

## ***POST-GAME NOTES: NEW MEXICO 75, NICHOLLS STATE 63***

### **Streaks and Trends**

- The Lobos were able to stay in the game despite 31 percent shooting in the first half. Lobos went 14-for-16 from the foul line before halftime, Colonels went 3-for-4. Lobos improved to 42.9 percent in the second half.
- New Mexico had 20 assists for the first time since defeating Texas Southern earlier this season (11-13-15).
- Head coach Craig Neal has started 4-1 in two of his three years as head coach of the Lobos.

### **In-Game Notes**

- Sam Logwood and Joe Furstinger each tied their personal records for steals in the first half.
- Lobos continued their strong defensive presence holding Nichols State to 33 percent shooting for the game and 25 percent in the second half.
- The Lobos are now 2-0 when scoring between 70 and 80 points.

### **RS-Sophomore Elijah Brown**

- Set the pace for the Lobos in the first half with 11 points off 2-for-6 FG and a perfect 6-for-6 from the free throw line.
- Career-high of nine rebounds.
- He has scored in double digits in four of five games.

### **Sophomore Joe Furstinger**

- Tied career highs in blocks and steals in the first half alone. Finished with three blocks and two steals.
- Recorded a +/- of 24 tonight, leading all Lobos.

### **RS-Junior Tim Williams**

- Recording his fourth double-digit scoring effort of the season in five games.
- Williams has recorded back-to-back double-doubles.

### **Sophomore Sam Logwood**

- First multiple steals game of the season, tying a career-high at two.
