Boise State Travels to New Mexico

WHAT'S HAPPENING

- **The Game:** The Broncos (13-3, 3-2 MW) are off to Albuquerque, N.M., for a Wednesday night Mountain West encounter with the New Mexico Lobos (8-8, 4-2 MW) at 7 p.m. (Mountain).
- **Next Up:** Boise State returns home to Taco Bell Arena, where it is 9-1 this year, when the Broncos host the San Jose State Spartans at 2 p.m. (MT) on Saturday.
- **Radio:** KTIK (AM 1350) will carry all of the women's games throughout the season. Chris Lewis is in his fourth season as the voice of the Broncos.
- **Internet Broadcast:** You can also listen to the radio broadcast on the internet at BroncoSports.com.
- **Watch Live:** The game will be broadcast live on the internet via the Mountain West Network on BroncoSports.com.

A QUICK GAME PREVIEW

- Boise State snapped a two-game slide last Saturday when the Broncos defeated Fresno State 67-66 at home in their lone game of the week ... Boise State is now 13-3 overall and 3-2 in MW play.
- Brooke Pahukoa leads Boise State averaging 13.6 points per game (9th MW) ... Shalen Shaw adds 11.3 points (16th MW) and team-high 7.2 rebounds (13th MW) per game.
- Boise State ranks 52nd nationally in 3-point percentage at .355 and is 15th in 3-pointers made per game at 8.6 ... the Broncos average 71.8 points per game, second in the Mountain West.
- New Mexico is 8-8 overall and 4-2 in MW play ... the Lobos have lost two straight entering the week, 56-42 at UNLV (Jan. 11) and 78-63 at home versus Colorado State (Jan. 14).
- Cherise Beynon leads the Lobos on the year averaging 15.8 points (5th MW) and 7.5 rebounds (9th MW) per game ... Richelle Van Der Keijl adds a double-double 13.8 points (8th MW) and 10.3 rebounds (2nd MW) per game.
- New Mexico averages 68.9 points (4th MW) per game on the year, allows 63.1 ppg (6th MW) and is shooting 38.2 percent (9th MW) from the floor as a team and 28.4 percent (11th MW) from beyond the arc.
- This will be the 14th meeting in the series all-time which Boise State leads 8-5 and 6-4 in the MW regular-season series.
- The Broncos are 3-2 all-time in Albuquerque versus the Lobos.
- The Lobos won the last meeting between the two programs 70-60 at Boise (Feb. 17, 2016).

TEAM NOTES

- The Broncos are 3-2 in conference play following a 67-66 win last Saturday (Jan. 14) at home over Fresno State which was preceded by a pair of defeats to UNLV, 58-55, in Boise (Jan. 4) and at San Diego State, 84-77, (Jan. 7).
- Boise State is now 13-3 overall and 3-2 in MW play.
- The Broncos started the season off at 12-1 overall which tied for the best start in program history after 13 games, since the 1974-75 squad set the school record at 12-0 before dropping to 12-1 ... the 1971-72 and 1973-74 teams also went 12-1.

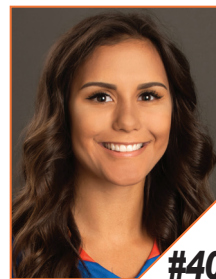

- Boise State just completed its best pre-conference campaign in program history at 10-1.
- Boise State has a balanced offensive attack and has had three or more players reach double-figure scoring in 13 of the first 16 games ... they are 11-2 in those 13 contests.
- Balanced attack with nine players having scored double-digit points this season, six have led the team in scoring at least once ... no one has led the team in scoring more than five times (Brooke Pahukoa).
- The Broncos currently have four players averaging double-digit points led by Brooke Pahukoa (13.6 ppg) followed by Shalen Shaw (11.3 ppg), Marta Hermida (10.3 ppg) and Marijke Vanderschaaf (10.0 ppg) ... five players average 8.3 or more points per game.
- Four Broncos have reached double-digit points at least eight times each with a high of 12 by Shaw.
- Boise State is second in the MW for 3-point percentage as a team at .355 to rank 52nd nationally ... they are 34th in the nation for total 3-pointers made at 137 and 15th nationally for 3-pointers made per game at 8.6.
- Defensively, Boise State ranks second in the MW and is 41st nationally in 3-point defense holding opponents to 27.7 percent from beyond the arc.
- On the year the Broncos have two of the top-15 3-point shooters in the MW: Riley Lupfer (.390) is seventh, while Brooke Pahukoa (.385) is 10th.

