LEADING OFF...

Winners of seven of its last 10 after a 3-1 week at home that included a midweek win over Grand Canyon and a series win over Air Force, New Mexico Baseball (15-12, 6-3 MW) heads south for its second Rio Grande Rivalry meeting of the season with New Mexico State (15-13, 3-3 C-USA) tomorrow evening in Las Cruces.

Heading into the fourth week of conference play, the Lobos remain one of the nation's most productive offenses - they rank No. 16 in the nation in team Batting Average (0.320), No. 16 in slugging (.545), tied for No. 13 in doubles per game (2.61) and tied for No. 28 in triples per game (0.37) while cracking the Top 75 in the nation in on-base percentage (65th, .413), scoring per nine innings (64th, 8.1), double plays per game (T-No. 72, 0.78) and homers per game (39th, 1.52).

They'll be looking to clinch at least a split in the season-long four game series, with the next two games on April 15 in Las Cruces and April 22 in Albuquerque. The Lobos took the first meeting between the two teams in dominant fashion at home on Feb. 25, when Dayne Pengelly and four other New Mexico relievers combined to throw a two-hitter as UNM blanked the Aggies 7-0 at Santa Ana Star Field.

ALL-TIME SERIES

UNM is 168-95 all-time against their rivals to the south, with a 79-34 record in home matchups after winning the two teams' only matchup last year in Albuquerque on March 19 and a 63-52 record in Las Cruces. UNM went 1-2 against the Aggies in 2024 before their initially-scheduled fourth game in Albuquerque was scrapped due to weather. Tod Brown is 7-4 against the Aggies in his tenure as UNM Head Coach.

LAST RIVALRY MEETING (2/25)

Dayne Pengelly and four other New Mexico relievers combined to throw a two-hitter, Jordy Oriach went yard for the third time in as many games and the Lobos blanked New Mexico State 7-0 in their first rivalry matchup of the season on Feb. 25 at Santa Ana Star Field, snapping a three-game win streak for the Aggies. Pengelly threw five shutout innings - holding the Aggies to just one hit in that span - while striking out four and walking two to earn his first win of the season (1-0). The bullpen backed him up with four shutout frames, including 1-2-3 innings from

Josh Barnhouse and Daxton Purser – the latter striking out the side in the ninth to end the game in emphatic fashion.

Jordy Oriach powered the UNM offense with a 2-for-3 performance, blasting his third home run of the season and driving in three runs. Will Asby added a two-run double, while Brodey Williams went 2-for-4 with an RBI as the Lobos (5-4) plated six runs in the first three innings and never looked back. Ethan Ott added a triple and scored a run and Karsen Waslefsky, Khalil Walker and Akili Carris all singled while scoring a run apiece.

The Lobos struck early, manufacturing a run in the second before exploding for five in the third. Oriach's two-run single capped a rally that included a two-run double from Asby and Williams' RBI single. They added one more in the eighth on a sacrifice fly from Cooper Brass after loading the bases to threaten to run-rule the Aggies late.

The Aggies never found an answer, managing just two singles while striking out nine times. The Lobos turned two double plays and didn't commit an error en route to their first shutout victory of the season.

LOBOS EDGE LOPES IN MIDWEEK SLUGFEST

New Mexico launched four home runs and used a pair of five-run frames to knock off Grand Canyon 12-10 in high-scoring midweek nonconference action at home on Tuesday night at Santa Ana Star Field, marking the Lobos' first win over the Lopes in five years.

Trailing 4-2 entering the bottom of the fifth, UNM erupted for five runs in the frame to take the lead for good. The Lobos tacked on five more in the seventh, holding off a late push from GCU (14-10, 2-1 WAC) to win their seventh home game in a row.

Akili Carris (2-for-4, HR, 5 RBI, 2B) fueled the offensive outburst with two clutch hits that sparked both five-spots for UNM, delivering a three-run double in the fifth before crushing his first career homer to drive in three runs in the seventh and notch a new career-high with 5 RBI. Jordy Oriach (3-for-4, HR, 3 RBI, 2B) also had a big night at the plate, collecting three hits and matching McAlister with his eighth big fly of the year as part of the Lobos' five-run fifth.

