UTAH STATE BACK IN ACTION, HOSTING NEW MEXICO ON WEDNESDAY

• Utah State returns to the Dee Glen Smith Spectrum and hosts New Mexico on Wednesday, Jan. 4, at 9 p.m.

• The game can be heard live on KVNU with Al Lewis providing play-by-play and Rod Tueller providing color. Fans can also watch the game on ESPNU (Comcast Ch. 400/753HD, Dish Network Ch. 141, DirecTV Ch. 208), with Steve Quis providing play-by-play and Adrian Branch providing color.

• Utah State is 21-8 all-time against New Mexico, including a 5-2 mark against the Lobos in Logan. UNM has won four of the last six meetings.

THINGS OF NOTE

• Senior wing **Jalen Moore** has scored in double figures in 26 consecutive games and needs five more games in double figures to tie the ninth-longest streak of double-digit outings in school history.

• **Moore** has scored 20 or more points in each of the last two games and needs 21 more points to tie **Preston Medlin** (2010, 12-14) for No. 16 on the all-time scoring list with 1,368 career points.

• Freshman guard **Koby McEwen** leads all freshmen in the Mountain West with 13.8 points and 30.9 minutes per game. McEwen is also tops among MW freshmen with a 1.5 assist/turnover ratio.

• Senior guard **Shane Rector** has recorded at least one steal in each of the last seven games.

• Utah State last started league play 0-2 during the 2009-10 season. The Aggies bounced back and won 14 straight, finishing first in the Western Athletic Conference and advanced to the NCAA Tournament that year.



Senior wing Jalen Moore has scored 20 or more points in each of the last two games. Moore needs 21 more points to move to No. 16 on the all-time scoring list at Utah State.

LOOKING AT UTAH STATE

Utah State men's basketball has started Mountain West play 0-2 after opening its conference slate with an 83-80 loss to Boise State and a 78-73 defeat at Air Force. Overall, USU is 6-7 on the year.

The Aggies are averaging 73.3 points per game and are shooting 46.4 percent (338-of-729) from the floor, 34.6 percent (93-of-269) from behind the 3-point line and 71.3 percent (184-of-258) at the free throw line. Senior wing **Jalen Moore** leads USU in scoring, averaging 17.5 points per game, and has logged double figures in every game this season. He is followed by a pair of double-digit scorers in freshman guard

Koby McEwen and senior guard **Shane Rector**, averaging 13.8 and 11.7 points per game, respectively. McEwen and Redshirt sophomore forward **Alexis Dargenton** lead the team on the glass, averaging a matching 4.8 rebounds per game.

Defensively, opponents are averaging 71.1 points per game against the Aggies, and shooting 41.1 percent (320-of-778) from the floor, 32.1 percent (98-of-305) from behind the 3-point line and 70.2 percent (186-of-265) at the free throw line. **Rector** leads the Aggies with 23 steals and **Dargenton** leads the team with 12 blocks.

Head coach **Tim Duryea** is in his second year at the helm, having served as an assistant the previous 14 seasons, and has compiled an overall mark of 22-22 during his tenure.

LAST TIME OUT

COLORADO SPRINGS, Colo. - Utah State came back from a 15-point deficit to begin the game, but lost 78-73 at the final whistle on Saturday afternoon at Air Force.

USU trailed throughout the game, taking its only lead, 34-31, with just under five minutes to play in the first half. However, AFA countered with a 9-0 run to end the half, taking a 40-34 lead into the break. The run continued in the second half as the Falcons scored the first five points to build a 45-34 lead. USU tied the game at 68-68 with 3:25 to play, but Air Force closed out the game on a 10-5 run to seal the victory.

Freshman guard Koby McEwen scored a career-high 22 points and was followed by senior wing Jalen Moore with 21 points. The duo each hit five 3-point shots, marking new career highs for both. Junior forward Ngor Barnaba led the Aggies on the glass with a career-high nine rebounds and freshman guard Sam Merrill led the team with a career-high seven assists.

Utah State shot 46.3 percent (25-of-54) for the game, including 39.4 percent from behind the 3-point line with a season-high 13 3-pointers, while shooting 90.9 percent (10-of-11) from the free throw line. Air Force finished the game shooting 49.2 percent (30-of-61) from the floor, 47.6 percent (10-of-21) from behind the 3-point line and 66.7 percent (8-of-12) at the free throw line.

SCOUTING NEW MEXICO

New Mexico is 9-5 on the year, including a 2-0 mark in the Mountain West, and has won three of its last four games.

