LEADING OFF...

Winners of seven of their last nine, New Mexico Baseball looks to keep momentum in a pivotal Mountain West series at home with San Jose State (April 25-27).

After winning more games on the road last week than they had the entire season previously, Head Coach Tod Brown's Lobos look to keep building momentum when they return to Santa Ana Star Field -- where they're 16-5 this season -- for all four games this week.

Heading into their seventh Mountain West series of the year, the Lobos remain one of the nation's most productive offenses – they now rank No. 6 in the nation in team Batting Average (0.327), No. 7 in total hits (462), No. 8 in slugging (.558), No. 4 in doubles per game (2.63) while cracking the Top 100 in the nation in in triples per game (46th, 0.30), on-base percentage (27th, .422), scoring per nine innings (23rd, 8.7), total base on balls (91st, 199) and homers per game (22nd, 1.65).

ALL-TIME SERIES

 In an all-time series between the Spartans and Lobos that began in 1998, UNM is 30-23-1 overall with a 20-7 mark at home and 10-11-1 away. The Lobos are 0-1 against the Spartans on neutral fields after falling to them in the opening round of the MW tournament last spring (5/23).
 Since SJSU joined the MW before the 2014 season, UNM is 28-20-21 against them.

CUNNINGHAM NAMED TO STOPPER OF THE YEAR WATCHLIST

- A day after collecting his 10th save of the season as New Mexico completed a season sweep of in-state rivals N.M. State, Lobos closer Ty Cunningham has been named to the National College Baseball Writers' Association's Stopper of the Year Midseason Watchlist.
- Cunningham's 10 saves lead the Mountain West so far this season and rank No. 4 in the nation
- he's just one away from matching a UNM singleseason record of 11 that has been untouched since 1985 (Ed Bartholomew). He's only the fourth Lobo in program history to record double-digit saves in the same season since it became an official statistical category in 1981.
- In 25.1 innings of work, Cunningham has posted a 3.91 ERA with 22 strikeouts (7.82 K/9) – he's held opponents scoreless in 10 of his 17 appearances so far this season. He's the lone Mountain West pitcher to make the cut.

JOSH McALISTER NAMED MW POTW

- After homering three times and posting a 1.638 OPS as New Mexico went 3-1 for the second week in a row, Lobo Senior Infielder Josh McAlister has been named Mountain West Player of the Week, the league announced Monday afternoon.

the Week honors this season along with Jordy Oriach (Feb. 24, March 3) and Tye Wood (April 15) - Cooper Brass has also earned MW Freshman of the Week honors this season (Feb. 17). It's the first MW Weekly honors of McAlister's career.

- McAlister slashed .400/.438/1.200 across four games (6-for-15) to help New Mexico go 3-1 on the road last week at New Mexico State (12-10) and UNLV (13-7, 3-10, 6-3), driving in a team-high eight runs and scoring three more while hitting three home runs, a double, and a triple. With their first true road series win of the year, the Lobos have now won six of their last eight since suffering a road sweep at first-place Fresno State April 4-6.
- The senior infielder finished with two RBI in all four games on the week with flawless defense across multiple infield positions (SS, 2B, 3B), handling 10 total chances for six assists and four putouts without an error.

RAKING AT HOME

• The Lobos are 16-5 in home games at Santa Ana Star Field this year and batting .374 with an average of 13.0 runs and 15.3 hits per nine innings in those games. Their .761 winning percentage at home so far this season would be the best in any season with 15 or more games in the 12 years since Santa Ana Star Field became the Lobos' home venue. UNM went 14-2 (.875) in their first season calling SAS Field home in 2013. • On Tuesday, UNM secured its 200th win at SAS Field since it opened in 2013.

- Jordy Oriach hits for even more power at 5,300 feet above sea level - he's slugging .913 at home (.772 overall) with 10 doubles, two triples and seven homers in Albuquerque. He leads four Lobos that are batting above .400 at home this season ahead of Khalil Walker (.423), Josh McAlister (.415) and Akili Carris (.407).
- RHP Josh Barnhouse has a 1.86 ERA at home across 10 appearances (19.1 IP), compiling a 3-0 record in those games.
- In games played in cities at 3,900 feet or higher above sea level, the Lobos are 18-7 (.720), batting .364 as a team.

