- ▶ Donovan Dent is the only player in the nation averaging 18.0 points and 7.5 assists per game this season

NON-CONFERENCE SUCCESS

- New Mexico has posted a 31-4 record in regular season non-conference games over the past three seasons (13-0 in '23, 12-1 last year, 6-3 this year)
- The Lobos' .886 win percentage in those games is the tied for the 3rd best record nationally (behind Purdue and Utah State)
- UNM posted a 12-win non-conference season in consecutive seasons for the first time the last two years since a four-year stretch from 2010-13

I WANNA GO FAST!

- New Mexico currently ranks No. 3 nationally in KenPom Tempo with an adjusted average of 74.1 possessions per game
- The Lobos' season-opening game against Nicholls featured 84 possessions, as did the third game of the season against Texas A&M-Corpus Christi, the most in a regulation game for New Mexico under Richard Pitino
- UNM has ranked in the top 25 nationally in KenPom tempo in all four seasons under Richard Pitino, finihsing ninth in tempo last season

SERIES HISTORY

- New Mexico leads the all-time series 20-3 (18-2 at home and 9-0 at The Pit)
- The Lobos have won the last nine meeting's since the Mustangs' last victory in the series in 1958-59
- The teams are meeting for the third time in the last four seasons, with UNM winning 88-63 in 2021-22 and 102-63 in 2022-23

NON-DIVISION I HISTORY

- Division II Western New Mexico is the only non-Division I team on the Lobos' schedule this season
- The Lobos have won 23 straight regular season games against non-Division I opponents since a 81-76 loss to Eastern New Mexico in 1991-92
- The last 16 wins have all come by at least 20 points, since an 86-73 win over Simon Fraser in 1998-99

STREAK SNAPPED WITH SAN JOSE STATE VICTORY

- Wednesday's win over San Jose State marked the first time in nearly two full years that the Lobos won a game in which they didn't have a double-digit lead at some point during the game (UNM's largest lead was the final margin of six)
- In each of the Lobos' previous 36 victories, they had a double-figure lead at some point during the game
- The Lobos held a double-digit lead in the first six victories this season, following a 2023-24 season where UNM held a double-digit lead in all 26 victories
- Prior to the win over the Spartans, New Mexico's last victory in a game when they never held a double-digit lead was an 81-79 overtime win over Boise State in 2022-23 (largest lead was five)

LAST TIME OUT

- New Mexico suffered its first home non-conference loss in three seasons, falling to New Mexico State 89-83 in overtime last Saturday
- The Lobos rallied from down 15 midway through the second half to force overtime
- Nelly Junior Joseph had 16 points and tied a career high with 17 rebounds for his fourth double-double of the season
- The loss snapped New Mexico's 15-game December win streak, which had been the nation's longest active streak

MAKING A DENT IN THE RECORD BOOK

- Donovan Dent made history on Nov. 12 in the win over Texas A&M-Corpus Christi, becoming the first Lobo to ever have a 25 point/10 assist game with no turnovers (fifth overall 25p/10a game in program history)
- It is one of just 18 games of 25 points/10 assists/no turnovers against D-I opposition in the past 20 years
- Dent now has a school-record three career games with at least 10 assists and no turnovers
- Dent's three 10 assist/0 turnover games over the past two seasons are tied for most in the nation with Gonzaga's Ryan Nembhard

DENT DISHING IT OUT

- Donovan Dent is the only player in the nation averaging 18.0 points and 7.5 assists per game this season
- He is one of two players in the nation to record at least 10 points and four assists in every game this season (Bennett Stirtz - Drake)
- Dent has led the Lobos in assists in every game this season, the fourth longest streak of being the team's assist leader to start a season
- Dent's 75 assists over the first 10 games are fourth most in UNM history
- Dent is one of two players nationally to have multiple 25-point games and multiple 10-assist games this season against Division I opponents (Kameron Jones - Marquette)
- Against St. John's, Dent recorded his 300th career assist and enters tonight's game with 344 career assists (16th in UNM history)

