ABOUT THE MATCHUP

- The Lobos enter Saturday's game coming off of Wednesday night's 78-59 win over Evansville at The Pit. The victory snapped a four-game loss streak for UNM.
- The Miners won their first regular-season game but are riding a six-loss streak since.
- UTEP head coach Tim Floyd retired abruptly on Nov. 27 immediately after the Miners' 66-52 loss to Lamar.
- UTEP played its first game under interim head coach Phil Johnson on Thursday night.
- The Lobos earned a narrow one-point win (78-77) in the teams' last meeting almost exactly a year ago on December 7, 2016.
- New Mexico leads the series history with UTEP 77-65 including a 49-21 advantage at home. On the road however, UTEP leads 40-27 while also leading in neutral site games 1-4.
- The Lobos have four players averaging in double figures on the season including Chris McNeal (16.6), Sam Logwood (15.7), Anthony Mathis (10.3) and Troy Simons (10.0).
- UTEP's top scorers include Matt Willms (14.8 ppg), Keith Frazier (13.3 ppg) and Omega Harris (9.4 ppg).
- As a team, the Lobos are averaging 87.4 points per game compared to 65.6 for UTEP.

SCOUTING UTEP

UTEP enters Saturday's matchup coming off of an 80-60 blowout loss against New Mexico State on Thursday night at home. The Miners have struggled this season as they have gone 0-6 since kicking off 2017-18 with a 100-50 victory over Louisiana College.

Head coach Tim Floyd retired abruptly on Nov. 27 in the post-game press conference immediately following the Miners' 66-52 loss to Lamar at home. Thursday's NMSU game was the first for the Miners under interim head coach Phil Johnson and yielded the largest crowd for UTEP of the season.

The Miners average 65.6 points per game as a team and allow 68.9 points per game of their opponents for a -3.3 scoring margin. UNM vs UTEP stat comparison below:

SERIES HISTORY

HIGH-SCORING LOBOS - ON THE CUSP OF 30

The Lobos have been putting up some impressive numbers this season. Several Lobos have tallied 20-point games this season including Sam Logwood (two), Chris McNeal (two) and Troy Simons (one). While the team has yet to have a 30-point scorer this season, a couple of Lobos have nearly crossed the 30-point threshold including Logwood, who tallied a career-high 27 points against TCU, and McNeal who notched 29 points against Tennessee Tech.

DON'T FOUL WITH US!

New Mexico boasts one of the highest free-throw shooting percentages in the nation, coming in at third (1st in the Mountain West) with 81.7. Leading the Lobo charge from

the charity stripe are seniors Joe Furstinger (15-16, 93.8%) and Sam Logwood (34-40, 85.0%). Junior Troy Simons has yet to miss going 8-for-8 from the line.

ABOUT THE 2017-18 LOBOS

The 2017-18 Lobos have just five returning student-athletes from the 2016-17 squad and feature an outstanding nine newcomers. Under first-year head coach Paul Weir, the Lobos look to improve on their 17-14 overall record last season, 10-8 in Mountain West play.

Top returners for the Lobos include lone regular starter Sam Logwood who averaged 7.3 points per game for a .449 field goal percentage and a .671 percentage from the free throw line. All four other Lobos to return to UNM this season played in at least 10 games, including junior Dane Kuiper who started 13 games, averaging 6.0 points per game.

NEW COACH, NEW ERA

At the helm of the Lobos in the 2016-17 season will be head coach Paul Weir, officially named the 21st head coach in UNM men's basketball history on April 11, 2017. Weir spent the last season with New Mexico State where he finished 28-6 and led NMSU to a WAC Tournament Championship and an NCAA appearance. Weir is the first basketball coach to serve as the head coach for both New Mexico DI institutions.

LOBO TRANSFERS

Of the nine fresh faces to the UNM squad, the Lobos welcome in six new transfers, four of which will be eligible to compete in the 2017-18 season. Those that are eligible and will don the Lobo Cherry & Silver this season include junior Chris McNeal (Indian Hills), senior Antino Jackson (Akron), junior Jachai Simmons (Midland College) and junior Troy Simons (Polk State). The pair of transfers that will not see action this season is JaQuan Lyle (Ohio State) and Vance Jackson (UCONN) due to NCAA transfer rules.

