ABOUT THE MATCH-UP

- New Mexico and Southern California will meet for the fourth time in five seasons on Saturday, and the second time in the Craig Neal and Andy Enfield eras. UNM is 2-1 against the Trojans since 2011. The overall series is tied at 6-6.
- The Lobos enter the game 3-0 on the season with wins over Texas Southern (86-57), New Mexico State (83-74) on the road and most recently, Loyola-Chicago (75-51). In all three games, the Lobos have had three different leading scorers. Cullen Neal scored 22 against TSU, Elijah Brown dropped 31 against NMSU and Tim Williams dropped 22 against LUC.
- USC is off to a strong start at 2-0 during the early season. The Trojans have defeated San Diego to open the season, 83-45, and Monmouth, 101-90. Both games were played at home in the Galen Center.
- The Lobos will be looking to exact revenge on the Trojans. Last year, the Trojans won a game inside WisePies Arena, 66-54, to become one of three programs to win a nonconference game inside The Pit since 2011. Also, the Trojans' 38 point win over San Diego came in LaMont Smith's debut, who was the associate head coach under Craig Neal the last two seasons.
- USC is led by Andy Enfield in his third year at the helm. He took over the USC program in April of 2013 after two seasons at Florida Gulf Coast. Enfield led that program to a 15th seed in the NCAA Tournament and defeated Georgetown and San Diego State in the postseason.

NEW MEXICO GAME NOTES

LAST TIME OUT

The (-/RV) University of New Mexico men's basketball team (3-0) snapped the Loyola-Chicago Rambler's (2-1) seven-game winning streak Wednesday in a 75-51 victory in WisePies Arena. Tim Williams became the third different leading scorer in as many games, with 22 points on 10-for-14 shooting, the most he's scored as a Lobo. He also brought down seven rebounds and a game-high tying four assists. Sam Logwood scored 12 points on a perfect 5-for-5 shooting, including two 3-pointers. Obij Aget had a season-high eight rebounds to go with eight points on 4-for-5 shooting. The winning streak that LUC held was the longest in the nation, tied with NIT Champions Stanford.

INJURIES

Injuries were a big part of the storyline in 2014-15, with five players missing a total of 52 games. Unfortunately, injuries have already taken out two players on the Lobo roster this season. JJ N'Ganga will miss the entire season due to injury. On Wednesday, Craig Neal announced that Devon Williams has been advised to end his basketball career following a neck injury at New Mexico State. The Lobos dedicated their effort Wednesday to Williams, with all of the players writing "DWill" on their shoes.

VERSATILITY

Despite the injuries, the Lobos have still shown plenty of versatility. The Lobos have had three different players have marquee games in three games. Cullen Neal scored a season-high 22 points against Texas Southern and could have scored much more. Neal logged 16 points in the first half, helping the team build a near 30 point lead. Elijah Brown had his big night at New Mexico State University, scoring 31 points en route to Mountain West Player of the Week honors. Finally, against Loyola-Chicago, Tim Williams scored 22 points on 10-for-14 shooting, his highest total as a Lobo. Williams also led the Lobos with four assists after not logging any assists entering the night.

HOT SHOOTING

Although the defense has been a highlight so far this season, the offense has been efficient as well. Through three games, the Lobos are shooting 54.7 percent from the floor, shooting 88-for-161 overall. The Lobos' shooting percentage, as of Nov. 19, ranks 13th in the nation. Among top 15 teams, New Mexico is the only one to have played three games as of the morning of Nov. 19. Boise State leads the Mountain West in shooting percentage at 55.5 percent, but only through two games. Butler, with just one game against Citadel, leads the nation at 63.6 percent. On Wednesday, the Lobos shot 61.7 percent from the floor on 29-for-47 shooting, their best mark of the early season.

ELIJAH BROWN - MOUNTAIN WEST PLAYER OF THE WEEK

University of New Mexico men's basketball starting guard Elijah Brown has been named the first Mountain West Conference Player of the Week of the 2015-16 season. In wins over Texas Southern and New Mexico State, both of whom were picked to win their conference, Brown averaged a conference-best 23.5 points per game on 54 percent shooting from the floor. He made timely buckets all week and reached the foul line consistently, converting on 15 of his 17 free throw attempts. Brown also helped create opportunities for his teammates and averaged a team-high four assists per game, earning an assist to turnover ratio of 2.7. He is currently second on the team with 4.5 rebounds per game.

Brown had a career night on Sunday in an 83-74 win at New Mexico State and scored 31 points on 8-for-17 shooting. In the season-opener against Texas Southern, Brown scored 16 points on 6-for-9 shooting and recorded a team-best six assists. The sophomore becomes the first Lobo to earn the first MW Player of the Week honor of the season since Mark Walters in 2004.