The Lobos are scoring 74.6 points per game and shooting 46.3 percent (343-of-741) from the floor, 30.8 percent (57-of-185) from behind the 3-point line and 76.0 percent (301-of-396) at the free throw line. Individually, senior forward Tim Williams leads UNM in both scoring and rebounding, averaging 17.6 points and 7.0 rebounds per game. Junior guard Elijah Brown is just behind, averaging 16.7 points per game.

Defensively, teams are scoring 71.6 points per game against New Mexico and shooting 44.1 percent (346-of-785) from the floor, 38.2 percent (124-of-325) from behind the 3-point line and 70.6 percent (187-of-265) at the free throw line. Senior center Obij Aget leads the Lobos with 13 blocks and Brown leads the team with 19 steals.

Head coach Craig Neal is in his four year and has compiled an overall mark of 68-43, including a 4-2 record against Utah State, during his tenure.

SERIES HISTORY AGAINST NEW MEXICO

Utah State leads the all-time series against New Mexico, 21-8, but has lost four of the last six games. The Aggies are 5-2 against the Lobos in Logan, including an 80-72 victory in the Dee Glen Smith Spectrum last season.

LAST TIME AGAINST NEW MEXICO

LOGAN, Utah - Senior guard Chris Smith scored 19 points with four assists and redshirt junior forward Lew Evans added 15 points and six rebounds as Utah State snapped a five-game losing streak with an 80-72 victory against New Mexico in front of 9,290 fans On Feb. 9, 2016, at the Dee Glen Smith Spectrum.

Junior wing Jalen Moore added 11 points, six rebounds, three assists, two blocks and one steal for the Aggies (12-11, 4-8 Mountain West), who handed the Lobos (14-10, 7-4) their second straight loss.

Redshirt sophomore guard Elijah Brown and redshirt junior forward Tim Williams finished with 22 and 21 points, respectively, for New Mexico.

As a team, Utah State shot 49.0 percent (25-of-51) from the floor, including 36.0 percent (9-of-25) from beyond the arc, and 75.0 percent (21-of-28) from the free throw line. The Aggies were 19-of-24 from the charity stripe in the second half alone.

New Mexico shot 45.8 percent (27-of-59) from the field on the night, including 36.8 percent (7-of-19) from 3-point range, and only 68.8 percent (11-of-16) from the free throw line.

DID YOU KNOW?

- New Mexico has won four of the last six games in the series, including two of the last three in Logan.
- The victories in the Dee Glen Smith Spectrum were the first for New Mexico in the series, a series that dates back to the 1951-52 season.
- The Aggies and Lobos faced each other for 11 straight years from 1951-62. The teams met a single time in Albuquerque during the 1979-80 season, before squaring off each of the last three seasons as members of the Mountain West.
- Utah State has lost the battle of the boards in all but one contest over the last six.
- Utah State has had fewer turnovers than New Mexico in all but one game over the last six.
- In Utah State's two victories over the last six, USU has led at the half in each game.
- In Utah State's two victories over the last six, USU has outshot the Lobos 48.1 percent (50-of-104) to UNM's 44.6 percent (50-of-112).
- In Utah State's two victories over the last six, USU bigs have outscored Lobo bigs 63 to 56.
- Utah State has been the aggressor over the last six games, committing more fouls than New Mexico in all but one game.
- The fouls have led to New Mexico recording more attempts than the Aggies at the free throw line in all but one game over the last six.
- Senior wing **Jalen Moore** has scored in double figures in each of the last four games against New Mexico, including a team-high 19 in Utah State's 63-60 victory in Albuquerque in 2015.

0 SENIOR GUARD SHANE RECTOR - Has started at point in each of Utah State's games this season and leads the team with 3.1 assists per game (6th in the MW) and 1.8 steals per game (2nd in the MW)... Third on the team with 11.7 points per game... Hit a pair of free throws with 1.6 seconds left in overtime to seal an 80-79 victory at Utah Valley (12/10)... Recorded a career-high-tying seven assists against NJIT and Idaho State... Tied his career high with two blocks against Weber State (12/21)... Has recorded at least one steal in each of the last seven games... Appeared in each game for the Aggies in 2015-16, recording his first career start at Missouri State (12/1/15) and starting in 12 overall, including each of the final two... Was the player handling the ball in last-second situations, looking to drive and draw a foul or to drive and kick... Third on the team in scoring, averaging 9.3 points per game... Led the team with 101 assists and 38 steals on the year... Finished ninth in the Mountain West in assists per game (3.3)... Recorded five or more assists in six games during the 2015-16 season... Hit a pair of free throws with 15 seconds left against Weber State (11/13/15) to seal the victory for the Aggies... Hit a pair of free throws with 3 seconds left at Missouri State (12/1/15) to give USU the 69-68 victory... AGGIES PICKED SIXTH IN MOUNTAIN WEST

Utah State men's basketball was selected sixth in the annual preseason Mountain West men's basketball poll.