New Mexico finished with nine hits, with Josh McAlister (1-for-3, HR, RBI, BB) going yard for

the eighth time this season and Andrew Neil (1-for-5, HR, RBI) adding a solo shot – his fourth in his last five games – to give the Lobos their third game of the season with four or more homers. RHP Josh Barnhouse (1.0 IP, 2 H, 0 ER) and RHP Ty Cunningham (1.0 IP, 2 H, 0 ER, Save) locked things down over the final two frames, with Cunningham earning his fifth save of the season.

LAST TIME OUT (vs. Air Force, 3/28-3/30)

New Mexico claimed its second Mountain West weekend series of the year with a pair of wins over Air Force at home last weekend (6-4, 12-7, 1-7), hitting .322 as a team while scoring 23 runs on 38 hits. The Lobos took Friday's opener in a 6-4 victory and clinched the series with a 12-7 win on Saturday that marked their third win in a row before the Falcons salvaged the finale with a 7-1 win. In total, UNM slugged five doubles and four home runs, posting a .454 slugging percentage and .393 on-base percentage. Defensively, the Lobos recorded a .974 fielding percentage with three errors in the series.

Khalil Walker (.500, 5-for-10, 2 2B, 1 RBI, .700 SLG, .545 OBP) led the offense with a dominant weekend, finishing with a team-high five hits with two doubles -- he's now up to 10 two-baggers on the season.

Brodey Williams (.375) was productive in two

EARLY RETURNS

Walker & Asby Named Preseason All-MW; Lobo Baseball Tabbed Fourth in Coaches' Poll:

- Outfielders Khalil Walker and Will Asby were named to the All-Conference Preseason Team and New Mexico was one of three teams tied for fourth in the Mountain West Preseason Coaches' Poll released Monday ahead of the 2025 baseball season.

- Walker and Asby – who both were All-MW selections after their first season at UNM in 2024 – make UNM one of four teams with multiple preseason all-league selections.

- With 27 points, the Lobos are tied for fourth alongside UNLV (1 first-place vote) and San Diego State, the third season in a row in which they've improved their preseason rank. Before the 2023 season, UNM was picked to finish seventh and ultimately finished fifth — before the 2024 season, they were voted fifth and closed out the regular season one game out of sharing a regular-season championship with Air Force.

Asby Named to D1Baseball.com's Top 100 Outfielders:

- Senior Will Asby clocked in at No. 91 in the nation on D1Baseball.com's National Outfielders Rankings released last week. In his first season with the Lobos in 2024, Asby entered the outlet's midseason Top 100 Outfielder rankings at No. 94 after not being ranked heading into the season.

- Last season, Asby ranked second in the league in runs scored (59), eighth in slugging (.601) and ninth in total hits (71), breaking the program record for single-season grand slams with four – he needs one more to match Mark Wulfert's career record of five.

"Keep an Eye On" New Mexico in Mountain West Race:

- D1Baseball.com slated New Mexico as the team to "Keep an eye on" in this year's Mountain West race behind preseason favorite Fresno State, citing improved pitching depth and a host of high-level hitters returning.

- "This year's team has a chance at making [an NCAA Regional] with five returnees who hit .300-plus, two returning weekend starters on the mound and five key pieces in the bullpen also coming back to campus."

A LOOK AT THE SCHEDULE

- The 53-game schedule, including 30 Mountain West Conference games, opens up at the MLB Desert Invitational in Arizona (Feb. 14-16) and concludes with a conference weekend series at home vs. Fresno State (May 15-17). In that span, the Lobos will face four different teams that reached NCAA Regionals last spring – Arizona, UC Irvine, Grand Canyon and Fresno State – nine times.

- In total, UNM will play 27 games at Santa Ana Star Field in Albuquerque and 26 games on the road throughout the regular season, with 18 games against seven opponents that ranked in the Top 150 in the nation in last season's final RPI rankings.

- Should the Lobos stand among the top six teams in the Mountain West standings upon the conclusion of that weekend, they'll earn a berth to the expanded MWC Baseball Championships May 21-25, hosted this year in Mesa, Ariz.

