- UNM is the only team in the nation to rank in the top 15 in both blocks and steals
- Donovan Dent is coming off a career-high 40 points in the Dec. 18 win over VCU and is the reigning Mountain West Player of the Week and Oscar Robertson National Player of the Week
- Nelly Junior Joseph is fourth among active Division I players with 48 career double-doubles

NON-CONFERENCE SUCCESS

- New Mexico has posted a 33-4 record in regular season non-conference games over the past three seasons (13-0 in '23, 12-1 last year, 8-3 this year)
- The Lobos' .892 win percentage in those games is the tied for the 5th best record nationally
- UNM's 33 non-conference wins are their most over a three-year span since 36 non-conference wins from 2012-14

I WANNA GO FAST!

- New Mexico currently ranks No. 9 nationally in KenPom Tempo with an adjusted average of 74.2 possessions per game
- The Lobos' season-opening game against Nicholls featured 84 possessions, as did the third game of the season against Texas A&M-Corpus Christi, the most in a regulation game for New Mexico under Richard Pitino
- UNM has ranked in the top 25 nationally in KenPom tempo in all four seasons under Richard Pitino, finishing ninth in tempo last season

SERIES HISTORY

- UNM leads the all-time series 80-53 (CSU leads 39-26 in Fort Collins, including 28-25 at Moby)
- The home team has won the last four regular season meetings
- The Lobos have won the last two meetings, winning 74-61 in last year's Mountain West semifinals after winning 68-66 on a game-winning Donovan Dent layup in The Pit
- The Rams have won the last six at Moby Arena, with UNM's last road win in the series coming in 2018

LIGHTING UP THE SCOREBOARD VS. WESTERN NEW MEXICO

- The Lobos' 122-70 victory over Western New Mexico on Dec. 14 was highlighted by numerous milestones
- The 122 points were the most by the Lobos since the 2017-18 opener (147-76 win vs. Northern New Mexico) and the most by a Mountain West team in three years (126 by UNLV vs. Life Pacific in 2022-23)
- It was the seventh time in program history that UNM scored at least 60 points in both halves of a game
- The 52-point margin of victory was the UNM's sixth-largest margin since 1999-2000
- The Lobos set highs in the Richard Pitino era with 122 points, 62 points in a half (second), .667 field goal percentage in a half (second), 52-point margin of victory, 47 field goals, 31 assists and 74 bench points
- UNM had a 22-0 run in the second half, the largest run by the Lobos in the past five years

STREAK SNAPPED WITH SAN JOSE STATE VICTORY

- The Dec. 4 win over San Jose State marked the first time in nearly two full years that the Lobos won a game in which they didn't have a double-digit lead at some point during the game (UNM's largest lead was the final margin of six)
- In each of the Lobos' previous 36 victories, they had a double-figure lead at some point during the game
- The Lobos held a double-digit lead in the first six victories this season, following a 2023-24 season where UNM held a double-digit lead in all 26 victories
- Prior to the win over the Spartans, New Mexico's last victory in a game when they never held a double-digit lead was an 81-79 overtime win over Boise State in 2022-23 (largest lead was five)

STOCK REPORT

- New Mexico ranks 13th nationally in blocks at 5.7 per game and 11th nationally in steals at 10.3 per game
- The Lobos are the only team in the nation to rank in the top 15 in both categories
- Last season, UNM led the Mountain West in both blocks and steals

MAKING A DENT IN THE RECORD BOOK

- Donovan Dent made history on Nov. 12 in the win over Texas A&M-Corpus Christi, becoming the first Lobo to ever have a 25 point/10 assist game with no turnovers (fifth overall 25p/10a game in program history)
- It is one of just 18 games of 25 points/10 assists/no turnovers against D-I opposition in the past 20 years
- Dent now has a school-record three career games with at least 10 assists and no turnovers
- Dent's three 10 assist/0 turnover games over the past two seasons are tied for most in the nation with Gonzaga's Ryan Nembhard

DENT DISHING IT OUT

- Donovan Dent is the only player in the nation averaging 19.0 points and 7.0 assists per game this season
- He is one of two players in the nation to record at least 10 points and four assists in every game this season (Bennett Stirtz - Drake)
- Dent has led the Lobos in assists in every game this season, the second longest streak of being the team's assist leader to start a season
- Dent has six games with at least eight assists this season, matching his total from last season and one shy of the most eight-assist games by a Lobo in the Mountain West era
- Dent is the only player in the nation to have three 25-point games and three 10-assist games this season
- Against St. John's, Dent recorded his 300th career assist and enters today's game with 356 career assists (13th in UNM history)

DENT PUTTING UP 40

- Donovan Dent scored a career-high 40 points on Dec. 18 in the 78-71 win over VCU
- It was the first 40-point game by a Lobo since Jaelen House scored 42 at Air Force in 2021-22
- Dent became the first Lobo to have a 40-point game against a top-50 KenPom opponent since Kendall Williams scored 46 at Colorado State in 2013
- It was the first 40-point game allowed by VCU in over 15 seasons
- Dent became the first Lobo to score at least half the team's points in a game since Elijah Brown scored 41 of UNM's 82 points vs. Fresno State in 2016

DENT'S THANKSGIVING BUCKETS AND DISHES

- In the Acrisure Classic semifinal vs. Arizona State on Thanksgiving, Donovan Dent had 30 points, seven assists and no turnovers
- It is the only 30pt/7asst/0to game in Division I this season, and just the fifth nationally over the past three years (since 2022-23)
- Ironically, two of the other four have UNM ties (former Lobo Taryn Todd for Arkansas State at Bowling Green last season; Fresno State's Jemarl Baker, Jr. two years ago vs. Chicago State, before he transferred to UNM for his final season)

