ABOUT THE MATCH-UP

- The Lobos and Rams will meet for the 120th time in program history on Saturday. This is the seventh longest rivalry in New Mexico history and second longest against a Mountain West opponent.
- The Lobos hold a record of 74-45 overall against Colorado State in a series that dates back to Dec. 20, 1940. The bulk of the series began in 1952, when the two institutions were in the Skyline Conference together until 1962. After a short break in the series, the two teams would compete against each other in the WAC and Mountain West.
- The Lobos have dominated the Rams inside WisePies Arena with a record of 44-5. But on the road against the Rams, the Lobos are 23-32. Colorado State had the upper hand on New Mexico when playing in the Skyline Conference. However, the Lobos have won 35 of the last 42 games in the series, dating back to Feb. 12, 1994.
- Last season, the Lobos played Colorado State once due to the Mountain West schedule. The Lobos traveled up to Fort Collins on Feb. 23, 2016 but fell 86-69.
- New Mexico comes into the match-up with a 2-3 conference record and 9-8 overall. The Lobos are on a three-game skid, falling against Utah State, Nevada and UNLV.
- Tim Williams continues to lead the Lobos in the scoring column at 18.5 points per game. He is still the leader of the Mountain West in field goal percentage at 59.7 percent. Elijah Brown is second on the team in scoring at 17.1 ppg.
- The Rams are led by Larry Eustachy, who previously coach at Idaho, Iowa St. and Souther Miss. CSU comes into the game with a 11-6 overall record and 3-1 record in the league.
- Colorado State is led by Gian Clavell. He is averaging 16.5 points per game on the season and 21.5 ppg in conference games. He is shooting 51.9 percent from the three. Emmanuel Omogbo and Prentiss Nixon are also in double figures at 12.8 and 12.5 respectively. Those two are shooting 48.5 percent from the field.
- Colorado State is leading the league in offensive rebounding. They are averaging 11.8 offensive rebounds per game. Omogbo is leading the MW in rebounds at 10.6 per game and is averaging 3.0 offensive rebounds per game.

LAST TIME OUT

The Lobos suffered their third straight loss on Tuesday night to UNLV, 71-66. The Lobos held a 37-31 lead over the Runnin' Rebels at half time but allowed them to go on a 22-9 run in the first eight minutes of the second half. The Lobos took a 62-61 lead after two made free throws from Dane Kuiper with 5:08 left to play. The Lobos only scored four points the rest of the way and allowed UNLV to score 10.

DANE KUIPER'S CAREER NIGHT

Dane Kuiper put together a career performance against UNLV on Tuesday. He finished with a career-high 17 points, which led the squad. He was 3-for-5 from the three and 6-for-10 from the field overall. He finished with three assists, four rebounds and a steal in his career-high 37 minutes played.

Kuiper has continued to step up for the Lobos. On the season, he is leading the team beyond the arc at 45.9 percent. In conference play, he is 8-for-15 from the three (53.3 percent).

AGET'S BLOCKS

On Tuesday night, senior Obij Aget recorded seven blocks against UNLV, all coming in the first half. It was the best block performance since the 1999-2000 season when two players recorded seven in a game. Luc Longley owns the block record with 10 in a single game. Aget now has over 100 blocks in his career and is seventh on the all-time list with 106. Longley is the all-time leader in blocks with a total of 336. Longley also owns the single season record with 117 (1989-90).

IN LEAGUE PLAY

Since conference play has started, the Lobos have ranked first among the league in field goal percentage. In five games, the Lobos are shooting 47.5 percent.

HARRIS STEPS UP

Freshman Jalen Harris has been a bright spot for the Lobos since conference action began. In five conference games, he is average 9.6 points per game and is dishing out 4.2 assists per game. His 4.2 assists per game is good for fourth in the league. Harris has a 1.9 assist/turnover ratio in conference play and that ranks eighth in the conference.

GETTING TO THE FREE THROW LINE

The Lobos continue to be among the top of the nation in free throws. The Lobos are second in the country in KenPom's free throw rate and second in Free Throw Point Distribution. New Mexico has a 51.6 free throw rate and receives 27.6 percent of their points from the line.

