THE OPENING TIP

- ▶ New Mexico opens the 2024-25 by hosting Nicholls at The Pit
- ▶ The Lobos have won 21 straight season-openers (since a loss to Cal in 2002-03) and are 52-5 in home openers in The Pit
- ▶ UNM has won 23 straight against Southland Conference opponents since a loss to Lamar in the first round of the 1984 NIT
- The Lobos were picked second in the preseason Mountain West poll, while the Colonels were picked third in the preseason Southland poll
- ▶ Donovan Dent and Nelly Junior Joseph were selected to the preseason All-Mountain West team, as UNM joined Boise State as the only schools with multiple players

FOR OPENERS

- New Mexico is 91-30 all-time in season openers and has won 21 straight openers since a loss to Cal in the first game of the 2002-03 season
- The Lobos are 52-5 in home openers in the Pit, having won their last 18 home openers since that same loss to Cal in the 2002-03 season opener
- Richard Pitino is 10-2 in season openers, having won the last nine since a loss to his father's Louisville team in Minnesota's 2014-15 season opener in Puerto Rico

SERIES HISTORY

- New Mexico leads the all-time series with Nicholls 2-0, both at The Pit
- The Lobos won the last meeting, 75-63, in 2015-16 as Elijah Brown scored 18 points to lead UNM
- The first meeting was in 2009-10, an 83-59 New Mexico victory

AGAINST THE SOUTHLAND

- Nicholls is the first of two Southland opponents for the Lobos this season (Texas A&M-Corpus Christi)
- New Mexico has a 25-1 all-time record against Southland Conference foes and has won 23 straight against Southland opponents since a loss to Lamar in the first round of the 1984 NIT
- UNM hasn't played a Southland opponent since 2019-20, a 107-88 victory over Houston Christian (then Houston Baptist) at The Pit

CHALLENGING START

- For the fourth straight year, the Lobos open the season against a team ranked in the top 206 of the KenPom preseason rankings (No. 187 Nicholls in 2024-25, No. 206 Texas Southern in 2023-24; No. 167 Southern Utah in 2022-23, No. 195 Florida Atlantic in 2021-22)
- New Mexico is one of 39 schools to play a top-206 school to open the last four seasons
- · Of those 39, most are schools that have played all on the road against power conference opponents
- The only other team to open the last four seasons by hosting a top-206 KenPom team is San Diego State

PRESEASON ACCOLADES

- For the second straight season, New Mexico had two players selected to the preseason All-Mountain West team as Donovan Dent and Nelly Junior Joseph were honored
- The Lobos were one of two teams (Boise State) to have multiple players on the 10-player team
- Last season, Dent was a second-team All-Mountain West selection

LOBOS PICKED SECOND IN MOUNTAIN WEST

- New Mexico was picked second in the preseason Mountain West poll
- It was the Lobos' highest projected finish since 2013-14 (picked to win the league)
- Boise State was picked to win the league, followed by New Mexico, Nevada, San Diego State, UNLV, Utah State, Colorado State, San Jose State, Wyoming, Fresno State and Air Force

CHALLENGING SCHEDULE

- In the preseason KenPom rankings, every one of the Lobos' opponents is ranked in the top 280 in the nation
- UNM is one of 29 teams in the nation to not have an opponent on their schedule ranked No. 300 or higher in the preseason KenPom rankings (one of 20 teams to not play a No. 280 to higher team)
- The non-conference schedule includes at least four games against teams ranked in the KenPom Top 100 (UCLA, St. John's, Arizona State, VCU) with a fifth coming against either USC or Saint Mary's

CAPTAINS NAMED

- Donovan Dent, Mustapha Amzil and CJ Noland were selected as the captains for the 2024-25 Lobos
- All are serving as a captain for the first time in their collegiate careers

WHO IS BACK?

- New Mexico returns eight letterwinners from last season, including two starters in Donovan Dent and Nelly Junior Joseph
- Mustapha Amzil, the 2023-24 Mountain West Sixth Man of the Year returns, as does Tru Washington, one
 of the league's top freshmen last season
- Braden Appelhans and Quinton Webb return after reserve roles last season during their redshirt freshman seasons
- Deraje Agbaosi and Shane Douma-Sanchez are coming off a redshirt season in 2023-24

WHO IS NEW?

- New Mexico added eight new players to the roster (four transfers and four freshmen)
- All four transfers have power conference experience (CJ Noland All Big XII Freshman Team at Oklahoma before playing last year at North Texas), Atiki Ally Atiki (BYU), Ibrahima Sacko (Georgia Tech), Filip Borovicanin (Arizona)
- Jovan Milicevic was a four-star recruit in the Class of 2024, while Kayde Dotson and Daniel Thomas were both All-State honorees in Texas

DENT ON POINT

- Preseason All-Mountain West guard Donovan Dent is one of the nation's top point guards
- Dent is the only Division I player in the nation to return after totalling at least 490 points and 190 assists last vear
- His 190 assists last season were sixth most in a season in Lobo history and the most ever by a Lobo sophomore
- Dent enters the season with 269 career assists, already T-20th on the UNM career list
- Last year, he was one of two players in the nation with a 30-point game (31 vs. Boise State) and a 14-assist game (14 vs. Utah State) against Division I opponents (Tyler Kolek Marquette)

OH NELLY

- Preseason All-Mountain West center Nelly Junior Joseph looks to be one of the top post players in the conference this season
- Joseph has 43 career double-doubles, the fourth most among active Division I players
- Last season Joseph was the only Lobo to start all 36 games, tying the UNM record for starts in a season
- He is UNM's leading returning rebounder (8.2 rpg), field goal percentage (.550) and blocks (49)

ON THE AIR

- New Mexico will play at least 18 games this season on national television
- 14 of UNM's 20 Mountain West games are televised, meaning 49 of the last 56 conference games have been on TV (2nd most in the conference)
- The Lobos will play two games this season on broadcast television, hosting San Diego State on CBS for the second straight year (Jan. 11) and playing on FOX for the first time ever on Jan. 25 at UNLV

LAST TIME OUT

- The Lobos ended the preseason with a 74-70 win over UTEP in a charity exhibition at The Pit, benefitting the UNM Children's Hospital
- Donovan Dent led New Mexico with 19 points and five assists
- Tru Washington added 17 points and four steals
- Nelly Junior Joseph had seven points to go with 16 rebounds and five blocks
- New Mexico had a 56-30 rebounding edge