THE LAST TIME USU STARTED 0-2 IN LEAGUE PLAY

Utah State last started league play 0-2 during the 2009-10 season. The Aggies bounced back and won 14 straight, finishing first in the Western Athletic Conference and advanced to the NCAA Tournament.

ALL-TIME RESULTS

Utah State has an overall record of 1,558-1,081 (.591) in its 2,639 games played.

ALL-MOUNTAIN WEST

Utah State had two players named to various preseason Mountain West awards, including freshman guard **Koby McEwen** as the Preseason Co-Freshman of the Year and senior wing **Jalen Moore** to the Preseason all-Mountain West team.

FIRST-YEAR TOURNAMENT WINS

Head coach **Tim Duryea** is the first Utah State head coach ever to win his first conference postseason game. In fact, Duryea is the first Aggie head coach to win his first-ever postseason game since **LaDell Andersen** led the Aggies to a 78-73 NCAA Tournament win against Arizona State in 1962.

BACK-TO-BACK STARTS

Utah State has started each of its season under head coach **Tim Duryea** with a perfect 3-0 record. Duryea is just the second coach in school history to begin each of his first two seasons as head coach with a perfect 3-0 record.

HISTORICALLY STRONG STARTS

Utah State has had strong first halves under head coach Tim Duryea, outscoring opponents 1,594 to 1,458 and averaging 36.2 points to 33.1 points over the course of the opening 20 minutes. USU has led at the half in seven of its 13 games this season.

WE'RE GOING TO OVERTIME

Utah State is 56-45 all-time in overtime contests. The Aggies picked up an 80-79 overtime victory at Utah Valley on Dec. 10, marking the first overtime contest for the Aggies since the 2014-15 season.

FIRST-YEAR RESULTS

Tim Duryea tied for third in Utah State history with 16 victories in his first year at the helm of the program. Duryea matched **Dutch Belnap's** win total of 16 and finished behind **Ladell Anderson** (22) and **Rod Tueller** (19).

THIEVERY

Senior guard **Shane Rector** has recorded at least one steal in each of the last seven games.

LONG RANGE BOMBERS

Utah State has hit at least one 3-point basket in 341 consecutive games, stretching back to Dec. 16, 2006.

WINNING WITH THE TIP

Utah State is 5-1 this season when winning the opening tip.

WINNING WITH THE LONG BALL

Utah State is 6-2 this season and 18-7 under head coach **Tim Duryea** when out shooting opponents from behind the 3-point line.

WINNING OFFENSIVELY

Utah State is 6-3 this season and 20-5 under head coach **Tim Duryea** when scoring 70 or more points in a game.

WINNING DEFENSIVELY

Utah State is 4-1 this season and 14-1 under head coach **Tim Duryea** when holding opponents to less than 69 points.

WINNING AT THE HALF

Utah State is 5-2 this season and 21-6 under head coach **Tim Duryea** when leading at the half.

WINNING ON THE GLASS

Utah State is 4-4 this season and 17-7 under head coach **Tim Duryea** when outrebounding the opposition.

CONSECUTIVE WINNING SEASONS

Utah State has recorded a winning record each of the past 23 seasons, dating back to the 1992-93 campaign.

SEASONED FRESHMAN

Freshman guard **Koby McEwen** leads all freshmen in the Mountain West with 13.8 points and 30.9 minutes per game.

HOMEGROWN

Utah State's 2016-17 roster includes four players from the state of Utah, including freshman guard **Sam Merrill** (Bountiful/Bountiful HS), senior wing **Jalen Moore** (North Logan/Sky View HS), freshman guard **Abel Porter** (Farmington/Davis HS) and freshman forward **Trevin Dorius** (Heber City/Wasatch HS).

MOORE BUCKETS

Senior wing **Jalen Moore** needs 21 more points to move to No. 16, tying Preston Medlin (1999, 03-05) with 1,368 career points. Furthermore, Moore is on track to etch his name on the Utah State record book in rebounding, assists, 3-point field goals, games played, games started and minutes.