The Lobos are shooting 75.3 percent from the foul line which leads the Mountain West and is 35th in the nation. Their opponents free throw rate is 35.1 and the average D-I free throw rate is 35.2.

BROWN AT THE LINE

Elijah Brown made 14-of-14 against Fresno State on Dec. 26, which was the third best in program history. He is 29-of-29 in Mountain West openers as he went 15-of-15 against Nevada in last year's MW opener. He continued his streak, making 8-of-8 at SDSU. That streak ended against Utah State on Jan. 4 as he missed his first free throw attempt against the Aggies. He made 26 straight which is his second longest streak. Last season, his longest streak was 31 straight free throws. The program record in 52 consecutive made free throws.

Brown ranks 15th in the nation in Free Throw Attempts (122) which is second best in the league. He is 11th in the country in Free Throws Made (98) which is first among the Mountain West.

IN THE CONFERENCE

Tim Williams continues to rank first among the league in field goal percentage and moved up to 22nd among the country this week. On the season, he is shooting 59.7 percent. He is second in points per game at 18.5 behind Nevada's Marcus Marshall's 20.7.

OTHER NUMBERS AMONG THE NATION

The Lobos moved up to second in the nation in free throws made. The Lobos have made a total of 356 this season. They also rank third in free throw attempts with 473. The Lobos are first among the conference in both categories.

TIM WILLIAMS PASSING 1,500

New Mexico Game Notes

With a game-high 17 points against Colorado State last season, Tim Williams crossed the 1,500 point milestone for his career. Prior to joining the Lobos, Tim Williams became the first sophomore ever to score 1,000 points in a career at Samford. He has scored a total of 278 points this season, bringing his career total to 1,835. He is 165 points away from reaching 2,000. As a Lobo, he is close to reaching 1,000 points. He currently has a total of 817.

BROWN CLOSING IN ON 1,000

Elijah Brown is coming up quick on 1,000 career points for the Lobos. He finished last season with 694 points and currently has 290 points, bringing his career total to 984. With him averaging 17.1 ppg, he is on pace to pass 1,000 points by the middle of January.

BIG WIN AT SAN DIEGO STATE

It was a different outcome this season for the Lobos in Viejas Arena. The Lobos had a come-from-behind effort on Jan. 1 to claim a 68-62 win over San Diego State. It was the program's first win in Vieja's since 2012 and Coach Neal's first win in Vieja's as head coach of the Lobos. The Lobos were down by 58-54 with 4:18 left to play but used a 14-4 run the rest of the way to pick up the win. In that final stretch, the Lobos converted eight free throws, four coming from Tim Williams. With the win, the Lobos are now 2-0 which is the fifth straight season that the Lobos have started conference play off with two victories.

LOBOS WIN THRILLER

It was a thriller on Dec. 7 inside WisePies Arena - The Pit, but the Lobos came out on top after Elijah Brown hit a jumper with 5.8 seconds left on the clock to defeat UTEP 78-77. The Lobos had a 21 point lead with 12 minutes left in the first half but UTEP was dangerous from 3-point range, working their way back in the second half to bring the game to 72-72. The two teams traded points and UTEP hit a three to go up 77-74 but the Lobos got a two from Jordan Hunter and a big rebound from Anthony Mathis to set up the shot for Brown and win their fifth straight inside The Pit.

FURSTINGER'S FIRST CAREER START

Junior Joe Furstinger made his first career start against Illinois State on Dec. 3. He finished with a career-high in points (9) and rebounds (11). His 11 rebounds were a game-high and led the squad. In his career-high 28 minutes, he finished 3-for-4 from the field and 3-for-5 from the foul line. He also led the team with two blocks. In previous games, he has been an energy booster off the bench for the Lobos.

#PIT50 GAME

With The Pit being built in 1966, this season marks the 50th anniversary of The Pit. The Lobos celebrated on Nov. 30 by taking on its first-ever opponent in The Pit, Abilene Christian on Wednesday. The Lobos pulled away in the second half to claim a 64-55 victory over the Wildcats, which was the same scoring margin as the first game played (62-53).

