first Lobo to record a hat trick since Jadyn Edwards did it against Cal State Bakersfield in 2022.

FIGHT UNTIL THE FINAL WHISTLE

- The Lobos found a different way to win against UTEP, scoring two goals in the final 6:58 to defeat UTEP 2-1 after UTEP opened the scoring in the 68th minute.
- Alysa Whelchel sent it up the field from the midfield area to Ellie Robinson, who stayed onside and gathered it outside the left side of the box with Robinson finding Nicole Anderson in the middle of the box, passing it between two Miner defenders, allowing Anderson to promptly go top left to even the match at one with 83:02 showing on the clock. The momentum continued to be on the home side as the Lobos went ahead with 1:09 left to
- play as Logan Nicholson sent a cross from outside the right side of the box, deflecting off of a Miner before it was collected by Robinson, with the Lobo turning and firing a shot off her right foot parallel from the penalty kick marker, finding the back of the net for the first time this season.

LUCK OF THE LOBOS

- The Lobos had a little bit of late-match luck on Thursday night at Air Force, with Alysa Whelchel getting a friendly roll for the game-winning goal at 87:24.
- A turnover by Air Force set up the game winner for New Mexico as Natalie DeGagne intercepted the pass from the Air Force keeper as the clock hit 87 minutes, and while her initial attempt to play the ball into the box was turned away by the Falcons, the ball eventually ended up at the feet of Whelchel, who shot the ball from the top of the box, with the ball hitting squarely off the Air Force keeper's hands and rolled towards the left post and past the goal line for the go-ahead goal in the 2-1 win.

JURAN, JENKINS AND ROBLES WILL DEFEND YOU

- UNM defenders Fiona Jenkins, Morgan Juran and Taryn Robles have been a solid and steady
 presence on the pitch with Jenkins playing 1191 minutes this season and started all 14 matches, 1143 minutes for Robles who has started 13 matches, and Juran at 1092 minutes, who has started the last 13.
- Jenkins has played 90 minutes in 10 matches, Robles in eight, including eight of the last 10 matches and Juran in five.
- The Lobo defense didn't allow a shot by UC Riverside until the 55th minute and just one shot on goal, and allowed just one shot on goal again against San Diego. UNM allowed just five shots against USD and six against UCSB and New Mexico State.
- During the six-match unbeaten streak, the Lobos held opponents to 52 shots, 17 on goal, and allowed two goals. In the first half of the matches, opponents took a total of 24 shots, while the Lobo offense outscored opponents 4-1. UNM also shutout five of the six opponents in the

final 45 minutes.

FRESHMAN JOINS THE DEFENSE FIRM

- Ashley Moody has joined the starting lineup as of late, starting the last eight matches and playing a total of 776 minutes, including six matches of 90 minutes. She has played the full 90 in five of the last six matches.
- The freshman made her first appearance against UTEP on Sept. 8 playing 62 minutes, followed by her first start at Northern Arizona on Sept. 19, where she played the full 90.
- In her seven starts, Moody has played 90, 87, 90, 90, 90, 90, 90 and 88 minutes.

DEVEY DELIVERS

- As noted previously, Presley Devey scored a goal in three-straight matches, with all three being the game-winner.
- Of note, her two goals in the first three matches of the season tied her career best in any of her three seasons (scored two goals last year), and her five points the week of Aug. 22 and Aug. 25 already surpassed her career best in points.
- Devey recorded her first hat trick against Nevada on Sept. 29, finishing with a career-high six points on three shots on goal and did so in 43 minutes of

- playing time.

 She leads the Lobos in points (17), goals (seven), shots (37) and shots on goal (15) and is tied for first in assists (three).

 Devey is averaging 1.21 points per match, 2.64 shots per match, 0.50 goals per match in 872 minutes.