ESTABLISHED HITTING

UNM holds the nation's 2nd-ranked batting average since 2014, a .307 clip in the last 10 seasons. The Lobos hit .319 to rank 7th nationally in 2024.

- UNM's 2025 roster includes 13 returning players with 17 newcomers – the Lobos return seven position players who appeared in at least 20 games in 2024 while losing seven.

- Of the Lobos' newcomers, five are freshmen and 12 are transfers – nine transfers are from junior colleges and three from four-year institutions.

- 30 players are upperclassmen – 15 seniors and 15 juniors – the most upperclassmen Brown has had on a roster in Albuquerque.

PROGRAM-BUILDING RESUME

- In his first five seasons as head coach at North Dakota State, Brown's teams improved their winning percentage in each season, going from 15-30 (.333) in his first season in 2008 to 40-20 (.667) in 2012 and finishing each of the next nine seasons above .400. The Bison reached the Summit League tournament eight times in that span, advancing to NCAA Regionals in 2014 and 2021.

- He's done the same in each of his first three years in Albuquerque, improving from 21-33 (10-20 MW) in 2022 to 26-25 (13-17 MW) in 2023 to 28-26 (17-13 MW) in 2024.

- Brown coached the Bison to 40-win seasons in 2012 and 2021.

- In Brown's second season at UNM, the Lobos improved to 26-25 from 21-33 the year prior, with the highest team batting average since 2013 (.328) and lowest team ERA since 2016 (5.95). They finished 28-26 on the season (28-24 in regular-season games) the following season in 2024.

- In 16 seasons as a D-I Head Coach, Brown has finished the season above .400 13 times and above .500 seven times – the only three seasons in which he's finished below .400 were his first two years in Fargo (2008, 2009) and his first season in Albuquerque (2022).

2024 REVIEW / 2025 PREVIEW

The Lobos improved their overall record for the second year in a row in 2024 en route to their first Mountain West Tournament berth since 2017, going 28-26 and 17-13 in Mountain West play. UNM wrapped up the season ranked among the nation's most productive offensive teams, posting the seventh-highest team batting average (.319) in the nation while ranking among the Top 50 in team slugging (No. 31, .515), on-base percentage (No. 13, .421), doubles per game (No. 17, 2.24), triples per game (T-No.40, 0.30) and runs per game (No. 25, 8.4).

Heading into Head Coach Tod Brown's fourth year at the helm, the Lobos return four of their top six batters by average – including 2024 MW batting and on-base leader Khalil Walker and fellow All-MW outfielder Will Asby - as well as three starting pitchers that saw significant weekend action last season in Dayne Pengelly (11 GS, 50 IP), David Lopez (11 GS, 65.1 IP) and Daxton Purser (7 GS, 35 IP).

This season, with Washington State joining as an affiliate member for baseball, the Mountain West is an eight-team league for the first time since in conference's history. With the addition of the Cougars, the conference tournament will expand to six teams for the first time since 2016, when UNM last won the tournament to secure an automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament. This year's MW Baseball Championship will also be the first hosted at a neutral-site, set for May 21-25 in Mesa, Ariz.

starts, doubling and finishing with three hits on eight at-bats, Will Asby (.375) homered and drove in a team-high four runs after being out of the lineup on Tuesday and Friday and Tye Wood (.333) and Josh McAlister (.300) made it five Lobos batting above .300 last weekend.

The Lobos posted a 5.67 ERA on the weekend, getting a solid start from LHP Daxton Purser on Friday (5.2 IP, 5 H, 3 ER, 1 BB, 10 K) as the big lefty came one strikeout shy of matching his career-high from last Friday at Nevada. RHP Ryan Castillo (5.0 IP, 6 H, 6 ER, 3 BB, 6 K) recovered well from an early Falcons outburst on Saturday to keep the Lobos in the game and seven relievers toed the bump for UNM on the weekend, with LHP Presley Monteforte (3.1 IP, 2 H, 0 R, 0 BB, 3 K) notching a new-career high with three scoreless frames of relief on Sunday.

