LEADING OFF...

- New Mexico Baseball opens a pivotal Mountain West series this weekend at Santa Ana Star Field, welcoming Washington State to Albuquerque for the first time in the first meeting between the two teams since 1994.
 - Heading into this week, the Lobos remain one of the nation's most productive offenses – they rank No. 27 in the nation in team Batting Average (0.314), No. 18 in slugging (.536), No. 12 in doubles per game (2.48) and tied for No. 43 in triples per game (0.31) while cracking the Top 100 in the nation in on-base percentage (86th, .404), scoring per nine innings (59th, 8.0), total double plays (No. 96, 22) and homers per game (31st, 1.55).
 - Last week, the Lobos defeated New Mexico State on the road on Tuesday (15-10) to secure at least a split of the two rivals' four-game season series but dropped all three matchups with Fresno State on the road last weekend (5-12, 3-11, 7-13) to drop into a tie for third in the conference standings (6-6 in MW play).
 - They bounced back with a loud 15-5 run-rule win on Tuesday upon their return to Albuquerque, plating seven runs in the opening frame and seven more across the seventh and eighth to end things early.
- All of this weekend's series will be available to stream free via the MW Network at GoLobos.com/BSBGameDay. Follow @UNMLoboBaseball on IG, X and Facebook for comprehensive coverage, promotional updates, behind-the-scenes content and more.

ALL-TIME SERIES

- The Lobos have only faced the Cougars twice in a pair of neutral-site matchups in 1992 and 1994, drawing in the first (8-8) before the Lobos fell 0-11 in the second. This will be the

first meeting between the two teams as conference opponents as well as the first in Albuquerque.

- UNM Head Coach Tod Brown has never faced the Cougars in his time as head coach at both NDSU and with the Lobos.

LOBOS RUN-RULE RED RAIDERS IN THE 505

- New Mexico plated seven runs in the opening frame and never looked back en route to its second run-rule victory in a row over Texas Tech in midweek action Tuesday afternoon at Santa Ana Star Field, dispatching the Red Raiders 15-5 in eight innings after a double from Will Asby yielded the requisite runs in the bottom of the frame to end things early.
- With the win, the Lobos have now defeated Texas Tech in each of the last four seasons. They've won the last two games against TTU by run rule – blowing the Red Raiders out 17-3 in seven innings in Lubbock in their previous meeting last April – and have outscored them 32-8 in those two games combined.
- It's also the Lobos' second Top-100 RPI win of the season -- they improve to 2-2 against teams among the Top 100 in the nation in RPI.
- Tye Wood reached base six times without being retired to lead a 16-hit outing for the

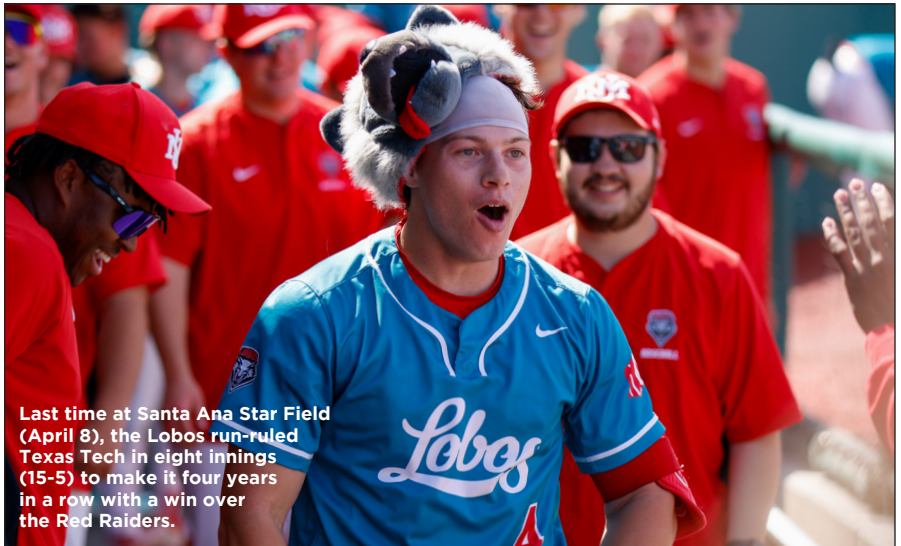

Last time at Santa Ana Star Field (April 8), the Lobos run-ruled Texas Tech in eight innings (15-5) to make it four years in a row with a win over the Red Raiders.

Lobos in their return to the mountains, going 3-for-3 with three walks to go with four runs scored and three more driven in. The senior switch-hitter picked up hits from both sides of the plate in the first inning alone – the first UNM player to get a hit both left-handed and right-handed in the same game since Mitch Haggerty against Fresno State on April 12, 2013. He finished a triple shy of the cycle after drawing a walk in each of his final three plate appearances.