 Her 17 points this season is more than four times her point total from last season and her goal total more than triples her goals last season, doing so in nine matches and doing so in fewer shots on goal than last season (12 last season, 10 this season).
- In conference matches, Devey is tied for first in the MW in goals (four) and in goals per match (0.57). On the season, she is tied for second in goals and tied for the lead in goals per match. Her 17 points are tied for third in the conference, but her points per match is second among all players in the conference. Her four game-winning goals is the most by any player in the MW and tied for ninth in program history. Nationally, her four game-winning goals is tied for 11th by any player.

SOPHOMORE SHOWCASE

- The Lobos feature eight sophomores on the roster and of them, four have started all 14 matches, two have started 13 and one has started seven.
- Fiona Jenkins, Nicole Anderson, Callie Droitsch (redshirt) and Kennedy Brown (redshirt) have started all 14 matches as a sophomore with Jenkins playing 1191 minutes, Droitsch playing 1259 minutes in net and Brown playing 1175 minutes. Anderson has played 853 minutes and has four goals on the season, the second most on the team, and has the fourth-most points on the team with eight. Whelchel has started 13 matches and has three assists and nine points, with her assists tied for the most on the team and her points tied for second. Juran has played 1092 minutes in her first season with the Lobos with 13 starts and recorded her first career assist against Nevada for her first career points, adding another assist at Boise State for the fourth-most assists on the team with two.
- For Samantha Corrie, Whelchel and Droitsch, their first collegiate starts came this season.
- In each match this season, the Lobos have started either six or seven sophomores with six matches with seven sophomores starting. In the NAU match, with freshman Ashley Moody starting, the Lobos had a total of eight underclassmen starting.

KEEPING IT CLEAN WITH CALLIE

- Called on to start in net in all 14 matches this season, Callie Droitsch has answered with 41 saves and six clean sheets, including in the last two matches.
- The redshirt sophomore twice made six saves in a match for a career high, making six saves in the scoreless draw with Northern Arizona and at Air Force, earning the win.
- Droitsch has made five or more saves in four matches
- Her first shutout came in the second match against UC Riverside, which also provided her first win.

PRESLEY'S POINTS PRODUCES MW POTW

- UNM junior forward Presley Devey scored two game-winning goals and contributed on three of the four goals scored by New Mexico, earning the Mountain West Offensive Player of the Week on Aug. 26.

 Devey led the Lobos with two goals and an assist on the week for a team-best five points, including one goal and one assist in the win against Oregon.
- Her assist on Alysa Whelchel's goal in the sixth minute to open the scoring was her first career assist, and combined with her own goal in the 10th minute, her three points in the match set a career high.
- Sunday's match was Devey's second game-winner on the week, as the Lobo scored the only goal of the match on Thursday against UC Riverside in the 11th minute.

FIRST TIME FOR EVERYTHING

- There have been several firsts for some Lobos this season:
- Alysa Whelchel scored her first career goal against Oregon with Presley Devey contributing on the goal for her first career assist.
- Whelchel recorded her first game-winning goal at Air Force.
- Kennedy Brown recorded her first point on an assist against San Diego on Sept. 1.

- Callie Droitsch, Samantha Corrie and Taryn Robles all made their first career start in the season opener at New Mexico State.

 Droitsch earned her first win, a shutout against UC Riverside.

 Devey finished with three points in the Oregon match to set a career high, which she later topped against Nevada on Sept. 29 with a career-high three goals for a career-high six points and her first hat trick.
- Ashley Moody made her collegiate debut in the match against UTEP on Sept. 8 and made her first collegiate start in the next match at NAU, playing the full 90 minutes. She has since started the last eight matches, playing 90 minutes six times.
- Devey played a career-high 84 minutes in the match at Air Force. She needed nine matches to surpass her career high in minutes in a season (465:09 Ellie Robinson recorded her first game-winning goal against UTEP on Sept. 8 and finished with a career-best three points in the match.

- Alejandra Puerto made her first appearance as a Lobo against UNLV on Sept. 26, playing 27 minutes and has appeared in six matches this season.

