### ABOUT THE MATCH-UP

- The Lobos and Aggies will be meeting for the 28th time in program history Saturday.
- It will be the 16th meeting between the two teams in Albuquerque, N.M., but just the fourth meeting inside WisePies Arena.
- All-time, the Lobos are 7-20 against Utah State in a series that dates back to Feb. 2, 1952. All but five of the games were played between 1952-1962. After a near-18 year break, the Aggies defeated New Mexico inside WisePies Arena, 117-83. They did not play again until Utah State joined the Mountain West two seasons ago. The Lobos are 3-1 over that time.
- After a sweep of the Aggies in 2014, New Mexico and Utah State split the series last year, with each team winning on the road. The Lobos won in Logan, 66-60, on Jan. 10 and the Aggies won in Albuquerque on Feb. 7, 63-60.
- In the two games played last season, the Lobos dominated the glass with a rebounding margin of +12. Over two games, the Lobos shot 43.8 percent (46-105) from the floor.
- The Aggies enter Saturday's game at 9-5 on the season and 1-2 in Mountain West Conference play. The Aggies opened up the league with a road win at San Jose State, 80-71, but have lost two straight home games to San Diego State and Boise State. They are led by Tim Duryea in his first year as a head coach.

## NEW MEXICO GAME NOTES

### LAST TIME OUT

The University of New Mexico men's basketball team (9-6, 2-0 MW) won their second-straight Mountain West Conference game, defeating the Fresno State Bulldogs (10-5, 1-1 MW), 77-62, on the road Saturday. The Lobos were led by sophomore Cullen Neal who scored a game-best 26 points, three shy of his career-high. The total pushed Neal over 500 points for his career with 515 total. He shot 7-for-14 from the floor and added five rebounds and three assists, tying Elijah Brown for the team-high. Brown also had 12 points, including a perfect 7-for-7 at the free throw line. He's now made 27 consecutive free throws over three games. Obij Aget had his second-straight double doubles with 10 points and 10 rebounds. He also swatted three shots and went 5-for-8 from the floor. Tim Williams finished his night with 13 points on 4-for-7 shooting. He was one rebound short of a double-double with nine, three on offense. Overall, the team shot 53.2 percent (25-for-47) from the floor and 42.9 percent (6-for-14) from 3-point range. The Lobos held Fresno State to 36.1 percent (26-for-72) shooting and 5.6 percent (1-for-18) from outside. The Lobos won the rebounding battle, 39-37, with eight offensive boards.

### STARTING 2-0

New Mexico is now 2-0 in Mountain West Conference play after wins over Nevada and Fresno State. This is the fourth straight season in which the Lobos have started 2-0 in MW play, a streak that encompasses head coach Craig Neal's entire run as the leader of the Lobos. Since the Lobos joined the MW, Craig Neal is the only head coach to start 2-0 in three straight seasons. Previous to this current run of strong starts, the Lobos had not started 2-0 in conference action since the 2001-02 season. A win on Saturday over Utah State would tie Noodles' best start to conference play at 3-0. In 2013-14, the Lobos had their 3-0 team snapped by UNLV, 76-73, the same team the Lobos could potentially go for 4-0 against on Tuesday.

### REBOUNDING IN THE PIT

WisePies Arena has been a historically treacherous environment for visiting teams, and this season has been no different. The Lobos are 7-1 inside WisePies Arena this season, with their one loss coming by a point. Of all the areas in which the Lobos have dominated at home, rebounding may be the most significant. The Lobos are averaging 38.5 rebounds per game at home with a rebounding margin of +8.5, which is nearly an 11 rebound swing from when the Lobos play away from Albuquerque. The Lobos average an even 10 offensive rebounds per game inside The Pit. Tim Williams has averaged 7.8 rebounds per game at home, 2.4 on the offensive end.

