MOUNTAIN WEST TIE-BREAKING PROCEDURES

General Procedure. All ties shall be broken in the order in which they occur, from top to bottom, in the standings. Tied teams in the higher position shall be considered as separate positions based upon their seeding (e.g., Team A and Team B are tied for first place in the standings. By using the established tie-breaking procedures, it is determined that Team B is the No. 1 seed and Team A is the No. 2 seed. Team C and Team D are tied for fifth in the standings. When using the tie-breaking formula to break the tie, Teams C and D are compared separately against Team B first, then Team A). When comparing tied teams against positions lower in the standings that are also tied, those lower-tied positions shall be considered a single position for the purposes of comparison.

When comparing records against a single team or a group of teams, the higher winning percentage shall prevail, even if the number of games played against the team or group are unequal (i.e., 3-0 is better than 3-1). However, 2-0 is better than 1-0, and 0-1 is better than 0-2. Thus, if two tied teams have split their regular-season series, but Team A is 2-0 against the top seed and Team B is 1-0 against the top seed, Team A would gain the higher seed.

MOUNTAIN WEST TIE-BREAKING PROCEDURES (CONT.)

Two-Way Tie. If two teams tie for a position, and one holds a win-loss advantage during regular season play, that team receives the higher seed. If the two teams split their games during the regular season, each tied team's record shall be compared against the team occupying the highest position in the standings, continuing down through the standings until one team gains the advantage, thereby gaining the higher seed. If two teams remain tied after all other tie-breakers have been exhausted, the last tie-breaker to determine an advantage shall be team RPI, as determined by the most recent NCAA RPI available on Friday, March 6, 2015.

Three-Way Tie. If three or more teams tie for a position, the combined record of each of the tied teams against the other teams involved in the tie shall be compared. If one team gains the advantage, thereby gaining the higher seed, the process shall then revert to the two-way tie-breaking procedure between the remaining two teams, until the tie is broken. If all three teams remain tied following the initial comparison, each tied team's record shall be compared against the team occupying the highest position in the standings, continuing down through the standings until the tie is reduced to a two-team tie, at which time the procedure shall revert to the two-way tiebreaking procedure. If all three teams remain tied after all other tie-breakers have been exhausted, the last tie-breaker to determine an advantage shall be team RPI, as determined by the most recent NCAA RPI available on Friday, March 6, 2015.

Ties Between Four or More Teams. If four or more teams tie for a position, the combined record of each of the tied teams against the other teams involved in the tie shall be compared. If one team gains the advantage, thereby gaining the higher seed, the comparison process shall then be repeated among the remaining tied teams, until the tie is reduced to a two-team tie, at which time the procedure shall revert to the two-way tie-breaking procedure between the remaining two teams, until the tie is broken. If all teams remain tied following the initial comparison, each tied team's record shall be compared against the team occupying the highest position in the standings, continuing down through the standings until one team gains the advantage, thereby gaining the higher seed. The entire tie-breaking procedure shall then be repeated from the beginning among the remaining tied teams, reverting to the three- and two-way tie-breaking procedures when appropriate. If four or more teams remain tied after all other tie-breakers have been exhausted, the last tie-breaker to determine an advantage shall be team RPI, as determined by the most recent NCAA RPI available on Friday, March 6, 2015.



MOUNTAIN WEST 3-POINTERS

AIR FORCE (0-0, 0-0 MW)

- Air Force is opening the season at home for the first time since hosting Army to begin the 2011-12 season. The Falcons have won nine consecutive home season openers dating back to the 1991-92 campaign.
- The Falcons return all five starters, and six players that started at least 12 games last season. AFA brings back 80.4% of its scoring from 2015-16, including the teams-leading scorer and rebounder in **Hayden Graham**. Graham, who averaged 13.8 points and 6.3 rebounds per game last year, recorded five double-doubles, the most in a single-season by a Falcon since 1999-2000.
- Senior guard **Zach Kocur** is one of the most accurate 3-point shooters in Air Force history. Kocur ranks fifth all-time with a 40.5% percentage from beyond the arc (126-311). Matt McCraw (03-07) holds the school record at 46.5%.

COLORADO STATE (0-0, 0-0 MW)

- The Rams open their season at home against New Mexico State on Sunday, Nov. 13. CSU has not lost a home opener since the Mountain West's inception in 1999-2000.
- Last season, Colorado State finished 25th nationally averaging 39.97 rebounds per contest. Under head coach **Larry Eustachy**, the Rams are 75-27 when outrebounding their opponent.
- In Eustachy's four seasons at Colorado State, the Rams are 75-5 when leading with five minutes to play and 78-6 when leading with two minutes to go.

NEVADA (0-0, 0-0 MW)

- Nevada opens on the road at Saint Mary's. This is the first time since 2012-13 that the Wolf Pack have began their season with a true road game. Nevada's last season-opening road victory came in 2008-09 at Montana State (72-63). Since then, it has started a season with a true road game just once (loss at UC Irvine).
- Sophomore forward **Cameron Oliver** is the Mountain West's active leader with 12 double-doubles. Oliver finished the 2015-16 season with double-doubles in three of the Wolf Pack's final four games, including two straight.
- Oliver also ranked No. 3 nationally with 99 blocked shots, which was a Mountain West freshman record and program best. Overall, the 99 blocked shots tied as the fifth-most for a single season in MW annals.

