**TAKING ON THE RED RAIDERS**

This will be the 20th-consecutive year the Lobos have played Texas Tech at least once during the season, last not playing the Red Raiders during the 1997 season. The Lobos went 1-3 against Texas Tech last season, including losing to the Red Raiders in the Lubbock NCAA Regional 4-3 - a game New Mexico led 3-1 heading into the eighth inning. The Lobos lost both meetings in Lubbock last season and are looking for their first win at Rip Griffin Park since beating the Red Raiders 7-6 on March 24, 2015.

**ABOUT NO. 11 TEXAS TECH**

The Red Raiders enter Tuesday's midweek game 8-1 after sweeping a four-game series at home against Cal - outscoring the Bears 23-7 and never allowing more than two runs in any game. Texas Tech is 5-0 at home this season and its only loss came to Mississippi State 8-5 on Feb. 19 in Starkville, Mississippi. Last season, Texas Tech as the No. 5 national seed reached the College World Series - the Red Raiders' second appearance in three years.



### Career Notes

- Five NCAA regionals appearances in the last season seasons (2010-13, '16), first NCAA postseason berths for UNM since 1962
- Birmingham coached the Lobos to their first three MW Tournament Championships in 2011-12 and 2016. The Lobos also shared the regular-season crown in both 2012 and 2014, and won the league by a record seven games in 2013.
- Attained highest RPI in UNM history (No. 19) in 2010 and its highest ranking ever (No. 13 by *Baseball America*) in 2013.
- Earned his 1,000th collegiate victory with a 19-5 victory at Air Force on April 6, 2013.
- Coached his 1,500th collegiate game on Thursday, May 23, 2013, in the Mountain West Tournament against Nevada.
- Guided New Mexico Junior College to the 2005 NJCAA National Championship and were the national runner-up in 2007.
- Birmingham set the foundations for the programs at College of the Southwest (1988-89) and NMJC (1990-2007).
- Birmingham began his coaching career at Las Cruces Mayfield High School where the Trojans won the 4A championship in 1981 and had three No. 1 rankings through 1983.

## HOME, SWEET HOME

On March 24, 2013, the UNM baseball team moved into its new old home. After spending most of the previous nine seasons at Isotopes Park, the Lobos returned to a newly renovated Santa Ana Star Field with astounding success. After losing two of their first five games in their new home park, the Lobos finished the season with 11 straight wins at home to post a 14-2 record at Santa Ana Star Field.

**LAST TIME OUT FOR UNM ...** The Lobos traveled to 23rd-ranked Dallas Baptist University and went 1-2 against the Patriots at Horner Ballpark - the first time UNM has traveled to play at DBU's field.

New Mexico gave itself a chance to take the rubber match of the series on Sunday after scoring three runs in the top of the ninth to tie DBU 4-4 - capped by a pinch-hit, game-tying RBI single from Hayden Schilling - to force extra innings. In extra innings, the Lobos scored two in the top of the 11th - led by a go-ahead RBI single by Schilling - to take a 6-4 lead before Dallas Baptist hit a game-winning, three-run home run to beat the Lobos, 7-6.

Highlighting the series for UNM was Luis Gonzalez as he went 8-for-11 with a home run, two doubles, two RBI, three runs and five walks. This includes reaching base in 13 of his 16 appearances and 11 of his last 12. DBU walked Gonzalez in each of his final three at-bats in the series, including an intentional walk in his final at-bat. For his effort Gonzalez was named the Mountain West Player of the Week.

UNM got a pair of solid starts in the final two games of the series as Carson Schneider picked up the win Saturday by going six innings and giving up two runs on eight hits with three strikeouts and two walks while Johnathon Tripp went six innings Sunday and gave up three runs on six hits with six strikeouts and two walks (getting a no decision).

Christian Tripp, who set a freshman UNM record last season with 27 appearances, picked up the Lobos' first save of 2017 on Saturday.

**SCOUTING NO. 10 TEXAS TECH ...** The Red Raiders have won five in a row heading into Tuesday's matchup with the Lobos and are playing well thanks to a 2.63 ERA on the season (34th in the nation).

That ERA dropped during a four-game sweep of Cal in Lubbock over the weekend as the Red Raiders didn't allow more than two runs in any game while outscoring the Bears 23-7.

Three of the four Texas Tech starting pitchers that have started two games this year have a 2.13 ERA or below.

Tuesday's projected starter against the Lobos, freshman John Henry Gonzalez, is 1-0 with a 3.10 ERA. In his first collegiate start against New Mexico State last Tuesday, Gonzalez went 5.1 innings and gave up one run on two hits with five strikeouts and two walks.

At the plate, Hunter Hargrove has been the Red Raiders' most dangerous hitter as he's batting .421 with three home runs, six doubles and 16 RBI. Orland Garcia is hitting .323 with three home runs and 14 RBI for Texas Tech while Grant Little leads the team with a .481 average and a team-best 13 runs.

