ABOUT THE MATCH-UP

- The Lobos and Cowboys will be meeting for the 133rd time in program history Saturday
- The series, which dates back to 1950-51, is the third longest series in New Mexico basketball history. The Lobos have only played New Mexico State and UTEP more often.
- The Lobos are 67-65 all-time against Wyoming. Despite the even nature of the series, the Lobos have won nine of the last 10 games.
- The Cowboys have had a rough go of it in Albuquerque in recent years. The Cowboys' last victory inside WisePies Arena came on Feb. 15, 2003.
- Overtime games have become the norm in the New Mexico-Wyoming series. The last four games between the teams have gone to overtime. The two teams have played nine overtime games against each other in series history.
- Last season, the series was split at 1-1, with each team winning at home. Wyoming won in Laramie, 63-62, on Jan. 24, while New Mexico won in Albuquerque on senior night on March 7, 52-49.
- The Cowboys are 9-8, 2-2 in MW play. They dropped their last game at San Jose State Wednesday, 62-55. Larry Shyatt is in his sixth season after a previous stint at Clemson.

NEW MEXICO GAME NOTES

LAST TIME OUT

The University of New Mexico men's basketball team (10-7, 3-1 MW) dropped its first Mountain West Conference game this season on the road Tuesday against the UNLV Rebels (10-7, 1-3 MW), 86-74. The Lobos were led offensively by Elijah Brown, who recorded his first double-double as a Lobo, with 24 points and a career-high 10 rebounds. He shot 10-for-20 from the floor. Cullen Neal scored 14 points, collected three rebounds and dished out three assists, tying Joe Furstinger for the team lead. Neal shot 8-for-10 from the foul line, tying his best production from the line this year. Furstinger's three assists tied a career-high. Both the Lobos and the Rebels shot an even 40 percent on the evening. New Mexico shot 24-for-60 while UNLV shot 26-for-65. The Lobos shot 46.2 percent (6-for-13) from deep, while the Rebels shot 23.3 percent (7-for-30). New Mexico won the rebounding battle, 43-39. There were 61 combined free throw attempts Tuesday, with the Lobos shooting 20-for-28 and the Rebels shooting 27-for-33.

STRONGEST DECADE EVER

Now on the backside of the decade, the Lobos will be playing for their best decade of basketball in program history over the next handful of seasons. New Mexico is 131-56 this decade, holding a winning percentage of .704 from 2010-present. Head coach Craig Neal has been the head coach or associate head coach of New Mexico for that entire time. The Lobos have never had a winning percentage of .700 or higher in any decade. From 2000-10, the Lobos were .556 prior to the beginning of the Neal/Alford era and finished at .615. LOBOS VS. TOP SCORERS

Saturday's game will pit the top two scorers in the Mountain West Conference against each other in Josh Adams and Elijah Brown. Adams currently ranks first in the league and sixth in the nation at 23.9 points per game. Brown is second in the MW and 38th in the NCAA at 19.6 points per game.

The Lobos have already faced three of the nation's top-50 scorers and have given them fits in areas outside of scoring. Pascal Siakam of New Mexico State is averaging 23 points per game, ranking seventh in the nation. In two games against the Lobos, Siakam averaged a shade under his average at 22 points per game. However, the Lobos kept him from earning a double-double and were the first team to do so. Obi Emegano of Oral Roberts is averaging 22.8 points per game, ranking ninth in the nation. He scored 25 against New Mexico, but was held to 8-for-21 shooting with three turnovers and no assists. Marcus Evans is averaging 19.9 points per game, ranking 31st in the country. He scored 21 in WisePies Arena, but again, was forced to miss double digit shots and made five turnovers.

PACKED PIT

New Mexico basketball is currently on track to finish in the national top 25 in attendance average for the 50th straight year. New Mexico returns to WisePies Arena Saturday, where the Lobos rank 19th in the country and first in the Mountain West in attendance at 12,882 fans a game. The Lobos average 500 more fans a game than second-place San Diego State. The Lobos are No. 2 in the nation in average attendance outside of the Big East and Power 5 schools.

EFFECTIVE SHOOTING

As a team, the Lobos currently lead the Mountain West in field goal percentage at 46.9 percent shooting a game. They are currently 56th in the nation in field goal percentage. The Lobos are led by a starting front court of Tim Williams and Obij Aget, who are combining to shoot 61 percent from the floor. The Lobos' most high volume shooter, Elijah Brown, is shooting 45 percent on 219 attempts. The Lobo bench has combined to shoot 41 percent from the floor as a group.

STARTING 3-1

New Mexico is now 3-1 in Mountain West Conference play after wins over Nevada, Fresno State and Utah State. The first half of that marked the fourth straight season in which the Lobos have started 2-0 in MW play, a streak that encompasses head coach Craig Neal's entire run as the leader of the Lobos. They have also started 3-1 in MW play for the second time in three years. 3-1 is the best start in Craig Neal's head coaching tenure and the second best in program history, being topped only once.

Since the Lobos joined the MW, Craig Neal is the only head coach to start 2-0 in three straight seasons. Previous to this current run of strong starts, the Lobos had not started 2-0 in conference action since the 2001-02 season.

PREMIER DEFENSE

The Lobos have received solid praise on their increased pace and scoring margin, 3rd in the league at +8.2, in Mountain West play through four games. However, the team's defense has been a huge reason why the Lobos have been so successful. In the first three games, the Lobos held their opponents scoreless for at least a five minute stretch in each first half. Currently, the Lobos are second in the Mountain West in field goal defense in conference play at 38.3 percent. Their 3-point field goal defense in conference is the leader in the league at 19.6 percent, holding opponents to 18-of-92 from deep.