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

- Head coach Gordy Presnell hit the 600 career wins milestone against Portland (Dec. 18), Presnell is the 32nd coach in NCAA DI history to hit the mark ... he now has 604 wins.
- Yaiza Rodriguez has dished out nine or more assists in six contests to date and six or more in 12 games ... she has three with 10-plus.
- Rodriguez leads the MW and is ninth nationally in assists per game at 7.1.
- Rodriguez set the school's career assists record earlier this fall at 452 and has since

stretched it out to 537.

- Rodriguez is the first Bronco and seventh individual in MW history to reach the 500 assists milestone ... had eight versus Hawaii (Dec. 20) to reach the mark.
- Rodriguez is now fifth in MW history for career assists at 537, nine short of fourth.
- Brooke Pahukoa leads the team and ranks ninth in the MW for points per game at 13.6 ... she has eight games in double-digit points, four with 20-plus, including 20 in the win at Colorado State (Dec. 31).
- Brooke Pahukoa has moved into 12th all-time (1,122) for career points at Boise State, 41 short of 11th.
- Brooke Pahukoa is 10th in the MW for 3-point percentage at .385 and is tied for third in the league for 3-pointers per game at 2.1.
- Shalen Shaw is second on team and 16th in MW for scoring at 11.3 points per game ... she leads the team and is 13th in MW for rebounds at 7.2 per game.
- Shaw tallied a team-high eight rebounds against Concordia (Dec. 7) to reach the 500 career rebounds milestone ... she currently stands at 563 to rank 16th all-time at Boise State, 17 short of sole possession of 15th.
- Marijke Vanderschaaf is averaging 6.7 rebounds per game (2nd on team / 14th MW) and has 11 games with six or more boards ... she had a career-high 11 in win at Colorado State (Dec. 31).
- Vanderschaaf has scored double-figure points in eight of the last 12 contests including a career-high 22 at San Diego State (Jan. 7).

(Expanded Notes)

LAST TIME OUT

- Shalen Shaw hit a 1-of-2 free throws with three seconds remaining to give Boise State a 67-66 victory over Fresno State (Jan. 14) in Taco Bell Arena.
- Boise State used a 13-0 run to turn a 6-2 deficit into a 15-6 lead, the Broncos never trailed again.

- The game was close throughout with the largest lead being nine by Boise State on two occasions ... Fresno State tied it four times in the second half but never took the lead.
- Boise State's Marta Hermida scored a team-high 14 points followed by Shaw with 13 and Braydey Hodgins with a career-high 11.

BRONCOS EARN 300th WIN

- Boise State's 74-60 win over Portland (Dec. 18) was the Broncos' 300th all-time in Taco Bell Arena.
- Boise State is currently 304-152 (.667) all-time in the facility.

PRESNELL HITS 200 AT BOISE STATE

- Gordy Presnell is in his 12th season at Boise State and his 30th overall as a collegiate head coach.
- He is the winningest coach in program history with 208 wins.
- On Nov. 26 he reached his 200th career win at Boise State when the Broncos defeated Charlotte 68-65 to give him a 200-149 record ... he is now 208-152.

PRESNELL JOINS ELITE GROUP

- Presnell's overall career record is impressive as he stands at 604-279 in 30 years of coaching.
- The win over Portland (Dec. 18) made him the 32nd coach in NCAA Division I history to reach the 600 wins milestone and the 63rd coach to reach milestone in NCAA & NAIA history for all levels.
- He currently ranks 17th among active NCAA Division I coaches for career wins at 604.

SHAW REACHES REBOUND MILESTONE

- Junior forward Shalen Shaw reached the 500 career rebounds milestone in the win over Concordia (Dec. 7) with a team-high eight boards to give her 506 in her career.
- Shaw is the 21st Bronco all-time to reach 500.
- Shaw is now ranked 16th overall for career rebounds with 563.

