LOBOS CLOSE OUT SEASON AT ARIZONA STATE, AT HOME VS. AFA

The surging New Mexico beach volleyball team is looking to extend its current run of success this weekend, playing two matches at Arizona State on Friday before returning to Albuquerque for a Saturday doubleheader.

Winners of seven straight and 11 of their last 13 matches, the Lobos (14-9) will head to Tempe to play No. 19 Arizona State (12-14) and No. 20 California (13-7) on Friday. They will then come back to the Duke City for two matches against Air Force, which is trying out beach volleyball.

With the regular season coming to end this week, the Lobos know they can finish their third season of beach volleyball on a high note.

They've torn through their schedule over the past month, racking up the wins and the momentum as they head down the homestretch. Four wins this weekend would eclipse the program record in single-season wins.

But, more importantly, a strong performance this week would underscore the development of the program, which struggled late during its breakout 2016 season and had trouble opening strong this season.

Over the season, the Lobos became increasingly consistent, which has been the story for New Mexico during its current run.

During the team's winning streak, UNM has dropped just five of a possible 35 points, registering three sweeps over the past two weeks. On the season, New Mexico has totaled nine 5-0 wins.

Remaining steady during this week's roller coaster of volleyball will be the key for the Lobos, who have four or their five pairs sitting with at least 14 wins on the season.

At the No. 5 position, **Julia Warren & Lauren Twitty** have been the epitome of consistency over the last three weeks, stringing together eight straight wins. It's the second-longest pairs winning streak in program history.

New Mexico has also gotten strong results this season from its pairs at the Nos. 2 and 3 positions.

At the 2's, **Devanne Sours & Lise Rugland**

won four straight last weekend in Birmingham en route to a 17-6 record on the year. At the 3's, **Marisa Doran & Eastyn Baletto** are 16-6 this season, having won 11 of their last 13 matches.

Additionally, the Lobos' top tandem of **Cassie House & Ashley Kelsey** have played some of their best volleyball recently, having won eight of their last 10. At 14-9 on the season, the tandem is in the hunt for a berth at the 2017 USA Volleyball Collegiate Beach Championships, a 24-team pairs championship in mid-May.

NEW MEXICO RECEIVING VOTES IN NATIONAL POLL

The University of New Mexico beach volleyball team is receiving votes in the DiG Magazine Poll as it enters the final week of the 2017 regular season.

Unofficially, the Lobos check in at 25th in poll, which was release on Monday, April 17. It's the seventh DiG poll out of eight that New Mexico has appeared in.

However, after being ranked in five of six regular-season AVCA Collegiate Beach Volleyball Polls, UNM did not make an appearance in that ranking.

Overall, New Mexico is 14-9 on the season, having won seven straight matches and 11 of its last 13. All of the Lobos' losses were to teams ranked in the polls at the time.

State and No. 20 California.

The AVCA poll has USC (25-0), UCLA (25-2), Pepperdine (21-3), Florida State (21-7) and Long Beach State (23-5) as the top five teams. In fact, both polls' top eight teams are identical, with Hawai'i, LSU and Arizona sitting 6-7-8.

By the end of the season, New Mexico will have played 11 of its 27 matches against teams ranked in the polls.

SEE HOW THEY RUN

Last season, the Lobos reeled off a streak of eight straight wins, setting the program record for consecutive victories. This season, the Lobos are quickly closing on that mark.

Over the month of April, UNM has reeled off seven straight wins, including a pair of undefeated weekends. In order, the Lobos have beaten Santa Clara, Colorado Mesa twice, Lincoln Memorial, UAB, UT Martin and UAB again.

During that run, UNM has dropped all of five points, defeating opponents by a combined score of 30-5.

In 2016, the Lobos' eight-game winning streak included wins over San Jose State, Colorado Mesa twice, Arizona State and CSUN, but also three wins against non-NCAA competition.

All seven of New Mexico wins during its current run are over NCAA teams.

STREAKING, PART I

Over the last month, **Julia Warren & Lauren Twitty** have been on fire. Like the Lobos as a team, New Mexico's No. 5 tandem has been racking up the wins, stretching their streak to eight-straight wins.

The pair's winning streak is the second-best in team history.

The duo started against CSU Bakersfield, and then added a three-set win over No. 8/8 Arizona in Tucson. They then posted a run of five straight-set wins in a row, and most recently notched their eighth win in a three-set thriller over UAB in Birmingham.

