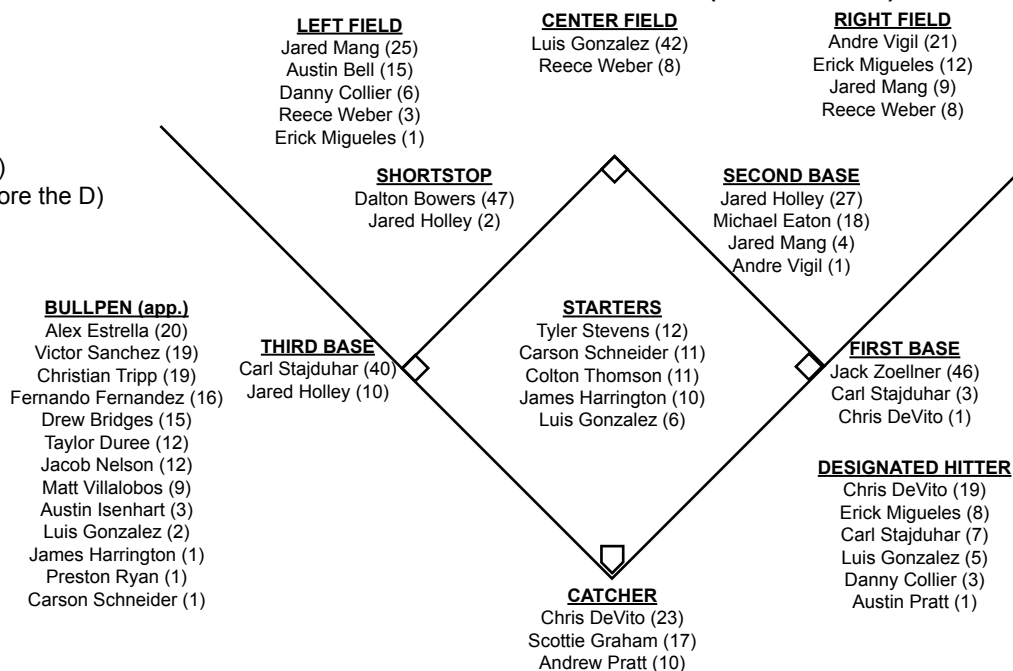

- Four straight NCAA regionals appearances (2010-13), first postseason berths for UNM since 1962
- Birmingham coached the Lobos to their first two MW Tournament Championships in 2011 and 2012. The Lobos also shared the regular-season crown in both 2012 and 2014, and won the league by a record seven games in 2013.
- Attained highest RPI in UNM history (No. 19) in 2010 and its highest ranking ever (No. 13 by *Baseball America*) in 2013.
- Earned his 1,000th collegiate victory with a 19-5 victory at Air Force on April 6, 2013.
- Coached his 1,500th collegiate game on Thursday, May 23, 2013, in the Mountain West Tournament against Nevada.
- The NMJC Thunderbirds won the 2005 NJCAA National Championship and were the national runners-up in 2007.
- Birmingham set the foundations for the programs at College of the Southwest (1988-89) and NMJC (1990-2007).
- Birmingham began his coaching career at Las Cruces Mayfield High School where the Trojans won the 4A championship in 1981 and had three No. 1 rankings through 1983.

HOME, SWEET HOME

On March 24, 2013, the UNM baseball team moved into its new old home. After spending most of the previous nine seasons at Isotopes Park, the Lobos returned to a newly renovated Santa Ana Star Field with astounding success. After losing two of their first five games in their new home park, the Lobos finished the season with 11 straight wins at home to post a 14-2 record at Santa Ana Star Field.

SCOUTING NEVADA ... Nevada is the hottest team in the Mountain West Conference at the moment, with a winning streak currently at 11 straight games. Nevada has climbed within one game of New Mexico at the top of the league standings.

TJ Friedl has been the leader on offense with a .381 batting average, .559 slugging percentage and .481 on base percentage. He has a team-best 49 runs scored.

On Friday night, Nevada opens the series with Christian Stolo. The Wolfpack's ace has a 4.75 ERA in his team-high 77.2 innings pitched.

THE SERIES WITH NEVADA ... All-time, the Lobos are an even 13-13 against the Nevada Wolfpack. The all time series began in 1994, but after two games that March, the rest of the series has taken place after Nevada joined the Mountain West Conference.

Although the Lobos hold a .727 all-time winning percentage at Santa Ana Star Field, the Wolfpack have been one of the more successful teams when visiting Albuquerque. Nevada has a 6-3 record against the Lobos in Albuquerque.

THIS SEASON AGAINST NEVADA ... The Lobos traveled to Reno in early March to open their Mountain West Conference slate, winning a close series, 2-1. The Lobos won big on opening night, 8-3. However, the next two games would be razor thin. The Lobos clinched the series with a 3-2 win on Saturday, but the Wolfpack presented the sweep with a 7-6 Sunday win.

LAST TIME OUT FOR UNM ... The University of New Mexico baseball team (32-18, 17-7 MW) dropped its final game of the weekend against the UNLV Rebels (20-27, 10-14 MW) Sunday, falling 10-4.

"UNLV is hot and we are a road weary team that needs to get home (Lobos are ending their longest road trip of the season)," said head coach Ray Birmingham. "We will regroup."

Luis Gonzalez was the leader on offense, finishing 3-for-5 with two runs and a RBI. The Lobos had five freshmen on the field Sunday, headlined by another big day from Jared Mang, who went 2-for-4 with two RBI.

