ABOUT THE MATCH-UP

- The Lobos and Wolf Pack will face off for the seventh time in program history Saturday and the fourth time in Reno.
- The Lobos are 5-1 all-time against Nevada, with the all-time series starting in 2013.
- After going 4-0 against Nevada, the Lobos lost in Reno last season against the Wolf Pack on Feb. 14, 2015 in a 66-63 overtime loss on the road. The Lobos held a 14-point lead over Nevada with 8:17 to play, but allowed the Wolf Pack to force a tie in regulation and then pull out a 66-63 win in overtime. The Lobos had three players in double figures with Hugh Greenwood leading the way with 15 points. He went 3-of-10 from 3-point range.
- Earlier this season, the Lobos began Mountain West Conference play with a win over Nevada, 88-76. Elijah Brown and Tim Williams combined for 44 points.
- The victory snapped a four game losing streak for the Lobos and began a new three game winning streak. Beginning with the win over Nevada, the Lobos won seven of nine matches in league play.
- Nevada head coach Eric Musselman is in his first year as a collegiate head coach. He has served numerous stints as a professional coach, including coaching Craig Neal on the CBA's Rapid Thrillers from 1989-90.

NEW MEXICO GAME NOTES

LAST TIME OUT

University of New Mexico men's basketball team (16-14, 9-8 MW) fell to the San Diego State Aztecs (22-8, 15-2 MW), 83-56, Tuesday at home before honoring three seniors in their last game at WisePies Arena. Tim Jacobs, Connor Joy and Michael Nesbitt were each honored after the game, alongside their families and teammates. Head coach Craig Neal had a chance to honor each senior individually before they were all given a chance to thank the Lobo fans in attendance. In the game, Elijah Brown led the Lobos with 18 points, 12 of which came at the free throw line. Tim Williams scored 11 points, pulled down four rebounds and had two blocks. Cullen Neal scored 10 points, wrapping up Lobos in double figures. Overall, the Lobos shot 35.9 percent from the floor on 14-for-39 shooting. The Lobos had an efficient night at the line, finishing 24-for-28. San Diego State was also efficient from the free throw line, finishing 20-for-24.

LAST TIME AGAINST NEVADA

The University of New Mexico men's basketball team kicked off Mountain West Conference play with a victory, defeating the Nevada Wolf Pack, 88-76, on Dec. 30. Elijah Brown scored a team-best 24 points, 15 of which came at the foul line. Brown also had five rebounds, four assists and three steals, a new career-high. Obij Agat earned a double-double with 14 points, 11 rebounds, three blocks and three steals. His point total ties a career high. Cullen Neal was the team leader in assists with six. He also finished with 11 points and two rebounds. The Lobos finished the game shooting 46.7 percent (28-for-60) from the floor and 80.6 percent (29-for-36) from the foul line. New Mexico's strong 3-point defense returned and held Nevada to 26.7 percent (4-for-15) shooting from outside. The Wolf Pack shot 43.9 percent (25-for-57) for the game. The Lobos won the rebounding battle, 37-30, with 14 offensive rebounds, the most since bringing down 23 against USC.

TOURNAMENT IMPLICATIONS

A win for the Lobos on Saturday over Nevada secures the fourth seed and a spot in the 4/5 game in the Mountain West Tournament and a bye in the first round. UNLV will end the season at San Diego State on their senior night Saturday at 7 p.m. PST. They need a win and a Lobo loss to tie. They would win the head-to-head tiebreaker due to a win over SDSU. If the Lobos end up as the fourth or fifth seed, they will play Nevada in back-to-back games. If the Lobos fall into the 6/11 game, they will face San Jose State, locked into last place in the league due to their 81-78 loss at Wyoming.

The 4/5 seed quarterfinal game will be played on Thursday, March 10, at 2:30 p.m. The 6/11 seed first round game will be played on Wednesday, March 9, at 4 p.m.

