BULLDOG BONES

- The Bulldogs took 2-of-3 games against Colorado State, winning their first conference series of the year for the fourth consecutive season. The Rams entered the series leading the MW in ERA.
- Fresno State leads the Mountain West and is tied for 22nd in NCAA Div. I with 31 home runs in 31 games played this season. The Bulldogs have hit at least one home run in 14 of their last 19 games.
- Hayleigh Galvan leads the Bulldogs and the MW with a .530 on-base percentage this season while also leading the team with a .387 batting average. She is currently on a 12-game hitting streak.
- The Bulldogs broke the single season program record for hit-by-pitches last week as they have now been hit 43 times. The MW record for HBP in a season is 47, set by San Jose State last year.
- In 31 games this season Fresno State has played just one true road game, at Cal State Fullerton on March 3. The Bulldogs will now play five road games over a seven day stretch starting on Thursday.

Opening MW with a W

In its first MW series of the season the Bulldogs took 2-of-3 games against Colorado State, winning their first conference series of the year for the fourth consecutive season. Colorado State entered the series leading the conference in ERA and second in batting average but the 'Dogs outscored the Rams 13-10 while posting a 3.33 team ERA.

Taking Several for the Team

The Bulldogs broke the single season program record for hit-by-pitches last week as they have now been hit 43 times this season. The MW record for HBP in a season is 47, set by San Jose State last year. No other MW team has been plunked more than 19 times. The NCAA does not track national team hit-by-pitch statistics. Hayleigh Galvan and Emily Brodner are tied for the Mountain West lead with eight hit-by-pitches while Schuyler Broussard has been hit seven times.

Road Rarity

In 31 games this season Fresno State has played just one true road game, at Cal State Fullerton on March 3. The 'Dogs have played 13 neutral site games but just one contest on an opponent's home field. The Bulldogs will now play five road games over a seven day stretch with the series at New Mexico and games at Stanford and Santa Clara, the latter of which was just added to the schedule this week.

Galvan-izing the Offense

Hitting in the clean-up spot, sophomore transfer Hayleigh Galvan leads the Bulldogs and the MW with a .530 on-base percentage this season while also leading the team in batting average (.387). With 29 hits (including five home runs and six doubles), 16 walks, and eight hit-by-pitches Galvan has reached base in more than half of her plate appearances this year. The Oklahoma State transfer has been especially strong at home, as she has reached base in all 17 home games the 'Dogs have played this year while hitting .477 with a .586 OBP at Margie Wright Diamond. Galvan enters the week on a team season long 12-game hitting streak.

They've Got the Power

Fresno State leads the Mountain West and is tied for 22nd in NCAA Div. I with 31 home runs this season. The Bulldogs have hit at least one home run in 14 of their last 19 games and have hit multiple homers in eight games this year. Savannah McHellen leads the MW with 12 home runs as eight 'Dogs have homered and six have hit multiple home runs.

Big K Day

Freshman Danielle East recorded a career-high 11 strikeouts while earning the win over Colorado State on Sunday. She topped her previous career high of nine strikeouts while tallying 11 K's over the first six innings of the game against the Rams. East recorded three consecutive strikeouts three times in the game and had at least one punch out in each of the first six innings.

Walk-Offs

Katie Castellon recorded Fresno State's eighth walk-off win of the season on Sunday. The Bulldogs have recorded three traditional walk-offs with two by Castellon and one from Savannah McHellen. The other five walk-off wins have come via the 8-run mercy rule. McHellen (3), Castellon, and Schuyler Broussard have hit walk-off homers.

McHellen Mashing

Senior Savannah McHellen leads the MW and is tied for ninth in NCAA Div. I with 12 homers this season. She is also third in the MW in slugging percentage (.769) and total bases (70). She has hit six homers and driven in 17 runs over the last 12 games with two run-rule walk-off homers, her second 2-homer game of the season, and her second grand slam this year. She has also won two games as the starting pitcher during the stretch with a 3.06 ERA.