WILLIAMS NAMED NABC ALLSTATE GOOD WORKS NOMINEE

Tim Williams was named an NABC Allstate Good Works nominee last week on Wednesday. This distinguished award shines a spotlight on a select group of student-athletes who have shown dedication to community service and altruism in their communities. The nomination is due to Williams' standout performance as a student-athlete and representative of Lobo Basketball. The 6-foot-8 senior is involved in many activities around the Albuquerque community. He has spent time volunteering with Lobo summer camps, Heart Gallery Stocking Stuffing, visiting the UNM Children's Hospital and handing out candy to children at the Lobo Howl-o-Ween event in The Pit. Williams not only succeeds on the court but in the classroom as well. Last season, he was a big part in the Lobos breaking their fall semester grade point average. The team finished with a 3.30. Williams finished the year with a 3.44 GPA and has a cumulative GPA of 3.42.

LOBOS TO COMPETE IN EMERALD COAST CLASSIC

The Lobos will compete in the Emerald Coast Classic in 2017. The first two rounds will be held in WisePies Arena - The Pit while the third and championship rounds will be held in Niceville, Fla. during Thanksgiving. Along with the Lobos, Maryland, St. Bonaventure and TCU headlining the

WOODEN LEGACY RECAP

The Lobos went 1-2 at the 2016 Wooden Legacy Classic. The Lobos started off the tournament with a 20-point loss to Virginia Tech, their first loss of the season, falling 92-72. New Mexico rebounded to claim its fourth win of the season against CSUN, 105-89. The Lobos dropped their final game of the tournament, falling in the last minute of the game, 64-57.

The Lobos were in the top two among the tournament field in shooting percentage. They finished second with a 50.6 shooting percentage behind UCLA's 51.3 percent. The Lobos also finished second in 3-point shooting (42.9 percent).

BREAKING RECORDS

At the Wooden Legacy Classic, the Lobos broke a few records in their game with CSUN. The Lobos' 105 points against the Matadors is the most any team has ever scored in a Wooden Legacy Classic game. Also in that game, the Lobos shot 64.9 percent from the field, which goes down as the best shooting percentage in a game at the Wooden Legacy. The Lobos scored 54 points in the first half against the Matadors, which is a record for first half points scored in a game at the tournament and ties the most points in any half record at the Wooden. The total number of points between the two teams, 194, is the most scored in a Wooden Legacy game.

WILLIAMS EARNS ALL-TOURNAMENT HONORS

At the Wooden Legacy Classic, Tim Williams earned All-Tournament honors after his stellar performance throughout the tournament for the Lobos. He averaged 18.7 ppg which was fourth among all the participants at the tournament. He also picked up 7.3 rebounds a game which was third among the field. He leads the Lobos with 20.8 ppg and 8.0 rpg. He is shooting 62 percent from the field and 80.4 percent from the foul line.

AGET HAS CAREER GAME

Against CSUN, senior Obij Aget had his best scoring game of his career. He produced 16 points in 19 minutes. He was perfect from the field (6-for-6) and was 4-for-5 from the foul line. His previous career-high was 14 points.

WILLIAMS EARNS FIRST MW PLAYER OF THE WEEK HONOR

Tim Williams picked up his first career Mountain West Player of the Week honor on Monday, Nov. 21. He led the Lobos to a pair of victories with a career-high 31 points against Houston Baptist and a team-high 20 points against NMSU. Against HBU, he finished with 11 rebounds, which was his second straight double-double of the season.

TIM WILLIAMS' CAREER NIGHT

It was Tim Williams' night against Houston Baptist on Nov. 14, as he went off for a career-high 31 points, shooting 10-for-11 from the field and 11-for-12 from the foul line. He also finished with 11 rebounds for his second straight double-double. The double-double marks his eighth in his career. Of his 31 points, 14 came in the first half. He was perfect from the field (6-for-6) and from the foul line (2-for-2)

Mike Parks, a 6-9 forward, commits to New Mexico from Southwest Mississippi Community College in Summit, Miss. Last year, he played at Missouri State - West Plains and averaged 8.3 points per game and 4.3 rebounds per game in 16 games. He shot 64 percent from the field, which ranked in the top 10 of the NJCAA. So far this season for the Bears, he is averaging 9.0 points and shooting 75 percent through four games.