RODRIGUEZ SETS SCHOOL ASSISTS RECORD

- Senior point guard Yaiza Rodriguez dished out 10 assists in Boise State's win at Saint Mary's (Nov. 25) giving her a new school record of 452 career assists, then stretched it to 456 before the game ended.
- She passed the previous top mark held by Bronco great Tricia (Bader) Binford, the head coach at Montana State, of 451 set from 1991-96.
- Rodriguez entered 2016-17 just 27 short of tying the record with 424.
- The native of Barcelona, Spain, has 113 assists this season giving her 537 career assists.

- Senior Brooke Pahukoa entered the 2016-17 campaign ranked 22nd in career points with 931, 69 points short of becoming the 18th member of the 1,000 career points club at Boise State.
- Pahukoa scored a team-high 26 points to lead the Broncos past Saint Mary's (Nov. 25) surpassing the 1,000 career points milestone with 1,005.
- She now has 191 points this season and sits in 12th place with 1,122 points.

BOISE STATE PICKED SECOND IN MW POLL

Boise State women's basketball has been picked to battle for the Mountain West title this

winter having been projected to finish second behind three-time defending champion Colorado State in the preseason coaches/media poll.

BROOKE PAHUKOA PRESEASON ALL-MW

Senior Brooke Pahukoa was among the individuals selected for the 2016 Preseason All-MW Team. The native of Lake Stevens, Wash., was the only Bronco picked among the five member team and three major award winners. This is the second-consecutive year that Pahukoa has been honored as a member of the preseason team.

SHAW, QUEEN OF THE DOUBLES

Junior Shalen Shaw is coming off an outstanding sophomore campaign where she recorded 11 double-doubles, including a MW-high 10 in conference play. She nearly notched her first of 2016-17 in the opener versus Southern Oregon (Nov. 13) with 17 points and nine rebounds.

SHAW WAS THE FIRST IN 36 YEARS

Shalen Shaw was the third Bronco in history to average a double-double during league play. She finished MW play in 2015-16 averaging 12.2 points and MW-high 10.1 rebounds per game. The last time a Bronco averaged a double-double was 36 years ago during 1979-80 season.

THREE STRAIGHT WINNING SEASONS

The Broncos have recorded three straight winning seasons and seven overall under head coach Gordy Presnell in 11 seasons. Last year they went 19-11 and 12-6 in Mountain West play to place third.

RETURNING STARTERS

Boise State returns four starters who combined for 118 starts last year and a combined 211 overall in their collective careers. Last year's starters include: Marta Hermida (30/30), Brooke Pahukoa (29/29), Yaiza Rodriguez (30/30) and Shalen Shaw (30/29).

RETURNING POSTSEASON HONOREES

The Broncos return three of their four 2016 postseason Mountain West honorees: Brooke Pahukoa and Shalen Shaw were all-conference, while Marta Hermida was the 2016 MW Freshman of the Year and a member of the all-freshman team.

VETERANS BACK IN 2016-17

Eight veterans return with seven having played in 28 or more games last season ... joining the four starters back are Brittney Pahukoa (28/1), Joyce Harrell (28/0), Marijke Vanderschaff (30/0) and Leonie Edringer (3/0).

STATISTICALLY WHAT'S BACK

Statistically, Boise State returns: 75.3 percent of its points, 79.5 percent of the rebounds, 91.8 percent of assists, 76.5 percent of blocked shots, 80.2 percent of steals and 95.5 percent of made 3-pointers.

KEY LOSS

Miquelle Askew started in 89 games at center over the last three years. She graduated with 1,261 points (10.1 ppg), 579 rebounds (4.6 rpg) and shot 50.1 percent from the floor over the course of her career, fourth all-time in program history.

WHAT'S NEW: TRANSFERS

Boise State added seven newcomers, three transfers and four true freshmen.

Brooke Wheeler is the lone transfer who can play this year coming from Snow College ... 6-3 center was a junior college all-region honoree last season ... averaged 11.8 points, team-high 7.4 rebounds, 1.4 assists, 0.7 steals, 1.2 blocks in 27.9 minutes per game ... shot 54.8 percent (153-279) from the floor.

