NON-CONFERENCE SUCCESS

- New Mexico has posted a 31-3 record in regular season non-conference games over the past three seasons (13-0 in 23, 12-1 last year, 6-2 this year)
- The Lobos' .912 win percentage in those games is the 3rd best record nationally (behind Purdue and Kansas)
- UNM posted a 12-win non-conference season in consecutive seasons for the first time the last two years since a four-year stretch from 2010-13

MOUNTAIN WEST OPENERS

- New Mexico is 15-10 in Mountain West openers (10-0 at home/5-10 on the road)
- Dec. 4 ties for the earliest Mountain West opener for the Lobos (def. Boise State 80-78 on Dec. 4 in the 2019-20 opener)
- The Lobos are playing San Jose State in an opener for the first time
- New Mexico has won 10 of its last 11 conference home openers (only loss was an overtime loss to Utah State in 2021-22)

DECEMBER TO REMEMBER

- New Mexico is looking for another strong December after going undefeated in the month of December in each of the last two seasons
- The Lobos have won 14 straight games in December since a loss to SMU on Dec. 19, 2021
- UNM's December win streak is the second-longest active December win streak in the nation (trailing only Kansas)

SERIES HISTORY

- New Mexico leads the all-time series 21-5 (12-1 at home and 11-1 at The Pit)
- The Lobos have won the last three, including a 95-75 win in San Jose in last year's only meeting
- The Spartans' lone victory in Albuquerque was a 78-68 win in 2016-17

SWEEP LA

- Since 2000, New Mexico was the 27th non-conference team to play both UCLA and USC in the same regular season, and became the seventh to earn wins over both in the same year
- The previous six teams since 1999-00 to beat both UCLA and USC in the non-conference schedule are Pepperdine (2001-02), Kansas (2010-11), Kansas (2011-12), San Diego State (2012-13), Monmouth (2015-16) and Gonzaga (2023-24)

I WANNA GO FAST!

- New Mexico currently ranks No. 1 nationally in KenPom Tempo with an adjusted average of 74.7 possessions per game
- The Lobos' season-opening game against Nicholls featured 84 possessions, as did the third game of the season against Texas A&M-Corpus Christi, the most in a regulation game for New Mexico under Richard
- UNM has ranked in the top 25 nationally in KenPom tempo in all four seasons under Richard Pitino, finihsing ninth in tempo last season

DOUBLE-FIGURE LEADS LEAD TO WINS

- In each of the Lobos' last 36 victories, they have had a double-figure lead at some point during the game
- The Lobos held a double-digit lead in all six victories this season, following a 2023-24 season where UNM held a double-digit lead in all 26 victories
- New Mexico's last victory in a game when they never held a double-digit lead was an 81-79 overtime win over Boise State in 2022-23 (largest lead was five)

MAKING A DENT IN THE RECORD BOOK

- Donovan Dent made history on Nov. 12 in the win over Texas A&M-Corpus Christi, becoming the first Lobo to ever have a 25 point/10 assist game with no turnovers (fifth overall 25p/10a game in program history)
- It is one of just 18 games of 25 points/10 assists/no turnovers against D-I opposition in the past 20 years
- Dent now has a school-record three career games with at least 10 assists and no turnovers
- Dent's three 10 assist/0 turnover games over the past two seasons are tied for most in the nation with Gonzaga's Ryan Nembhard

DENT DISHING IT OUT

- Donovan Dent is the only player in the nation averaging 18.0 points and 8.0 assists per game this season (the last two players to average 18/8 for an entire | 12 Darrell McGee (1988-89) season were Ja Morant of Murray State in 2018-19 and Trae Young of Oklahoma in 2017-18)
- He is the only player in the nation to record at least 10 points and five assists in every game this season
- · His streak of eight straight games with at least five assists to open the season is tied for the second-longest ever by a Lobo
- Dent is one of two players nationally to have multiple 25-point games and multiple 10-assist games this season (Kameron Jones - Marquette)
- Against St. John's, Dent recorded his 300th career assist and enters tonight's game with 328 career assists (16th in UNM history)

DENT'S THANKSGIVING BUCKETS AND DISHES

- In the Acrsiure Classic semifinal vs. Arizona State on Thanksgiving, Donovan Dent had 30 points, seven assists and no turnovers
- It is the only 30pt/7asst/0to game in Division I this season, and just the fifth nationally over the past three years (since 2022-23)
- Ironically, two of the other four have UNM ties (former Lobo Taryn Todd for Arkansas State at Bowling Green last season; Fresno State's Jemarl Baker, Jr. two years ago vs. Chicago State, before he transferred to UNM for his final season)

OH NELLY

- Preseason All-Mountain West center Nelly Junior Joseph looks to be one of the top post players in the conference this season
- Joseph has 45 career double-doubles, the fourth most among active Division I players
- Last season Joseph was the only Lobo to start all 36 games, tying the UNM record for starts in a season
- He is UNM's leading returning rebounder (8.2 rpg), field goal percentage (.550) and blocks (49)

TURNOVER IMPORTANCE

- The Lobos are averaging 22.4 points off turnovers this season
- UNM is 6-0 when having more points of turnovers and 0-2 when allowing more points off turnovers
- In victories, the Lobos are averaging a +13.7 (24.5-10.8) points off turnovers advantage, while allowing a -2.0 (16.0-18.0) points off turnover margin in losses
- Dating back to last season, New Mexico is 29-2 when winning the stat (only losses at Colorado State and at San Diego State last year), while 2-10 when losing the stat (only wins at New Mexico State and at Nevada last season)

DEFENSIVE DOUBLE-DOUBLE

- New Mexico had 10 blocks and 10 steals in the victory over Nicholls to open the season
- It was the Lobos' second 10-and-10 game since the start of the 2023-24 season (10 blks and 12 stls vs. Utah State last season)
- Since the start of 2023-24, there have been only 32 10-and-10 games in the nation against Division I opponents, with the Lobos being one of four teams to do it twice (Auburn, Bryant, UConn)
- Last season, New Mexico led the Mountain West in both blocks and steals

DOUBLE-DOUBLE x3 ON OPENING NIGHT

- New Mexico had three players record double-doubles on opening night against Nicholls, tying the school record for most double-doubles in a game
- Nelly Junior Joseph tied a career high with 28 points and matched his UNM high with 16 rebounds for his 44th career double-double
- Mustapha Amzil had his fourth career double-double with 13 points and a career-high 13 rebounds
- Donovan Dent had his fourth career double-double with 15 points and 11 assists
- UNM hadn't had three double-doubles in a game in 27 years, dating back to a victory over Texas Tech in 1997-98

PITINO vs. RANKED OPPONENTS

- The Lobos are 6-6 against ranked opponents under Richard Pitino (win vs. No. 22 Wyoming in 2022, win at No. 23 San Diego State in 2023, wins vs. No. 19 San Diego State, No. 16 Utah State and No. 22 Colorado State in 2024, win vs. No. 22 UCLA in 2025)
- Going back to his tenure at Minnesota, Pitino has led his squad to at least one ranked in each of the past 10 seasons (since 2015-16)
- Pitino is one of 11 active coaches in the nation to enter the season with at least one AP ranked win every season since 2015-16

AT HOME IN THE PIT

- New Mexico has won 23 straight regular-season non-conference home games, dating back to a loss to SMU on Dec.19, 2021
- It is the Lobos' longest such streak since winning 33 straight regular-season non-conference games at The Pit from 2004-05 (loss to No. 5 Wake Forest) to 2008-09 (loss to UCF)






