NON-CONFERENCE SUCCESS

- New Mexico has posted a 30-2 record in regular season non-conference games over the past three seasons (13-0 in '23, 12-1 last year, 5-1 this year)
- The Lobos' .938 win percentage in those games is the 2nd best record nationally (behind Purdue) through games on Monday
- UNM posted a 12-win non-conference season in consecutive seasons for the first time the last two years since a four-year stretch from 2010-13

NOVEMBER TOURNAMENTS

- New Mexico is looking to win a November tournament for the third consecutive season (won last year's Ball Dawgs Classic in Henderson, Nev. and the 2022-23 Lobo Classic at The Pit)
- UNM has won a MTE title four times before (2023 Ball Dawgs Classic, 2022 Lobo Classic, 2012 Paradise Jam, 2007 Basketball Travelers Invitational)

HAPPY THANKSGIVING

- UNM is playing on Thanksgiving for the fourth time in history in search of its first win
- New Mexico most recently played on Thanksgiving in the 2021 Las Vegas Invitational, an 86-73 loss to UAB
- Previously, the Lobos lost to Virginia Tech 92-72 on Thanksgiving in the 2016 Wooden Legacy and lost to Santa Clara 79-76 in overtime on Thanksgiving in the 2011 76 Classic

NEUTRAL IS AN ADVANTAGE

- UNM is playing its second neutral site game of the season (win over No. 22 UCLA in Henderson, Nev.)
- Over the past three seasons, the Lobos are 6-0 in regular season neutral site games
- Including postseason, New Mexico is 11-2 in neutral site games since the start of 2022-23

SERIES HISTORY

- New Mexico leads the all-time series 47-38 as both schools were members of the WAC from 1962-63 to
- Tonight's game is the first ever neutral site matchup between the schools (previous 85 matchups were 49 in Albuquerque and 36 in Tempe)
- The Lobos have won the last four meetings, sweeping home-and-home series in 2010-11/2011-12 and 1994-95/1995-96
- The Sun Devils' last win in the series was a 71-69 victory at The Pit in 1991-92

AGAINST THE BIG XII

- Arizona State is the only Big XII team on the Lobos' regular season schedule this season
- Since the formation of the Big XII in 1996-97, UNM is 13-8 against Big XII foes
- The Lobos have lost their last two against Big XII teams (2018-19 loss to TCU in Emerald Classic, 2013-14 loss to Kansas in Kansas City)
- Prior to those two losses, UNM won six straight against Big XII teams (2009 NIT vs. Nebraska, 2009-10 vs. Texas A&M in Houston, 2009-10 home vs. Texas Tech, 2010-11 vs. Colorado in Las Vegas, 2010-11 at Texas Tech, 2011-12 vs. Oklahoma State in Oklahoma City)

I WANNA GO FAST!

- New Mexico currently ranks No. 1 nationally in KenPom Tempo with an adjusted average of 75.6 posses-
- The Lobos' season-opening game against Nicholls featured 84 possessions, as did the third game of the season against Texas A&M-Corpus Christi, the most in a regulation game for New Mexico under Richard
- UNM has ranked in the top 25 nationally in KenPom tempo in all four seasons under Richard Pitino, finihsing ninth in tempo last season

MAKING A DENT IN THE RECORD BOOK

- Donovan Dent made history on Nov. 12 in the win over Texas A&M-Corpus Christi, becoming the first Lobo to ever have a 25 point/10 assist game with no turnovers (fifth overall 25p/10a game in program history)
- It is one of just 18 games of 25 points/10 assists/no turnovers against D-I opposition in the past 20 years
- Dent now has a school-record three career games with at least 10 assists and no turnovers
- Dent's three 10 assist/0 turnover games over the past two seasons are tied for most in the nation with Gonzaga's Ryan Nembhard

DENT DISHING IT OUT

- Donovan Dent is the only player in the nation averaging 17.0 points and 8.0 assists per game this season
- He is the only player in the nation to record at least 10 points and five assists in every game this season
- His streak of six straight games with at least five assists to open the season is tied for the second-longest ever by a Lobo
- Dent is one of two players nationally to have multiple 20-point games and multiple 10-assist games this season (Tyson Dunn-Buffalo)
- Against St. John's, Dent recorded his 300th career assist and enters tonight's game with 317 career assists (T-16th in UNM history)

OH NELLY

- Preseason All-Mountain West center Nelly Junior Joseph looks to be one of the top post players in the conference this season
- Joseph has 45 career double-doubles, the fourth most among active Division I players
- Last season Joseph was the only Lobo to start all 36 games, tying the UNM record for starts in a season
- He is UNM's leading returning rebounder (8.2 rpg), field goal percentage (.550) and blocks (49)