In fact, Warren & Twitty could have stretched their run to nine wins, but didn't play against a shorthanded UT Martin squad as UTM forfeited the court Warren & Twitty were slated to play.

Along with their run of eight straight match wins, they also posted a stretch of 12 straight set wins, which is tied for fourth in program history.

STREAKING, PART II

Coming into the season, there had been eight instances of a New Mexico pair winning at least five consecutive matches.

Heading into the final weekend the 2017 season, and UNM has registered four more.

The longest this season was mentioned above, an eight-game run by **Julia Warren & Lauren Twitty**, but a number of other Lobos have also

gotten into on the action.

Eastyn Baletto & Marisa Doran reeled off six wins in a row, starting with a come-from-behind, three-set win over Georgia State. They added wins over Morehead State, Jacksonville State, No. 14/12 Stetson, Lincoln Memorial and CSU Bakersfield.

Their run of six straight wins is tied for the fifth-longest in program history. Last season, the duo posted the No. 1 (14 wins) streak and also have another streak of six wins.

Their winning streak also included 12 straight set wins, which also ranks as the fourth-longest run. They also own the program record in this category with 22 straight set wins last season.

Additionally, **Devanne Sours & Lise Rugland** posted their own five-match winning streak, capturing five straight from March 12-18. The opened with a win over No. 13/8 Arizona, and followed that with victories over No. 17/ RV Florida Atlantic, No. 12/8 Georgia State, Morehead State and Jacksonville State.

The tandem's winning streak included nothing but two-set wins, giving the tandem a 10-set winning streak. That streak ties for the ninth-longest in program history.

On top of that, the Lobos' top-seeded tandem of **Cassie House & Ashley Kelsey** also strung together a handful of wins, capturing six straight. They topped Santa Clara, Colorado Mesa twice, Lincoln Memorial, UAB and UT Martin in April, ranking their streak as the fifth-longest ever.

All of those wins were in straight sets, giving them a 12-set win streak. That is tied for the fourth-best in program history.

CLEAN SWEEP

When the Lobos sweep opponents, they leave no doubt in the final score.

Of New Mexico's nine sweeps this season, seven were dominant wins where UNM won every court in two sets. UNM's only sweeps where they didn't win every court in two sets was vs. Colorado Mesa (where the No. 4 court went to three sets) and Lincoln Memorial in Birmingham (where the 2's and 4's went three).

Of the 91 sets the Lobos have played in 5-0 wins this season, they've lost just three, with just 12 having been decided by three points or fewer. 63 were decided by at least six points.

The nine sweeps sets the new program record for sweeps in a single season. Last season, UNM tallied seven sweeps.

Over the three-year history of the program, New Mexico has logged 19 sweeps.

FROM THRILLER TO KILLER

Cassie House & Ashley Kelsey face off against some of the toughest pairs in the nation playing out of the No. 1 position for the Lobos. And that duo had been giving the fans their money's worth during the early goings of the season.

During the first two weeks of the season (eight matches), House & Kelsey saw eight of their 16 sets decided by three points or fewer.

During that stretch of white-knuckle play, they posted five 21-19 scores, winning three. Two of those 21-19 victories came in a marquee win over Arizona State's top tandem of Bianca Arellano/Whitney Follette on March 12. They also went to extra points twice during the first two weeks of action, with a 25-23 loss to Loyola Marymount and a 22-20 setback to TCU.

However, over the last month of action, they played some of their best ball, pummeling their opponents at a much higher frequency.

Over their last 13 matches, House & Kelsey have won 16 of the 28 sets that they've played by at least seven points. During the same time, they've played just six sets that were decided by three points or less.

Last season, 19 of their 48 sets were decided by three points or fewer, while only six were won by at least seven points.

THIRD SET'S A CHARM

Over the first two weeks of the season, **Devanne Sours & Lise Rugland** probably would not have agreed with the above statement.

Within their first seven matches, they played four three-setters. Three of those three-setters were losses, but they did manage a three-set win over Grand Canyon.

After an 11-match stretch of nothing but two-setters, the finally played another match to three sets, falling a tightly contested contest vs. Colorado Mesa.

However, last weekend at the Blazer Beach Duals in Birmingham, Alabama, the duo reversed their fortunes in three-set matches, claiming back-to-back matches in three.

