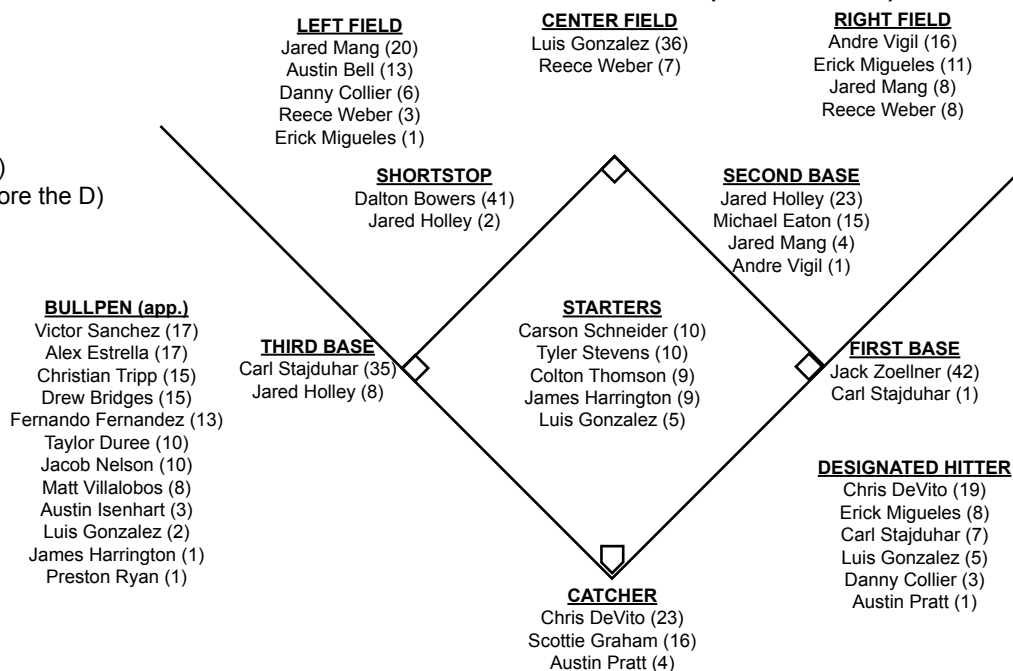

- Four straight NCAA regionals appearances (2010-13), first postseason berths for UNM since 1962
- Birmingham coached the Lobos to their first two MW Tournament Championships in 2011 and 2012. The Lobos also shared the regular-season crown in both 2012 and 2014, and won the league by a record seven games in 2013.
- Attained highest RPI in UNM history (No. 19) in 2010 and its highest ranking ever (No. 13 by *Baseball America*) in 2013.
- Earned his 1,000th collegiate victory with a 19-5 victory at Air Force on April 6, 2013.
- Coached his 1,500th collegiate game on Thursday, May 23, 2013, in the Mountain West Tournament against Nevada.
- The NMJC Thunderbirds won the 2005 NJCAA National Championship and were the national runners-up in 2007.
- Birmingham set the foundations for the programs at College of the Southwest (1988-89) and NMJC (1990-2007).
- Birmingham began his coaching career at Las Cruces Mayfield High School where the Trojans won the 4A championship in 1981 and had three No. 1 rankings through 1983.

HOME, SWEET HOME

On March 24, 2013, the UNM baseball team moved into its new old home. After spending most of the previous nine seasons at Isotopes Park, the Lobos returned to a newly renovated Santa Ana Star Field with astounding success. After losing two of their first five games in their new home park, the Lobos finished the season with 11 straight wins at home to post a 14-2 record at Santa Ana Star Field.

SCOUTING ARIZONA STATE ... The Sun Devils are 23-15 on the season and 15-9 at home. The team is an even 9-9 in the Pac-12.

The Sun Devils got to .500 with a weekend sweep at Stanford. They followed that up with a loss to Arizona on Tuesday in a non-conference game 8-0.

David Greer and Colby Woodmansee are the only two regulars hitting over .300, as both are at .313 for the year. ASU is hitting .259 as a team, but they have just 19 home runs all told.

Pitching-wise, while the weekend rotation hasn't been announced yet, last week ASU went with Seth Martinez (6-3, 1.89), Eli Lingos (2-2, 3.32) and Zach Dixon (1-0, 1.93). ASU's pitching has been very good with a .344 ERA and 10 saves along with two shutouts.