### GUARDING THE 3

Early on this season, the Lobos were among the nation's best perimeter defensive teams. A rough four-game stretch brought the Lobos' overall numbers back down to Earth. However, the Lobos have rediscovered their perimeter defense and are stifling league opponents. In Mountain West play, the Lobos have held opponents to 15.2 percent shooting from 3-point range, giving up five treys on 33 attempts. In the conference opener, New Mexico held Nevada to 26.7 percent (4-for-15) shooting from outside. On the road at Fresno State, the Lobos locked the Bulldogs down to 5.6 percent (1-for-18) from outside. Marvelle Harris, the MW Preseason Player of the Year, was held to 1-for-8 shooting from distance, 5-for-19 overall.

### BROWN AT THE LINE

Elijah Brown is currently on a run of 27 straight made free throws, after shooting perfect the last two games and making his last five shots against Washington State. The run is just over halfway to the program record of 52 consecutive made free throws, set by Rob Robbins in 1989-90. Overall this year, Brown ranks ninth in the nation with 92 free throws made, 27th with 105 free throws attempted and 31st with an 87.6 percent free throw percentage.

In the highlight game of his streak against Nevada, Elijah Brown scored 15 of his team-best 24 points at the free throw line, where he held a perfect percentage. He became just the fourth player in program history to make 15 free throws without a miss. He was one short of the program record, set by Kendall Williams, who shot 16-for-16 at the free throw line against San Diego at home on Nov. 30, 2013. The other two Lobos to go 15-for-15 at the line were Ruben Douglas against UNLV on Feb. 5, 2002 and Phil Smith against Wyoming on Feb. 12, 1981.

## CULLEN NEAL'S FIRST HALF IN FRESNO

Fresno State looked to be in a good position going into the game against the Lobos, playing in front of their largest crowd since their home opener. The situation was bleak when Elijah Brown picked up two early fouls, but ultimately, Fresno State never led and fell behind big after an offensive explosion from starting point guard Cullen Neal. Neal scored 20 points against the Bulldogs in the first half on 6-for-11 shooting. He made three big 3-pointers, shooting 50 percent from outside before the break. Neal played the entire first half, 10 minutes alongside fellow point guard Jordan Hunter. New Mexico led by as much as 19 points in the first half and entered the break up, 44-27.

## SPEEDY LOBOS

Before the season, head coach Craig Neal stated that he wanted to play an up tempo style in 2015-16. So far, he has accomplished that goal in spades. The Lobos are the fastest team in the Mountain West this season, with an adjusted tempo of 73.7 possessions per game according to KenPom.com. That number not only tops the league, but ranks 30th in the nation. The Lobos are ahead of the national average of 69.8 and the MW league average of 71.3. Utah State may look to slow the Lobos down after averaging only 67.5 possessions per game this year, the second slowest pace in the conference.

Last season, the Lobos averaged 62 points per game on an average of 62.5 possessions per game, ranking 290th in the nation in tempo. Since 2002, the Lobos have never finished a season averaging 70 possessions a game or more.

## 50 WINS FOR NOODLES

With an 88-76 victory over Nevada last Wednesday, New Mexico head coach Craig Neal earned his 50th victory as the leader of the Lobos. With an overall record of 51-29, Coach Neal becomes one of only five coaches to pick up 50 wins within their first 80 contests. His overall winning percentage of .638 puts him in an elite class historically at New Mexico. Only five coaches in the program's history have at least 50 wins and a winning percentage above .600. The others include Bob King, Norm Ellenberger, Dave Bliss and Steve Alford, whom Neal worked alongside as an associate head coach.

After a strong start last season, Neal reached 40 wins in just 53 games, the second fastest mark in program history. These are among several notable achievements in less than three years as head coach, including becoming the first rookie head coach to guide the Lobos to the NCAA Tournament.

## STATISTICAL RANKINGS

ESPN has New Mexico ranked 85th in the country in their BPI ranks, which ranks them a close third among Mountain West Conference teams behind No. 82 UNLV and No. 83 Boise State. The Lobos are 117th in RPI, with the Fresno State win pushing them up nearly 20 spots.

