SERIES HISTORY

The Lobos 49-26 all-time against New Mexico State, including beating the Aggies 86-75 at home Nov. 18 of this year. UNM is 22-14 all-time in Las Cruces, and since 1996, the Lobos are 37-5 against the Aggies. UNM lost last season's matchup in Las Cruces, 77-70 (UNM won at home, 84-55, last season)

HEADING INTO THE MATCHUP

UNM improved its record to 8-0 on Thursday night in its first road game of the season at UTEP thanks to a strong defensive effort in a 59-35 victory over the Miners. The 35 points allowed is the fewest by a UNM team since holding Air Force to 33 points in the 2015-16 season. The Lobos also forced a season-high 25 turnovers against UTEP while holding the Miners to 25 percent shooting from the field, also a season best.

UNM, which didn't allow more than nine points in a quarter over the final three quarters, were led by Tesha Buck's 19 points as the senior - last week's Mountain West Player of the Week - went 5-for-12 from 3-point range. The Lobos as a team, a game off hitting a program-record 18 3-pointers in a win over Illinois, went 12-for-36 on 3-pointers in the game. Cherise Beynon, despite foul trouble, also finished in double figures with 11 points, going 4-for-4 from the field and 3-for-3 on 3-pointers.

The Aggies have had a week to prepare for Saturday's matchup as NMSU last played Saturday when it lost to Arkansas 69-60 at the UTEP Thanksgiving Classic in El Paso. NMSU also lost the opener of the event, losing to Texas Southern 66-50.

NEW MEXICO GAME NOTES**SCOUTING NMSU**

The Aggies under first-year coach Brooke Atkinson were selected unanimously as the WAC preseason favorites - the third year in a row they were picked to win the conference.

NMSU returns two starters and four letter winners from a 2016-17 season that saw them go 24-7 and qualify for the NCAA Tournament. The returning players include 2016-17 All-WAC first-team member Brooke Salas (also selected to preseason first team) and Zaire Williams, who was named to the WAC preseason second team.

Thus far in this young season, Salas is leading the team in scoring (16.3), rebounding (9.3) and blocks (1.5) while Gia Pack (14.2) and Monique Mills (10.8) are averaging double figures as well. As a team, the Aggies are averaging 65.8 points per game while allowing 67.3.

UNM WRAPS UP UNDEFEATED NOVEMBER

UNM wrapped up a perfect opening month of the season after defeating UTEP in its first road of the season, 59-35, on Nov. 30. The Lobos finished the month outscoring their opponents by an average of 19.3 points per game (85.5-66.2) and had a turnover margin of plus 7.0 per game for the month. They also had twice as good a turnover-to-assist ratio as their opponents (1.6 to 0.8).

LOBOS WIN UNM THANKSGIVING TOURNAMENT, BUCK NAMED MVP

For the first time since 2008, the Lobos won their own Thanksgiving Tournament by beating Wichita State, UC Irvine and Illinois - winning each game by double figures and two of the games by 20-plus. Tesha Buck was named the tournament's MVP while she was joined on the all-tournament team with Jaisa Nunn and Alex Lapeyrolerie.

BRADBURY GETS WIN NO. 200

UNM coach Mike Bradbury has had a successful 10-plus seasons as a head coach and now he's hit win No. 200 in just his 11th season when the Lobos defeated Illinois 97-68 on Nov. 26. The second-year Lobo coach averaged 19.3 victories per season in his first 10 years as a head coach.

LOBOS MAKE IT 3-FOR-3, BUCK NAMED MW PLAYER OF WEEK

For the third week in a row with a third different player, the University of New Mexico women's basketball program has earned the Mountain West Player of the Week honor as Tesha Buck's stellar and steady performance while guiding the Lobos to the UNM Thanksgiving Tournament title was honored Monday by the conference. Buck averaged 17.3 points, 5.7 assists, 4.3 rebounds and 2.0 steals per game in helping the Lobos to three convincing victories. Along with her averages, the senior shot 50 percent (12-for-24) from 3-point range during the tournament.

Buck joins Cherise Beynon (first week) and Jaisa Nunn (second week) in earning Mountain West Player of the Week honors this season, marking the first time since the 2008-09 season the Mountain West has awarded the same school three straight weeks (was also to three different players). It's the first time the Lobos have ever won the award three straight weeks

and is the first time since the 2010-11 season the program has had three honors in the same season as well as three different players win the award in the same season.

LOBOS RECEIVING VOTES IN AP TOP 25, USA TODAY POLLS

The Lobos with their 7-0 start received 19 points in this week's AP Top 25 poll (See page 4 of these notes for the full AP Top 25). UNM owns a victory over a current top 25 team in Marquette (now No. 22, but was No. 16 when the Lobos beat the Golden Eagles). It's the second week in a row UNM has received votes (earned eight points last week).