High RPI

In the most recent NCAA Rating Percentage Index (RPI) rankings Fresno State is No. 61, the second highest in the MW behind only No. 51 San Jose State. The RPI rankings reflect quality wins and strength of schedule as the 'Dogs played a very difficult non-conference slate and have wins over highly ranked teams, including a

SCOUTING NEW MEXICO (8-24, 2-4 MW)

New Mexico was unanimously picked to finish in last place in the preseason MW Coaches' Poll after changing coaching staffs following a 20-30 overall record and 6-18 MW mark last year. The Lobos have three wins this year over Saint Mary's and earned a win at Texas Tech in the pre-conference season. New Mexico opened conference play losing 2-of-3 games against both UNLV and Nevada, dropping the UNLV series on its home field to fall to 4-5 at home this year. New Mexico ranks last in the MW and 288th out of 296 Div. I schools with a 7.24 team ERA. The Lobos are allowing 7.9 runs per game this year with a .353 opposing batting average. The squad has allowed 60 runs in six MW games, giving up 43 runs in three games vs. Nevada. Andrea Howard leads the team hitting .325 with five home runs while Chelsea Johnson is hitting .319 with five homers and a team-high 22 RBIs. The Lobos are 24-of-30 on stolen bases. Fresno State has won 11 straight games against New Mexico dating back to the 2014 season.

Super Support

• The red wave has averaged 1,056 fans per game this season, the most among all 20 NCAA Div. I schools in California and the 13th highest attendance average in the nation. The team's total attendance of 17,967 this season is the eighth most in all of Div. I.

• Last season Fresno State led the MW and ranked 13th in NCAA Div. I averaging 1,101 fans per game. The 'Dogs drew more fans than any other team in California last year and have averaged more than 1,000 fans per game for 25 consecutive seasons.

Working the Field

• Fresno State has committed just six errors in the last 12 games and now ranks second in the MW with a .972 fielding percentage this year.

• The Bulldogs have 14 error-free games this season and have committed multiple errors just twice over the last 21 games.

20th Anniversary of WCWS Title

• Coach Margie Wright and nine members of the 1998 National Championship team were in attendance last Saturday as Fresno State celebrated the 20th anniversary of the first national championship in school history.

• Fresno State is the only non-Power 5 school that has won a WCWS national title since 1986 and is one of just two non-Power 5 schools to ever win the WCWS since its inception in 1982 (Cal State Fullerton, 1986).

Home Cooking

• In 17 home games this year the 'Dogs are 12-5, having outscored the opposition 107-57 while hitting .310 with 14 home runs and tallying a 3.01 team ERA.

• The win over Monmouth on Mar. 11 was the 900th home victory in program history. The 'Dogs are 904-235-1 all-time at home over 41 seasons.

Irregular Innings

• Thirteen of Fresno State's 31 games so far this season were not completed in the standard seven innings. The team has played seven 5-inning games, three 6-inning games, two 8-inning games, and one 9-inning game.

• The Bulldogs did not play a seven-inning

game until their fifth contest of the season.

On Base a Lot

• As a team the Bulldogs rank second in the MW with a .402 on-base percentage after tallying a .373 mark at the end of the 2017 season.

• Hayleigh Galvan leads the MW with a .530 on-base percentage this year while four other Bulldogs have an on-base percentage at or above .400.

Doubling Up

• Fresno State is tied for second in the MW with 15 double plays turned and has hit into only six double plays this season.

• The 'Dogs turned a pair of double plays in consecutive games against Wisconsin and No. 3 LSU.

Running Free

• Fresno State had been successful on 21 consecutive stolen base attempts over 12 games before its last caught stealing.

• The Bulldogs were 15-for-15 in steals in the Fresno State Invitational and rank third in the MW with 33 stolen bases this year.

• Miranda Rohleder, who leads the team with 13 steals in 14 attempts has been successful on six straight steal attempts while Brooke Coates is five of her last five.

Triple Time

• Miranda Rohleder is tied for 12th in NCAA Div. I with four triples this season.

• Rohleder had four triples over the last three Fresno State games in the Bulldog Classic, including a two-triple game against Pacific.

Non-Conference Non-Easy

• Fresno State faced six ranked teams in non-conference play, playing four games vs. teams ranked in the top-7 at the time of the game

• In terms of opponent winning percentage the Bulldogs have played the third toughest schedule among MW teams, behind only San Diego State and New Mexico.