 Nicole Anderson recorded her first brace against Nevada on Sept. 29, scoring in the 29th minute and in the 55th minute for a career high in goals and points for the sophomore.
- After missing the last three seasons due to injury, Fatso Williams made her first appearance as a Lobo in the Sept. 29 match against Nevada, coming in
- to replace Callie Droitsch in goal for the final 1:26.
 Devey, Droitsch and Moody all earned their first MW weekly awards this season with an Offensive Player of the Week, Defensive Player of the Week and Freshman of the Week, respectively.
- Fiona Jenkins' first career point came on an assist against Fresno State on Oct. 17.

HOME WAS GOOD TO THE LOBOS

- UNM finished its five-match homestand at the beginning of the season 4-0-1 at home after defeating UC Riverside on Aug. 22 1-0, Oregon 3-1 on Aug. 25, San Diego 1-0 on Sept. 1, a 0-0 draw against UC Santa Barbara on Sept. 5 and a 2-1 win over UTEP on Sept. 8.

 During the homestand, the Lobos outscored their opponents 7-2, taking a 32-11 advantage in shots on goal and a 82-37 advantage in shots (16.4 per
- match/ 7.4 per match).
- The Lobos are currently 6-1-1 at home, with the six wins the most since 2021. UNM is outscoring opponents 15-7 at home following a 54-23 advantage in shots on goal. UNM is averaging 17.9 shots per match at home compared to 7.9 for opponents. Of the 15 goals, eight have been scored in the first half, seven in the second half.
- UNM is 50-22-12 at home under Coach Heather Dyche.

TALENTED TRIO

- Natalie DeGagne, Sophia Roberts and Alli Davis were picked for the 2024 Mountain West Women's Soccer Watch List comprised of three players from each school that is expected to lead their respective programs.
- Davis returns for her third season in the net, after starting all 36 matches in the last two seasons and made a career-best 75 saves last season.
- Roberts (team-high four goals) and DeGagne (three goals tied for second) were two of UNM's top-three goal scorers from a season ago with De-Gagne and Roberts tied for the team lead in points in 2023 at nine.
- DeGagne led the Lobos with 48 shots, 17 shots on goal and finished tied for the team high in assists at three.

Sophia Roberts returns as the top goal scorer from last season with four goals and tied for the team lead in points at nine. Her nine points triples her



point total from the 2022 season (three points on one goal and one assist).

- The Lobo forward finished the season strong, scoring four goals in October with nine points, including a season-and career-high three in the second to last match against Wyoming.
- Eleven of Roberts' 30 shots were on goal and the Lobo averaged 1.76 shots and 0.53 points per match.
- In her three seasons at UNM, Roberts has started in all but two matches (the USD match last season and didn't start against Nevada) and has played a total of 3039:21 minutes. She's played in 47 matches with 45 starts and has 15 career points behind six goals and three assists.
- Roberts opened the 2024 season with an assist on Natalie DeGagne's goal at New Mexico State in the 28th minute and scored in the 77th minute to tie the match at two for her first goal of the season.

NATALIE NOTES

- UNM midfielder Natalie DeGagne is a veteran on the roster, with the Washington native in her fifth season with the Lobos.
- DeGagne has logged 4414:41, the most of any Lobo on the team, and has played in 73 matches with 48 starts, also the most on the team.
- She has started the last 40 matches dating back to Colorado College on Oct. 2, 2022.
- DeGagne's production has increased in the last three seasons and has scored at least one goal in every season, which has held true this season. Last season was DeGagne's best to date behind three goals and three assists for nine points, an improvement from 2022 where she scored two goals and was credited with one assist for five points. Her minutes have also increased in the last two seasons, playing 1463 in 2022 and 1406 in 2023 after playing a combined 370 minutes in 23 matches her first two seasons. She has played 1173:16 this season in 14 matches.
- The midfielder led the Lobos in shots with 48 and in shots on goal at 17 in 2023, which was more shots (28) and shots on goal (13) than the previous three years combined.
- Twice last season DeGagne finished with three points (vs. Colorado State and Wyoming), which were two of the last three matches of the season. She
- took a career-high 10 shots against Colorado College, with a career-high four on goal.

