## FAST START TO CONFERENCE PLAY

- New Mexico has matched its best nine-game start to a Mountain West season at 8-1 (also accomplished in 2013-14)
- With a win today, its would be UNM's second ever 9-1 MW start (2013-14) and be just the fifth time the Lobos ever started a conference season 9-1 or better
- With a win, UNM would become the 17th Mountain West team to go 9-1 or

better over the first 10 games of a conference season and first since 2021-22 (Boise State/Wyoming)

• Prior to the loss at San Jose State, the Lobos opened a Mountain West schedule 6-0 for the first time in history and it was their longest win streak to open a conference schedule in 47 years (started 10-0 in the WAC in 1977-78)

## I WANNA GO FAST!

- New Mexico currently ranks No. 8 nationally in KenPom Tempo with an adjusted average of 73.0 possessions per game
- The Lobos' game at Fresno State on New Year's Eve featured 87 possessions, the most in a regulation game of the Richard Pitino era and the most in any Mountain West game since 2018
- UNM has ranked in the top 25 nationally in KenPom tempo in all four seasons under Richard Pitino, finihsing ninth in tempo last season

## **GOING ON A RUN!**

- New Mexico has gone on nine runs of 10-0 or better in Mountain West play, nearly twice as many as any other team this season
- The Lobos have had a 10-0 run in seven of nine conference games this season, including in each of the last five, tied for the longest streak of games with a 10-0 run under Richard Pitino (also had a five-game streak last season)
- Last season, UNM had a total of nine 10-0 runs over the 18 league games
- Including the non-conference, the Lobos have a total of 18 10-0 runs this season (nine in non-conference)

## STOCK REPORT

- New Mexico ranks 15th nationally in blocks at 5.4 per game and 25th nationally in steals at 9.4 per game
- The Lobos are one of two teams in the nation to rank in the top 25 in both categories (St. John's)
- Last season, UNM led the Mountain West in both blocks and steals

## **ROAD WARRIORS**

- New Mexico is searching for its fourth conference road win of the season today, which would match its total from last season when UNM went 4-5 in Mountain West road games
- UNM is looking to go 4-1 in its first five conference road games for the first time since 2013-14, when the Lobos won their first five Mountain West road games
- The four conference road wins last season were the Lobos' most since going 4-5 in 2017-18
- Overall, UNM is 5-3 away from home this season, with neutral victories over UCLA and USC in addition to the three conference wins

## **BIG WINS**

- New Mexico is looking for its eighth Quad 1/2 victory of the season today as it visits UNLV for a Quad 2 game
- UNM has a 7-2 record against Quad 1/Quad 2 opponents in the NET, tied 13th most Quad 1/2 wins in the nation (through games of 1/23)
- The Lobos have three wins over top-100 NET teams in the non-conference (vs. UCLA, vs. USC, home vs. VCU)
- Last season, the Lobos had eight total Quad 1/2 wins, all against Mountain West opponents (five in regular season, three in Mountain West Tournament)

### **DENT DISHING IT OUT**

- Dent has led the Lobos in assists in every game this season, the second longest streak of being the team's assist leader to start a season
- Dent has seven games with at least eight assists this season, tying the record for the most eight-assist games by a Lobo in the Mountain West era
- Dent has three games this season with at least 20 points and seven assists with no turnovers (only other player with more than one this season is Mark Sears of Alabama with two)
- Against Fresno State, Dent recorded his 400th career assist and enters today's game with 406 career assists (9th in UNM history)

## MAKING A DENT IN THE RECORD BOOK

- Donovan Dent made history on Nov. 12 in the win over Texas A&M-Corpus Christi, becoming the first Lobo to ever have a 25 point/10 assist game with no turnovers (fifth overall 25p/10a game in program history)
- It is one of just 18 games of 25 points/10 assists/no turnovers against D-l opposition in the past 20 years
- Dent now has a school-record three career games with at least 10 assists and no turnovers
- Dent's three 10 assist/0 turnover games over the past two seasons are tied for most in the nation with Gonzaga's Ryan Nembhard

## **DENT PUTTING UP 40**

- Donovan Dent scored a career-high 40 points on Dec. 18 in the 78-71 win over VCU
- It was the first 40-point game by a Lobo since Jaelen House scored 42 at Air Force in 2021-22
- Dent became the first Lobo to have a 40-point game against a top-50 KenPom opponent since Kendall Williams scored 46 at Colorado State in 2013
- It was the first 40-point game allowed by VCU in over 15 seasons
- Dent became the first Lobo to score at least half the team's points in a game since Elijah Brown scored 41 of UNM's 82 points vs. Fresno State in 2016