LOBOS ON TV

The 2017-18 schedule includes many national and regional broadcasts of New Mexico basketball. The Lobos are currently slated for TV 22 times, including 13 of 16 Mountain West games. UNM had 22 of 26 UNM and MW controlled games selected for TV while three non-conference road games, at New Mexico State, at UTEP and at Colorado are expected to be broadcast as well. The Lobos will be on ATT SportsNet/ROOT eight times, on CBS Sports Network five times, ESPN3 five times, and ESPNU and the Mountain West Network on Stadium once. Additionally, two games (at UNLV on January 17 and January 27 at home against Colorado State) are flex games that will be either on ESPNU or ESPN3.

THERE'S NO PLACE LIKE HOME

After two years as WisePies Arena - The Pit, the famous home of Lobo basketball has been given a new name. While it will still be referred to as "The Pit," this season will be the first that the Lobos will compete in "Dreamstyle Arena" as part of an exciting \$10 million agreement for naming rights by Dreamstyle Remodeling of both of UNM's largest-capacity athletic venues. In addition to the official renaming of the Lobo basketball arena, the UNM football stadium, formerly referred to as "University Stadium" is now officially named "Dreamstyle Stadium."

In conjunction with the new name, The Pit was given a new floor this season, featuring both "New Mexico" and "The Pit" on the baselines, the new university interlocking UNM logo, fresh Mountain West logos customized in the Lobo cherry and silver, cherry free throw lines and dual Dreamstyle Arena logos on both sides of center court.

"The Pit" is nationally recognized as one of the top basketball venues. Need more evidence? How about Sports Illustrated ranking it as one of the top 20 sporting venues, of any sport, in the world for the 20th century. The Pit is truly a special place, and it has created an unparalleled environment for the New Mexico men's basketball program. Since the Mountain West conference began in 1999-2000, New Mexico has ranked in the top two in home attendance among MW teams in every year except one, including 12 seasons as the top-ranked MW team in overall attendance.

LOBOS FROM NEAR AND FAR

Just one Lobo on the 2017-18 roster hails from near as a New Mexico native, freshman Matt Vail. Of the remaining 13 players on the roster, two are from California (Joe Furstinger and Vance Jackson) and two more are from Indiana (Sam Logwood and JaQuan Lyle). That leaves nine players all from different states or countries.

The Lobo melting pot includes players from as close as Arizona (Connor McDougall) and Texas (Antino Jackson) and as far as Alaska (Dane Kuiper), New Jersey (Jachai Simmons), Oregon (Anthony Mathis), Pennsylvania (Troy Simons) and Tennessee (Chris McNeal).

Not only are the Lobos' home towns spread across the United States, but two come from overseas including freshmen Makuach Maluach from Sydney, Australia, and Vladimir Pinchuk from Schwelm, Germany.

Five score in double figures, Lobos claim 78-56 win

ALBUQUERQUE, N.M. --- Paced by five Lobos in double figures, The University of New Mexico men's basketball team rebounded from a four-game losing skid on Wednesday night in Dreamstyle Arena - The Pit, topping Evansville by a score of 78-59 while shooting 49 percent from the floor (30-61).

Senior Sam Logwood and junior Troy Simons led the Lobos (3-4) with 14 points each, with Logwood adding five rebounds. Junior Chris McNeal added 13 points while junior Anthony Mathis and freshman Makuach Maluach chipped in 10 points apiece. The Lobos also posted 23 assists on 30 made baskets, 10 of which came from senior Antino Jackson.

"Obviously it was really good to get a win," head coach Paul Weir said. "I thought we played a lot better tonight. We had a little lull there in the middle of the second half... but you've got to give Evansville credit. I've coached against and scouted against a lot of teams, and Marty Simmons is as good of a basketball coach as I've ever had to scout against. He eats basketball for breakfast. The guy is just awesome."

Jackson's 10 assists marks the second time this season that a Lobo has posted 10 or more assists, despite scoring just two points on the night compared to his usual 9.3 average.

"We've talked about it all week: your shots can't dictate your effect on the game," Weir said. "Antino's ability to push the ball and transition in the second half really helped us win the game."

After entering Wednesday's game ranked fourth in the nation in forced turnovers (21.33) and eighth in turnover margin (6.5), New Mexico forced over 20 turnovers (21) for the fourth time this season while only committing 11, including just three in the second half.

Evansville (5-2) entered the matchup second in the country in three-point percentage (47.8) and the Lobos held the Purple Aces to just 3-of-13 from behind the arc, including 0-for-6 in the first half. Wednesday marked the first time this season that Evansville has been completely denied from the arc in a half.

In addition, the Purple Aces entered the game ranked eighth nationally in scoring defense, allowing just 58.2 points per game. Prior to the Lobos' 78 points, the most Evansville had allowed in a game this season was 63.