LOGWOOD HAS CAREER NIGHT

Fans saw a glimpse of what Sam Logwood was capable of doing for the Lobos in last year's final game against Nevada at the Mountain West tournament. That carried over into the season opener against Idaho State on Nov. 11, as he went off for a career-high 20 points, shooting 7-for-10 from the field, 1-for-2 from the three and perfect from the foul line (5-for-5). He also picked up four assists, three rebounds and a steal. Logwood put up 16 points in the second half.

OPENING STRONG

The Lobos started off strong for the 14th straight season, winning their opener 81-70 over Idaho State on Nov. 11. The Lobos are 56-11 (.835) in season openers. That record includes a 48-5 (.905) mark in season openers in Albuquerque.

New Mexico Game Notes

HEROES NIGHT

Coach Neal and the Lobos kicked off the 2016-17 season by honoring and celebrating the men and women who have served and continue to serve our country. The Lobos wore special game jerseys that were red with camo lettering. A jersey auction was held and the Lobos raised \$3,082 for the Wounded Warriors and UNM's ROTC program.

MLI SIGNING DAY

High school prospects Isaiah Poor-Bear Chandler of Omaha Central High School and Chris Sodom of Tennessee Prep pledged to join the Lobos as freshmen beginning the 2017-18 season on signing day last week. Poor-Bear Chandler, a 6-foot-9 forward, chose New Mexico over Wichita State, among others. Chandler, a four-star recruit by ESPN, averaged 13 points, 8.5 rebounds and more than three blocks per game as a junior at Central qualified for the Class A State tournament. During the summer time, Poor-Bear Chandler plays for the Omaha Elite AAU team. Sodom, a 7-foot-3 center originally from Nigeria, chose New Mexico over offers from TCU and Purdue. He lived in the Houston area before moving to Tennessee this school year. Sodom, a four-star recruit by ESPN, plays for the Houston Defenders' AAU squad.

WHAT WE HAVE RETURNING

After having the youngest team in the Mountain West and one of the youngest in the NCAA last year, the Lobos return 10 players, including two All-Mountain West players in Elijah Brown and Tim Williams. Those two are the only two returners in the Mountain West that averaged 16 or more points last season, and it is the first time in Lobo history that two All-MW First Teamers have returned. Along with Brown and Williams, the Lobos return two more starters in Sam Logwood and Obij Aget. Aget and Williams are the only two seniors on the squad. Despite the young team, Lobos finished fourth in the league standings.

LOBOS PICKED TO FINISH THIRD

The Mountain West Preseason Poll was announced at Media Day in Las Vegas, Nevada, on Oct. 12. The Lobos are picked to finish third, receiving three first-place votes. San Diego State is predicted to finish at the top, earning 23 first-place votes. Fresno State, who is picked to finish behind the Lobos, picked up the only other first-place vote. Nevada, who took down the Lobos in the quarterfinals last year of the Mountain West Tournament, is slated to finish second.

BROWN, WILLIAMS EARN PRESEASON MW HONORS

Along with the Lobos being picked to finish third, Elijah Brown was named Mountain West Preseason Player of the Year by the media. Brown was named to the All-Mountain West team along with teammate Tim Williams. This is the first year in Lobo history that the Lobos return two First Team All-Mountain West selections.

AIR FORCE & SAN JOSE STATE ONCE

The 18-game MW schedule means the Lobos will face every conference opponent twice with the exception of two programs. New Mexico will only play Air Force (in Colorado Springs) and San Jose State (in The Pit) once.

LOBOS ON TV

The 2016-17 schedule includes many national and regional broadcasts of New Mexico basketball. The Lobos had 24 of its 30 regular-season games picked up through the Mountain West's package. Of those games, 16 will be broadcasted by ROOT Sports or CBS Sports Network. In addition to those 16 games, there will be many that will be broadcasted by the ESPN family of networks, including the Wooden Legacy Classic. The road game with Arizona will be on the Pac-12 Network. Road games at Illinois State and New Mexico State will be televised on ESPN3, giving the Lobos all 30 games being nationally televised.