LONG BALL LOBOS

Through 27 games this season, 12 different players have combined for 41 home runs, exiting the ballpark eight times last week at home vs. Grand Canyon and Air Force. UNM is averaging 1.52 homers per nine innings so far this season, good for 39th in the nation.

Josh McAlister leads the way with nine homers after going yard twice last week and Jordy Oriach is just behind with eight, while Ethan Ott (5), Will Asby (4), Andrew Neil (4), Caleb Herd (3) Karsen Waslefsky (2) and Khalil Walker (2) all have multiple. McAlister has already exceeded his homer total from the 2024 season (31 games played).

2025 ROSTER BREAKDOWN

THE OUTFIELD

The Lobos have the best possible problem on their hands in the outfield, with three returning starters in Khalil Walker, Tye Wood and Will Asby as well as 2023 NJCAA All-American transfer Jordy Oriach (Frank Phillips College) in the mix to compete for a spot.

In 2024, Walker led the MW in batting average (.391) and on-base percentage (.490) – ranking 20th and 43rd in the nation in those categories – with the lowest strikeout-to-walk ratio (30 BB/24 SO) among conference players in his first season as a Lobo. Asby ranked second in the league in runs scored (59), eighth in slugging (.601) and ninth in total hits (71), breaking the program record for single-season grand slams with four – he needs just one more to match Mark Wulfert's career record of five.

They're joined in the outfield by a productive switch-hitter in Wood (51 starts in 2024), who ranked 44th in the nation in on-base percentage (.488) and stole 20 bases last season, the second-most in the league and most by a Lobo in a single season since Josh Melendez in 2012 (23).

THE INFIELD

First and foremost, the Lobos look to replace three crucial middle infielders that soaked up most of the reps at shortstop and second in 2024 – Chase Weissenborn, Devon Dixon and Konner Kinkade. After both splitting time at the hot corner last season, junior Akili Carris (.301 average, 30 GS) looks to slot in at third full-time with senior Josh McAlister (.287 average, 10 XBH, 25 GS) moving back to second base, where he played over two seasons at Ohio State (2021-22). Luke Mansy (14 GP/7 GS) and juco transfer Karsen Waslefsky (South Mountain CC) also look to get significant reps up the middle, with utility transfer Elias Fiddler (Utah) as another option with D-I experience. Cooper Brass – who redshirted last season as a true freshman – and freshman Shane Miller are also both in the mix for reps up the middle in their collegiate debut seasons.

With the graduation of Reed Spenrath – who started 89 of 104 games at first base for UNM the past two seasons – UNM has two sluggers that could feasibly move into the starting spot in Ethan Ott (.553 slugging, 23 RBI in 30 games in 2024) and Gene Trujillo (.630 slugging, 13 RBI in 25 games). Both showed plenty of power at the DH spot in 2024, combining for eight homers and 10 doubles even with limited AB's.

CATCHERS

UNM relied on two fifth-year catchers in 2024, and there's a three-way competition for who will get the most reps behind the dish in '25. Ironically, Caleb Herd – a junior who played his true freshman season at UNM in 2023 before transferring to Pima CC and returning to UNM this fall – is the only catcher on roster who's appeared in a collegiate game for the Lobos. But junior transfer Brodey Williams (McLennan CC) and 2024 greyshirt Luke Banister are both in the mix to become key pieces.

PITCHING STAFF

In '24, the Lobos' pitching staff posted a 7.71 team ERA after losing all three weekend starters from 2023 to the draft or graduation – with 10 newcomers and 32 games at elevation in New Mexico, UNM's arms had significantly improved by the end of the season, posting a 5.17 ERA over the Lobos' final 10 games and a 5.98 over their last 20.

In the process, they struck out 394 in total – the most in a single season in Brown's tenure and seventh-most in a single season in program history. This year's returning arms produced 233 of those punchouts.

This year, all three projected weekend starters are senior returners that all got significant reps in 2024 in RHP Dayne Pengelly (11 GS, 50 IP), RHP David Lopez (11 GS, 65.1 IP) and LHP Daxton Purser (7 GS, 35 IP).