The Lobos got off to a quick start as Simons opened the game with an early three-pointer, and UNM followed with an 11-0 run four minutes into the game to take a 16-5 lead, highlighted by back-to-back threes from junior Dane Kuiper. Evansville answered with a 9-0 run to close the gap to 16-14 with six minutes left in the first half.

The Lobos extended the lead back to nine at 25-16 on a pair of Logwood free throws three minutes later, and held a similar margin the rest of the half to enter the break leading 35-27.

New Mexico shot 40 percent from the floor, including 6-of-15 from behind the arc and a perfect 5-for-5 from the charity stripe, compared to Evansville's 33.3 field goal percentage, no three-pointers and 77.8 from the free throw line.

The Lobos opened up a 52-40 lead eight minutes into the second half with threes from McNeal, Simons and Mathis to fire up the crowd and claim the momentum. Four minutes later, another three from Mathis extended the Lobo lead to 19, 62-43.

Senior Joe Furstinger followed with a dunk 30 seconds later and the Lobos continued to run away with the game. An eight-point run fueled by a pair of Logwood layups, a McNeal jumper and a swift jumper from freshman Vladimir Pinchuk increased the lead to 24 with 1:43 left before the final 78-59 score.

The Lobos were able to capitalize on Evansville turnovers, scoring 20 points, while also outscoring the Purple Aces 20-2 on the fast break.

"It feels great (to get the win)," Maluach said. "There's not a better feeling than winning in front of your home crowd. We're a resilient group and we like each other a lot. When we win, we win together, and when we lose, we lose together. Hopefully we win more games than we lose."

New Mexico travels to face UTEP in El Paso, Texas on Saturday, Dec. 2 at 7 p.m.

New Mexico Holds Off UTEP, 78-77

ALBUQUERQUE, N.M. – Junior Elijah Brown hit a jumper with 5.8 seconds left on the clock to help the University of New Mexico men's basketball team to its fifth-straight home victory in WisePies Arena – The Pit, a 78-77 win over the Lobos' second oldest rival, UTEP on Wednesday night. The Lobos are now 6-3 on the season and 5-0 inside The Pit.

"We had a good player make a big shot," said UNM head coach Craig Neal. "It's a one-point win, but it's a win and we'll take it. We just have to get better."

The Lobos tied the game up 74-74 after a Sam Logwood jumper with 1:02 left on the clock. UTEP sunk a three to take a 77-74 lead with 30 seconds left to play. The Lobos then called their final timeout to draw up a play. After the timeout, Jordan Hunter drove into the paint and scored to bring the Lobos within one, 77-76.

Xavier Adams fouled a Miner with 18 seconds left on the clock and UTEP missed with Anthony Mathis picking up the rebound. Brown ended up with the ball and pulled up to hit the game-winner. UTEP tried to hit a three in the final seconds, but it was no good.

"Xavier made some big time plays," Neal said. "If it weren't for him coming in late and making those tough nose plays, I don't think we would have gotten over the hump, but we finally got over it and won a close one."

Brown finished with a season-high 25 points, scoring 16 in the first half. He finished 8-for-13 from the field, 3-for-7 from 3-point range and 6-for-11 from the foul line. He also led the Lobos with six rebounds. Logwood and Hunter were the other Lobos in double digits. Logwood finished with 11 points and a career-high six assists while Hunter finished with 10 points and six assists. Off the bench, Connor MacDougall added nine points.

The Lobos came out with a lot of energy, starting the game off with a 15-2 run into the first media time. They held UTEP to just nine points in the first eight minutes and went up by as much as 21 with 12:27 left in the first half.

UTEP made it an interesting game though as the Miners worked their way back with their three-point offense. They hit six in the first half and continued to push in the second half with nine. The Miners took their first lead of the game with 9:41 left in the game but the Lobos continued to attacked, drawing fouls. The Lobos hit nine straight free throws which tied the game up at 72-72 and led the Lobos to the final minute of the game.

"We gave them way too many threes," said Neal. "We have to continue to work on that."

On the game, the Lobos shot 56.8 percent (25-44) from the field, 50 percent (7-14) from the three and 65.6 percent (21-32) from the free-throw line. They outrebounded the Miners 31-26 and had the advantage in the paint 24-16.

New Mexico is on the road Saturday, traveling to Las Cruces for the second game against Rio Grande Rival New Mexico State. The game will be available on ESPN3 and tip-off is set for 7:30 p.m. MT. Fans can also follow along on 770 Kkob and via live stats at Lobos.statbroadcast.com.