CAREER NIGHTS AGAINST NEVADA

The Lobos earned their first Mountain West Conference victory against Nevada in large part due to career nights from Obij Agat and Xavier Adams. Agat earned a double-double and tied his career high of 14 points, the third time he's reached that mark in his career. He also tied a season-best of 11 rebounds, one short of his all-time best. He secured three steals, the most of any Lobo this year. Adams scored a career-high 14 points, double his season best going into the night. It was the second double-digit scoring effort of the sophomore's career.

BROWN AT THE LINE

Against Nevada, Elijah Brown scored 15 of his team-best 24 points at the free throw line, where he held a perfect percentage. He became just the fourth player in program history to make 15 free throws without a miss. He was one short of the program record, set by Kendall Williams, who shot 16-for-16 at the free throw line against San Diego at home on Nov. 30, 2013. The other two Lobos to go 15-for-15 at the line were Ruben Douglas against UNLV on Feb. 5, 2002 and Phil Smith against Wyoming on Feb. 12, 1981.

Elijah Brown has drained 201 free throws this season and is also climbing up that single season list. With 12 free throws made against San Diego State, he is third all-time in free throws made, passing Kelvin Scarborough in 1986-87. He is 18 free throws away from matching Cameron Bairstow's 2013-14 total of 219 made. The all-time record is set at 253 by Ruben Douglas in 2002-03.

NEW MEXICO GAME NOTES

OPENING AND CLOSING

For the first time since the inception of the Mountain West Conference, New Mexico will conclude the regular season and conference play against the same team they opened league play against.

BACK TO BACK?

If the Lobos are matched against Nevada in the quarterfinals of the Mountain West Conference Tournament, it would be the first time since 2010-11 in which the Lobos played the same opponent in back-to-back games. That season, the Lobos ended the regular season at home against Air Force with a 66-61 win. In their first postseason game, they defeated Air Force, 67-61. It also happened in 2008-09, in which the Lobos defeated Wyoming, 74-73, to finish the regular season but got clipped in the tournament, 75-67. The Lobos have not lost back-to-back games against the same opponent since falling to UNLV consecutively in 2001-02, 91-82 and 120-117 (2OT).

CHAMPIONSHIP EXPERIENCE

When 11 Mountain West Conference head coaches enter the league tournament next week, eight will head into the tournament having never won it before. Only New Mexico's Craig Neal, San Diego State Steve Fisher and Wyoming's Larry Shyatt have won a Mountain West Conference Tournament title. Neal earned his first tournament title in his first season as head coach. It was the seventh trophy in seven years for the Lobos, all with Neal serving on the staff.

SENIOR DAY

The New Mexico men's basketball team celebrated the careers and accomplishments of three seniors following the game on Tuesday during Senior Day festivities. A native of Evansville, Indiana and a La Lumiere School alum, Nesbitt joined the Lobos after three seasons with Missouri S&T. In his final year of eligibility, Mike Nesbitt walked on the New Mexico basketball team and has been a valuable veteran on and off the court. Nesbitt scored his first basket as a Lobo against Air Force here in WisePies Arena. He will continue to pursue his Master's degree in Business Administration following this season. A 2011 graduate of Rehoboth Christian School, Connor Joy started his time with the New Mexico men's basketball program as a team manager. After assisting the program tirelessly for years, head coach Craig Neal gave Connor the opportunity to don the Cherry and Silver as a member of the team this season. In his first appearance as a Lobo against Loyola-Chicago, he knocked down his first collegiate 3-pointer. Joy will go on to graduate with a degree in English. An Onate High School graduate and resident of Las Cruces, New Mexico, Jacobs finishes his two year Lobo career after transferring to New Mexico from Coe College. Jacobs has been a valuable point guard over the last two seasons, accumulating 126 points and 119 assists at New Mexico. He is also an Academic All-Mountain West honoree as a liberal arts major.

BROWN'S 41 POINT GAME

Brown's 41 point game against Fresno State Saturday was a rare feat for the program. It is the most points scored by a Lobo since Kendall Williams' 46 point game at Colorado State in 2013. Inside of WisePies Arena, it's the most points scored by a Lobo since Ruben Douglas scored 43 against Wyoming on Feb. 15, 2003. It is tied for the ninth most points ever scored by a Lobo inside WisePies Arena. Brown becomes only the ninth individual to ever score 41 points or more in a game at New Mexico.