For the first time, the Lobos received votes this week in the USA Today women's basketball coaches poll (2 points).

NUNN NAMED MOUNTAIN WEST PLAYER OF THE WEEK

A near flawless – and Lobo-record – performance by Jaisa Nunn that helped The University of New Mexico women's basketball team defeat a ranked opponent highlighted a week that saw the junior average 17.7 points and 10.7 rebounds and be selected the Mountain West Player of the Week for the week of Nov. 20. Nunn broke a 35-year-old New Mexico scoring record by piling up 39 points (the old record was 35 set by Yvonne McKinnon in 1979) and adding 13 rebounds in the Lobos' 88-87 victory over No. 16 Marquette on Nov. 13 at Dreamstyle Arena – including converting on a three-point play with 1.8 seconds remaining to give UNM the victory. The Kirkland, Wash., native was 14-for-15 from the field and 11-for-12 from the free-throw line while committing no turnovers in 34 minutes of play.

RECORD SCORING NIGHT FOR THE LOBOS

The Lobos broke a 38-year-old scoring record Wednesday, Nov. 15, when they defeated Northern New Mexico 107-66 - breaking the old record set March 3, 1979, when UNM defeated Northern Arizona 106-81. It's the first time the Lobos have reached 100 points in a game since beating Morgan State 101-22 on Jan. 4, 2005.

WASHINGTON NEARLY SETS RECORD OFF BENCH VS. NMJC

Northern New Mexico and scored 27 points during the Lobos' win Wednesday, Nov. 15 - tied for the second-most points off the bench and tied for the sixth-most points for a freshman in UNM history. The UNM record for points off the bench is Jordan Adams who scored 30 against Utah Feb. 3, 2000. The Lobo record for points by a freshman was the previous UNM overall scoring record set by Yvonne McKinnon with 35 points against Adams State on Feb. 19, 1982.

NUNN BETTER AGAINST NO. 16 MARQUETTE

Junior post Jaisa Nunn had a night for the ages during the Lobos' 88-87 win over Marquette on Monday, Nov. 13. She set a school-record with 39 points (besting the previous record of 35 by Yvonne McKinnon in 1982) on 14-for-15 shooting from the field (new career high in field goals made) and going 11-for-12 from the free-throw line (New career high in free throw makes and attempts). She also grabbed a career-high 13 rebounds.

FIRST WIN OVER A RANKED TEAM SINCE 2010

In the Lobos' 88-87 victory over No. 16 Marquette, it marked the first Lobo win over a ranked team since beating No. 25 SMU March 17, 2010 - a stretch of eight consecutive losses to ranked teams. It's the highest-ranked opponent the Lobos have defeated since UNM beat No. 16 BYU March 4, 2006.

BEYNON NAMED MW PLAYER OF THE WEEK

For the first time in her decorated career, senior Cherise Beynon was named Mountain West Player of the Week on Monday, Nov. 13, after nearly putting up a triple-double in the Lobos' season-opening win over Western Michigan. The Las Vegas, Nevada, native had 24 points, nine assists and eight rebounds in the victory. It's just the second time a Lobo has earned the honor in the previous three seasons.

NICE DEBUT BY BUCK

Senior transfer shined her Lobo debut during an 88-76 win over Western Michigan on Friday, Nov. 10. The Wisconsin-Green Bay transfer racked up 22 points and added five assists in the victory. She was, not surprisingly, deadly accurate from beyond the arc - going 5-for-8 from long distance.

The Lobos collected four first-place votes (there were 25 votes total) and 186 points – only behind Boise State (221 points, seven first-place votes), Wyoming (216 points, six first-place votes) and Colorado State (211 points, six first-place votes).

UNM SWEEPS PRESEASON CONFERENCE AWARDS

The Lobos swept the three preseason Mountain West individual awards with Cherise Beynon named the MW Preseason Player of the Year (as well as to the All-MW Preseason Team), Tesha Buck selected the MW Preseason Newcomer of the Year and N'Dea Flye voted the MW Preseason Freshman of the Year.

BEYNON CLIMBING CAREER UNM CHARTS IN ... ALMOST EVERYTHING

Cherise Beynon's first three seasons as a Lobo have been spectacular to say the least and the do-it-all guard will continue to climb the Lobo all-time lists this season. The Las Vegas, Nevada, native is in the career top 15 in points (1,295 - 9th), field goals made (486 - seventh), field goals attempted (1,373 - fifth), 3-pointers made (144 - fifth), 3-pointers attempted (487 - fourth), assists (424 - fifth), steals (197 - third) and rebounding (613 - 12th). She's also nearing the top 10 in minutes played (3,022 - No. 10 is at 3,406). She can also become the second UNM basketball player - male or female - to reach the 1,000-point, 500-rebound and 500-assist mark (Mandi Moore finished with 1,057 points, 603 rebounds and 651 assists for the Lobos from 2002-05).