UTEP Falls to NM State, 80-60

EL PASO, TEXAS - A.J. Harris scored 18 points, and Jemerrio Jones had a double-double with 11 points and 13 rebounds as NM State dominated UTEP, 80-60, on Thursday night at the Don Haskins Center.

The Miners (1-6) got off to a strong start, building an 11-5 lead in the first few minutes, but after that it was all Aggies. NM State (5-1) crushed the Miners on the boards (45-25), shot 53.6 percent from the field and scored 20 points off UTEP turnovers – including 16 in the first half.

“We tried to play a little different style tonight and it was new for our team,” said UTEP Interim Head Coach Phil Johnson, who took over for the retired Tim Floyd. “We had 48 hours to get ready. Not an excuse. And we tried to get a little more aggressive offensively because we have been offensively challenged. We haven’t scored the ball very well, and so we wanted to be aggressive and we interpreted that the wrong way. We interpreted that, which I’m not surprised by it, that we shot it very quickly, a lot of forced shots, a lot of quick shots, and those shots didn’t fall. And then the turnovers were really bad. I didn’t think we guarded anybody tonight and I just told the team, and really it was a lot of our veteran guys that disappointed and we told them that. We have one day to get ready to play another good basketball team and then a week [off], and we’ll use those days to get better.”

UTEP had scored 63 and 52 points in the previous two games since losing Matt Willms to a broken hand. That called for some changes to the offensive execution.

“Just coming into this game, again with limited time, we had really looked at our offense, particularly late clock, and there just wasn’t enough attack to us,” Johnson said. “There was a lot of standing around, it became a lot of one-on-one. And if you look at our stats through the last two games, we had seven assists in the Lamar game and eight assists in the New Mexico State game the other night, and tonight we had four. So I told the team, one guy ought to have eight assists. We had Dominic Artis last year many games [where he] would have eight, nine or 10 assists. Our whole team had four. So the ball’s not moving enough and we’re not sharing the ball enough. The change that we made was, let’s get more aggressive with our cutting and screening. We’re living behind the three-point line and we just kind of gave up on it, the team did. I don’t know if they didn’t really understand what we were trying to do, we tried to be real simple with what we were trying to run. And it was just no good. But that’s really with one day of practice, so I guess I shouldn’t expect any more. I am disappointed in some guys’ effort and a few guys with how they defended tonight, because they shot the ball 54 percent. That’s ridiculous. We’ve got to get better at that and we will.”

After the fast start by the Miners, NM State regrouped with a 24-5 run to take a 29-16 lead. The Aggies led 37-23 at the half.

UTEP’s Keith Frazier opened the second-half scoring with a three-pointer and the Miners were only down 11 at 37-26. But NMSU scored the next eight points and that really was the story of the second half. Every time UTEP crept within 15 points, the Aggies went on another run. And the lead ultimately ballooned to as many as 24 points.

After the Aggies went ahead 3-0, the Miners scored 11 of the next 13 points. But that was UTEP’s only run of the night.

“I think we came out real aggressive and they came out with a press which we knew they would, and I thought we did a nice job early against the press,” Johnson said. “Isiah Osborne had two breakaways right off the bat. And we got it at the rim. So that part was good. And we had really worked on that, and I was pleased with it the first seven minutes or so. And then it became quick shots and quick shots led to runouts on their end and rebounding coming in transition. We didn’t get back very well. There really wasn’t anything that I felt like we did very well. But we tried to implement a new style within a few days and we’ll stay with that. We’re not giving up on anything. I heard some guy say we’ve got to play zone. No, we’re not going to go junk everything because we played so poorly. We’re going to get what we do better.”

The Miners were held to 37.5 percent shooting as no player scored in double figures. Keith Frazier, Tirus Smith, Paul Thomas and Trey Touchet scored nine points each.

“The bright spot, I thought we got some good [play] out of Trey Touchet in 21 minutes,” Johnson said. “I thought DeShaun Highler, who has not played this year and is a walk-on, I thought he gave us some good energy. And I was really pleased with Tirus Smith. I thought he posted, I thought he rebounded, I thought he gave effort. I thought he was our toughest guy. But a lot of disappointment, especially with some veterans.”

Harris shot 7-for-8 from the field, 2-for-2 from three and 2-for-2 from the line to lead NM State.

The Miners will host another long-time rival, New Mexico, for the first time since January of 2008 on Saturday. Tip-off is set for 7 p.m. MT and tickets are available by calling 747-5234.

