

Postgame notes: New Mexico 78, Fresno State 73

In-Game Notes:

- This was the 24th time in program history that UNM and Fresno State faced off against each other. Also, this was the 11th meeting between these two teams in the WisePies Arena – The Pit.
- With the win, the Lobos are 15-9 against the Bulldogs all time and are 10-1 inside The Pit against them. The Lobos first loss to the Bulldogs at home came last season when Fresno State beat UNM 92-82 in The Pit. Coach Neal is 5-2 against the Bulldogs as head coach.
- UNM improves to 7-0 at home which is the first time the lobos have gone undefeated at home.
- In the Mountain West openers, the Lobos have won the last six straight and are 8-0 in Mountain West openers inside WisePies Arena – The Pit.
- The Lobos are now 6-1 when leading at halftime of the year.
- When the Lobos have 10+ turnovers, they improve to 7-4 on the year.
- With tonight's victory, UNM is now 3-2 in December and 6-0 when wearing white jerseys.

Head Coach, Craig Neal:

- Improves to 8-5 on the year and 67-43 (.609) as UNM's Head Coach.

RS-Senior, Tim Williams:

- Set a season-high and tied career-high with four assists.
- Set a season high and tied his career-high for a fourth time with two steals.
- Led the team in rebounding seventh time this season.

RS-Junior, Elijah Brown:

- Set a season-high in free-throws with 14.
- Set a season-high in FTA with 14.
- Elijah's 14-14 effort from the free-throw line is tied for third best in program history.
- Elijah is 29-29 in Mountain West openers at the free-throw line (Elijah Brown vs. Nevada (15-15) Dec. 30, 2015).
- Set a season-high in blocks with 1.

Freshman, Jalen Harris:

- Set a career-high in free-throws made with 5.

Junior, Sam Logwood:

- Set a season high in rebounds with 6 for a second time, first was vs. UAPB on 12/17/16.

Senior, Obij Aget:

- Set a season-high in FGA with 8.
- Set a season-high in rebounds with 6.
- Set a season-high in steals with 1 for a fifth time.
