
All interviews with Lobo coaches and studentathletes must be arranged through Frank Mercogliano and Eugene Canal in the UNM Athletics Media Relations office.



### **Career Notes**

- Four straight NCAA regionals appearances (2010-13), first postseason berths for UNM since 1962
- Birmingham coached the Lobos to their first two MW Tournament Championships in 2011 and 2012. The Lobos also shared the regular-season crown in both 2012 and 2014, and won the league by a record seven games in 2013.
- Attained highest RPI in UNM history (No. 19) in 2010 and its highest ranking ever (No. 13 by Baseball America) in 2013.
- Earned his 1,000th collegiate victory with a 19-5 victory at Air Force on April 6, 2013.



- The NMJC Thunderbirds won the 2005 NJCAA National Championship and were the national runners-up in 2007.
- Birmingham set the foundations for the programs at College of the Southwest (1988-89) and NMJC (1990-2007).
- Birmingham began his coaching career at Las Cruces Mayfield High School where the Trojans won the 4A championship in 1981 and had three No. 1 rankings through 1983.

### HOME, SWEET HOME

On March 24, 2013, the UNM baseball team moved into its new old home. After spending most of the previous nine seasons at Isotopes Park, the Lobos returned to a newly renovated Santa Ana Star Field with astounding success. After losing two of their first five games in their new home park, the Lobos finished the season with 11 straight wins at home to post a 14-2 record at Santa Ana Star Field.

**SCOUTING AIR FORCE** ... Air Force enters the final series of the regular season with a 27-23 record overall, 11-16 in the Mountain West. This current squad is considered one of the best the program has had, going 16-5 at home.

Leading the way on offense is Tyler Jones, who holds a team-best 60 RBI. He also holds the team's best slugging percentage of .675.

Griffin Jax, scheduled to start Friday's game, holds a 1.91 ERA over 89.1 innings pitched. He holds a 8-2 record with a .226 opponent batting average.

**THE SERIES WITH AIR FORCE** ... All-time, the Lobos hold a 131-46 overall record against the Falcons. The Lobos have won five straight games against Air Force.

New Mexico holds 46 wins against Air Force on the road. The Lobos have won the last nine series against the Falcons in Colorado Springs, dating all the way back to 2002. Head coach Ray Birmingham has never lost a series at Air Force.

**LAST TIME OUT FOR UNM ...** The University of New Mexico baseball team (33-20, 18-9 MW) dropped game three of its weekend series Sunday at home, falling to the Nevada Wolf Pack (30-21, 18-9 MW), 13-9.

Dalton Bowers had a big day in the ninth spot in the lineup, going 2-for-5 with a game-high three RBI on a home run in the second inning. Luis Gonzalez finished 2-for-4 with a walk, two RBI and a run, while Jared Holley, Carl Stajduhar and Andrew Pratt each finished 2-for-4.

Prior to the game, the Lobos celebrated senior day by honoring eight Lobos for their hard work at the University of New Mexico. Among the honored were Bowers, Drew Bridges, Taylor Duree, Michael Eaton, Alex Estrella, Holley, Victor Sanchez and Colton Thomson.

For the second day in a row, the Wolf Pack jumped out to a quick 5-0 lead. Nevada posted a run in the first frame and put a four spot on the board in the second. The Lobos did not waste time climbing back in it, scoring five runs for the best frame of the day in the bottom of the second. Stajduhar led off the side with a single and the bases would load up on walks of Andre Vigil and Jared Mang. The Lobos brought their first run across on a sacrifice fly by freshman catcher

With two outs on the board in the second inning, Bowers hit his fourth home run of the week on a bomb over left field. The homer plated three runs and brought the Lobos within a run. A four-pitch walk of Gonzalez kept the rally going, and a Holley double to left centerfield tied the game at 5-5.

The Lobos took their lone lead of the game in the third inning, scoring once to take a 6-5 lead. Jack Zoellner hit a one-out double to right field and was plated on a single from Vigil. The lead was short lived, as the Wolf Pack scored five runs on their best frame in the fourth.