THE GREATEST GAME EVER PLAYED

The Pit was the site of one of the greatest college basketball games ever played. It hosted the 1983 national championship game that saw the NC State Wolfpack upset Hakeem Olajuwon, Clyde Drexler and the Houston Cougars. Coach Jimmy Valvano and the Wolfpack downed the Cougars on a last second put back by Lorenzo Charles. The iconic shot of the late Valvano running onto the court looking for a hug is one of the lasting images in college basketball history.

- The Lobos have averaged an astounding 15,410 fans the past 49 years, an amazing 95% of capacity
- The Pit has ranked in the top 25 in attendance nationally nearly every season since the 1966-67 season with 35 seasons in the top ten in the NCAA in attendance
- Led the Mountain West in attendance in 10 of the conference's 15 years of existence
- The floor is named Bob King Court in honor of the former head coach who led the Lobos from 1963 to 1972.

Lobos Break Records in Season Opener, Win 147-76

ALBUQUERQUE, N.M. --- The University of New Mexico men's basketball team shocked a crowd of over 10,500 fans in Dreamstyle Arena - The Pit in its first regular-season outing under first-year head coach Paul Weir on Saturday night. The Lobos shattered the UNM record for points scored in a game (136), claiming a 147-76 victory over Northern New Mexico.

The 71-point victory margin also ties the nearly 45-year-old record for largest victory margin, which occurred on December 29, 1972 against Dartmouth at The Pit.

Northern New Mexico is now 2-8 on the season while the Lobos start out 1-0 for the 15th straight season.

"I am extremely thankful to every fan that came through the door tonight and hopefully they'll continue to come out and support us as we try and earn their trust and their respect as a basketball program," Coach Weir said. "Obviously (this was) the kind of offensive game we've been looking for. Our last scrimmage was a very similar outcome, so we're thankful that we're shooting the ball the way we are."

The fiery Lobo offense dominated early and refused to let up. UNM got out to a 15-point lead less than five minutes into the first half, taking a 22-7 advantage with 15:38 still remaining in the first half. The Eagles went on an ensuing 7-0 run, testing the Lobo defense and cutting the home lead to eight, but UNM quickly pushed back ahead and extended the lead to 20 on a three from junior Troy Simmons with 9:43 left.

The Lobos concluded the first-half performance with a trio of back-to-back-to-back 3-pointers, two from junior Anthony Mathis and a third from junior transfer Chris McNeal. McNeal collected four threes in the first half alone and helped pace UNM to a 74-point first-half showing, just two points shy of the UNM record for most points in a single half. The record is 76, which occurred on November 23, 1990 against Texas-Arlington.

The Lobos shot 61 percent from the field in the first half (25-41) and 50 percent from 3-point range (10-20). Three players had reached double digits including McNeal (13), senior Sam Logwood (12) and freshman Makuach Maluach (11).

Junior Dane Kuiper opened the second half with a pair of free throws to put the Lobos up 40, 75-35.

Simons and freshman Vladimir Pinchuk shined in the second half, putting up 11 and 10 points, respectively en route to the victory.

McNeal burst on the scene in his first regular-season game as a Lobo with the first UNM double-double in points and assists since March 2, 2014. He posted a team-best 24 points on the night to go along with 10 assists.

Led by McNeal, eight of the 11 Lobos to hit the floor scored in double digits including Simons (19), Maluach (18), Kuiper (17), Mathis (16), Logwood (14), Pinchuk (12) and senior Antino Jackson (12).

As a team, the Lobos collected 40 assists and 22 steals, both ranking high in Lobo history. Forty assists ties the record for most in a game, which the Lobos had done twice previously, the first on December 16, 1978 against Central Florida and again on November 23, 1990 against Texas-Arlington. Twenty-two steals is the second-most in a game in team history (25 is the record).

On the night, UNM shot 64.7 percent (55-85) from the floor including 46.2 percent from three and 86.4 percent from the free-throw line. The Lobos' 55 field goals is just four shy of the record for most in a game. The Lobos posted 59 in the November 23, 1990 game against Texas-Arlington.

The Lobos also posted an outstanding 18 3-pointers on the night, just two short of the record 20 set on November 13, 2004 against Santa Clara, while defensively UNM posted six blocks and collected 32 defensive rebounds (45 overall). Senior Joe Furstinger led the way with three blocks.

Lobos Top Omaha with Second Straight 100+ Game

ALBUQUERQUE, N.M. --- The University of New Mexico men's basketball team posted its first back-to-back 100+ point games since December 1998 on Tuesday night as the Lobos routed the visiting Omaha Mavericks 103-71 in their Nike N7 game. Junior transfer Troy Simmons paced the Lobos with 24 points that included six 3-pointers on the night.