The Lobos are currently predicted by KenPom.com to finish one game away from the MW conference title. After taking a fall during a rough stretch, the Lobos are ranked 103rd by KenPom and on the verge of reentering the top 100 again.

## YOUNG LOBOS

The New Mexico men's basketball team has started the same starting lineup in every game this season: Cullen Neal, Elijah Brown, Obij Aget, Sam Logwood and Tim Williams. It is the youngest starting lineup by class grade since Neal's first season on the coaching staff at New Mexico in 2008-07, when the team started two freshmen and a sophomore. This is one of only two years during the Neal/Alford era in which the Lobos have not started a senior. When compared to the rest of the league the Lobos have the fourth youngest starters in the Mountain West Conference.

When looking at the entire roster, the Lobos have the youngest team in the entire Mountain West Conference. KenPom.com rates their experience level at 1.24 (0 points for freshmen, 1 for sophomores...), which ranks 309th in the nation. Only 42 teams in the nation are younger than the Lobos.

## NEW MEXICO GAME NOTES

### CULLEN NEAL FLASHBACK

It's been a few years since Albuquerque's own Cullen Neal joined the Lobos to become the program's starting point guard of the future. With so much time gone by, it's easy to forget that the Eldorado HS grad was one of the most prolific point guards in New Mexico high school basketball history. Going into this season, Neal still holds the state record for free throws made in a career at 775, while no other player in New Mexico history has ever reached 600. He is the only player in the state's history to make 230 free throws in a season, and he did it twice.

Neal ranks third in the state's history in career assists at 480. He ranks fifth in both total points and 3-pointers made in a career with 2,310 and 213, respectively.

### PLUS MINUS

Through 15 games played this year, the Lobos are led in total plus minus by starting point guard Cullen Neal, who sits at +101 over 451 minutes played. His plus minus/gm sits at +6.73, also a high mark for the Lobos. Against Nevada, the Lobos were even with the Wolf Pack in the time that Neal rested on the bench. With over 505 minutes played, Elijah Brown is second on the team at +87, a 15 point boost after the Fresno State contest. Last year, the Lobos did not have a player finish over +81 on the year.

New Mexico's leader in plus minus/40 minutes with at least 50 minutes played is Neal at +8.96, .01 ahead of sophomore Xavier Adams. Adams' overall plus minus sits at +40. UNM's starting five of Neal, Brown, Sam Logwood, Tim Williams and Obij Aget, the initial lineup in every game this season, is +25 on the year.

### LOBOS BACKCOURT

The starting backcourt duo of Elijah Brown and Cullen Neal are on pace to have a historic season if they can maintain their current standard. The duo is currently averaging a combined 34.1 points per game. That would be the most of any starting backcourt in the Neal/Alford era and the highest mark reached since 2002-03 (Ruben Douglas led the nation at 28 points per game). ### CAREER NIGHTS AGAINST NEVADA

Much of the attention on New Mexico basketball goes to the Lobos' "Big Three" of Cullen Neal, Elijah Brown and Tim Williams. However, the Lobos earned their first Mountain West Conference victory against Nevada in large part due to career nights from Obij Aget and Xavier Adams. Aget earned a double-double and tied his career high of 14 points, the third time he's reached that mark in his career. He also tied a season-best of 11 rebounds, one short of his all-time best. He secured three steals, the most of any Lobo this year. Adams scored a career-high 14 points, double his season best going into the night. It was the second double-digit scoring effort of the sophomore's career.

### MW/MVC CHALLENGE

The Mountain West and Missouri Valley Conferences have announced next season's pairings for the MW/MVC Challenge Series, and the University of New Mexico men's basketball team will play at Illinois State on Dec. 3, 2016. - Has ranked in the top 25 in attendance nationally every season since the 1966-67 season with 35 seasons in the top ten in the NCAA in attendance
- Led the Mountain West in attendance in 10 of the conference's 15 years of existence
