LEADING OFF...

New Mexico Baseball returns to Santa Ana Star Field for its final – and highest-stakes – weekend series of the 2025 season when the Lobos host Fresno State (25-26, 16-11 MW) for three games with Mountain West Tournament and regular season title implications.

Winners of seven of their last 10, the Lobos dropped into a tie for second place in the league standings after their streak of four consecutive series wins was snapped on the road at Air Force last weekend. They're now dead even with the Bulldogs ahead of their meeting this weekend, with both teams one game behind first-place Nevada (30-20, 17-10 MW). Either team could still secure at least a share of the regular-season Mountain West title – and a first-round bye at next week's Mountain West Tournament – with a series win. UNM is guaranteed the No. 2 seed with a series win and would share the title with Nevada if they win one more game than the Wolf Pack this week. They'd win the regular season title outright if they win two more games than Nevada.

New Mexico hasn't won the Mountain West pennant since 2017, when they went 30-27-1 overall and 19-9-1 in conference play under Coach Ray Birmingham.

Heading into the final week of the regular season, UNM leads the nation in team batting average (.338) and doubles (133 / 2.71 per game) for the third week in a row – they also rank No. 1 in total hits (598), No. 4 in slugging (0.573), No. 6 in scoring (9.4), No. 8 in runs (460), No. 14 in on-base percentage (.427) and 16th in homers per game (1.73), while cracking the Top 100 in the nation in in triples per game (54th, 0.29), total base on balls (97th, 245).

ALL-TIME SERIES

- UNM trails the all-time series by a three-game margin (36-39-1) with a 23-11 edge in home matchups and a 12-26-1 mark on the road.
- Fresno snapped a four-game losing streak to the Lobos last season, winning three of four matchups, before sweeping the Lobos in their first series this year at home.

TOP BATTING TEAM IN THE NATION

New Mexico leads the entirety of NCAA D-I in team batting average (.338), doubles (133 / 2.71 per game) and total hits (598) for the third week in a row. Four different Lobos rank among the Top 150 in the nation in individual batting average -- Jordy Oriach (#20, .403), Khalil Walker (#38, .388), Ethan Ott (#103, .368) and Josh McAlister (#128, .364) -- they rank Nos. 1, 3, 4 and 5 in the Mountain West.

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ON DECK

The Lobos have clinched a spot in the Mountain West Tournament for the second year in a row -- they'll head to Sloan Park in Mesa, Ariz. next week to play for a conference championship and NCAA Regional berth.

TY CUNNINGHAM NAMED TO NCBWA STOPPER OF THE YEAR WATCH LIST

A day after collecting his 10th save of the season as New Mexico completed a season sweep of in-state rivals N.M. State, Lobos closer Ty Cunningham has been named to the National College Baseball Writers' Association's Stopper of the Year Midseason Watchlist.

Cunningham's 10 saves lead the Mountain West so far this season and rank No. 6 in the nation – he's just one away from matching a UNM single-season record of 11 that has been untouched since 1985 (Ed Bartholomew). He's only the fourth Lobo in program history to record double-digit saves in the same season since it became an official statistic in 1981.

RAKING AT HOME

- The Lobos are 18-6 in home games at Santa Ana Star Field this year and batting .392 with an average of 14.0 runs and 16.3 hits per nine innings in those games. Their .750 winning percentage at home so far this season would be the second-best in any season with 15 or more games in the 12 years since Santa Ana Star Field became the Lobos' home venue. UNM went 14-2 (.875) in their first season calling SAS Field home in 2013.
- UNM notched its 200th win at Santa Ana Star Field last Tuesday.

- The Lobos currently have the most home wins (18) in the Mountain West and the highest home win percentage (.750).
- Jordy Oriach hits for even more power at 5,300 feet above sea level – he's slugging .897 at home (.777 overall) with 13 doubles, two triples and eight homers in Albuquerque. He leads four Lobos that are batting above .400 at home this season ahead of Khalil Walker (.473), Ethan Ott (.419), Josh McAlister (.415) and Karsen Waslefsky (.400).

• RHP Josh Barnhouse has a 2.35 ERA at home across 12 appearances (23 IP), compiling a 3-0 record in those games.

• In games played in cities at 3,900 feet or higher above sea level, the Lobos are 21-8 (.724), batting .377 as a team.

LONG BALL LOBOS

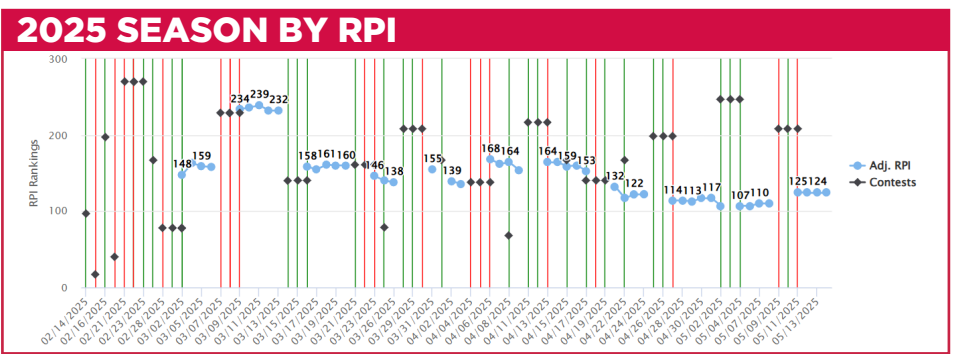
Through 49 games this season, 15 different players have combined for 85 home runs. UNM is averaging 1.73 homers per game so far this season, remaining at No. 16 in the nation after moving up in each of the last five weeks among the nation's home run team leaders.

After going yard twice last weekend, Jordy Oriach is second in the Mountain West in total homers with 15. Josh McAlister (14) and Will Asby (13) are just behind, while Ethan Ott (12), Tye Wood (5), Andrew Neil (4), Caleb Herd (4), Karsen Waslefsky (5), Gene Trujillo (3) and Khalil Walker (4) all have multiple, with Cooper Brass hitting his first career homer two weeks ago at SDSU.

The Lobos moved up to No. 4 on the all-time single season list with seven homers last weekend -- they're now just eight away from matching the UNM single-season record set in 2003 and nine away from surpassing it.