The Nike N7 jersey auction in Dreamstyle Arena raised over \$2,500 for the NB3 Foundation and American Indian Student Services (AISS).

Four Lobos scored in double figures including Simons and seniors Antino Jackson (19), Sam Logwood (18) and Joe Furstinger (11). Furstinger's 11 points marks a new career-best for the senior, who has tallied a previous high of nine points twice in his career, including Saturday's game against Northern New Mexico. He also tied his career-best in free throws (5) and blocks (4).

Coach Weir earned his 30th career victory on the night as the Lobos improve to 2-0. Omaha falls to 0-3 on the season.

The Lobos opened the game with an 8-0 run over the first 2:30, half which came from Furstinger. Omaha followed with a 7-0 run as the Lobos struggled to find a consistent offensive flow, closing the gap to make it 19-16 UNM midway through the first half.

Alternating scoring droughts for both teams caused the score to remain close through the remainder of the first half, sending UNM into the locker room up by just one, 35-34. The Lobos shot an unimpressive 34.1 percent from the field and 20 percent from 3-point range compared to 37 percent from the floor and 35.7 percent from the arc for the Mavericks.

The second half was another story as the Lobos stormed past Omaha and didn't look back. In the second half, the Lobos shot 55.6 percent from the field and an outstanding 68.4 percent from 3-point range, hitting 13 triples en route to a 68-point second-half performance while limiting Omaha to just 37 points.

"I thought in the second half, we kept our defensive energy up and our offensive energy ended up coming around," head coach Paul Weir said. "I was much more pleased with our defensive energy in the second half."

"As far as our style of play, it's how we want to play and it went the way we wanted to. We were able to shoot the way we wanted to and hopefully we continue playing this way moving forward."

Simons's six 3-pointers combined with five from Jackson, three from junior Anthony Mathis, two from junior Chris McNeal and another from freshman Makuach Maluach - his first as a Lobo.

The UNM advantage was held within single digits until midway through the second half when the Lobos pulled away - fast. Sparked by a pair of Furstinger free throws and a three from McNeal, the Lobos took off on a 9-0 run in just one minute, taking a reachable 63-57 game to a 72-57 contest. McNeal's three was set up after he snagged a steal and, just 10 seconds later, Simons grabbed another steal in the Lobos' full-court press and posted the layup.

The 15-point lead was stretched to a 30-point blowout with four minutes left, 92-62 on a pair of Logwood free throws. Logwood went 10-for-11 from the stripe on the night, doubling his previous career-best five free throws in a single game.

It was a Jackson three that put the Lobos over 100 with 1:09 left. With seven seconds left on the clock, Omaha's Alex Alberry hit a three to cut the 35-point Lobo lead to 32 to close the game.

The Lobos are averaging 29.5 turnovers forced per game to start the season to go along with 44.5 field goals and 58.5 bench points. In the last two games, UNM has hit 35 3-pointers, at least 17 per game. Last season, it took nine games to reach that mark.

UNM out rebounded the Mavericks 48-37 including 19-9 offensive boards and forced 26 turnovers on the night.

Men's Basketball Upended by TTU in Final Minute

ALBUQUERQUE, N.M. --- For the first time since 2006-07, the Lobos have opened their first four games with three scoring over 90 points, but it wasn't enough on Tuesday night as Tennessee Tech pulled ahead for good in the final minute for a 103-96 win over New Mexico in Dreamstyle Arena - The Pit.

Junior Chris McNeal led UNM with 29 points on the night marking the third time this season he has scored in double digits, the second over 20 points. McNeal went 8-for-16 from the field and 7-for-11 from behind the arc to go along with 6-of-8 from the free throw line.

Tennessee Tech (4-1) started the game going 0-for-10 from the field over the first 5:31, allowing the Lobos (2-2) to go on an 8-0 run and claim a nine-point advantage (10-1) with 14:29 left to play in the first half. The Lobos extended their lead to 14 over the next four minutes (24-13, 10:10) until TTU's Aleksa Jugovic scored a trio of 3-pointers in the next three Golden Eagle possessions to cut the UNM lead to eight.

TTU closed the final 10:40 of the first half shooting 15-of-19 from the field. In the first half, Jugovic couldn't miss, going 8-for-8 from the field including 6-for-6 from 3-point range and 2-for-2 from the charity stripe. His efforts helped make it a one-point game with 10 seconds left in the half until a Dane Kuiper three with two seconds on the clock stretched the Lobo lead to four at the half.