WILLIAMS AT 58%

New Mexico forward Tim Williams is having one of the most efficient offensive seasons in Lobo basketball history. Williams is currently shooting 58% from the floor on 115-of-197 shooting. He currently leads all eligible players in the Mountain West Conference. In Lobo history, only seven players have finished the season shooting 60 percent or better with at least three field goal attempts per game, a mark Tim Williams is in range of. Williams is taking almost 12 attempts per game and still maintaining a high percentage. Historically, only Luc Longley (.656, 349 attempts) in 1990-91 and Charlie Thomas (.622, 365 attempts) have shot over 60 percent for a season and taken at least 300 shots.

REBOUNDING IN THE PIT

WisePies Arena has been a historically treacherous environment for visiting teams, and this season has been no different. The Lobos are 8-1 inside WisePies Arena this season, with their one loss coming by a point. Of all the areas in which the Lobos have dominated at home, rebounding may be the most significant. The Lobos are averaging 39.1 rebounds per game at home with a rebounding margin of +8.6, which is nearly an 11 rebound swing from when the Lobos play away from Albuquerque. The Lobos average 10.3 offensive rebounds per game inside The Pit. Tim Williams has averaged 7.8 rebounds per game at home, 2.3 on the offensive end.

STATISTICAL RANKINGS

ESPN has New Mexico ranked 88th in the country in their BPI ranks, which ranks them a close third among Mountain West Conference teams. The Lobos are 124th in RPI, with the loss to UNLV pushing them back just eight spots.

The Lobos are currently predicted by KenPom.com to finish two games away from the MW conference title. After taking a fall during a rough stretch, the Lobos are ranked 100thth by KenPom.

BROWN AT THE LINE

Elijah Brown just ended a run of 31 straight made free throws, after shooting perfect for three games and making his last five shots against Washington State. The run was 21 short of the program record of 52 consecutive made free throws, set by Rob Robbins in 1989-90. Overall this year, Brown ranks 14th in the nation with 97 free throws made, 39th with 111 free throws attempted and 30th with an 87.4 percent free throw percentage.

NEW MEXICO GAME NOTES

GUARDING THE 3

Early on this season, the Lobos were among the nation's best perimeter defensive teams. A rough four-game stretch brought the Lobos' overall numbers back down to Earth. However, the Lobos have rediscovered their perimeter defense and are stifling league opponents. In Mountain West play, the Lobos have held opponents to 19.6 percent shooting from 3-point range, giving up 18 treys on 92 attempts. In the conference opener, New Mexico held Nevada to 26.7 percent (4-for-15) shooting from outside. On the road at Fresno State, the Lobos locked the Bulldogs down to 5.6 percent (1-for-18) from outside. Marvelle Harris, the MW Preseason Player of the Year, was held to 1-for-8 shooting from distance, 5-for-19 overall. On Saturday, Utah State took 29 3-point attempts trying to climb back into the game, but only made six. The Lobos held UNLV to 23.3 percent shooting from outside, which, remarkably hurt the Lobos' shooting defense in conference.

CULLEN NEAL'S FIRST HALF IN FRESNO

Fresno State looked to be in a good position going into the game against the Lobos, playing in front of their largest crowd since their home opener. The situation was bleak when Elijah Brown picked up two early fouls, but ultimately, Fresno State never led and fell behind big after an offensive explosion from starting point guard Cullen Neal. Neal scored 20 points against the Bulldogs in the first half on 6-for-11 shooting. He made three big 3-pointers, shooting 50 percent from outside before the break. Neal played the entire first half, 10 minutes alongside fellow point guard Jordan Hunter. New Mexico led by as much as 19 points in the first half and entered the break up, 44-27.

SPEEDY LOBOS

Before the season, head coach Craig Neal stated that he wanted to play an up tempo style in 2015-16. So far, he has accomplished that goal in spades. The Lobos are the fastest team in the Mountain West this season, with an adjusted tempo of 73.8 possessions per game according to KenPom.com. That number not only tops the league, but ranks 28th in the nation. The Lobos are ahead of the national average of 69.7 and the MW league average of 70. Wyoming is currently ninth of 11 teams in tempo at 67.3 possessions per game.

Last season, the Lobos averaged 62 points per game on an average of 62.5 possessions per game, ranking 290th in the nation in tempo. Since 2002, the Lobos have never finished a season averaging 70 possessions a game or more.

50 WINS FOR NOODLES

With an 88-76 victory over Nevada, New Mexico head coach Craig Neal earned his 50th victory as the leader of the Lobos. With an overall record of 52-30, Coach Neal becomes one of only five coaches to pick up 50 wins within their first 80 contests. His overall winning percentage of .634 puts him in an elite class historically at New Mexico. Only five coaches in the program's history have at least 50 wins and a winning percentage above .600. The others include Bob King, Norm Ellenberger, Dave Bliss and Steve Alford, whom Neal worked alongside as an associate head coach.

After a strong start last season, Neal reached 40 wins in just 53 games, the second fastest mark in program history. These are among several notable achievements in less than three years as head coach, including becoming the first rookie head coach to guide the Lobos to the NCAA Tournament.

YOUNG LOBOS

The New Mexico men's basketball team has started the same starting lineup in every game this season: Cullen Neal, Elijah Brown, Obij Aget, Sam Logwood and Tim Williams. It is the youngest starting lineup by class grade since Neal's first season on the coaching staff at New Mexico in 2008-07, when the team started two freshmen and a sophomore. This is one of only two years during the Neal/Alford era in which the Lobos have not started a senior. When compared to the rest of the league the Lobos have the fourth youngest starters in the Mountain West Conference. When looking at the entire roster, the Lobos have the youngest team in the entire Mountain West Conference. KenPom.com rates their experience level at 1.24 (0 points for freshmen, 1 for sophomores...), which ranks 309th in the nation.