THREE YEAR LEADER

Senior wing **Jalen Moore** has led the Aggies in scoring and rebounding in each of the past two seasons, averaging 15.2 points and 6.0 rebounds as a junior, and 15.2 points and 6.7 rebounds as a sophomore, and could become just the third player in Utah State history to lead the team in scoring and rebounding for three years, joining **Greg Grant** (1982-84, 1985-86) and **Marvin Roberts** (1968-71).

ONE OF THE NATION'S BEST

Senior wing **Jalen Moore** has been named to the Julius Erving Small Forward of the Year Award watch list, as announced by the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame. Moore is one of only 20 small forwards in the nation on the watch list that was determined by a national committee comprised of top college basketball personnel.

CANCUN CHALLENGE ALL-TOURNAMENT TEAM

Senior wing **Jalen Moore** was named to the Cancun Challenge all-Tournament team after leading the Aggies with 18.5 points and 5.5 rebounds per game against Purdue and Texas Tech. Over the two-game stretch, Moore shot 57.7 percent (15-of-26) from the floor and 50.0 percent (5-of-10) from behind the 3-point line.

NO PLACE LIKE HOME

Utah State is calling the Dee Glen Smith Spectrum home for the 47th season, amassing a 556-134 (.811) record on its home court.

BATTLE OF THE BOARDS

Utah State has outrebounded its opponents in six of the last seven games.

MOUNTAIN WEST LEADERS

Senior guard **Shane Rector** is among the top-five of the Mountain West in steals (2nd, 1.8 spg). Senior wing **Jalen Moore** is among the top-five of the league in field goal percentage and scoring, ranking fourth in each statistic, shooting 51.7 percent (78-of-151) and averaging 17.5 points per game. Moore also ranks fifth in minutes per game, averaging 33.6 per contest. Freshman guard Koby McEwen is among the top five in assist/turnover ratio, grading to 1.5 to rank fifth.

BEST AT THE LINE IN THE MOUNTAIN WEST

Utah State is tops in the Mountain West at the free throw line in conference play, converting 94.7 percent of its free throws (36-of-38).

WHITE SHIRTS, BLACK NAME TAGS

Utah State has four players on its roster that served LDS Church Missions, including freshman guard **Sam Merrill** (Managua, Nicaragua), sophomore forward **Quinn Taylor** (Sao Paulo, Brazil), senior wing **Connor Garner** (Hermosillo, Mexico) and **Abel Porter** (Samara, Russia).

MELTING POT

Utah State has five internationals on its roster, the most at one time in the history of Aggie basketball. The group includes **Diogo Brito** (Portugal), **Norbert Janicek** (Slovakia), **Koby McEwen** (Canada), **Alexis Dargent** (Martinique) and **Ngor Barnaba**, who was born in Sudan, but grew up in Minnesota.

TEAM OF THE MILLENNIUM

Utah State has one of the top winning percentages since the turn of the Millennium in 2000, ranking No. 10 with a mark of .718 (403-158) going into the 2016-17 season.

Second Year (16th Overall) (22-22)

Head coach Tim Duryea (pronounced Dur-yea) will begin his second season at the helm of Utah State men's basketball in 2016-17 after compiling the third-best start in USU history, when he led the Aggies to 16 wins in his first season in 2015-16. Prior to being promoted to the head job, Duryea was an assistant coach for the Aggies for 14 seasons. Duryea had been the longest tenured assistant coach in program history before taking over in April of 2015 and becoming the 18th head coach for USU men's basketball.

During his inaugural season, Duryea mentored junior wing Jalen Moore and senior guard Chris Smith to third-team all-Mountain West honors and became the first coach in USU history to win a conference tournament game in their first season. In addition, Utah State led the Mountain West in 3-point field goal percentage, shooting a league-best 37.0 percent (257-of-695).

In his 15 seasons at Utah State, Duryea has been part of an Aggie program that has averaged 23.1 wins per season, advanced to the NCAA Tournament six times (2003, 2005, 2006, 2009, 2010, 2011), and won five conference championships in the Big West (2003) and Western Athletic Conferences (2008, 2009, 2010, 2011), while winning four conference tournament titles in the Big West (2003, 2005) and WAC (2009, 2011).

In seven seasons leading up to his appointment as head coach, Duryea was in charge of an Aggie offense that traditionally was one of the best in the nation. The trend continued as head coach, with Utah State leading the Mountain West in 3-point field goal percentage (.370) and finishing third in the league in overall field goal percentage (.451). In 2014-15, Utah State led the Mountain West and ranked No. 14 nationally in 3-point shooting (.394), while also ranking second in the conference and No. 17 in the nation in assist-to-turnover ratio (1.38), and second in the conference and No. 19 nationally in fewest turnovers per game (10.4). Individually, USU had the best field goal shooter in the Mountain West in redshirt freshman forward David Collette, who was No. 14 in the nation at 59.1 percent (163-of-276).