"You have to tip your cap to them," head coach Paul Weir said. "They shot the heck out of the ball tonight and made a lot of shots at the back of it. Some of them were tough and some of them were probably on us. They were good, and they were better than us tonight."

McNeal got hot toward the end of the first half, drilling three-straight threes in under a minute and picked up where he left off. He opened the second half with a three 17 seconds in to give the Lobos what would be their largest lead of the second half, seven (58-81), before the teams battled throughout the remainder of the contest.

With the Lobos trailing by one point with 1:06 left to play, 94-93, the Golden Eagles took off on an 8-0 run over 35 seconds to get out to a nine-point lead, 102-93 with 21 seconds left. Kuiper drained another three with 12 seconds left to give the Lobos hope, 102-96, but the six-point margin was too much for the final seconds.

McNeal paced the Lobos with 29 points and was followed by senior Sam Logwood with 21. The last time UNM had a pair of 20-point scorers was almost a year ago on January 7 against Nevada.

The third Lobo to score in double figures on the night was junior Anthony Mathis who notched 11, going 4-for-7 from the field and 3-for-6 from three. The outing marked the third time this season that he registered double digits.

Senior Joe Furstinger neared a double-double on the night, scoring seven points and bringing down nine rebounds. He also tied his career-high in blocks with four.

As a team, the Lobos shot 40.6 percent from the field compared to 55.7 percent for TTU. Similarly, UNM went 41 percent from three compared to 54.5 percent to the Golden Eagles, but the Lobos did have the advantage in free throws, shooting 82.8 percent (24-29) from the line compared to just 75 percent (24-32) for TTU.

After suffering drastically on the glass against New Mexico State, the Lobos stepped up their rebound game but were still out rebounded 39-32.

TTU registered 42 points in the paint to 20 for UNM and held a 49-9 fast-break point advantage. The Lobos edged the Golden Eagles in second-chance points, 13-9, and in points off of turnovers, 24-22.

"We looked like the ninth-place team in the Mountain West tonight," Weir said. Which I never thought we were going to be and we just have to do everything in our power to make sure that this is not going to be our final destination. All I can tell you is that we are going to do whatever we can to work our way out of whatever we're in right now."

"We're not discouraged," McNeal said. "We're just going to try and bounce back, come back tomorrow and work even harder. Try to turn this around."

UNM will return to action on Friday, Nov. 24 when the Lobos compete in the third round of the Emerald Coast Classic against TCU at 5 p.m. MT. TCU is currently receiving votes in the USA Today Coaches Poll. Both Friday and Saturday's games will be available to watch on CBS Sports Network.

Lobo Comeback Falls Short vs (RV) TCU

NICEVILLE, FLA. --- The University of New Mexico men's basketball team lost a heartbreaker on Friday night after nearly pulling off an upset over (RV) TCU at the Emerald Coast Classic in Niceville, Fla. The Lobos came back from a 13-point deficit and looked to junior Chris McNeal for a game-winning 3-pointer with 1.9 seconds left in regulation, but it went wide and UNM fell 69-67.

Senior Sam Logwood led New Mexico with a career-high 27 points, leading a trio of Lobos who scored in double figures including McNeal and junior Antino Jackson (12 apiece).

The Lobos will face either St. Bonaventure or Maryland Saturday at 2 p.m. MT (3 p.m. CT).

As a team, despite being outshot and out-rebounded, the Lobos (2-3) forced 16 turnovers on TCU (5-0) and committed just nine to keep them in the game. UNM had 14 points off of turnovers (TCU had 11) and edged TCU 16-14 in second-chance points while the Horned Frogs dominated the paint, outscoring UNM 46-24 down low.

"You have to tip your cap to TCU, it's a big team, a good rebounding team that just kind of continued to punish us inside and they did a really good job," head coach Paul Weir said.

"We're going to play teams very similar to TCU this year, they're going to be bigger than us, stronger than us, they're going to be more experienced than us," Weir said. "They have a lot of things we don't, so we're trying to accentuate the things we have, which to me would be speed, shooting, depth and conditioning and trying to bring those into the game as much as we can."

The Lobos shot a season-low 34.3 percent from the field and 20 percent from 3-point range to hang in with the national vote recipient TCU. The Horned Frogs went 47.5 percent from the field and 28.6 percent from three while the Lobos dominated at the charity stripe, going 15-for-18 for 83.3 percent while TCU was just 9-for-17 (52.9 percent).

The victory marked TCU's ninth straight dating back to last season when the squad captured the NIT Championship.