From D1Baseball: "The highlight of the fall practice sessions had to be the performance of the three projected starting weekend pitchers: righthanders Dayne Pengelly and David Lopez and lefthander Daxton Purser. The three seniors offer a lot of experience and combined for 30 of last year's 54 starts. Pengelly can hit 95 on the guns and though he had some peaks and valleys last year (4-5, 7.63), the coaches say he can flash "unicorn-level stuff" when he is on. His power slider is his go-to pitch when he needs a big out. Lopez also posted some lofty numbers (4-2, 7.71) but his low-90s fastball has good life and his four-pitch mix (fastball, curveball, slider, splitter) has shown good improvement over the course of the offseason. Purser came out of high school as the No. 2-ranked lefthanded pitcher in the state of Utah and held opposing batters to a .245 average last season, which was the best of all the regular Lobo pitchers. He did not allow an earned run in his final three appearances."

McBroom (95.1 IP in 59 app. at UNM), Josh Barnhouse (18 app. 35.1 IP in 2024), Ryan Castillo (10 app., 20.1 IP in 2024) and Ben Baker-Livingston (52.2 IP in 24 app. at UNM) – with six transfer juniors and four freshmen joining them.

From D1Baseball: "The bullpen has some interesting pieces and timely additions. Righthander Ryan Castillo exceeded expectations as a freshman last season and looks to improve on his 1-2, 11.57 numbers. The coaches say he showed flashes of "next-level strike throwing" in the fall sessions. Castillo could also figure into a starting role this coming spring. Two transfers who will play key roles this season are lefty Matthew Cornelius (12 appearances at Arizona State, 3-0, 10.80) and righty Jack Messmore (13 starts at Delaware State, 2-4, 6.47), who both have key D1 experience. Another southpaw who will play a big role in the bullpen plans will be JC transfer Presley Monteforte, who uses a ton of deception in his offspeed offerings, which makes his 87-89 fastball play way up."

SANTA ANA STAR FIELD - ALBUQUERQUE, N.M.

Santa Ana Star Field has become one of the toughest places for opponents to play in college baseball as The University of New Mexico baseball team is 166-98-2 (.629) since returning to its former location on March 24, 2013 after nine seasons at Isotopes Park. For decades the home of UNM baseball was known as Lobo Field, but thanks to a 10-year, \$1 million naming rights gift from Tamaya Enterprises, Lobo Field was rechristened Santa Ana Star Field on Dec. 11, 2015.

"We are delighted to strengthen our relationship with Tamaya Enterprises, who have been long-standing supporters of the Lobos," said former UNM Vice President for Athletics Paul Krebs. "The field naming rights is a great example of their commitment to the community and provides us an opportunity for Lobo Athletics to give back to the Pueblo of Santa Ana. The beneficiary of this field naming rights is not just our baseball program but our entire community and state." That was the second major announcement regarding the facility in a three-week span in 2015 as on Nov. 20, the UNM Board of Regents approved construction for the \$2.3 million R.D. and Joan Dale Hubbard Clubhouse.

"This has been a long process, but I want to thank the Hubbards, Scott Grady and his family, our administration, Vice President for Athletics Paul Krebs, and everyone on main campus that helped this project," UNM head coach Ray Birmingham said. "I could go on for hours thanking people because so many have helped make this possible." Santa Ana Star Field received a major upgrade that started before the 2013 season. It received a FieldTurf playing surface, upgraded scoreboard, dugouts, bullpens, and bleachers as a part of the first phase of the Santa Ana Star Field renovation. Further renovations and phases will enhance the concessions areas, the fan plaza between Santa Ana Star Field and the softball field, the press box and the bleachers. Lights were installed



in the fall of 2013.

"We have lights because of (former Lobo) Dee Dennis and a bunch of guys who chipped in to help me and Dee do this," Birmingham said. "This is Lobo Field. This is (the state of) New Mexico's baseball field, at least that's how I feel about it. ... There will not only be Lobo games on here, but there will also be state championship games here. We hope to bring in some great big tournaments over the years to this city and let our kids experience the world. We think New Mexico kids can get the rest of the experiences that the rest of the country has, then they will grow faster and realize they're as good

TOD BROWN

HEAD COACH

Tod Brown was named the 12th Lobo Baseball Head Coach on June 17, 2021. He enters the 2024 season in his third year at the helm.