LOBOS SECURE RIVALRY SWEEP AT HOME

- New Mexico Baseball completed a four-game season sweep of in-state rival New Mexico State on Tuesday night at Santa Ana Star Field, never trailing in a 7-6 win that sealed the program's first perfect season series over the Aggies since
- Now winners of seven of their last nine for the only the second time this season, the Lobos (23-17, 10-8 MW) have beaten the Aggies four times in the same season for only the third time

since 1985.

- The Lobos immediately put a run on the board with a leadoff homer from Tye Wood his third of the year and never looked back, building a 7-2 lead through five innings and holding off a late NMSU push down the stretch as RHP Ty Cunningham earned his 10th save of the season to move within one of matching the UNM single-season record held by Ed Bartholomew that has been untouched since 1985. Cunningham is only the fourth Lobo to record double-digit saves in the same season in school history.
- Senior RHP Dayne Pengelly (7.0 IP, 4 H, 4 ER, 2 BB, 4 K) earned his second win of the year to improve to 2-2 on the season with one of his best outings as a Lobo, extending to a season-high 7.0 innings and allowing just four hits and four earned runs while striking out four and walking two. The right-hander out of Rio Rancho faced just one batter over the minimum through four hitless innings before a pair of two-run frames in the fifth and sixth cut the lead to three.
- RHP Luke Wiseman (1.0 IP, 1 H, 1 ER, 0 BB, 1 K) and RHP Ty Cunningham (1.0 IP, 1 H, 1 ER, 2 BB, 1 K) took over for the final two innings, with Cunningham working around two walks and a hit in the ninth to earn his fourth save in his last five appearances. The Aggies' lone run in the top of the ninth snapped a streak of four scoreless outings and six consecutive scoreless frames for Cunningham.
- At the plate, Wood (2-for-5, HR, RBI, 2 R) and Will Asby (1-for-4, HR, BB, RBI. 2 R) each homered and scored a pair of runs, while Jordy Oriach (2-for-4, 2 2B, RBI, BB, 2 R) recorded his 16th and 17th doubles of the season to move back into a tie for most in the Mountain West. Cooper Brass (2-for-3, 2B, 2 RBI, BB) delivered a clutch two-run double on a full count in the third, and Khalil Walker (2-for-3, BB, 1 R) reached base three times out of the nine spot.
- The Lobos outhit the Aggies 10-6 and committed no errors for the 15th time this season. With the win, UNM improves to 4-0 against NMSU on the year, outscoring them 31-26 across the four meetings.

LAST WEEKEND'S SERIES (AT UNLV, 4/17-19)

- New Mexico took its fourth MW weekend series of the year with two wins against UNLV last weekend (13-7, 3-10, 6-3) at Earl E. Wilson Stadium April 17-19.
- The Lobos slugged seven home runs across the series and hit .306 as a team (33-for-108) with a .565 slugging percentage and 22 runs scored.
- UNM tallied five multi-hit games from Akili Carris (.538) and received big-time production from Josh McAlister, who homered three times and drove in a team-high six runs while slugging 1.600 for the weekend to earn his first MW Player of the Week honors.
- Ethan Ott added two home runs and four RBIs, while Jordy Oriach hit .545 with three extra-base hits and three RBIs of his own.
- On the mound, the Lobo bullpen combined for a 3.00 ERA over 12.0 innings, led by senior closer Ty Cunningham, who earned two saves in 3.2 shutout innings and now leads the Mountain West with nine on the year.
- As a staff, UNM held the Rebels to a .250 average and just two home runs while striking out 17 and

LONG BALL LOBOS

Through 40 games this season, 14 different players have combined for 66 home runs, exiting the ballpark eight times last week on the road at New Mexico State and UNLV. UNM is averaging 164 homers per nine innings so far this season, moving up among the nation's leaders in that category for the third week in a row from 31st in the nation last week to 21st heading into this week's games. With three homers last week, Josh McAlister has matched teammate Jordy Oriach - who also homered last week - with a Mountain West-leading 12 HR this season. Ethan Ott is just behind with 11 on the season after going yard three times in the Lobos' last two weekend series, while Will Asby (9), Andrew Neil (4), Caleb Herd (4), Karsen Waslefsky (3), Tye Wood (3) and Khalil Walker (3) all have multiple.