The first was a largely decisive win over Lincoln Memorial, 21-9, 17-21, 15-6, while their second was a strong, come-from-behind win over host UAB, 18-21, 21-13, 15-9.

This season, Sours & Rugland have played seven three-set matches, tied for the most by a pair this season.

RETURN TO FORM

Last season, **Marisa Doran & Eastyn Baleto** tore their way through their schedule to the tune of a 23-3 record. Two of their three losses were three-setters, which essentially meant Doran & Baleto were about as sure of a bet as your were going to get on the beaches of Albuquerque.

However, through the early goings of the 2017 season, they were just 5-4. But, over their last 13 matches, they've returned to form, reeling off 11 wins to improve to a 16-6 on the season.

All 10 of their 11 wins during their run have been two-set sweeps. Just one set in those 11 wins was decided by less than five points. In

fact, Doran & Baleto held their opponents to less than 14 points in 16 sets.

WARREN/TWITTY NAMED TO WILDCAT SPRING CHALLENGE ALL-TOURNEY TEAM

Julia Warren & Lauren Twitty were named to the Wildcat Spring Challenge All-Tournament team after a 3-0 performance on March 31-April 1 in Tucson, Arizona.

The duo were the only Lobo tandem to post a spotless record during the tournament as they played on the No. 5 court and scored a point vs. CSU Bakersfield, No. 8/8 Arizona and Santa Clara.

They scored New Mexico's only point against the host Wildcats, winning 21-15, 16-21, 15-10. They also captured their matches vs. the Roadrunners and the Broncos in convincing fashion, winning 21-8, 21-15 and 21-15, 21-9, respectively.

SHE'S BEEN EVERYWHERE

Over the course of the three-year history of New Mexico beach volleyball, only one player has managed to play at least one match in every position. That player: **Chloe Crappell**.

With her debut at the No. 4 slot at the Wildcat Spring Challenge, Chloe has now seen action at the 1's, 2's, 3's, 4's and 5's positions for the Lobos.

She's played the bulk of her 23 career matches at the Nos. 2 and 3 courts, going 3-3 and 0-6, respectively. She is also 1-2 all-time at the 1's, and 3-1 at both the 4's and 5's.

The only other players who have come close to the platinum sombrero are **Julia Warren** and **Lise Rugland**, who have played in four of the five positions.

AND WE MEET AGAIN...

New Mexico is a bit of an island in the world of NCAA beach volleyball. The Lobos are the only team in the state of New Mexico to sponsor beach volleyball as an NCAA varsity sport, so with the lack of in-state competition, UNM has to find nearby neighbors for games.

With multiple schools in Arizona sponsoring the sport, the Lobos can travel west for some matches, which means New Mexico has played its fair share of games against those schools.

In fact, of the 63 matches ever played in UNM history, 17 have come against Arizona schools. (That's just over 25 percent.)

The Lobos have played Arizona six times, plus five matches against both Arizona State and Grand Canyon. The 17th match came in this season's opener vs. Benedictine University at Mesa.

UNM will get one more opportunity to add to this list when its faces off against Arizona State on April 22 in Tempe.

20-WIN CLUB, PAIRS STYLE

Entering the program's third year of play, just one tandem, **Marisa Doran & Eastyn Baletto**, had reached 20 career pairs wins.

That duo, which is currently 39-9 all-time, actually broke the 20-win plateau last season during their 23-3 campaign.

But, as the 2017 campaign has continued, two other Lobo partnerships have eclipsed that plateau.

Last month at the Stetson Beach Invitational, **Devanne Sours & Lise Rugland** joined their teammates, as they won five of six matches. After four wins at the Blazer Beach Duals, the broke into the 30-win club and sit 31-12 all-time.

Additionally, **Cassie House & Ashley Kelsey** moved into the 20-win club after picking up two wins at the Wildcat Spring Challenge. They currently own an 25-19 all-time record.

Next up to join the club is **Julia Warren & Lauren Twitty**, who currently own 15 wins in their first season playing together.

30-WIN CLUB, INDIVIDUAL STYLE

While just three tandems currently reside in the 20-Win Club, that makes sense since pairs change over the course of players' careers.

However, with a handful of Lobos having played for almost three full seasons, a handful of student-athletes have won over 30 matches individually, earning a spot in the 30-Win Club.

Currently, **Eastyn Baletto** is the clubhouse leader with 48 career wins. She has a chance to reach the half-century mark this Friday in Tempe.