Karsen Waslefsky also had himself a career day, going 4-for-4 with a walk while scoring three runs and adding one RBI. Will Asby (2-for-4, BB, HR, 2B, 4 RBI, 1 R) doubled and homered while drawing a pair of walks, Jordy Oriach (2-for-5, HR, 2 RBI, 2 R) mashed his league-leading 11th home run of the season and Ethan Ott (2-for-4, BB, 2B, 1 RBI, 1 R) laced his 10th double of the year to make it five Lobos with multiple hits.

Starting on the bump on Tuesday for the second week in a row since working his way back from Tommy John surgery over the offseason, redshirt freshman RHP Cristian Mogen (2.2 IP, 0 H, 0 R, 1 BB, 3 K) turned in a strong outing to earn his first win of the season, retiring nine of the ten batters he faced.

LONG BALL LOBOS

Through 31 games this season, 13 different players have combined for 48 home runs, exiting the ballpark seven times last week on the road at New Mexico State and Fresno State. UNM is averaging 1.55 homers per nine innings so far this season, moving from 39th in the nation last week to 31st heading into this week's games.

With two homers last week, Jordy Oriach leads the Lobos – and the Mountain West – in homers with 10. Josh McAlister is just behind with nine on the season, while Ethan Ott (7), Will Asby (5), Andrew Neil (4), Caleb Herd (3) Karsen Waslefsky (2) and Khalil Walker (3) all have multiple.

premier hitter in the Mountain West, winning two MW Player of the Week awards and leading the league in hits (45), homers (10), RBI (38), slugging (.756) and total bases (90). He ranks among the Top 100 players in the nation in each category.

THUNDER IN McALISTER'S BAT

Hampered by injury early in his first season as a Lobo in 2024, Josh McAlister homered six times with three doubles and a triple in 31 games played, primarily at third base. In 31 games in 2025 – with the majority of them at second and shortstop – McAlister has exited the ballpark nine times with five doubles. Should he homer one more time this year, he'll match his total homers across the first three seasons of his collegiate career at Ohio State and in Albuquerque (10).

Walker & Asby Named Preseason All-MW; Lobo Baseball Tabbed Fourth in Coaches' Poll:

- Outfielders Khalil Walker and Will Asby were named to the All-Conference Preseason Team and New Mexico was one of three teams tied for fourth in the Mountain West Preseason Coaches' Poll released ahead of the 2025 baseball

season.

- Walker and Asby – who both were All-MW selections after their first season at UNM in 2024 – make UNM one of four teams with multiple preseason all-league selections.

Asby Named to D1Baseball.com's Top 100 Outfielders:

- Senior Will Asby clocked in at No. 91 in the nation on D1Baseball.com's National Outfielders Rankings released last week. In his first season with the Lobos in 2024, Asby entered the outlet's midseason Top 100 Outfielder rankings at No. 94.

ESTABLISHED HITTING PROGRAM
UNM holds the nation's 2nd-ranked batting average since 2014, a .307 clip in the last 10 seasons. The Lobos hit .319 to rank 7th nationally in 2024.

COACH BROWN'S PROGRAM-BUILDING RESUME

– In his first five seasons as head coach at North Dakota State, Brown's teams improved their winning percentage in each season, going from 15-30 (.333) in his first season in 2008 to 40-20 (.667) in 2012 and finishing each of the next nine seasons above .400. The Bison reached the Summit League tournament eight times in that span, advancing to NCAA Regionals in 2014 and 2021.

– He's done the same in each of his first three years in Albuquerque, improving from 21-33 (10-20 MW) in 2022 to 26-25 (13-17 MW) in 2023 to 28-26 (17-13 MW) in 2024.

– In Brown's second season at UNM, the Lobos improved to 26-25 from 21-33 the year prior, with the highest team batting average since 2013 (.328) and lowest team ERA since 2016 (5.95). They finished 28-26 on the season (28-24 in regular-season games) the following season in 2024.

2024 IN REVIEW / 2025 PREVIEW

The Lobos improved their overall record for the second year in a row in 2024 en route to their first Mountain West Tournament berth since 2017, going 28-26 and 17-13 in Mountain West play. UNM wrapped up the season ranked among the nation's most productive offensive teams, posting the seventh-highest team batting average (.319) in the nation while ranking among the Top 50 in team slugging (No. 31, .515), on-base percentage (No. 13, .421), doubles per game (No. 17, 2.24), triples per game (T-No.40, 0.30) and runs per game (No. 25, 8.4).

Heading into Head Coach Tod Brown's fourth year at the helm, the Lobos return four of their top six batters by average as well as three starting pitchers that saw significant weekend action last season. This season, with Washington State joining as an affiliate member for baseball, the Mountain West is an eight-team league for the first time since in conference's history. With the addition of the Cougars, the conference tournament will expand to six teams for the first time since 2016, when UNM last won the tournament to secure an automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament. This year's MW Baseball Championship will also be the first hosted at a neutral-site, set for May 21-25 in Mesa, Ariz.