## DENT'S THANKSGIVING BUCKETS AND DISHES

- In the Acrsiure Classic semifinal vs. Arizona State on Thanksgiving, Donovan Dent had 30 points, seven assists and no turnovers
- It is one of only two 30pt/7asst/0to game in Division I this season (Arizona's Caleb Love vs. TCU), and just one of six nationally over the past three years (since 2022-23)
- Ironically, two of the other five have UNM ties (former Lobo Taryn Todd for Arkansas State at Bowling Green last season; Fresno State's Jemarl Baker, Jr. two years ago vs. Chicago State, before he transferred to UNM for his final season)

## **BEST IN THE (MOUNTAIN) WEST**

- Nelly Junior Joseph and Donovan Dent are two of the three players to earn Mountain West Player of the Week multiple times this season (Utah State's Mason Falslev)
- The Lobos' four total awards are their most in a season since 2013-14 (Cam Bairstow-3, Alex Kirk-1)
- They are the first Lobos to earn multiple awards in a season since JaQuan Lyle won it twice in 2019-20
- The last time two Lobos each won the award twice in a season was 2009-10 (Darington Hobson and Roman Martinez)

### **OH NELLY**

- Nelly Junior Joseph is the only Mountain West player and one of 15 players nationally averaging a double-double this season
- He is the only player in the nation this year to have at least 250 points, 200 rebounds, 30 blocks and 20 steals
- Joseph became just the third player in Mountain West history, and the first in 20 years, to have 125 points/100 rebounds/15 blocks/15 steaks over the first 10 games of a season, joining UNM's Danny Granger and Utah's Andrew Bogut (both in 2004-05)
- Joseph has 52 career double-doubles, the fourth most among active Division I players

## **NELLY GETTING DEFENSIVE**

- Nelly Junior Joseph is one of 12 players this season nationally to have at least 30 blocks and 20 steals this season
- He is on pace to become the first Lobo since Danny Granger in 2004-05 to have at least 40 blocks and 40 steals in a season
- Joseph enters the game with 80 blocks in his two seasons as a Lobo, 15th most in program history

## **FINNISH STRONG THIS SEASON**

- Mustapha Amzil is having a strong 2024-25 season after a 2023-24 season in which was named Mountain West 6th Man of the Year
- Amzil has nearly doubled his scoring average and rebounding average from last year, while already eclipsing his totals of three-pointers and double figure games
- He set a career high with 28 points vs. Arizona State in the Acrisure Classic
- Amzil recorded his 1,000th career point in the Nov. 24 win over Texas Southern

## **BOROVICANIN CLIMBING THE MOUNTAIN**

- Filip Borovicanin has grown into his role since Mountain West play began, already scoring more points (73) in the first nine conference games than he did over 11 non-conference games (45)
- Borovicanin has doubled his scoring and rebounding average and has already matched his total of double-figure games since MW play began

- At San Jose State on Jan. 14, he had his fifth career five-steal game, the second-most by a Lobo in the Mountain West era
- Washington tied UNM's freshman steals record last season with 49
- He enters the game with 84 career steals, just 11 shy of the UNM record for most steals through their freshman and sophomore seasons (Kendall Williams, 95 in 2010-11 and 2011-12)

## **MILICEVIC EARNS FRESHMAN HONOR**

- Jovan Milicevic earned his first Mountain West Player of the Week honor on Dec. 16 after a strong performance against Western New Mexico
- In the 122-70 win, Milicevic scored a career-high 21 points on 8-11 shooting (3-4 3FG), becoming the first Lobo in over a year to have a 20-point game off the bench

## **DEFENSIVE DOUBLE-DOUBLE**

- New Mexico had 10 blocks and 10 steals in the victory over Nicholls to open the season
- It was the Lobos' second 10-and-10 game since the start of the 2023-24 season (10 blks and 12 stls vs. Utah State last season)
- The Lobos had gone 12 seasons without a 10-and-10 game prior to last season's Utah State game
- UNM has nearly had three more 10-and-10 games this season, with three games of double-digit steals and nine blocks

## **RALLYING FOR WINS**

- The Lobos have rallied from halftime deficits to win two conference games (vs. Nevada, at Wyoming)
- It is the first time since 2013-14 that UNM has won after trailing at the half in consecutive games
- New Mexico did not rally from a halftime deficit last season and had gone almost 1.5 seasons (since a win over Wyoming in the first round of the 2023 Mountain West Tournament) since rallying from a halftime deficit
- The 14-point deficit at Wyoming on Jan. 7 tied for the fourth-largest halftime deficit in a win in program history and the largest since rallying from down 14 at the half against Davidson in 2012-13

## PITINO vs. RANKED OPPONENTS

- The Lobos are 6-6 against ranked opponents under Richard Pitino (win vs. No. 22 Wyoming in 2022, win at No. 23 San Diego State in 2023, wins vs. No. 19 San Diego State, No. 16 Utah State and No. 22 Colorado State in 2024, win vs. No. 22 UCLA in 2025)
- Going back to his tenure at Minnesota, Pitino has led his squad to at least one ranked in each of the past 10 seasons (since 2015-16)
- Pitino is one of 11 active coaches in the nation to enter the season with at least one AP ranked win every season since 2015-16