Into the Polls

• The Bulldogs appeared in the national rankings on Feb. 20 as D1softballnews.com chose Fresno State as the No. 25 team in the nation.

• Fresno State earned votes in the 2018 pre-season USA Today/NFCA Coaches Poll as well

as in the first edition of the season.

- The Bulldogs have been ranked in the top-25 in the coaches' poll, one of two polls officially recognized by the NCAA along with the ESPN.com/USA Softball poll, in each of the last two seasons, reaching No. 17 in 2016 and No. 21 in 2017.

Home Run Streaking

- Hayleigh Galvan homered in four straight completed games over a two-week stretch.
- Galvan hit a 3-run home run against BYU followed by solo shots against No. 3 UCLA and CSUN. She also homered against Loyola Marymount in the first completed game the Bulldogs played at the Judi Garman Classic, but because the suspended Cal Poly game is officially listed as taking place on Friday the streak officially ended at three games.

Powered Down

- Fresno State opened the 2018 season with three wins over Power-5 schools at the Kajikawa Classic. The 'Dogs took down Stanford, Purdue, and Notre Dame, earning wins against the Pac-12, Big 10, and ACC schools, respectively.
- The Bulldogs tallied three Power-5 wins at the Kajikawa Classic for the third consecutive season, beating both Purdue and Stanford at the tournament for the second straight year.
- Fresno State had seven total wins over Power-5 schools last season and has one more against a Power-5 team still to come facing Stanford again on April 3.

Freshman Phenom

- True freshman Danielle East was the winning pitcher in all three Fresno State victories at the season-opening Kajikawa Classic and earned MW Pitcher of the Week honors.
- East threw an 8-inning shutout against Stanford for her first collegiate victory, allowing just seven singles and no walks with two strikeouts. She beat Purdue 13-4 in 6-innings and pitched out of a bases-loaded, no-out jam in relief to earn the win against Notre Dame.

Split Squad

- The 2018 Bulldog rosters is nearly evenly split with 13 returners and 12 newcomers.

- Fresno State returned and lost nearly the same number of starters (5/4) from the 2017 team while returning one of their two primary starting pitchers from last year.

- The class breakdown is also fairly balanced with five seniors, eight juniors, six sophomores, and six freshmen.

A History of Wins

- In 2017 Fresno State qualified for the NCAA Regionals for the third straight year and the 30th time in the last 33 seasons.
- The Bulldogs have won at least 30 games in 36 straight seasons with an overall winning record in each of those years.
- Fresno State has won 23 conference titles, 59 NCAA Regional games, and 93 total postseason games, reaching the Women's College World Series 12 times with four runner-up finishes and the 1998 NCAA title.

'Dogs Picked Third

- The Mountain West Coaches selected Fresno State to finish third in the preseason conference poll.
- The top three teams in the poll are the three MW schools from California, as San Diego State was picked first and San Jose State second followed by the Bulldogs.
- The 'Dogs finished tied with Utah State for third place in the MW last season and earned one more point than the Aggies in the 2018 preseason poll.

Year Two

- In 2018 the Bulldogs play their second season under head coach Linda Garza.
- A Fresno native, Garza led the 'Dogs to a 35-23 record in her first season at the helm as the 'Dogs finished third in the Mountain West and qualified for the NCAA regionals, earning a postseason win.
- The entire coaching staff is unchanged in 2018.

How do you spell HAY-lee?

- The Bulldogs have three players with the same name spelled three different ways: sophomore Haley Fuller, sophomore Hayleigh Galvan, and freshman Hailee Rios.
- Fresno State has a fourth HAY-lee as well in volunteer assistant coach Haley Janzer.

In July 2016, Linda Garza, a Fresno native, became the Fresno State softball program's fourth head coach in its storied history. Garza took over a team that had won back-to-back Mountain West Championships, but lost eight seniors to graduation, including the reigning MW Pitcher of the Year and MW Defensive Player of the Year.

She wrapped up her first season at the helm of the program with a 35-23 record, continuing Fresno State's streak of 36 straight 30-win seasons, and the Bulldogs' 33rd NCAA Tournament appearance. Fresno State tied for third place in the MW with a 14-9 conference record and received an at-large bid into the NCAA Tournament Seattle Regional. In the regional, the 'Dogs fell to No. 20 Michigan 3-1, shut out Montana 7-0, then fell to Michigan again, 4-0.