Next up is **Julia Warren**, who has 44 career wins.

But, after going 5-1 at the Stetson Beach Invitational during mid-March, **Marisa Doran** and **Lise Rugland** both surpassed 30 career wins individually. Doran currently owns 39 career wins, followed by Rugland's 38.

Devanne Sours also eclipsed the 30-win mark at the Wildcat Spring Challenge and owns 36 wins heading into the final weekend of the 2017 season.

Ashley Kelsey (29 wins) and **Cassie House** (26) can also make their way into the club during the final week of the season.

SCOUTING ARIZONA STATE

Arizona State currently sits 12-14 on the season, but it just 6-11 over its last 14 matches, after a 6-3 start to the season. The Sun Devils, who are ranked 19th in the DiG Magazine Poll, have played a strong schedule, with wins over Arizona, TCU, Florida Atlantic and Saint Mary's.

ASU is led by its No. 1 tandem of Bianca Arellano/Whitney Follette, who have tallied a

team-best 17 wins on the season. However, New Mexico's top pairing of **Cassie House & Ashley Kelsey** logged a two-set sweep of Arellano/Follette in March in Tempe.

This is the sixth meeting all-time between Arizona State and New Mexico, with the Sun Devils leading the series 3-2. ASU won two matchups in 2015 before the Lobos swept two matches last season. In March, Arizona State won 3-2 in Tempe.

SCOUTING CALIFORNIA

California is 13-7 on the season and is currently riding a three-game winning streak. However, this season has been uneven for the Bears, who started off the year off 8-0 before losing seven of nine. In fact, this season has been one of close matches, as 11 of Cal's 20 matches were 3-2 decision.

Overall, California has struggled to score consistently at the top of its lineup. The Bears' No. 1 duo of Jessica Gaffney/Mia Merino are just 1-10, and Cal has posted just a 4-17 record from the top spot.

At the 2's, Cal isn't much better, with Grace Campbell/Olivia Rodberg compiling a 5-11 mark at that slot. As a team, California is 6-15 at the No. 2 position.

However, the Bears do have strong pairings at the bottom of the lineup, with a combined 14-7 record at the No. 3 position and identical 15-6 marks at the Nos. 4 and 5 spots.

Last season, New Mexico edged Cal 3-2 in Phoenix in the first meeting between the two programs.

SCOUTING AIR FORCE

Air Force, a volleyball program that is in the Mountain West like UNM, is hitting the sand for the first time ever as it experiments with the NCAA's fastest-growing sport.

The Falcons, who are coached by Marc Swindle, a former New Mexico men's volleyball player and volunteer assistant with the Lobo women's team, will have the services of Elizabeth Pennington, the indoor team's leader in kills last fall.

Overall, Air Force will bring a fair deal of size to their matchups with the Lobos, as seven players that the Falcons are expected to compete are taller than 5-foot-10.

MOVIN' ON UP

Although the Lobos have been on a roll their last nine games — winning seven during that span — it wasn't until their 4-1 win vs. Colorado Mesa on April 8 that the beach volleyball program at UNM once again rose above .500 for its all-time record.

After a 3-11 record during its inaugural season in 2015 (which featured a loss in the first game followed by one win in its next 12 games), New

Mexico managed to make up eight games in 2016 to play seven games with an all-time record above .500. But the Lobos ended their 2016 campaign with a 20-20 all-time record.

UNM did surpass .500 after its first game of the 2017 season, moving to 21-20 all-time after beating Benedictine University at Mesa, but a 2-7 stretch pulled the Lobos at 23-27 all-time heading into their current run of success.

Now winners of seven straight, New Mexico currently owns a 34-29 record all-time. When the Lobos face Arizona State on April 22 in Tempe, it will be the 13th match the team has ever played at .500 or better.

HEAD EAST

While also the name of a hard rock band from Illinois (their song "Never Been Any Reason" charted at No. 68 on the *Billboard* Hot 100 in 1975), Head East was also the mantra of the Lobos during their Spring Break trip to Florida on March 15-20.

When New Mexico headed to Tavares, Florida, for the Stetson Beach Invitational, it was the team's first-ever foray into the Eastern time zone and the eastern portion of the United States.

Last year, UNM made it as far east as Baton Rouge, but the state capitol of Louisiana is in the Central time zone and its arguably more "south" than "east".