 DeGagne has contributed at least one point in six of the matches in 2024, opening 2024 with a goal in the season opener at New Mexico State with a goal in the 28th minute and added an assist in three matches (against UC Riverside, Oregon and San Diego). She scored her second goal of the season to tie the match at one at Boise State in the 40th minute and her third goal to tie the match at Air Force at 37:59.
- She has already matched her best point production in a season with nine points, matching her three goals and three assists from last season.
- DeGagne is tied for the team high in assists (three) and is second in shots (26) and tied for second in points (nine). She has also played the full 90 minutes six times this season (New Mexico State, UC Riverside, UC Santa Barbara, at NAU, at Boise State and at Utah State), 76 minutes against Oregon, 70 minutes against San Diego, 87 against UTEP and at Air Force, 86 against Fresno State, 81 against UNLV and 72 against Nevada for 1174 (93.2%) on the season. The Lobo is averaging 0.64 points per match, 1.86 shots per match and 0.21 assists per match with four shots in three matches on the season

SEEING DOUBLE

- UNM is one of 21 schools with a set of twins on the roster with Lobo sophomores Allie and Nicole Anderson.

 Other schools with twins on the roster are Lamar (two), North Dakota State (two), Wake Forest (two), Bucknell (one), Colorado (one), Davidson (one), Elon (one), Florida Atlantic (one), Grand Canyon (one), Maryland (one), Northwestern State (one), Ohio State (one), South Dakota State (one), Southeastern Louisiana (one), Syracuse (one), Texas A&M-Commerce (one), UC Irvine (one), UC San Diego (one), UMass (one) and Wright State (one).
- However, when it comes to sisters, there are over 40 schools with at least one pair of sisters on their roster. Of the teams that the Lobos will play this season, there is a pair of sisters on Abilene Christian, Boise State and New Mexico State.
- Nicole, a forward, changed her number from 25 to four this season and appeared in 17 matches with seven starts her freshman season. She scored her first collegiate goal at Nevada (which was the game-winner) and added two assists at UNLV. Nicole tied for the team high in assists with three, was fourth on the team in points with five, and had the second-most shots on goal with 14 (of 25 total shots). She made her first collegiate start at Fresno State on Sept. 24, 2023 and started the final six matches of the 2023 season.
- Allie, a defender, appeared in 11 matches and made her first collegiate start in the final match of the 2023 season at San Diego State.

PRESEASON PREDICTIONS

- The Lobos were picked fifth in the Mountain West Preseason Women's Soccer Coaches' Poll with 76 points.
- San Diego State was picked as the conference preseason favorite with eight first-place votes, Utah State (107 points, two first-place votes) and Colorado State (two first-place votes) and Boise State, both with 99 points, were picked ahead of UNM.
- Behind the Lobos was a large gap with Nevada (56 points) and Fresno State and UNLV each with 55 points, and from there was further separation with Air Force (37 points), San José State (34 points), Wyoming (32 points) and Colorado College rounding out the preseason picks with 25 points.
- Of note, New Mexico plays all but one team ahead of them in the poll on the road this season with the lone exception the final conference match against San Diego State.

- The Lobos feature 10 players from The Land of Enchantment on the 2024 roster.
- Kennedy Brown, Dalis Bruce, Ayla Dils, Alix Hailey, Zaria Katesigwa, Mercedes Morris, Sophia Roberts, Taryn Robles, Savanah Sanchez and Fatso Williams all hail from New Mexico, joined by head coach Heather Dyche, who is a 1997 graduate of Eldorado High School and was a four-year all-state defender, a two-time district Player of the Year and the 1996 Defensive Player of the Year. She also played basketball for the Eagles and was a firstteam all-state performer two years.