The Bulldogs began the season ranked No. 24 in the USA Today/NFCA Coaches' Poll and moved up to No. 21 on Feb. 14.

Five players on the Bulldogs' 2017 squad were named NFCA All-Pacific Region, four were selected to All-MW teams (two first-team and two second-team) and sophomore pitcher Kamalani Dung earned the honor of MW Pitcher of the Year. Fresno State also had seven MW All-Academic selections.

In 2017, the Bulldogs broke the program's single-season record for grand slams (5) and the single-game record for RBIs (23), which they accomplished against Stanford on Feb. 12. Also in their game against Stanford, they tied the single-game program records for runs (24), home runs (6) and total bases (40).

As a team, the Bulldog pitching staff led the MW with a 2.95 ERA (88th in NCAA) and ranked fourth in scoring (5.16 runs/game), which ranked 46th in the NCAA. The 'Dogs also ranked fourth in the conference with a .435 slugging percentage (59th in NCAA) and seventh in batting average (.282).

Throughout the season, the Bulldogs were 17-8 at home, 8-7 in away games and 10-8 on neutral fields. Scoring was a priority for the 'Dogs as they went 24-2 when scoring five runs or more and 6-18 when scoring three or fewer. Fresno State was 17-2 when scoring in the first inning and was 22-6 when scoring first. The

Bulldogs played in six extra-inning games, going 4-2 in them, and their best winning streak was six games, achieved in back-to-back series sweeps of UNLV and New Mexico.

Fresno State's most significant wins were a 6-1 victory over then-No. 25 BYU on March 10 and 4-1 and 6-2 wins over Oregon State on March 10 and 11, respectively.

Prior to coming to Fresno State, she spent four seasons at the helm of the UC Riverside program, in which the team won 39 and 32 games in 2015 and 2016, respectively. Garza also led Wright State to a 31-win season, Horizon League title and an automatic NCAA tournament berth in 2010.

Prior to her time at UC Riverside, Garza was an associate head coach at Cal Poly (2010-12), head coach at Wright State (2009-10), and an assistant coach at Purdue (2005-09), Tulsa (2004-05) and Arkansas (2002-04).

In the summer of 2012, Garza took over an 11-year-old UC Riverside program that had yet to have a winning season and averaged only 17.4 wins per season over that span. The Highlanders went 13-33 in 2011 and by 2015 she led them to a 39-17 record and the 14th-best ERA (2.13) in the nation. The team averaged 28.8 wins under the leadership of Garza and she coached over 10 All-Big West student-athletes, three NFCA all-region performers, and back-to-back 20-game winning pitchers in 2015 and 2016.

During her time at UCR, nearly every major offensive, defensive and pitching records were set. Its back-to-back 30-win seasons (2015-16) were a first for the program since joining the Big West in 2002 and its 2015 RPI ranking (70) was its highest ever. Garza's student-athletes also shined in the classroom - posting the program's highest team grade point average (GPA) in program history in 2014 at 3.33.

Prior to UCR, Garza was the associate head coach/recruiting coordinator for Cal Poly (2010-12), while coaching the outfield and assisting with hitting and the infield. She also assisted with all day-to-day operations of the program.

As the head coach at Wright State in 2010, the Raiders established single-season records for hits (538), walks (148) and stolen bases (150). This came after serving as an assistant at Purdue and aiding the Boilermakers to 30-plus victories during each of her four seasons.

Garza received her start at UNLV as a student assistant following her playing career from 1998-2001, posting a .262 career batting average as a four-year starter and earning a spot on the All-Mountain West team. She finished her career with 155 straight starts and was among the program's top 10 players for doubles, walks, hits and sacrifices.

A four-time All-MW academic honoree, she received her bachelor's degree in school health education with a minor in athletic coaching and physical education in 2002. Garza earned her master's degree in kinesiology in 2009 from Texas Woman's University.

Garza's ties to the San Joaquin Valley have remained strong over the years as she has ran many camps for club teams such as the Fresno Force (her former team), Central California Krush and Central Cal Dirt Dogs.

Garza attended Hoover High School while growing up in Fresno.