STATISTICAL RANKINGS

ESPN has New Mexico ranked 109th in the country in their BPI ranks, fourth among Mountain West Conference teams. The Lobos are 144th in RPI. The Lobos are ranked 140th by KenPom.

NEW MEXICO GAME NOTES

BROWN CLIMBING UP THE SCORING LIST

At 651, Brown passed Johnny Brown's 649 points in 1985-86. Brown's season currently ranks seventh all-time in New Mexico history. He is nine points shy of Kelvin Scarborough in 1986-87 (660). The record holder is Kenny Page in 1979-80 at 784 points. In the coming games, Brown will be looking to become the fourth Lobo to ever score 700 points in a season, a feat reached by Page, Ruben Douglas (2002-03) and Hunter Greene (1986-87).

TIM WILLIAMS PASSING 1,500

With a game-high 17 points against Colorado State on Tuesday, Tim Williams crossed the 1,500 point milestone for his career. Prior to joining the Lobos, Tim Williams became the first sophomore ever to score 1,000 points in a career at Samford. Now in his third collegiate season, he sits at 1,534 points and can set realistic sights at blowing past the 2,000 point mark before his career is over.

During Mountain West play, Williams is the team's second leading scorer at 18 points per game. He is shooting 63.7 percent against league opponents, with a line of 114-for-179. He's the team's leading rebounder at 7.6 boards per game, an even two per game on the offensive end.

YOUNG LOBOS

The New Mexico men's basketball team has started the same starting lineup in all but three games this season: Cullen Neal, Elijah Brown, Obij Aget, Sam Logwood and Tim Williams. It is the youngest starting lineup by class grade since Neal's first season on the coaching staff at New Mexico in 2008-07, when the team started two freshmen and a sophomore. This is one of only two years during the Neal/Alford era in which the Lobos have not started a senior. When compared to the rest of the league the Lobos have the fourth youngest starters in the Mountain West Conference.

When looking at the entire roster, the Lobos have the youngest team in the entire Mountain West Conference. KenPom.com rates their experience level at 1.24 (0 points for freshmen, 1 for sophomores...), which ranks 309th in the nation. Only 42 teams in the nation are younger than the Lobos.

THE COMEBACK

With six minutes remaining on Feb. 17 at home, the Lobos trailed Boise State, 61-76. The Lobos would finish the game outscoring their opponents 19-2 to win the game by two points. The comeback was the largest in Lobo history in the final six minutes of a game. It was the first 15 point comeback since the team's 61-60 win over Texas Tech on Dec. 29, 2010. Defensively, the Lobos sparked the comeback by forcing five straight missed shots. A Tim Williams free throw and a Sam Logwood layup started the comeback, and a four-point play from Brown cut the deficit to single digits and erupted the home crowd. A Williams dunk and a pair of 3-pointers from Elijah Brown cut the Bronco lead to 78-77 with 1:08 left. The Lobos forced a turnover on the opposite end, and with 30 seconds left, Brown drew a foul and hit both to grab the lead. On the opposite end, Williams earned his fourth and biggest block on a driving layup and was fouled while corralling in the rebound. He hit one of two free throws, but the Lobos forced a tough 3-pointer on the final possession to seal the game.

ACADEMIC ALL-DISTRICT HONOREES

University of New Mexico men's basketball student-athletes Cullen Neal and Tim Williams have received CoSIDA Academic All-District 7 honors. The Academic All-District program recognizes the nation's top student-athletes for their combined performances athletically and in the classroom. Neal earned the honor with a 3.8 cumulative grade point average in his communications program. Williams holds a 3.38 cumulative GPA as an economics major. The MW earned three academic honors, with the Lobos taking two of them. Only five teams in all of NCAA Division I had multiple honorees. Prior to this season, the only Lobos to ever receive CoSIDA Academic All-District honors were Troy Devries and Roman Martinez.