A'Shanti Coleman is a transfer from Arizona where she started 11 of 32 games played ... averaged 2.2 points, 1.6 rebounds and 0.5 blocks in 11.4 minutes per game ... shot 41.3 percent from the floor (33-80) ... will sit out due to NCAA rules.

Ellie Woerner is a transfer from Portland where she started in 28 of 29 games played ... shot 40.4 percent from the floor (118-292), 38.9 percent (44-113) from beyond the 3-point arc and 72.4 percent (63-87) from the free-throw line ... averaged 11.8 points, 3.3 rebounds, 1.2 assists and 0.6 steals in 29.2 minutes per game ... led the team and ranked 13th in West Coast Conference for scoring.

WHAT'S NEW: FRESHMEN

All four of the freshmen were standouts and all-state honorees as seniors in their respective states.

Braydey Hodgins: Named to Washington 4-A All-State First Team ... Mid-Columbia Conference Player of the Year and Defensive Player of the Year, as well as Mid-Columbia All-Conference First Team ... led the Mid-Columbia Conference in scoring at 27.1 points per game, more than 10 points better than the second ranked player; averaged 8.9 rebounds, 3.8 steals and 3.4 blocks per game.

Riley Lupfer: As a senior named to Associated Press of Washington All-State First Team and Greater Spokane League Player of the Year ... overall during prep career a three-time All-Greater Spokane League honoree garnering first team recognition as a junior and senior ... last year averaged a conference-high 20.6 points per game to go with 6.4 rebounds, 4.8 assists, 1.2 steals and 1.1 blocks.

Jordan Woodvine: A McDonald's All-American nominee ... three-time Oregon 6A All-State honoree, first team as a senior ... three-time Greater Valley All-Conference First Team honoree and honorable mention as a freshman ... as a senior year averaged 13.4 points, 5.3 rebounds and 3.4 assists per game.

BOISE STATE TENURE (2005-present)

Twelve years ago Gordy Presnell returned to his home state to become the sixth head coach in Boise State University's women's basketball program history. He brought with him a mild and laid back demeanor, 18 years of head coaching experience and a long record of success. Presnell currently ranks first in Bronco history for victories by a coach with a record of 195-149 (.567) overall. The 2016-17 season will mark his 30th as a collegiate head coach with a career record of 591-276 (.682).

Since his arrival in the spring of 2005 Presnell has turned the Broncos around and has them competing for conference championships. His teams have won two regular season titles in 2007 and 2008, as well as recording the program's first ever conference tournament titles in 2007 and 2015 to advance to the NCAA Tournament.

In the first 11 years under his direction, the Broncos have recorded seven winning seasons and one at .500. After going 15-15 in his first year (2005-06) the Broncos recorded four consecutive-winning seasons, including a school-record 24 wins in both the 2006-07 (24-9) and 2007-08 (24-8) campaigns. Boise State currently has an active streak of three straight winning seasons with two national postseason appearances. Presnell's teams have gone 96-84 in conference games and an impressive 117-49 (.705) at home in Boise, including a perfect 14-0 in 2007-08.

Presnell's teams have advanced to national postseason play four times and have recorded the only postseason victories in program history reaching the second round of both the 2008 Women's National Invitation Tournament and 2014 Women's Basketball Invitational.

Over the course of his tenure Presnell's Broncos have pushed the tempo of the game. His teams are routinely ranked among the top scoring and rebounding teams in the conference and have set numerous school records along the way. Presnell coached teams have set the school record for points in a season three times in 2006-07 (2,275), 2007-08 (2,330) and 2014-15 (2,331), in addition to recording six of the top 10 season totals all-time (46 years). In rebounding the Broncos have turned in the top six totals all-time and have set the record three times in 2005-06 (1,252), 2006-07 (1,330) and most recently 2007-08 (1,335).