**GONZALEZ'S BIG WEEK LEADS TO MW PLAYER OF THE WEEK (Feb. 20-26) ...** For the second week in a row to start the season the Lobos have earned the Mountain West Player of the Week as Luis Gonzalez was selected for the honor.

The junior outfielder hit .727 (8-for-11) with a home run, two doubles, two RBI, two stolen bases and three runs on the road against No. 23 Dallas Baptist. He also drew five walks and reached base 13 of his 16 plate appearances, including reaching base in 11 of his final 12.

**RUN SCORING STREAK FOR VIGIL ...** Andre Vigil has started a nice streak for himself to start the 2017 campaign as the senior has scored a run in each of the Lobos' first six games.

Overall, he has scored seven runs and already has doubled his career home run total entering the season with two blasts early in the season.

**ZOELLNER TABBED MW PLAYER OF THE WEEK (Feb. 13-19) ...** Jack Zoellner was the story of the weekend against Binghamton for the Lobos at the plate as the senior went 6-for-12 with three home runs, a double, eight RBI and five runs to earn Mountain West Player of the Week honors.

Zoellner's three home runs and six RBI in the Feb. 18 win over Binghamton were both career highs. This is the first time Zoellner has been selected for this honor.

**INNING TO REMEMBER ...** Freshman Beau Capanna had an inning to remember against Binghamton in his collegiate debut Feb. 19.

In his first plate appearance as a Lobo in the third inning, Capanna singled, stole second base and eventually scored. As the Lobos kept putting together hits for what would be a seven-run inning, Capanna came up again and hit an RBI single - and stole another base.

When the damage was done in the third inning, Capanna went 2-for-2 with two stolen bases, a run and an RBI. Not a bad debut to say the least.

**MOUNTAIN WEST FAVORITES ...** The Lobos are the favorites in the Mountain West according to the conference's preseason coaches' poll.

The defending Mountain West Tournament champion Lobos, who went 39-23 and reached the NCAA postseason for the fifth time in seven seasons in 2016, picked up four first-place votes and edged Fresno State (which had three first-place votes) by a point for the top spot in the preseason poll (each program voted, but could not vote for themselves). Following UNM and Fresno State was Nevada and San Diego State in third and fourth, respectively, Air Force and UNLV tied for fifth and San Jose State seventh.

Gonzalez, who plays center field and pitches for UNM, is the first Lobo to be on the preseason list since Mitch Garver and D.J. Peterson made the list in 2013. The last player on the list at any point in the season was Chris DeVito in 2016 when he made the midseason watch list.

**TO BE THE BEST, YOU GOT TO PLAY THE BEST**

... The Lobos take on arguably one of the toughest non-conference schedules in the country in 2017 with five NCAA postseason opponents – including two College World Series participants – and a combined winning percentage of almost .600 between the Lobos' 10 non-conference foes.

UNM faces CWS teams Texas Tech (on the road Feb. 28, April 11; at home April 25-26) and Oklahoma State (on the road March 14-15) along with fellow 2016 NCAA postseason teams Cal State Fullerton (on the road March 17-19), Dallas Baptist (the Lobos took one of three from the No. 23 Patriots, losing the rubber match in extra innings) and Binghamton (a team the Lobos swept already Feb. 17-19 by a combined score of 29-12).

Four of those teams finished in the top 30 of the NCBWA's final rankings in No. 4 Oklahoma State, No. 5 Texas Tech, No. 24 Dallas Baptist and No. 29 Cal State Fullerton.

Of the Lobos' 26 non-conference games, 21 are against teams that finished above .500 last season with 15 against NCAA postseason qualifiers. All 10 teams on the Lobos' non-conference schedule finished with 25 or more victories.

Along with taking on five NCAA postseason teams, the Lobos face a Missouri State team (at home April 13-15) that finished 38-21 in 2016 and lost in the 12th inning of the Missouri Valley Conference Tournament championship game to Dallas Baptist.

UNM faces in-state foe New Mexico State (34-23 last season) three times in three locations – March 7 in El Paso at Southwest University Park, March 28 (6:30 p.m.) at

New Mexico State and May 2 (6:30 p.m.) at Santa Ana Star Field in Albuquerque.

The Lobos added a third Big 12 opponent on their schedule as they travel to take on Kansas State April 18-19.

**30-WIN SEASONS & BIRMINGHAM GO TOGETHER LIKE PEANUT BUTTER & JAM**

... The Lobos are averaging 35.5 wins per year in the nine years under coach Ray Birmingham, a New Mexico native. UNM only reached that number eight times before the Birmingham era.

UNM's 39 wins in 2016 was the third most in program history and the most since winning a program-best 42 in 2016. The Lobos' run from 2012-14 (three straight 37-win seasons) was the most wins UNM has recorded in a three-year period. In 2010, New Mexico had the third most wins in program history. The Lobos are currently in the midst of the most successful nine-year stretch in program history (311 wins).