## **NON-CONFERENCE SUCCESS**

- New Mexico has posted a 33-4 record in regular season non-conference games over the past three seasons (13-0 in '23, 12-1 last year, 8-3 this year)
- The Lobos' .892 win percentage in those games is the tied for the 5th best record nationally
- UNM's 33 non-conference wins are their most over a three-year span since 36 non-conference wins from 2012-14

## **NOTABLE WIN AT THE BUZZER OVER NEVADA**

- New Mexico earned an 82-81 overtime victory over Nevada on Jan. 3 as Nelly Junior Joseph scored the game-winner on a 15-foot jumper as time expired
- It was the first time in 26 years that the Lobos won a game on a buzzer beater as time expired (Jan. 16, 1999 Damion Walker's layup gave No. 16 New Mexico a 79-78 win over No. 7 Arizona)
- It was the first time since 2022-23 that the Lobos won a game after trailing at halftime (lost 10 straight when trailing at half since rallying against Wyoming in the 2023 Mountain West Tournament)

## **DOUBLE-DOUBLE x3 ON OPENING NIGHT**

- New Mexico had three players record double-doubles on opening night against Nicholls, tying the school record for most double-doubles in a game
- Nelly Junior Joseph tied a career high with 28 points and matched his UNM high with 16 rebounds for his 44th career double-double
- Mustapha Amzil had his fourth career double-double with 13 points and a career-high 13 rebounds
- Donovan Dent had his fourth career double-double with 15 points and 11 assists
- UNM hadn't had three double-doubles in a game in 27 years, dating back to a victory over Texas Tech in 1997-98

## THE CENTURY MARK

- New Mexico has three 100-point games this season, its most in a season since four in 2017-18
- It is only the second time in the past 30 years that the Lobos have three 100-point games in a season
- The 122 points vs. Western New Mexico on Dec. 14 were the most by the Lobos since the 2017-18 opener (147-76 win vs. Northern New Mexico) and the most by a Mountain West team in three years (126 by UNLV vs. Life Pacific in 2022-23)
- The 103 points in the Dec. 31 win at Fresno State were the Lobos' most in a road game and the most in a Mountain West game since 2018 (108-87 win at Colorado State)

- UNLV leads the all-time series 43-26 (UNLV leads 25-11 in Las Vegas, 21-9 at Thomas & Mack)
- The Rebels have won the last three meetings, including sweeping both games last year when the Lobos were nationally ranked both times
- UNLV has won 10 of the last 11 meetings, dating back to the 2018-19 season
- New Mexico has lost six straight to the Rebels at Thomas & Mack, with the Lobos' last road win in the series coming in 2017-18 (85-81)

## **A TALE OF TWO SIN CITIES**

- Recently, UNM has had a lot of success in Las Vegas, just when playing anyone other than UNLV
- The Lobos have won nine straight in Vegas (inc. Henderson) over the past two seasons in neutral site games, but have lost six straight to the Runnin' Rebels at Thomas & Mack
- Last year at the Thomas & Mack Center, New Mexico became the first team to ever win four games in four days to win the Mountain West Tournament
- UNM is 5-0 in Henderson over the past two seasons, including a win over No. 22 UCLA this season

## STREAK SNAPPED WITH SAN JOSE STATE VICTORY

- The Dec. 4 win over San Jose State marked the first time in nearly two full years that the Lobos won a game in which they didn't have a double-digit lead at some point during the game (UNM's largest lead was the final margin of six)
- In each of the Lobos' previous 36 victories, they had a double-figure lead at some point during the game
- The Lobos held a double-digit lead in the first six victories this season, following a 2023-24 season where UNM held a double-digit lead in all 26 victories
- Prior to the win over the Spartans, New Mexico's last victory in a game when they never held a double-digit lead was an 81-79 overtime win over Boise State in 2022-23 (largest lead was five)
- The Lobos have since accomplished the feat twice more, having won without a double digit leads in the wins over Nevada and at Wyoming

## **SWEEP LA**

- Since 2000, New Mexico was the 27th non-conference team to play both UCLA and USC in the same regular season, and became the seventh to earn wins over both in the same year
- The previous six teams since 1999-00 to beat both UCLA and USC in the non-conference schedule are Pepperdine (2001-02), Kansas (2010-11), Kansas (2011-12), San Diego State (2012-13), Monmouth (2015-16) and Gonzaga (2023-24)

### <u>UP NEXT</u>

- The Lobos visit Utah State next Saturday (7:30 pm, FS1) in a matchup of the two teams currently with just one Mountain West loss this season
- It is the first of two meetings, with UNM hosting the Aggies on Feb. 16
- New Mexico is looking for its first win in Logan since 2015 (lost seven straight at Smith Spectrum)