In Brown's second season, the Lobos posted their best winning percentage in a full season since 2017 (.510), finishing fifth in the Mountain West standings (26-25, 13-17 MW) and leading the league in a variety of categories including team batting average (.328), runs (441), RBI (411), triples (24), home runs (87), slugging % (.559) and on-base % (.406). UNM also improved from a 9.06 ERA as a team in Brown's first season to a 5.95 ERA — the program's lowest in a single season since 2016 — while

averaging only 3.20 walks per nine innings, its fewest since 2014. Following the completion of that season, RHP Isaac Gallegos became the first UNM player coached by Brown to be selected in the MLB Draft, going in the 16th Round to the Atlanta Braves.

The 2023 Lobos ranked in the Top 10 in the country in a variety of team statistical categories:

No. 3 in Batting Average (.329)

No. 9 in Double Plays per Game (0.94)

No. 5 in Doubles Per Game (2.45)

No. 10 in Runs per Game (8.60)

No. 4 in Slugging Percentage (.560)

No. 5 in Triples (24) and Triples per Game (0.47)

No. 10 in Walks Allowed per Nine Innings (3.20)

Following the 2023 season, the Lobos also got three All-MW selections — first baseman Reed Spennath was a first-team selection, while third baseman Dylan Ditzenberger and left fielder Lenny Junior Ashby were second-team selections. Ditzenberger went on to be named a CSC Academic All-American for his efforts on the field and in the classroom. Both UNM teams that Brown has coached (2022, 2023) have earned the ABCA Team Academic Excellence Award for their academic accomplishments.

In the 2022 season — Brown's first season in Albuquerque — UNM went 21-33 and finished sixth in the MW standings, with Lenny Junior Ashby and Jeffrey David named to the All-MW Second Team.

PRIOR TO UNM

Brown came to New Mexico after a successful 14 years and 341 wins with North Dakota State, where he currently sits as the second-winningest coach in program history and is the all-time leader in wins per season (24.4). In 2021, Brown led the Bison to the 2021 NCAA Tournament, winning its first Division I postseason game 6-1 over Mountain West opponent Nevada. In the same season, NDSU broke a school record with 20 Summit League victories, besting the previous record of 19 set by his 2017 team, and posted an overall record of 42-19. The Bison also led the nation with 25 road wins and set new school records in strikeouts (474) and putouts (1,567) in a single season.

Brown is no stranger to winning — he owns the two highest single season win totals in NDSU history (42 wins in 2021, 40 wins in 2012), and the only two 40+ win seasons by the program. Brown also owns three of the top-five single-season win totals in NDSU history. Under Brown's leadership, NDSU has played in five Summit League championship games, winning it outright in 2021 and 2014, and qualified for the league's baseball championship eight out of the last 11 years.

Brown took the helm of NDSU in 2008 and turned around a program that had faced three consecutive losing seasons, posting just 38 wins from 2005-07. In 2012, NDSU won a then-school-record 40 games, including an 8-2 win over a No. 5-ranked Arizona team that went on to win the 2012 College World Series. North Dakota State had a school-record .973 fielding percentage and posted a team ERA of 3.38, which was the program's lowest ERA in 37 years.

In 2016, the Bison posted a 29-25 overall record and set a new record for home wins at Newman Outdoor Field with 17 victories. In addition, North Dakota State set a new single season record in saves (17). NDSU defeated No. 19-ranked Minnesota on April 26 in Fargo, marking the second-ever win over an NCAA Division I top-25 opponent.

In the Summit League, Brown has coached two Summit League Players of the Year, one Summit League Newcomer of the Year, 46 All-Summit League selections, 22 Summit League Players of the Week, and 30 Summit League Pitchers of the Week. Under his leadership, Brown has also led players to two Collegiate Baseball Freshmen All-America selections and two College Baseball National Players of the Week.