In 2013-14, Utah State ranked second in the nation in 3-point field goal percentage (.406), as well as No. 12 in assists per game (15.9) and No. 19 in assist-to-ratio (1.44). During the 2011-12 and 2012-13 seasons, USU ranked No. 24 nationally in field goal percentage at 47.5 and 46.9 percent, respectively, while ranking No. 28 nationally in field goal percentage (.470) during the 2010-11 campaign.

During the 2009-10 season, Utah State ranked third nationally in 3-point field goal percentage (.414), ninth in overall shooting (.488) and No. 10 in free throw shooting (.758), and was the only team in the nation to rank among the top-10 in all three shooting categories. During the 2008-09 season, USU finished the year as the nation's best shooting team (.496) and ranked No. 17 in 3-point field goal percentage (.394).

Duryea spent his first seven seasons at Utah State in charge of an Aggie defense that traditionally ranked among the top in the nation in points allowed, including No. 4 in 2002 (58.1), No. 8 in 2005 (57.8) and No. 9 in 2003 (60.0).

During his time as an assistant at Utah State, the Aggies recorded a dozen 20-win seasons, including setting the school record for wins with a 30-5 mark during the 2008-09 season and a 30-4 mark during the 2010-11 campaign. USU also had 18 players earn a total of 30 all-conference honors during the past 14 years, including three WAC Players of the Year in Jaycee Carroll (2008), Gary Wilkinson (2009) and Tai Wesley (2011). Furthermore, USU had three players earn All-American citations a total of four times with Duryea on staff in Carroll (2007, 2008), Wilkinson (2009) and Wesley (2011).

Along with his on-the-court responsibilities, Duryea also oversaw academic progress as an assistant at Utah State, which resulted in 22 Aggies earning academic all-conference honors a total of 40 times over the last 14 years, while nearly 90 percent of USU's players during that time graduated.

Prior to joining the Aggies, Duryea was the head coach at Hutchinson (Kan.) Community College from 2000-01. During his two years at the helm, his teams produced a 40-25 record and back-to-back trips to the Region Six Championships.

A 1988 graduate of North Texas, Duryea began his coaching career in 1988 at Colorado State before moving on to North Texas in 1993. Duryea then went to Hutchinson (Kan.) Community College as an assistant coach for two seasons before becoming the head coach there prior to the 1999-2000 season.

Duryea played basketball at Denton (Texas) High School and Texas Pan-American before transferring to North Texas. At UNT, Duryea was a co-captain in 1988 for one of only three teams in school history to advance to the NCAA Tournament.

Duryea and his wife Angie have 21-year-old twins, Tanner (son) and Taylor (daughter), and a 14-year-old daughter (Kaylee). Tanner is a junior at Utah State, while Taylor is a sophomore volleyball player at Dixie State (Utah).

Moore has now scored 1,347 points in his career and moved to No. 17 all-time in career scoring, passing Mike Santos (1975-78) with 1,287 career points. Next on the list is Preston Medlin (2010, 12-14) with 1,368 career points. Moore passed his father on the list following the Idaho State game (11/19) and assistant coach Spencer Nelson following the game against New Orleans (12/19).

NICE FRO

Just in case you were wondering, Moore's hair has been in the making since his junior year in high school, but does get an occasional trim.

THREE-YEAR LEADER

Moore has led the Aggies in scoring and rebounding in each of the past two seasons, averaging 15.2 points and 6.0 rebounds as a junior, and 15.2 points and 6.7 rebounds as a sophomore, and could become just the third player in Utah State history to lead the team in scoring and rebounding for three years, joining Greg Grant (1982-84, 1985-86) and Marvin Roberts (1968-71).

ALL IN THE FAMILY

Father, Jimmy Moore, played basketball at USU from 1972-75, and still ranks 26th all-time in school history with 1,164 career points and 15th all-time in rebounds with 652. Jimmy Moore is currently the assistant athletics director for special projects for Utah State Athletics. Brother, Grayson, was a member of the squad last season.

DOUBLE-DIGIT SCORING STREAK

Moore has scored in double figures in each of the last 26 games and 38 of the last 39, dating back to the 2015-16 season. The streak is the longest since the 2007-08 seasons when Jaycee Carroll scored in double figures in 39 consecutive games. Moore needs five more games in double figures to tie for 10th all-time for consecutive games in double figures.