The Lobos attacked early and grabbed the first lead after two innings. The Lobos earned leadoff hits in the first three innings, and took advantage of it in the second. Jack Zoellner pelted a leadoff double to left center and reached third base on a passed ball. Freshman Jared Mang grounded out to second base, but grabbed his first RBI of the day on the play to make it a 1-0 ball game.

The leadoff hit in the third would also become advantageous. Luis Gonzalez led off the side with a double to left field. He reached third base on the following at bat on a perfect bunt single from Jared Holley. After two pop ups, Zoellner loaded the bases on a base on balls. Mang slapped a single to third base, allowing Gonzalez to score and securing his seventh RBI of the week. The bases were left loaded, but the Lobos were able to give Harrington an early 2-0 lead.

The Rebels swung back in the bottom of the third, leading off with a triple and bringing in a run on a sacrifice fly. However, Harrington stayed composed and stranded a runner in scoring position for the third straight inning. The Rebels would eventually break through, securing three runs in a fourth inning rally that gave the home team a 4-2 lead.

The game went away from New Mexico in the bottom of the fourth, when the Rebels rallied for three runs, followed by a four-run fifth frame. Chris DeVito blasted a home run over the right centerfield fence in the fifth, but the

Lobos entered the sixth inning trailing, 8-3.

UNLV posted its final two runs in the seventh inning, establishing a seven-run advantage. The Lobos continued to fight until the end, and scored their final run in the ninth inning. Gonzalez earned his third leadoff hit, but this time sent the ball out of the yard for a solo shot. However, the Rebels drew three straight outs to end the game.

ACADEMIC ALL-DISTRICT ...
University of New Mexico baseball players Alex Estrella and Chris DeVito were each named CoSIDA Academic All-District 7, as announced Thursday.

Estrella becomes the third Lobo since 2003 to repeat as an Academic-All District honoree. He built an easy case for voters, with a 4.0 GPA in his graduate MBA program. On the field, Estrella holds a 2.42 ERA in a team-high 20 appearances this season. He has five saves and is holding opponents to a .205 batting average. His strikeout to walk ratio sits at 3/1 with 21 total punch outs.

DeVito earns his first career Academic All-District honors with a 3.52 GPA in New Mexico's criminology program. He has a chance to become the fourth Lobo ever to earn All-America honors athletically and academically. He currently leads the team with a .408 batting average, .707 slugging percentage and 54 RBI. He also has 17 doubles and 12 home runs. His 130 total bases ranks third in the nation.

Both Estrella and DeVito will be eligible

for Academic All-America honors, which will be announced later this season.

2016 FRESHMEN... The University of New Mexico baseball team is currently sitting in first place in a tight race for the Mountain West Conference Championship. The Lobos will look to win their sixth conference trophy since 2011 over the next six games. In order for the team to accomplish its goals, the current freshman class will have to make a major impact.

"Playing here as a freshman is tough," said head coach Ray Birmingham. "There are a whole bunch of games in a short period of time. The travel alone this year has been hard on them. And the home work, weightlifting, study hall... everything. It's really hard on freshman. On top of everything, they have to learn to compete. It's amazing what some of these kids have done."

Over the course of the conference season, coach Birmingham has put several freshmen on the field and relied on them to perform. In the team's latest victory, a 6-2 win at UNLV Saturday, Birmingham used seven freshman in a crucial road game.

This is nothing new for coach Birmingham, who has routinely put young players in position to succeed. The Lobos have had a freshman All-American every year since 2011, with seven over a five year span. Current players Danny Collier, Carl Stajduhar and Tyler Stevens are among them. Needless to say, the bar is set high for first year players at New Mexico.

"It's hard being a freshman here because they play a lot. The pro door takes players out so quickly that a lot of pressure is put on the freshmen, and they have to step up. So you see the growth. I am proud of (Andrew) Pratt, I am proud of (Jared) Mang and I am proud of (Austin) Bell and (Erick) Migueles, and (Christian) Tripp."

During conference play, Jared Mang, Austin Bell, Andrew Pratt and Erick Migueles have all played a key role in the team's ascension to the top spot in the conference. Over the course 18 MW games played, Bell leads the freshman class with a .355 average. Mang is hitting .302 in conference and logged a team-best seven RBI last week. Migueles is hitting .294 and slugging .478 in conference. Pratt has had to make an immediate impact in the wake

of recent injuries. He came in to catch on April 29 at Arizona State and has been the team's starting catcher ever since.

Arguably the most impressive development of any freshman has been on the mound from Christian Tripp. The 6-7 right hander holds a 2.61 ERA and a .200 opponent batting average over 10.1 innings pitched against MW teams. Last week, he made three appearances, allowing no runs and one hit.

The Lobos wrap the season up with three games this weekend against Nevada at home, before traveling to Air Force for the final three games next week. They enter this stretch as the leaders in the MW, but will need big time performances from this group in order to finish strong.

"They have to play at freshman All-American status for us to (finish successful) because of some of the injuries. Danny Collier being gone is a huge deal that impacts everything. The injury to DeVito has put a lot of stress on Pratt, who's caught well enough defensively. But they are going to need to step up offensively too."

CLINCHING THE TITLE... Mathematically, the Lobos could clinch the Mountain West Conference Championship this weekend. However, it would take a sweep of Nevada and a sweep of Fresno State at the hands of UNLV.

The Bulldogs finish conference play this weekend, while the Lobos still have three games left at Air Force.

DUREE-ABLE... Taylor Duree made two appearances against Arizona State, giving him a program-record 76 career appearances as a Lobo. He is the second pitcher to reach 70 appearances at New Mexico and has passed Joe Coleman for the school record