JOSEPH EARNS FIRST MW HONOR

- Nelly Junior Joseph earned the first Mountain West Player of the Week honor this season after double-doubles in the wins over Nicholls and No. 22 UCLA
- In the season-opening win over Nicholls, Joseph tied a career high with 28 points and matched his UNM high with 16 rebounds
- It is one of only three 28 point/16 rebound games in Division I this season (Auburn's Johni Broome vs. North Alabama: Stanford's Maxime Raynaud at Santa Clara)
- Joseph had 16 points and 12 rebounds in the win over the Bruins in the Las Vegas Hoopfest

FINNISH STRONG IN EARLY SEASON

- · Mustapha Amzil is having a strong start to the 2024-25 season after a slow start during the 2023-24 non-conference schedule
- Amzil is averaging over three times as many points and rebounds per game than last year's non-conference schedule, and has already tripled his 3-point FGs and blocks from last year's non-conference slate
- Amzil recorded his 1,000th career point in Sunday's win over Texas Southern as he matched his UNM career high with 18 points

CAPTAINS NAMED

- Donovan Dent, Mustapha Amzil and CJ Noland were selected as the captains for the 2024-25 Lobos
- All are serving as a captain for the first time in their collegiate careers

TURNOVER IMPORTANCE

- The Lobos are averaging 24.8 points off turnovers this season
- UNM is 5-0 when having more points of turnovers and 0-1 when allowing more points off turnovers
- In victories, the Lobos are averaging a +16.2 (26.0-9.8) points off turnovers advantage, while allowing a -2.0 (19.0-21.0) points off turnover margin in losses
- Dating back to last season, New Mexico is 28-2 when winning the stat (only losses at Colorado State and at San Diego State last year), while 2-9 when losing the stat (only wins at New Mexico State and at Nevada last season)

DOUBLE-FIGURE LEADS LEAD TO WINS

- In each of the Lobos' last 35 victories, they have had a double-figure lead at some point during the game
- The Lobos held a double-digit lead in all four victories this season, following a 2023-24 season where UNM held a double-digit lead in all 26 victories
- New Mexico's last victory in a game when they never held a double-digit lead was an 81-79 overtime win over Boise State in 2022-23 (largest lead was five)

DEFENSIVE DOUBLE-DOUBLE

- New Mexico had 10 blocks and 10 steals in the victory over Nicholls to open the season
- It was the Lobos' second 10-and-10 game since the start of the 2023-24 season (10 blks and 12 stls vs. Utah State last season)
- Since the start of 2023-24, there have been only 32 10-and-10 games in the nation against Division I opponents, with the Lobos being one of four teams to do it twice (Auburn, Bryant, UConn)
- · Last season, New Mexico led the Mountain West in both blocks and steals

DOUBLE-DOUBLE x3 ON OPENING NIGHT

- New Mexico had three players record double-doubles on opening night against Nicholls, tying the school record for most double-doubles in a game
- Nelly Junior Joseph tied a career high with 28 points and matched his UNM high with 16 rebounds for his 44th career double-double
- Mustapha Amzil had his fourth career double-double with 13 points and a career-high 13 rebounds
- Donovan Dent had his fourth career double-double with 15 points and 11 assists
- UNM hadn't had three double-doubles in a game in 27 years, dating back to a victory over Texas Tech in 1997-98

PITINO vs. RANKED OPPONENTS

- The Lobos are 6-6 against ranked opponents under Richard Pitino (win vs. No. 22 Wyoming in 2022, win at No. 23 San Diego State in 2023, wins vs. No. 19 San Diego State, No. 16 Utah State and No. 22 Colorado State in 2024, win vs. No. 22 UCLA in 2025)
- Going back to his tenure at Minnesota, Pitino has led his squad to at least one ranked in each of the past 10 seasons (since 2015-16)
- Pitino is one of 11 active coaches in the nation to enter the season with at least one AP ranked win every season since 2015-16

AT HOME IN THE PIT

- New Mexico has won 23 straight regular-season non-conference home games, dating back to a loss to SMU on Dec.19, 2021
- It is the Lobos' longest such streak since winning 33 straight regular-season non-conference games at The Pit from 2004-05 (loss to No. 5 Wake Forest) to 2008-09 (loss to UCF)

PRESEASON ACCOLADES

- For the second straight season, New Mexico had two players selected to the preseason All-Mountain West team as Donovan Dent and Nelly Junior Joseph were honored
- The Lobos were one of two teams (Boise State) to have multiple players on the 10-player team
- Last season, Dent was a second-team All-Mountain West selection

ON THE DOT(SON)

- Freshman guard Kayde Dotson scored 18 points off the bench against Texas A&M-Corpus Christi in the third game of the season




