- ▶ New Mexico is making its first visit to MSG since the 1990 NIT
- ▶ Donovan Dent became the first Lobo in history to have a 25-point, 10-assist, 0-turnover game with his performance against Texas A&M-Corpus Christi
- ▶ Nelly Junior Joseph is the reigning Mountain West Player of the Week after posting double-doubles vs. Nicholls and No. 22 UCLA last week
- The Lobos have won their last three games against Big East opponents (last in 2013-14 vs. Marquette in Las Vegas)

NON-CONFERENCE SUCCESS

- New Mexico has posted a 28-1 record in regular season non-conference games over the past three seasons (13-0 in '23, 12-1 last year, 3-0 this year)
- The Lobos' .964 win percentage in those games is the 2nd best record nationally (behind Purdue)
- UNM posted a 12-win non-conference season in consecutive seasons for the first time the last two years since a four-year stretch from 2010-13

AGAINST RANKED FOES

- St. John's is the second ranked opponent of the season for the Lobos, having defeated then-No. 22 UCLA last week in the Las Vegas Hoopfest
- The Lobos are looking to post two non-conference ranked wins in the same season for the first time since 2012-13 (wins vs. No. 21 UConn in Paradise Jam final, at No. 8 Cincinnati both Big East foes)
- The 55-54 win at No. 8 Cincinnati in 2013-14 was UNM's last true road non-conference ranked win
- New Mexico is 6-5 overall against ranked foes in the Richard Pitino era (1-1 in non-conference play)

WE JUST KEEP DANCING LIKE WE'RE (PLAYING) 22

- St. John's is the fourth straight ranked opponent for the Lobos that has been at No. 22 in the AP poll
- The Lobos defeated then-No. 22 UCLA last week in Las Vegas after playing No. 22 Colorado State (win) and at No. 22 Utah State (loss) in their last two matchups with ranked opponents last season
- In the Pitino era, the Lobos have played an AP No. 22 team every season (win vs. Wyoming in 2022, loss vs. San Diego State in 2023, in addition to the two last year and the two this season)

SERIES HISTORY

- St. John's leads the all-time series 3-0
- The last two meetings have come in The Pit, with the Red Storm winning in the 1999-00 CoSIDA Classic and the 1971-72 Lobo Invitational
- The only previous meeting in New York was a 61-54 St. John's win in the 1965 NIT Quarterfinals at the previous Madison Square Garden (MSG III)

AGAINST THE BIG EAST

- St. John's is the only Big East team on the Lobos' regular season schedule this year
- New Mexico is 3-11 all-time against Big East opponents, but have won the last three matchups against the Big East (vs. Marquette in 2013-14, at Cincinnati in 2012-13, vs. UConn in 2012-13)
- Of the 11 losses to Big East opponents, six have come in the postseason (five NCAA, one NIT)
- The Lobos are 1-1 in true road games vs. the Big East (won at Cincinnati in 2012-13, lost at Georgetown in 1985-86

UNDER THE BRIGHT LIGHTS OF THE WORLD'S MOST FAMOUS ARENA

- UNM is returning to Madison Square Garden for the first time since 1990 NIT semifinal/3rd place game
- New Mexico is 0-5 all-time at the current MSG (two losses in 1990 NIT, two losses in 1988 preseason NIT, loss in 1973 NIT) after going 3-3 at the previous MSG (1-1 in 1967 NIT, loss to St. John's in 1965 NIT, 2-1 in 1964 NIT)
- Richard Pitino is 2-3 at Madison Square Garden, all while at Minnesota, including two victories in the arena to win the 2014 NIT

DOUBLE-FIGURE LEADS LEAD TO WINS

- In each of the Lobos' last 33 victories, they have had a double-figure lead at some point during the game
- The Lobos held a double digit lead in all three victories this season, following a 2023-24 season where UNM held a double-digit lead in all 26 victories
- New Mexico's last victory in a game when they never held a double-digit lead was an 81-79 overtime win over Boise State in 2022-23 (largest lead was five)

MAKING A DENT IN THE RECORD BOOK

- Donovan Dent made history on Tuesday in the win over Texas A&M-Corpus Christi, becoming the first Lobo to ever have a 25 point/10 assist game with no turnovers (fifth overall 25p/10a game in program history)
- It is one of just 18 games of 25 points/10 assists/no turnovers against D-l opposition in the past 20 years
- Dent now has a school-record three career games with at least 10 assists and no turnovers
- Dent's three 10 assist/0 turnover games over the past two seasons are tied for most in the nation with Gonzaga's Ryan Nembhard

DENT ON POINT

- Preseason All-Mountain West guard Donovan Dent is one of the nation's top point guards
- Dent is the only Division I player in the nation to return after totalling at least 490 points and 190 assists last year