They have five of the top 10 scoring averages in program history including the fourth-best mark of 72.8 points per game in 2007-08 and the fifth-most at 70.6 in 2014-15. Presnell's Broncos have six of the top 10 season marks for field goals made, seven of the top 10 in field goal attempts, eight of the top 10 in 3-point field goals made and the top 10 marks for 3-point field goal attempts. His 2015-16 team set the school record for free-throw percentage hitting .752; while his 2011-12 squad hit .742 and the 2012-13 .734 to round out the top three marks all-time.

In 2007, Presnell led the team to new heights with a 24-9 overall record, they won the league regular-season crown and WAC Tournament title advancing to the NCAA Tournament, the program's first postseason national tournament since the 1998 WNIT. For his coaching performance he was named the WAC and WBCA Division I Regional Coach of the Year.

Program honors during his tenure at Boise State include: winning back-to-back Western Athletic Conference regular-season crowns in 2007 and 2008; the 2007 WAC Tournament title; 2015 Mountain West Tournament title; two NCAA Tournament appearances in 2007 and 2015; advanced to the second round in both the 2008 Women's National Invitation Tournament and the 2014 Women's Basketball Invitational; one WBCA All-Region and one Honorable Mention All-American honors; 11 all-conference honors, one honorable mention all-conference honor, eight conference all-freshmen

team members, two conference newcomers of the year, two freshman of the year, three conference all-defensive team honors, five conference all-tournament team honors with two tournament MVP, four CoSIDA Academic All-District and a combined 65 academic all-conference honors by 27 individuals.

PRIOR TO BOISE STATE

Prior to taking over at Boise State, Presnell coached for 18 successful years at Seattle Pacific University in Washington. At SPU, he inherited a program that had not recorded a winning season in the previous nine years. He built the Falcons into a NCAA Division II national power, accumulating an overall record of 396 victories with 127 defeats (.757). Along the way his teams amassed an average of 22 wins per season while claiming seven conference championships, including four in his last five seasons. In addition, his teams were an impressive 221-29 (.884) at home in Broughman Pavilion, including five unbeaten home seasons.

On the national scene under Presnell, the Falcons advanced to nine-straight (1997-2005) and 10 of 11 NCAA Division II tournaments while he was in Seattle. Overall, Seattle Pacific made postseason appearances in 13 of his 18 years, 10 NCAA and three NAIA. Presnell's teams reached three NCAA Division II Elite Eights and advanced to the 2005 national title game.

At the time of his departure from Seattle Pacific in the summer of 2005, Presnell was ranked tied for 10th-place nationally among NCAA Division II coaches for win percentage (.757) and 21st for total victories.

COACHING HIGHLIGHTS

In 29 years as a collegiate head coach Presnell has experienced 25 winning seasons and one at .500. His teams have won a combined nine regular-season titles, seven at SPU and two at Boise State. In addition, he has guided 17 of his 28 squads into postseason national tournaments.

During his career he has been named conference coach of the year eight times, WBCA Regional Coach of the Year five times (four at NCAA Division II level and one at Division I), and the WBCA NCAA Division II National Coach of the Year twice. His coach of the year honors now total 15 in 28 years. In 2007 during the NCAA's 25th anniversary celebration for women's sports, coach Presnell was listed as one of the top coaches all-time in their publication "Women's Basketball Finest."

His student-athletes have accumulated numerous honors along the way: one All-American; seven individuals have earned 10 honorable mention All-American awards; five league players of the year; 11 freshman/newcomers of the year; 33 players have combined for 52 all-conference honors; eight conference all-freshmen team members; three conference all-defensive team members; 41 individuals have combined for 105 academic all-conference honors; 14 combined for 16 national academic honors including two academic All-Americans.

PERSONAL

Presnell, a Lapwai, Idaho, native graduated from Northwest Nazarene University in Nampa, Idaho, in 1983 with a B.A. in physical education. He continued his studies in physical education at Seattle Pacific University, where he earned a master's degree in 1989. He and his wife, former SPU gymnast Susan Nolte, live in Meridian, Idaho. They have two children, a daughter, Jacquelyn (25), and a son, Ryder (21).

In 2008 he was honored by his alma mater Northwest Nazarene as the "Outstanding Educator of the Year." While at Seattle Pacific he was asked to throw out the opening pitch at two Seattle Mariners games.