New Mexico fought back in the middle innings, scoring a run in both the fourth and fifth innings. Chris DeVito gave the Lobos instant offense with two outs in the fourth inning on a solo home run past left field. It was his 14th home run of the season. The fifth-inning run also came on two outs, starting with a Pratt single up the middle. He moved to second on a single from Bowers and scored on Gonzalez's single straight to centerfield.

The Lobos were in striking distance at 10-8 entering the sixth inning, but the Wolf Pack scored one in both the sixth and seventh innings to build another four-run lead. In the bottom of the seventh, Austin Bell led off with a single to left field. After two outs, he would score the team's ninth run on a RBI single from Luis Gonzalez. The Lobos would find themselves in a bases loaded situation with two outs and the

tying run on first base. However, a near DeVito single up the middle was fielded well by the shortstop for an inningending ground out.

After the Lobos stranded a runner on second in the eighth, Nevada posted an insurance run in the ninth. New Mexico could not reach base to start a rally in the ninth, ending the high-offense affair.

2016 FRESHMEN... The University of New Mexico baseball team is currently in a tight race for the Mountain West Conference Championship. The Lobos will look to win their sixth conference trophy since 2011 over the next three games, needing a sweep. In order for the team to accomplish its goals, the current freshman class will have to make a major impact.

"Playing here as a freshman is tough," said head coach Ray Birmingham. "There are a whole bunch of games in a short period of time. The travel alone this year has been hard on them. And the home work, weightlifting, study hall...everything. It's really hard on freshman. On top of everything, they have to learn to compete. It's amazing what some of these kids have done."

Over the course of the conference season, coach Birmingham has put several freshmen on the field and relied on them to perform. In the team's last road win, a 6-2 win at, Birmingham used seven freshman in a crucial road game.

This is nothing new for coach Birmingham, who has routinely put young players in position to succeed.

The Lobos have had a freshman All-American every year since 2011, with seven over a five year span. Current players Danny Collier, Carl Stajduhar and Tyler Stevens are among them. Needless to say, the bar is set high for first year players at New Mexico.

"It's hard being a freshman here because they play a lot. The pro door takes players out so quickly that a lot of pressure is put on the freshmen, and they have to step up. So you see the growth. I am proud of (Andrew) Pratt, I am proud of (Jared) Mang and I am proud of (Austin) Bell and (Erick) Migueles, and (Christian) Tripp."

During conference play, Jared Mang, Austin Bell, Andrew Pratt and Erick Migueles have all played a key role in the team's ascension to the top spot in the conference. Over the course 21 MW games played, Bell holds a .350 average. Mang is hitting .299 in conference and logged a team-best seven RBI 2 weeks ago. Migueles is hitting .291 and slugging .418 in conference. Pratt has had to make an immediate impact in the wake of recent injuries. He came in to catch on April 29 at Arizona State and has been the team's starting catcher ever since.

Arguably the most impressive development of any freshman has been on the mound from Christian Tripp. The 6-7 right hander holds a 2.03 ERA and a .200 opponent batting average over 13.1 innings pitched against MW teams. He made two appearances that weekend.

"They have to play at freshman All-American status for us to (finish successful) because of some of the injuries. Danny Collier being gone is a huge deal that impacts everything. The injury to DeVito has put a lot of stress on Pratt, who's caught well enough defensively. But they are going to need to step up offensively too."

CLINCHING THE TITLE... Fresno State has clinched at least a share of the Mountain West Conference regular season championship. However, both Nevada and New Mexico are still in the running for a part of that title. Both teams will need to sweep their weekend opponents. If New Mexico ties either Fresno State or Nevada, or both, the Lobos will win the tiebreaker. Therefore, a sweep of Air Force will give the Lobos the top seed in the MW Tournament.

**DUREE-ABLE...** Taylor Duree made two appearances against Arizona State, giving him a program-record of career appearances as a Lobo. He is the second pitcher to reach 70 appearances at New Mexico and has passed Joe Coleman for the school record