THE SERIES WITH ARIZONA STATE ... The weekend series will mark the 151st, 152nd and 153rd meetings between New Mexico and Arizona State, and while ASU holds a decided advantage, it's been closer as of late.

Arizona state leads the series 120-30, with a 77-9 mark in Tempe. However, in the last two years, it's 2-2, including a 7-1 win for New Mexico in Tempe in 2014 and a 9-6 win in Albuquerque last year.

STAJDUHAR PLAYER OF THE WEEK ... Carl Stajduhar earned his third overall and second consecutive Mountain West Player of the Week Award, marking the fifth time in 10 weeks a UNM position player was named Player of the Week.

For the second week in a row, Stajduhar was a no doubt selection, increasing his averages from the previous award-winning week. He batted .500 over five games had multiple hits in four of five contests. During that span, he slugged .950 and reached base at a .600 clip, good for an OPS of 1.550.

Overall, he had two home runs and four extra base hits, going for the cycle over five games. He drove in a team-best 10 runs. He scored in four out of five games, good for five runs scored.

On Tuesday against No. 7 Texas Tech, he hit a game-tying home run in the fourth inning. His best stretch came from

Fresh off his third Mountain West Player of the Week honor, Carl Stajduhar had another multiple home run game for the Lobos. He finished 2-for-3 with two walks, three RBI and two runs scored. Andre Vigil continued to swing the bat well, finishing 3-for-4 with a run scored and a RBI.

The win went to James Harrington (7-1), who was lights out in 6.2 innings of work. He did not allow an earned run and limited the Aggies to four hits and one walk. Christian Tripp and Alex Estrella finished the game, combining for three strikeouts and four hits allowed.

The first half of the ball game moved quickly, as three runs were scored between the two sides. The Lobos took a lead early on the first blast from Stajduhar. With two outs, the designated hitter sent an opposite field homer over right field. After being blanked for two frames, the Aggies tied the game win a run in the third. The Lobos retook the lead in the fourth, on a

two-out RBI single from Andre Vigil that plated Jared Holley.

The Lobos ran away with the game in the middle innings, on four runs in both the fifth and sixth. The entire fifth inning rally came with two outs on the board, starting with back-to-back walks from Dalton Bowers and Luis Gonzalez. After both runners stole base, a routine third out throw to first was off target, allowing both runners to score.

The error put Jared Holley on first base, but he wouldn't be there long. On the first pitch of the at bat, Stajduhar pelted his second home run of the game over left field, giving the Lobos a 6-1 lead.

New Mexico repeated in the sixth, beginning with a leadoff single by Vigil. Erick Migueles reached base on a fielder's choice, but Vigil was called safe at second on a bobbled catch. Bowers brought Vigil around on a single to the left side, before Gonzalez secured two RBI with a double to right centerfield. Holley capped off the middle inning explosion with a RBI single to right field, putting the Lobos up 10-1.

Harrington held the Aggies back during the middle innings, and at one point retired 10 straight batters. After four straight zeros on the board, the Aggies scored two runs in the eighth inning and one final run in the ninth to secure the final score.

AND NMSU MAKES THREE ... For the third time in his career, and second this season, Carl Stajduhar hit two home runs in a game. Stajduhar hit a solo shot in the first and a two-run bomb in the sixth. The two put him in the team lead for home runs with 13, and he is just four behind the sophomore record, set by D.J. Peterson in 2012.

HOW MANY HALL OF FAMES CAN ONE GUY GET INTO? ... Apparently if you are Ray Birmingham, the answer is three.

After the UNLV series that Sunday night, New Mexico's all-time leader in collegiate coaching wins was inducted into the New Mexico Athletics Hall of Fame. It's the third hall of fame he has been inducted into, along with the Lea County Hall of Fame and National Junior College Athletic Association Hall of Fame.

AND THAT MAKES SEVEN ... Despite a one-run loss Sunday, the Lobos took the series against San Diego State. For the season, UNM has now won all seven conference series meetings (SJSU twice, San Diego State twice, Nevada, Fresno State and UNLV).

That is in stark contrast to how UNM finished the 2015 season, when UNM lost two of its final three Mountain West series.

PROOF IT'S GOOD ... UNM's 30-13 record is good for a .698 winning percentage, which would be third all-time in school history.