Not only does Brown produce talent on the field, but also in the classroom. During his tenure at NDSU, Brown has had three NCAA Postgraduate Scholarship Winners, one Senior CLASS Award All-America, one CoSIDA Academic All-America Athlete of the Year, nine CoSIDA Academic All-America selections, 11 CoSIDA Academic All-District selections, one Summit League Scholar-Athlete of the Year, 16 Summit League Academic All-League selections, and was twice honored by NCAA with Public Recognition for perfect APR scores (2012-13 and 2015-16).

The Tucson, Ariz. native, was a left-handed pitcher for the Arizona Wildcats from 1989-94, leading the team in 1992 to a Pac-10 Championship. In 1993 he won six games and saved eight, setting a record with 35 appearances as Arizona fell one game short of Omaha.

Brown then made a career out of coaching college ball in the northern tier of the country. He came to NDSU after eight seasons in Ohio as the pitching coach and recruiting coordinator for Bowling Green State University.

During this time, he recruited or helped develop eight players who have reached the major leagues, including former UNM pitching standout Jamie Vermilyea, who played for the Lobos from 2001-03.

from Sabino High School, in Tucson, Ariz., outfielder Shelley Duncan and pitchers Josh Pearce and Ben Diggins at the University of Arizona, and pitcher Burke Badenhop and outfielder Nolan Reimold from Bowling Green.

After two years as the pitching coach at Sabino High School in Tucson, Ariz., Brown began his collegiate coaching career in 1999 as a volunteer assistant for Arizona. He worked with pitchers and catchers and was the first-base coach for the Wildcats, who qualified for an NCAA regional.

Brown was also a head coach for the San Francisco Seals of the California Coastal Collegiate League in the summer of 1999, compiling a 43-29 record and making a fourth-place finish in the National Baseball Congress World Series.

Tod and his wife Janet have a 23-year old son, Brooks, and a 20-year old daughter, Blake.



MICHAEL LOPEZ

ASSISTANT COACH: PITCHING

Michael Lopez, who previously served as head coach at Howard Community College in Big Spring, Texas, joined the Lobos in the 2021-22 season as a pitching coach. Lopez joined the Lobo squad after spending two seasons at the helm of the Howard program, bolstering a 48-19 overall record.

In 2024, UNM's pitching staff struck out 394 batters in Lopez' third year — the most since 2019 and seventh-most in program history — and collected 10 saves, also the most since 2019. They finished the season with the most wins (28) since 2017 with a No.

2 seed in the MW Tournament, finishing one game away from a regular season championship. In the second season with Lopez coordinating UNM's pitching, the team's ERA improved from 9.06 to 5.95 — UNM's lowest since 2016. UNM pitchers under Lopez also posted their lowest WHIP (1.59) since 2015 and fewest walks per nine innings (3.20) since 2014 in the process, with RHP Isaac Gallegos selected in the 2023 MLB Draft following the season's completion. Under Lopez, two Howard Hawks were named to the 2021 All-Region V Baseball Team, including pitcher Kris Anglin, who led the league in strikeouts (103). Howard's Ethan Coombes was second in the league in strikeouts, retiring 82 throughout the season. Prior to becoming the head coach of the Hawks, Lopez spent three years as an assistant coach under previous head coach, Rob Martinez.

During his time at Howard College, Lopez worked primarily with the pitchers and served as the recruiting coordinator. He has had over 40 players sign with Division I schools during his tenure, three players sign contracts with professional teams, and three players selected as

NJCAA All-Americans.

Lopez originally came to Howard College after a one-year stint with a brand-new NAIA program, Marymount California University (MCU). During his one year at MCU, Lopez was named the associate head coach and helped with day-to-day recruiting.

In the first year of the program, Lopez helped the Mariners win the CAL PAC Conference Championship and reach the 2016 West Grouping Championship. Lopez had three players selected to the 2016 All-California Pacific Conference Team while also coaching the CAL PAC conference player of the year and the CAL PAC Freshman of the year.

Prior to coaching at Marymount California University, Lopez was the volunteer assistant coach for two seasons at the University of Arizona under head coach Andy Lopez. Lopez assisted with the pitchers during practices and helped run the bullpen during games. Off the field, his job consisted of preparing scouting reports on opposing teams, directing the Andy Lopez Baseball Camp, and assisting with recruiting.