- His 190 assists last season were sixth most in a season in Lobo history and the most ever by a Lobo sophomore
- Dent enters the game with 298 career assists, already 19th on the UNM career list
- Last year, he was one of two players in the nation with a 30-point game (31 vs. Boise State) and a 14-assist game (14 vs. Utah State) against Division I opponents (Tyler Kolek Marquette)

OH NELLY

- Preseason All-Mountain West center Nelly Junior Joseph looks to be one of the top post players in the conference this season
- Joseph has 45 career double-doubles, the fourth most among active Division I players
- Last season Joseph was the only Lobo to start all 36 games, tying the UNM record for starts in a season
- He is UNM's leading returning rebounder (8.2 rpg), field goal percentage (.550) and blocks (49)

JOSEPH EARNS FIRST MW HONOR

- Nelly Junior Joseph earned the first Mountain West Player of the Week honor this season after double-doubles in the wins over Nicholls and No. 22 UCLA
- In the season-opening win over Nicholls, Joseph tied a career high with 28 points and matched his UNM high with 16 rebounds
- It is the only 28 point/16 rebound game in Division I this season
- Joseph had 16 points and 12 rebounds in the win over the Bruins in the Las Vegas Hoopfest

ON THE DOT(SON

- Freshman guard Kayde Dotson scored 18 points off the bench against Texas A&M-Corpus Christi in the third game of the season
- In the Mountain West era (since 1999-00), it is the second most points by a Lobo freshman one of the first three games of his career, trailing only Jamaal Williams (20 vs. Texas Southern in 2001-02) and matching Makuach Maluach (18 vs. Northern New Mexico in 2017-18)

CAPTAINS NAMED

- Donovan Dent, Mustapha Amzil and CJ Noland were selected as the captains for the 2024-25 Lobos
- All are serving as a captain for the first time in their collegiate careers

PRESEASON ACCOLADES

- For the second straight season, New Mexico had two players selected to the preseason All-Mountain West team as Donovan Dent and Nelly Junior Joseph were honored
- The Lobos were one of two teams (Boise State) to have multiple players on the 10-player team
- Last season, Dent was a second-team All-Mountain West selection

HOW FAST CAN YOU GO?

- New Mexico currently ranks No. 1 nationally in KenPom Tempo with an adjusted average of 77.2 possessions per game
- The Lobos' season-opening game against Nicholls featured 84 possessions, as did the third game of the season against Texas A&M-Corpus Christi, the most in a regulation game for New Mexico under Richard
- UNM has ranked in the top 25 nationally in KenPom tempo in all four seasons under Richard Pitino, finihsing ninth in tempo last season

DEFENSIVE DOUBLE-DOUBLE

- New Mexico had 10 blocks and 10 assists in the victory over Nicholls to open the season
- It was the Lobos' second 10-and-10 game since the start of the 2023-24 season (10 blks and 12 stls vs. Utah State last season)
- Since the start of 2023-24, there have been only 24 10-and-10 games in the nation against Division I opponents, with the Lobos being one of three teams to do it twice (Auburn, Bryant)
- Last season, New Mexico led the Mountain West in both blocks and steals

DOUBLE-DOUBLE x3 ON OPENING NIGHT

- New Mexico had three players record double-doubles on opening night against Nicholls, tying the school record for most double-doubles in a game
- Nelly Junior Joseph tied a career high with 28 points and matched his UNM high with 16 rebounds for his 44th career double-double
- Mustapha Amzil had his fourth career double-double with 13 points and a career-high 13 rebounds
- Donovan Dent had his fourth career double-double with 15 points and 11 assists
- UNM hadn't had three double-doubles in a game in 27 years, dating back to a victory over Texas Tech in 1997-98

CHALLENGING SCHEDULE

- In the preseason KenPom rankings, every one of the Lobos' opponents is ranked in the top 280 in the
- UNM is one of 29 teams in the nation to not have an opponent on their schedule ranked No. 300 or higher in the preseason KenPom rankings (one of 20 teams to not play a No. 280 to higher team)
- The non-conference schedule includes at least four games against teams ranked in the KenPom Top 100 (UCLA, St. John's, Arizona State, VCU) with a fifth coming against either USC or Saint Mary's

PITINO vs. RANKED OPPONENTS

- The Lobos are 6-5 against ranked opponents under Richard Pitino (win vs. No. 22 Wyoming in 2022, win at No. 23 San Diego State in 2023, wins vs. No. 19 San Diego State, No. 16 Utah State and No. 22 Colorado State in 2024, win vs. No. 22 UCLA in 2025)
- Going back to his tenure at Minnesota, Pitino has led his squad to at least one ranked in each of the past 10 seasons (since 2015-16)
- Pitino is one of 11 active coaches in the nation to enter the season with at least one AP ranked win every season since 2015-16

- New Mexico will play at least 18 games this season on national television