BEYNON 2016-17 ACADEMIC ALL-AMERICAN

Cherise Beynon was named the second Academic All-American in program history last season as she is one of just five players in the nation to make the CoSIDA Academic All-American First Team list.

ABOUT THE 2017-18 LOBOS

The 2017-18 University of New Mexico women's basketball team returns key pieces from head coach Mike Bradbury's first season and the additions of several others have the Lobos in a position to play the up-tempo style Bradbury hopes for and improve from their 15-15 campaign in 2016-17.

UNM returns All-Mountain West and Mountain West All-Defensive Team member Cherise Beynon as well as fellow starters Alex Lapeyrolerie and All-Mountain West Freshman team member Mykiel Burleson. UNM also returns Jaisa Nunn in the post and guards Laneah Bryan and Emily Lines. Add to it with two talented transfers and five freshmen that all will likely see action and UNM is excited to see what 2017-18 has in store.

Lobos take down in-state foe Aggies, 86-75

UNM ATHLETICS

ALBUQUERQUE, N.M. --- The University of New Mexico women's basketball team used a 21-2 first-half run to turn a one-point deficit into an 18-point lead and held off a New Mexico State second-half charge to defeat the Aggies 86-75 Saturday afternoon at Dreamstyle Arena in the Lobos' annual Nike N7 Game.

The Lobos (4-0), who sported turquoise uniforms for the Nike N7 Game to celebrate Native American Heritage Month as the turquoise color represents harmony, friendship and fellowship in the Native American culture, had four players reach double figures with Cherise Beynon leading the way with 27 points, nine assists, seven rebounds and a career-high six steals. Tesha Buck finished with 17 points (going 4-for-8 from 3-point range) to go along with six rebounds, Alex Lapeyrolerie had 17 points with 12 coming in the fourth quarter as NMSU tried to rally and Jaisa Nunn finished with 12 points and tied a career high with 13 rebounds.

"It was the game that was expected - hard fought," UNM coach Mike Bradbury said. "It was a game that had big runs both ways. They fought back, and I thought it was really competitive. I thought both teams really competed at a high level."

UNM trailed 12-11 with 5:37 left in the first quarter after New Mexico State's (1-2) Zaire Williams drained a 3-pointer to give the Aggies the lead.

Buck answered for the Lobos as her own 3-pointer with 4:51 left in the first quarter ignited a UNM 21-2 run capped by an Antonia Anderson bucket with 5:04 remaining in the second quarter to make it 32-14 Lobos as they held NMSU to one field goal for a stretch of 10 minutes, 49 seconds.

NMSU cut the UNM lead to 35-24 at the half, but the Lobos opened the second half on 13-3 burst – including 3-pointers from Buck, Lapeyrolerie and Laneah Bryan to make it 50-27 with 6:46 remaining, UNM's largest lead of the game.

The Aggies didn't go away as they outscored the Lobos 23-10 (including a 7-0 run to end the quarter) to cut the UNM lead to 10 at 60-50 heading into the fourth quarter.

"We knew they weren't going away," Beynon said. "They're a good team, and we each play really hard, so we knew we couldn't let up and it was an intense game for the entire 40 minutes."

NMSU got the UNM lead down to as low as seven in the fourth, but 12 fourth-quarter points from Lapeyrolerie – including 10 in a row for the Lobos at one point – helped UNM hold off the Aggies and win their fourth game in a row to start the season.

"I was focusing on trusting in my teammates and getting into a rhythm where we're getting good shots and taking good shots," Lapeyrolerie said. "I definitely felt I had to step up for the team. You know, it was a team effort, and when one of us falls, we each have to step it up."

UNM has scored 86 or more points in their first four games of the season – the first time doing that since 1979 as the Lobos are averaging 92.2 points per game, 17th in the nation.

UNM, which has played four games in the first nine days of the season, is off until hosting the UNM Thanksgiving Tournament starting Friday. UC Irvine and Illinois get things going at 4:30 p.m. with the Lobos taking on Wichita State at 7 p.m.

Overall, UNM outshot UTEP 43.9 percent to 37.7 percent despite the Miners outshooting the Lobos 35.0 to 34.5 percent from three and **70.0 to 52.4 percent from the charity stripe.**