Lopez's collegiate career in baseball includes four years (2009-2012) at the University of Arizona. Lopez was named captain of the 2012 team, which won the NCAA National Championship in Omaha, Nebraska.

Lopez graduated from The University of Arizona in 2013 with a bachelor's degree in family studies.



MATT RISDON

ASSISTANT COACH / RECRUITING COORDINATOR

Matt Risdon joined the Lobo Family in 2022 as a volunteer assistant coach, and he currently serves recruiting coordinator and assistant coach. Risdon was previously at Lenoir-Rhyne University for three seasons. Risdon was a Division I catcher at Western Illinois for two seasons and served on the coaching staff for the Fighting Leathenecks from August 2015-July 2019. At UNM, he has been primarily responsible for coaching fielders and hitters.

In 2023, Risdon-coached hitters posted UNM's highest team batting average since 2013 (.328) — good

for best in the conference and No. 3 in NCAA D-I — while leading the MWC in OPS, hits, runs, triples, RBI and home runs. The Lobos' .974 fielding percentage in 2022 was the second-best in program history and best in the MWC, and their 48 double plays turned was the most in the conference.

The Lobos put up similar numbers in 2024 en route to their best MW finish (2nd) and first MW Tournament berth since 2017 — at the end of the season, UNM ranked No. 7 in NCAA D-I in Batting Average (.319) and No. 13 in On Base Percentage (.421) as well as No. 17 in Doubles Per Game (2.24), No. 31 in Slugging Percentage (.515), No. 25 in Scoring (8.4), leading the MW in nearly every offensive category. The Lobos posted a .968 fielding percentage while

ranking No. 15 in the nation in Double Plays Per Game (0.94).

In 2022, Risdon helped Lenoir-Rhyne University to the best season in program history with a 46-13 overall record and a record 25 wins at home. The Bears would post a 19-game winning streak, the longest in program history, and were ranked as high as No. 11 in the nation. The Bears would capture just the third SAC Tournament title in program history and advanced to just the second NCAA Tournament appearance in team history. Risdon was the catching coach and assisted with hitting and recruiting. In 2022 the Bears broke multiple offensive records such as: home runs, runs, RBIs, walks, HBPs, hits, as well as many other team records. The Bears season was capped off with their senior catcher, Nick Clarno, signing with the Atlanta Braves.

Risdon began his coaching career as the Director of Baseball Operations with WIU in August 2015 and served in that role for one season before being named the program's graduate assistant. After finishing his Master in Sports Management in May 2017, Risdon earned the title of assistant coach and recruiting coordinator prior to the 2018 campaign. Risdon was primarily responsible for catchers and assisted with hitting and infielders while also serving as the third base coach. Risdon helped with defensive positioning and discussed hitting approach with players during game review. Risdon also helped with administrative duties such as: travel, team meals, fundraising, scouting, and monitoring student-athlete academic eligibility.

Risdon played in 40 career games for Western Illinois. He earned his bachelor's degree in exercise science in 2015.



JUSTIN MITCHELL

ASSISTANT COACH: HITTING

Justin Mitchell joined the Lobo Family in August of 2023 and he serves as assistant coach. He coaches UNM's catchers as well as hitting for head coach Tod Brown.

In his first season as UNM's hitting coach, the Lobos wrapped up the regular season as the MW's statistical leaders in batting average (.323), slugging % (.521) and on-base % (.426) as well as runs (448), hits (588), RBI (415), total bases (947) and walks (285).

They ranked No. 8 in the nation in average at the conclusion of the season.

Mitchell spent the 2023 season as a graduate assistant coach at K-State under Pete Hughes. The 2023 Wildcats went 35-24 and advanced to the semifinals of the Big 12 Championship. His G.A. stint came after he played one season at K-State, hitting .308 with five homers and 22 RBIs over 52 games, playing catcher as a grad transfer. Mitchell played four seasons at Oklahoma, where he graduated. Over his time he played in 116 games, hitting .261 with two homers and 38 RBIs. He recorded 991 career putouts as a catcher.

He graduated from Oklahoma in 2022.