A DECADE OF GREATNESS

- Head coach Heather Dyche is in her 10th season at the helm of the Lobos.
- She is also on the verge on a milestone at UNM, two wins away from her 100th win.
- Coach is 98-57-31 and 59-30-17 in MW contests with six seasons finishing with 10+ wins and four MW regular season championships and one tournament championship, which includes three consecutive regular season titles (2020, 2021 and 2022). In 2020, the Lobos advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament
- In addition, she was named the MW Coach of the Year in 2020 and 2021.
- Coach is the second-winningest coach in program history behind Kit Vela (2001-14, 122 wins) and would be just the second Lobo coach to reach 100 wins at UNM.

COACHING STAFF

Heather Dyche joined the Lobo family in 2015 as the fourth head women's soccer coach at The University of New Mexico. The 2024 season marks her 10th season in charge of the Lobos.

CAREER SUMMARY

Dyche was named the Mountain West Coach of the Year in back-to-back seasons, in 2020 and 2021. She has led New Mexico to six Mountain West Tournament appearances, including three championship games. Under her guidance, UNM has won four regular season titles (2018, 2020, 2021, 2022), the 2021 Mountain West Championships title, and made back-to-back NCAA Tournament appearances (2020 & 2021).

Dyche's 98 wins are second-most in UNM history behind Kit Vela, who went 122-105-45 (.529) from 2001-2014. Her seven postseason wins are also second-most behind Vela's 12. Dyche's .610 winning percentage is the best ever by a UNM head coach, as is her postseason winning percentage of .559.

Overall, she has coached 35 All-Mountain West selections (14 First Team, 12 Second Team), 16 All-MW Tournament Players, seven All-Region players, 14 CoSIDA Academic All-District selections, three CoSIDA Academic All-America, 19 Mountain West Players of the Week, 123 Mountain West All-Academic selections and 109 Mountain West Scholar-Athletes. Four student-athletes that she coached signed professional contracts under her tenure.

2023

The Lobos went 5-6-6, 2-5-4 in conference, which included a win over New Mexico State to extend the win streak to four matches and her record against the Aggies to 6-1. In addition, the Lobos opened the season with a 1-1 tie against Texas Tech, extending the unbeaten streak in the series against the Red Raiders to three matches, part of a four-match unbeaten streak to start the campaign.

2022 - Mountain West Regular-Season Champions - Mountain West Championships Semifinal

Dyche guided the Lobos to a share of their third-consecutive Mountain West regular-season title in 2022, with the team going 7-3-9 overall and 5-1-5 in conference play. The Lobos hosted the Mountain West Championships, falling to San José State in penalty kicks in the semifinals of the tournament. UNM broke the program record for consecutive shutout minutes with 602:51, ending the season with the streak intact. UNM's team goals-against average of .082 was the lowest the program had seen since a mark of .068 during the 2011 season.

2021 - Mountain West Regular-Season Champions - Mountain West Championships Champions - NCAA Championship First Round

The 2021 season followed in the 2020 season's success. The Lobos won their first Mountain West Tournament championship since 2011. Dyche led the Lobos to many records, including a program-high eight-game winning streak and nine-game conference winning streak (dating back to the 2020 season). She guided the team to the second-most single-season wins as they finished the season with 14 wins, also going undefeated in conference play at home. In typical MW Coach of the Year fashion, she coached the Newcomer of the Year and Offensive Player of the Year.

2020 - Mountain West Regular-Season Champions - NCAA Championship Second Round The 2020 season saw records fall as UNM advanced to the second round of the NCAA College Cup and winning its first outright Mountain West title since 2011. The program went 10-2-1 under Dyche as she was named the Mountain West's Coach of the Year. The Lobos blasted their way into the record books by averaging 2.38 goals per game (scoring 31 in just 13 games). The team turned in a 0.90 goals against average, the lowest in seven years, and UNM was nearly unstoppable in the regular season, allowing just three goals in 10 games leading up to the title game. The Lobos of 2020 advanced to the NCAA Tournament after a thrilling 3-2 overtime win over San Diego State in front of a capacity crowd in Albuquerque. UNM then got past Navy in the opening round, winning 4-2 in penalties after tying 1-1 in regulation.