BROWN SELECTED ON 2017 JERRY WEST AWARD WATCH LIST

Redshirt junior guard Brown has been named as one of 20 finalists for the 2017 Jerry West Shooting Guard of the Year Award Preseason Watch List, as announced by the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame on Oct. 20. By mid-February, the watch list of 20 players for the award will be narrowed down to 10. In March, five finalists will be presented to West and the Hall of Fame's selection committee. The winner of the 2017 Jerry West Shooting Guard of the Year award will be presented at the ESPN College Basketball Awards Show in Los Angeles, Calif. on April 7. Broadcast information will be released at a later date.

BEST FANS IN THE MOUNTAIN WEST

With an average of 13,031 fans per game inside WisePies Arena last season, the Lobos finished 23rd in the nation and tops in the Mountain West Conference. Overall, the Lobos ranked second in the nation to BYU in average attendance for non-Power Five or Big East schools. Most importantly, the Lobos completed 50 straight years in the top-25 nationally in average attendance. Since WisePies Arena was renovated before the 2010-11 season, the Lobos have seen massive support from its fans. On average, WisePies Arena was 85 percent full last season. That was a mark the program did not hit from 2002-2010, but have exceeded it every year since the renovation.

ROAD WARRIOR

In three seasons, head coach Craig Neal won 24 games away from Albuquerque. Prior to Coach Neal coming to New Mexico along with former head coach Steve Alford, no other coach in program history won 20 or more road and neutral games in their first three seasons. Alford holds the record at 27 road and neutral wins.

LOBOS EARN NABC TEAM EXCELLENCE AWARD

Over the summer, the NABC recognizes outstanding academic achievement by a team with a cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 3.0 or better for the 2015-16 season. The Lobos finished the 2015-16 season with a program record 3.03 GPA for the academic year. The honor places the Lobos in an elite class academically. There are the first Mountain West team to ever receive this honor, now in its fourth year of existence. This year, the NABC recognized 119 collegiate teams across all divisions of the NCAA and NAIA. Of those teams, New Mexico was one of just 25 NCAA Division I Institutions to be honored.

FOUR LOBOS NAMED ON NABC HONORS COURT

Another NABC academic achievement came for the Lobos over the summer as they earned four on the NABC Honors Court. The Lobos had four academic seniors recognized for their GPA of 3.2 or higher. Only five teams in the league had student-athletes named to the Honors Court, with New Mexico holding twice as many honorees as any other MW team. The Lobos were also one of just 63 teams, across all NCAA and NAIA divisions in the country, to have four or more honorees.

LOBOS ON ACADEMIC ALL-MW LIST

The Lobos one again stood out from the pack in the Mountain West academically, with a league-leading five players selected as Academic All-Mountain West. Dane Kuiper, Anthony Mathis, Cullen Neal, Devon Williams and Tim Williams all earned the honor. Head coach Craig Neal has now led the MW in Academic All-Mountain West honorees in all three seasons as head coach. To be eligible for selection, student-athletes must have completed at least one academic term at the member institution while maintaining a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 or better.


THE GREATEST GAME EVER PLAYED

WisePies Arena - The Pit was the site of one of the greatest college basketball games ever played. It hosted the 1983 national championship game that saw the NC State Wolfpack upset Hakeem Olajuwon, Clyde Drexler and the Houston Cougars. Coach Jimmy Valvano and the Wolfpack downed the Cougars on a last second put back by Lorenzo Charles. The iconic shot of the late Valvano running onto the court looking for a hug is one of the lasting images in college basketball history.

- Capacity of 15,411 (previously 18,018)
- \$60 million renovation was completed in 2010
- New floor installed before the 2013-14 season
- Seating includes 40 suites and a club area
- Officially named WisePies Arena on Dec. 1, 2014 after \$5 million gift for naming rights by local New Mexico business. It is still referred to as The Pit, its officially-recognized nickname.
- Less than 30 of 345 NCAA Division I basketball programs play in a college-only arena named after a business or organization founded or headquartered in its home state.
- The Lobos have averaged an astounding 15,410 fans in 49 out of 50 years, an amazing 95% of capacity
- Has ranked in the top 25 in attendance nationally every season since the 1966-67 season with 35 seasons in the top ten in the NCAA in attendance