OH NELLY

- Nelly Junior Joseph is one of two players nationally this year to have at least 150 points, 115 rebounds, 15 blocks and 15 steals (UAB's Yaxel Lendeborg)
- Joseph became just the third player in Mountain West history, and the first in 20 years, to have 125 points/100 rebounds/15 blocks/15 steals over the first 10 games of a season, joining UNM's Danny Granger and Utah's Andrew Bogut (both in 2004-05)
- Joseph has 48 career double-doubles, the fourth most among active Division I players

FINNISH STRONG IN EARLY SEASON

- Mustapha Amzil is having a strong start to the 2024-25 season after a slow start during the 2023-24 non-conference schedule
- Amzil averaged three times as many points and rebounds per game than last year's non-conference schedule, and quadrupled his 3-point FGs and blocks from last year's non-conference slate
- He set a career high with 28 points vs. Arizona State in the Acrisure Classic
- Amzil recorded his 1,000th career point in the Nov. 24 win over Texas Southern

DEFENSIVE DOUBLE-DOUBLE

- New Mexico had 10 blocks and 10 steals in the victory over Nicholls to open the season
- It was the Lobos' second 10-and-10 game since the start of the 2023-24 season (10 blks and 12 stls vs. Utah State last season)
- The Lobos had gone 12 seasons without a 10-and-10 game prior to last season's Utah State game
- UNM has nearly had three more 10-and-10 games this season, with three games of double-digit steals and nine blocks

DOUBLE-DOUBLE x3 ON OPENING NIGHT

- New Mexico had three players record double-doubles on opening night against Nicholls, tying the school record for most double-doubles in a game
- Nelly Junior Joseph tied a career high with 28 points and matched his UNM high with 16 rebounds for his 44th career double-double
- Mustapha Amzil had his fourth career double-double with 13 points and a career-high 13 rebounds
- Donovan Dent had his fourth career double-double with 15 points and 11 assists
- UNM hadn't had three double-doubles in a game in 27 years, dating back to a victory over Texas Tech in 1997-98

PITINO vs. RANKED OPPONENTS

- The Lobos are 6-6 against ranked opponents under Richard Pitino (win vs. No. 22 Wyoming in 2022, win at No. 23 San Diego State in 2023, wins vs. No. 19 San Diego State, No. 16 Utah State and No. 22 Colorado State in 2024, win vs. No. 22 UCLA in 2025)
- Going back to his tenure at Minnesota, Pitino has led his squad to at least one ranked in each of the past 10 seasons (since 2015-16)
- Pitino is one of 11 active coaches in the nation to enter the season with at least one AP ranked win every season since 2015-16

- Jovan Milicevic earned his first Mountain West Player of the Week honor on Dec. 16 after a strong performance against Western New Mexico
- In the 122-70 win, Milicevic scored a career-high 21 points on 8-11 shooting (3-4 3FG), becoming the first Lobo in over a year to have a 20-point game off the bench
- The 21-point performance more than doubled his season total of 14 points combined over the first 10 games of the season
- Milicevic also tied a career high with six rebounds, while setting career highs of four assists and three steals

JOSEPH EARNS FIRST MW HONOR

- Nelly Junior Joseph earned the first Mountain West Player of the Week honor this season after double-doubles in the wins over Nicholls and No. 22 UCLA
- In the season-opening win over Nicholls, Joseph tied a career high with 28 points and matched his UNM high with 16 rebounds
- It is one of only three 28 point/16 rebound games in Division I this season (Auburn's Johni Broome vs. North Alabama; Stanford's Maxime Raynaud at Santa Clara)
- Joseph had 16 points and 12 rebounds in the win over the Bruins in the Las Vegas Hoopfest

PRESEASON ACCOLADES

- For the second straight season, New Mexico had two players selected to the preseason All-Mountain West team as Donovan Dent and Nelly Junior Joseph were honored
- The Lobos were one of two teams (Boise State) to have multiple players on the 10-player team
- Last season, Dent was a second-team All-Mountain West selection

ON THE AIR

- New Mexico will play at least 18 games this season on national television
- 14 of UNM's 20 Mountain West games are televised, meaning 49 of the last 56 conference games have been on TV (2nd most in the conference)
- The Lobos will play two games this season on broadcast television, hosting San Diego State on CBS for the second straight year (Jan. 11) and playing on FOX for the first time ever on Jan. 25 at UNLV

LOBOS PICKED SECOND IN MOUNTAIN WEST

- New Mexico was picked second in the preseason Mountain West poll
- It was the Lobos' highest projected finish since 2013-14 (picked to win the league)
- Boise State was picked to win the league, followed by New Mexico, Nevada, San Diego State, UNLV, Utah State, Colorado State, San Jose State, Wyoming, Fresno State and Air Force

WHO IS BACK?

- New Mexico returns eight letterwinners from last season, including two starters in Donovan Dent and Nelly Junior Joseph
- Mustapha Amzil, the 2023-24 Mountain West Sixth Man of the Year returns, as does Tru Washington, one of the league's top freshmen last season
- Braden Appelhans and Quinton Webb return after reserve roles last season during their redshirt freshman seasons
- Deraje Agbaosi and Shane Douma-Sanchez are coming off a redshirt season in 2023-24

WHO IS NEW?

- New Mexico added eight new players to the roster (four transfers and four freshmen)
- All four transfers have power conference experience (CJ Noland - All Big XII Freshman Team at Oklahoma before playing last year at North Texas), Atiki Ally Atiki (BYU), Ibrahima Sacko (Georgia Tech), Filip Borovic-anin (Arizona)
- Jovan Milicevic was a four-star recruit in the Class of 2024, while Kayde Dotson and Daniel Thomas were both All-State honorees in Texas