New Mexico jumped out on top early, getting out to a 9-2 lead with 17:46 left in the first half before TCU chipped away and cut the lead to one.

The Horned Frogs followed with an 11-1 run over three minutes to take a seven-point advantage, 31-24 with 4:08 left in the half. TCU got up by as much a nine before a layup with eight seconds on the clock from senior Joe Furstinger made it seven, 40-33 at the half.

In the second half, TCU pushed the lead out to 13 before the Lobos roared back on a 12-3 run sparked by a jumper and a three from McNeal to get back within four, 61-57 with 8:31 left to play. The run was full of TCU turnovers and Lobo buckets to shift the momentum in favor of UNM.

McNeal hit a big three with the Lobos down five with 12 seconds left to bring the game within two, 69-67. Weir called his only full timeout to draft a play, but McNeal called the Lobos' final timeout on the inbound before the final shot went wide.

Five score in double figures, Lobos claim 78-56 win

ALBUQUERQUE, N.M. --- Paced by five Lobos in double figures, The University of New Mexico men's basketball team rebounded from a four-game losing skid on Wednesday night in Dreamstyle Arena - The Pit, topping Evansville by a score of 78-59 while shooting 49 percent from the floor (30-61).

Senior Sam Logwood and junior Troy Simons led the Lobos (3-4) with 14 points each, with Logwood adding five rebounds. Junior Chris McNeal added 13 points while junior Anthony Mathis and freshman Makuach Maluach chipped in 10 points apiece. The Lobos also posted 23 assists on 30 made baskets, 10 of which came from senior Antino Jackson.

"Obviously it was really good to get a win," head coach Paul Weir said. "I thought we played a lot better tonight. We had a little lull there in the middle of the second half... but you've got to give Evansville credit. I've coached against and scouted against a lot of teams, and Marty Simmons is as good of a basketball coach as I've ever had to scout against. He eats basketball for breakfast. The guy is just awesome."

Jackson's 10 assists marks the second time this season that a Lobo has posted 10 or more assists, despite scoring just two points on the night compared to his usual 9.3 average.

"We've talked about it all week: your shots can't dictate your effect on the game," Weir said. "Antino's ability to push the ball and transition in the second half really helped us win the game."

After entering Wednesday's game ranked fourth in the nation in forced turnovers (21.33) and eighth in turnover margin (6.5), New Mexico forced over 20 turnovers (21) for the fourth time this season while only committing 11, including just three in the second half.

Evansville (5-2) entered the matchup second in the country in three-point percentage (47.8) and the Lobos held the Purple Aces to just 3-of-13 from behind the arc, including 0-for-6 in the first half. Wednesday marked the first time this season that Evansville has been completely denied from the arc in a half.

In addition, the Purple Aces entered the game ranked eighth nationally in scoring defense, allowing just 58.2 points per game. Prior to the Lobos' 78 points, the most Evansville had allowed in a game this season was 63.

The Lobos got off to a quick start as Simons opened the game with an early three-pointer, and UNM followed with an 11-0 run four minutes into the game to take a 16-5 lead, highlighted by back-to-back threes from junior Dane Kuiper. Evansville answered with a 9-0 run to close the gap to 16-14 with six minutes left in the first half.

The Lobos extended the lead back to nine at 25-16 on a pair of Logwood free throws three minutes later, and held a similar margin the rest of the half to enter the break leading 35-27.

New Mexico shot 40 percent from the floor, including 6-of-15 from behind the arc and a perfect 5-for-5 from the charity stripe, compared to Evansville's 33.3 field goal percentage, no three-pointers and 77.8 from the free throw line.

The Lobos opened up a 52-40 lead eight minutes into the second half with threes from McNeal, Simons and Mathis to fire up the crowd and claim the momentum. Four minutes later, another three from Mathis extended the Lobo lead to 19, 62-43.

Senior Joe Furstinger followed with a dunk 30 seconds later and the Lobos continued to run away with the game. An eight-point run fueled by a pair of Logwood layups, a McNeal jumper and a swift jumper from freshman Vladimir Pinchuk increased the lead to 24 with 1:43 left before the final 78-59 score.

The Lobos were able to capitalize on Evansville turnovers, scoring 20 points, while also outscoring the Purple Aces 20-2 on the fast break.

"It feels great (to get the win)," Maluach said. "There's not a better feeling than winning in front of your home crowd. We're a resilient group and we like each other a lot. When we win, we win together, and when we lose, we lose together. Hopefully we win more games than we lose."

New Mexico travels to face UTEP in El Paso, Texas on Saturday, Dec. 2 at 7 p.m.