The Lobos will also make a trip to Birmingham this weekend for the Blazer Beach Duals, but, again, Birmingham is more south than east and resides in the Central time zone.

New Mexico's trip to Florida also added to the Lobos' list of states visited. Of the 18 weekends of competition in program history, 10 have been to Arizona (including three this season), with four in Albuquerque, two in California and one each in Texas, Louisiana and Florida.

(For those of you counting at home, one of those trips went to both Arizona and California.)

LOBOS FINISH 2016 WITH STRONG PRESENCE IN POLLS

The New Mexico beach volleyball team finished its second season with a strong presence in the national polls, ranking 18th in the season-ending DiG Magazine Poll and receiving votes in the final AVCA Collegiate Beach Volleyball poll.

The Lobos, who compiled a 17-9 record on the year, unofficially finished as the 17th-ranked team in the 10-team AVCA ranking released Tuesday, May 10, and closed their second season as the youngest program ranked in the DiG Magazine poll released Thursday, May 5.

Overall, New Mexico received votes in the AVCA poll in all but three releases since the start of the regular season, rising to an unofficial high of 13th twice (March 28 and April 11).

The Lobos also maintained a steady presence in the DiG Magazine poll, first being ranked on March 29 and climbing to a program-best No. 12 on April 12.

During the 2016 season, UNM played USC, Florida State, No. 6 Arizona and No. 10 LSU and had matches against six other teams — No. 11 Grand Canyon, No. 14 Tulane, No. 16 California, No. 20 South Carolina, (RV) TCU and (RV) Washington — that were either ranked or receiving votes in the DiG Magazine poll.

BEACH VOLLEYBALL POSTS PROGRAM-BEST GPA IN FALL 2016

After posting a tremendous campaign in the sand last spring, the University of New Mexico beach volleyball team posted a stellar semester in the classroom last fall.

The Lobos recorded a team GPA of 3.64 for the Fall 2016 semester, the highest in the five-semester history of the program. It's fourth semester that the team registered a mark of at least 3.4.

The beach team combined with the rest of the women's sports at UNM for a 3.55 GPA. It's the 13th-straight semester of at least a 3.4 by the combined women's teams, as well.

A PRIMER ON BEACH VOLLEYBALL

Beach volleyball and court volleyball share many of the same basic rules. Each side gets three hits, there's rally scoring, and a team earns a point when the ball hits the ground or goes out of bounds. But there are some key differences between the two sports:

- Beach volleyball is a partner sport played during the spring. Court volleyball is a six-player sport played during the fall.
- Beach volleyball plays the best of three sets, with the first two sets played to 21 points, and a tiebreaker set played to 15 points, if necessary. A set must be won by at least two points.
- Open-handed tipping is prohibited in beach volleyball and the block touch counts as one of three permitted contacts.
- Coaches may only speak or give any kind of input to their players during timeouts or between sets.
- Beach volleyball players switch sides of the court every seven points during a 21-point set and every five points during a 15-point set.
- Beach volleyball is usually contested in dual matches, where the winning team is the school that wins three of five individual matches versus its opponent. Similar in format to tennis, each of those individual matches consist of a doubles — a pair of teammates ranked by ability — that are matched against their corresponding doubles from the opposing team.

BEACH VOLLEYBALL ENTERS 2ND SEASON AS 90TH NCAA CHAMPIONSHIP

Before the 2016 season, the NCAA approved beach volleyball as the 90th NCAA Championship at the 2015 NCAA Convention, which allowed the sport to advance from the emerging sports for women list to a full-fledged NCAA championship.

The NCAA Beach Volleyball Committee also determined the sport will be officially referred to as "beach volleyball". When the sport was placed on the list of emerging sports for women in 2009, it was called sand volleyball. But because the sport is known as beach volleyball at all other levels of play throughout the world, the committee made its decision to refer to the sport as beach volleyball.

The second-annual NCAA Beach Volleyball Championships will take place May 5-7, 2016 at the Gulf Shores Public Beach in Gulf Shores, Alabama. The championship will have an eight-team bracket that will be played in a double-elimination format.

USC won the inaugural NCAA National Championship 3-0 over Florida State.

Beach volleyball is the fastest-growing NCAA sport with 53 Division I colleges and universities sponsoring. NCAA rules require 40 sponsoring schools to request an NCAA championship. Data shows that on average, 60 percent of participants at a sponsoring school participate only in beach volleyball instead of playing both beach and indoor volleyball.