Gwen Maly was one of five players to earn First Team All-Mountain West honors, and she became the first women's soccer player in the history of the Mountain West to be named Mountain West Female Scholar-Athlete of the Year, the highest individual honor bestowed to a student-athlete in the league.

Lotos NEW MEXICO SOCCER

The 2019 season saw the Lobos go 11-8-1 overall and finish 6-4-1 in the Mountain West, good for fourth place. The Lobos for the second straight season placed five players on the All-Mountain West squad and it gave UNM 36 wins over the previous three seasons, the second-best three-year win total in school history. One of those wins was a 1-0 season opening win over No. 22 Texas Tech at the UNM Soccer Complex, UNM's first win over a ranked opponent since 2010.

2018 - Mountain West Regular-Season Champions - Mountain West Championships Final

Dyche's 2018 Lobo team set a program record for goals scored with 45 and posted second-best program marks in assists (33) and points (123). In terms of individual player accolades, three standouts received All-Pacific Region honors from the United Soccer Coaches, which was a program record. From the Mountain West, the 2018 team had five honorees, three of which were first team selections. The Lobos won the Mountain West regular season title this season.

2017 - Mountain West Championships Final
The Lobos posted double-digit wins in 2017, going 12-8-2 overall and
placing fourth in the Mountain West standings with a league record of
7-2-2. The Lobos advanced their way to the Mountain West Championships title game by virtue of two successful penalty kick shootouts, before
falling to San Diego State in the title match.

2016

Dyche led UNM to another winning season in 2016, as the Lobos went 9-7-3 overall and finished 5-5-1 in league play to tie for seventh place.

2015 - Mountain West Championships Semifinal In her first season, Dyche became the third coach in Lobo women's soccer history to begin her career with double-digit victories by going 10-8-2 in 2015. That record included a 7-3-1 record in Mountain West play and a run to MW Tournament semifinals.

BEYOND UNM

Along with leading the Lobos, Dyche is also a technical advisor for USL team New Mexico United. She is one of only two women in the country involved with men's professional team staffing. She is also the vice president of United Soccer Coaches and set to be named the president of the organization in 2026.

She is on the US Soccer Senior Instructional Staff as one of two women teaching the National A and B license, awarding licenses to candidates. Dyche is currently the only American woman on the FIFA Women's Development Team as a Technical Expert.

Dyche traveled to Brazil to assist the U.S. Women's National Team during the 2016 Summer Olympic Games – assisting with scouting and analyzing opponents. She also served as an assistant coach for the U-18 U.S. Women's National Team's trip to Australia in the summer of 2017. She also was on the U.S. Women's National Team staff for the 2017 World Cup in Canada, 2019 World Cup in France and 2021 World Cup Qualifying in Monterrey, Mexico.

Dyche is also a coach, instructor, and scout with the United States Soccer Federation (USSF). Dyche is an assistant coach for the U14, U15, U16, U17, U18, U19 and U20 US Youth National Teams. She helped lead the U20 team to a victory in the CONCACAF World Cup qualifier in the Dominican Republic. She also serves on the USSF instructional staff, instructing USSF B- and USSF C-licensed national coaching schools across the country.

Dyche's footprint at the elite level spans past the national stage, as she has also assisted for national teams from Antigua, St. Kitts and Nevis and Grenada. Dyche serves on the instructional staff for The Confederation of North, Central American and Caribbean Association Football (CONCACAF), teaching CONCACAF courses and licensing coaches throughout our confederation.

Dyche is a US Youth Region IV ODP head coach. There, she coaches the team at Olympic Development Interregional events and identifies top players in the region to participate in the Olympic Development Program Regional Team.

She is also the co-founder and head coach of LEAD Academy (Leadership and Empowerment through Athletic Development Soccer) – an all-girls soccer leadership training school located here in Albuquerque.

Prior to joining the University of New Mexico, Dyche was a presenter at the National Soccer Coaches Association of America/U.S. Youth National Conference in 2013 and at the U.S. Soccer National Symposium in 2011.