DENT'S THANKSGIVING BUCKETS AND DISHES

- In the Acrsiure Classic semifinal vs. Arizona State on Thanksgiving, Donovan Dent had 30 points, seven assists and no turnovers
- It is the only 30pt/7asst/0to game in Division I this season, and just the fifth nationally over the past three years (since 2022-23)
- Ironically, two of the other four have UNM ties (former Lobo Taryn Todd for Arkansas State at Bowling Green last season; Fresno State's Jemarl Baker, Jr. two years ago vs. Chicago State, before he transferred to UNM for his final season)

OH NELLY

- Nelly Junior Joseph is the only player in the nation this season to have at least 125 points, 100 rebounds, 15 blocks and 15 steals
- Joseph became just the third player in Mountain West history, and the first in 20 years, to reach those benchmarks over the first 10 games of a season. joining UNM's Danny Granger and Utah's Andrew Bogut (both in 2004-05)
- He is the first Lobo to be averaging a double-double through 10 games of a season since Drew Gordon in 2011-12
- Joseph has 47 career double-doubles, the fourth most among active Division I players

FINNISH STRONG IN EARLY SEASON

- Mustapha Amzil is having a strong start to the 2024-25 season after a slow start during the 2023-24 non-conference schedule
- Amzil is averaging over three times as many points and rebounds per game than last year's non-conference schedule, and has already quadrupled his 3-point FGs and blocks from last year's non-conference slate
- He set a career high with 28 points vs. Arizona State in the Acrisure Classic
- Amzil recorded his 1,000th career point in the Nov. 24 win over Texas Southern

STOCK REPORT

- New Mexico ranks third nationally in blocks at 6.2 per game and 15th nationally in steals at 10.0 per game
- The Lobos are the only team in the nation to rank in the top 15 in both categories
- · Last season, UNM led the Mountain West in both blocks and steals

DEFENSIVE DOUBLE-DOUBLE

- New Mexico had 10 blocks and 10 steals in the victory over Nicholls to open the season
- It was the Lobos' second 10-and-10 game since the start of the 2023-24 season (10 blks and 12 stls vs. Utah State last season)
- Since the start of 2023-24, there have been only 32 10-and-10 games in the nation against Division I opponents, with the Lobos being one of four teams to do it twice (Auburn, Bryant, UConn)

DOUBLE-DOUBLE x3 ON OPENING NIGHT

- · New Mexico had three players record double-doubles on opening night against Nicholls, tying the school record for most double-doubles in a game
- Nelly Junior Joseph tied a career high with 28 points and matched his UNM high with 16 rebounds for his 44th career double-double
- Mustapha Amzil had his fourth career double-double with 13 points and a career-high 13 rebounds
- Donovan Dent had his fourth career double-double with 15 points and 11 assists
- UNM hadn't had three double-doubles in a game in 27 years, dating back to a victory over Texas Tech in 1997-98

PITINO vs. RANKED OPPONENTS

- The Lobos are 6-6 against ranked opponents under Richard Pitino (win vs. No. 22 Wyoming in 2022, win at No. 23 San Diego State in 2023, wins vs. No. 19 San Diego State, No. 16 Utah State and No. 22 Colorado State in 2024, win vs. No. 22 UCLA in 2025)
- · Going back to his tenure at Minnesota, Pitino has led his squad to at least one ranked in each of the past 10 seasons (since 2015-16)
- Pitino is one of 11 active coaches in the nation to enter the season with at least one AP ranked win every season since 2015-16

PRESEASON ACCOLADES

- · For the second straight season, New Mexico had two players selected to the preseason All-Mountain West team as Donovan Dent and Nelly Junior Joseph were honored
- The Lobos were one of two teams (Boise State) to have multiple players on the 10-player team
- · Last season, Dent was a second-team All-Mountain West selection

ON THE DOT(SON)

- Freshman guard Kayde Dotson scored 18 points off the bench against Texas A&M-Corpus Christi in the third game of the season
- In the Mountain West era (since 1999-00), it is the second most points by a Lobo freshman one of the first three games of his career, trailing only Jamaal Williams (20 vs. Texas Southern in 2001-02) and matching Makuach Maluach (18 vs. Northern New Mexico in 2017-18)

CAPTAINS NAMED

- Donovan Dent, Mustapha Amzil and CJ Noland were selected as the captains for the 2024-25 Lobos
- All are serving as a captain for the first time in their collegiate careers

JOSEPH EARNS FIRST MW HONOR