RV/RV SAN DIEGO STATE (0-0, 0-0 MW)

- Since the start of the 2005-06 season, San Diego State has compiled a 159-20 (.888) record at Viejas Arena. The .888 home win percentage ranks as the eighth-best nationally in that time. The Aztecs have played in front of 72 consecutive regular-season home sellouts. A streak that began on Jan. 14, 2012 vs. UNLV.
- Last season, the Aztecs had one of the toughest defenses nationally. SDSU ranked No. 1 in field-goal percentage defense (37.3) and No. 3 in scoring defense (60.6).
- SDSU has won 11 straight home openers dating back to an overtime loss vs. UC Santa Barbara (80-72) to begin the 2004-05 season.

UNLV (0-0, 0-0 MW)

- UNLV has won 20 of its last 21 season openers, with the lone loss coming vs. St. Mary's (64-54) on Nov. 23, 2004. Overall, when opening at home the Rebels are 39-5.
- Friday's opener vs. South Alabama marks the first game as head coach for **Marvin Menzies**, who spent the last nine seasons at New Mexico State. Menzies spent one season with the Rebels in 2004-05 as an assistant coach under Lon Kruger.
- The Rebels have connected on at least one 3-pointer in 974 consecutive games, the second-most in NCAA behind Kentucky (975). The last game UNLV did not make a 3-pointer was vs. Long Beach State on Jan. 25, 1986.

WYOMING (0-0, 0-0 MW)

- Wyoming has won 11 of its last 12 season-opening games, and six straight home openers. The Cowboys last season-opening home defeat came on Nov. 13, 2009 vs. South Dakota State (77-61).
- Senior guard **Jason McManamen** poured in 92 3-pointers last season, the third-most in a single season by a Cowboy. McManamen's 44.0% from beyond the arc ranked 15th nationally, while his 2.97 made three-point field goals per contest was 27th.
- The Cowboys have won eight straight over Western State, with the last loss against the Mountaineers coming on Jan. 2, 1937 (46-37). Twenty two of the 30 games played in the series happened prior to 1975.

BOISE STATE (0-0, 0-0 MW)

- Boise State has won 13 straight home openers, with its last defeat coming at the beginning of the 2002-03 season vs. Eastern Illinois (73-59).
- Under head coach **Leon Rice**, the Broncos have never lost at Taco Bell Arena during the month of November, compiling a 19-0 record.
- Boise State is one of nine institutions in the west to win at least 20 games in each of the last four seasons. The Broncos join Mountain West foe San Diego State on this list as well as Arizona, BYU, Gonzaga, New Mexico State, Oregon, Saint Mary's and UC Irvine.

FRESNO STATE (0-0, 0-0 MW)

- Fresno State is riding an eight-game home win streak, the longest in the Mountain West. The Bulldogs, who compiled a 16-2 record at the Save Mart Center last season, suffered their last home defeat vs. New Mexico (77-62) on Jan. 2.
- The Bulldogs, who open the season at home against UTSA, have rattled off 15 consecutive home-opening victories, with their last loss coming on Nov. 17, 2000 vs. Saint Mary's (104-66).
- When leading at halftime, the Bulldogs have won 29 of their last 30 games.

NEW MEXICO (0-0, 0-0 MW)

- New Mexico opens up at home for the ninth consecutive year, a streak dating back to the 2007-08 season. Overall, the Lobos have won 13 straight season openers, with the last season-opening defeat coming on Nov. 23, 2002 vs. California (76-68).
- New Mexico guard **Elijah Brown** was named Mountain West Preseason Player of the Year. The junior is coming off a 2015-16 campaign where he averaged 21.7 points, 5.5 rebounds and 3.1 assists per game.
- Dating back to 2010, the Lobos have compiled a 39-5 record at home in nonconference games. New Mexico has lost two nonconference home games over the last two years, losing 90-89 vs. Rice last season and 66-54 to USC in 2014-15.

SAN JOSÉ STATE (0-0, 0-0 MW)

- San José State has lost four of its last five season openers, with the lone victory coming vs. Bethesda (67-44) to open the 2014-15 season.
- The Spartans are coming off a nine-win season, which is tied for the most wins by a SJSU team since 2012-13.
- SJSU forward **Brandon Clarke** was the first-ever freshman to earn Mountain West Sixth Man of the Year honors after averaging 10.1 points and 7.3 rebounds per game during league play in 2015-16. Clarke set a program freshman record with 37 blocks, and registered five double-doubles.

UTAH STATE (0-0, 0-0 MW)

- Utah State has won nine consecutive season openers dating back to 2007-08. The Aggies last season-opening loss as at Northwestern State (88-71) in 2006-07.
- Aggies wing **Jalen Moore** earned preseason Mountain West honors, the first preseason recognition for a USU player since joining the league prior to the 2013 season. Moore averaged 15.2 points and 6.0 rebounds per game last season.
- Moore is just 45 points shy of surpassing his father, Jimmy, on Utah State's all-time scoring list for 25th. Jimmy, who played from 1973-75, scored 1,164 career points.

AZTECS PICKED TO WIN 2016-17 MW REGULAR-SEASON CROWN

For the fourth consecutive year, San Diego State is the preseason favorite to finish the 2016-17 regular season in first-place, according to a vote of the Conference media. The league's predicted order of finish was announced today by the Mountain West at Media Day, being held at the Renaissance Las Vegas Hotel.

The Aztecs received 23 of a possible 27 first-place votes and 293 points to garner the top spot in the poll. Nevada claimed the second spot, earning 234 points, while New Mexico received three first-place votes and 249 points to finish third. This is the highest predicted finish for the Wolf Pack since joining the Mountain West in 2012.

Fresno State, which received one first-place vote, collected 200 points for fourth place, followed by Boise State in fifth (164 points) and Utah State (153 points) in sixth. Rounding out the poll were Colorado State (146 points) in seventh, UNLV (120 points) in eighth, Air Force (90 points) in ninth, Wyoming (73 points) in 10th and San José State (41 points) in 11th.