NEW MEXICO GAME NOTES

PACE OF PLAY

Head coach Craig Neal has made a point to play a more up tempo style in 2015-16. Last season, the Lobos averaged 62 points per game on an average of 62.5 possessions per game. This year, with the 30 second shot clock, the Lobos have improved to 81.3 points per game on an average of 69.8 possessions per game. Despite the increase from last season, the Lobos are still under the national average of 71.9. The possession average was hurt against Loyola-Chicago, who doubled up New Mexico's backcourt often, for which the Lobos took advantage of in the paint but subsequently slowed the game down. During exhibition play, the Lobos averaged over 78 possessions per game against two Division II opponents.

GETTING DEFENSIVE

The cherry and silver have continued last season's defense prowess. Last year, they held opponents to just 60.2 points per game, which was the second-best defensive scoring mark posted by a UNM team in the last three decades. The Lobos were the last team in the nation to concede 70 points in a game after allowing 70 points to Colorado State in their 24th game of the season. It was New Mexico's best defensive scoring start to a season since World War II.

So far this year, the Lobos are living up to their lofty defensive expectations. They are holding opponents to 35.7 percent shooting from the floor and 25.8 percent shooting from 3-point range. Despite the Lobos forcing an up tempo style so far this season, opponents have only scored 60.7 points per game.

RIO GRANDE RIVALRY

The University of New Mexico men's basketball team won its eighth straight game in Las Cruces, New Mexico, and 14 out of the last 16 meetings, against the New Mexico State Aggies Sunday, 83-74. The Lobos were led by a career-night from sophomore Elijah Brown, who scored 31 points on 8-for-17 shooting. The guard scored 13 of his points at the line out of 14 attempts. It's the most points a Lobo has scored since Alex Kirk dropped in 32 on Nov. 22, 2013. He also tied the game-high of six rebounds. Fellow sophomore Cullen Neal scored 18 points with five rebounds. The Lobos are now 1-0 this year in the Rio Grande Rivalry series, with the second game slated for Dec. 16 at home.

CANNED FOOD DRIVE

New Mexico athletics held its annual Canned Food Drive Wednesday during the game against Loyola-Chicago. Fans received a \$10 ticket in bench Rows 1-10 in exchange for a canned food donation at time of purchase at the Lobo Ticket Office in WisePies Arena. Donations went directly to the Road Runner Food Bank, serving the community here in Albuquerque.

MOUNTAIN WEST-MISSOURI VALLEY CHALLENGE SERIES

The Loyola-Chicago game was part of the renewed Mountain West/Missouri Valley Challenge Series. The previous series ran from 2009-10 through 2012-13, with the MW compiling a 22-13 record. During that span, the Lobos went 4-0, the most wins of any team in the league. The Lobos defeated Creighton in 2009, 66-61; Southern Illinois in 2010, 74-59; Missouri State in 2011, 76-60; 17 and Indiana State in 2012, 77-68 (OT). With the win Wednesday, the Lobos are 18 now 9-8 all-time against Missouri Valley teams.

NEW MEXICO GAME NOTES

CONFERENCE FAVORITES DEFEATED

The Lobos are 2-0 against both Texas Southern and New Mexico State to start 2015-16. Both opponents were considered the top dogs in their respective conferences. Texas Southern won the SWAC last season and was the preseason pick to win it again. Likewise, New Mexico State was selected by the coaches and the media to win the WAC and accept their bid to the NCAA Tournament, as they did last year. After Wednesday, all three of the Lobos' opponents received at least one first place vote in their respective preseason polls.

OPENING STRONG

Since the 1950-51 season, the New Mexico Lobos are 55-11 (.833) in season openers. That record includes a 47-5 (.904) mark in season openers in Albuquerque. That record is boosted by season-opening wins for the last 13 straight seasons. The last time the Lobos dropped a season-opener was against California on Nov. 23, 2002, 76-68. Despite the wide margin of victory Friday night for the Lobos, it was not close to the widest margin in a season opener during the 13-year stretch. In 2013, the Lobos defeated Alabama A&M 88-52 to open 2013-14. Two years prior, UNM defeated New Orleans 92-40.

The Lobos' big win over SWAC preseason favorites, Texas Southern, marked multiple milestones that were never reached in the 2014-15 campaign. The Lobos scored a whopping 54 points in the first half, the first time the team scored 50 in a first half since Nov. 17, 2013 against Charleston Southern. The Lobos hit the 20 assist mark, the first time they had reached 20 in a game since Dec. 17, 2014 against Central Arkansas. The team's 86 points marked the first time the Lobos had crossed 80 since March 5, 2014, when the Lobos faced Air Force.

The Lobos dawned jerseys with camouflage lettering. An auction was held for the game-worn jerseys that netted \$3,200 that will be donated to the UNM Veterans Resource Center.

GETTING IN TIME

Head coach Craig Neal suited up 16 players for exhibition play and used all of his active players at some point. He made it clear in a press conference prior to Friday's opener that no player wanted to take a red shirt for this season. Therefore, Neal has continued to dig deep into his bench, using all 16 of his players at some point in the first three games. In the first two contests, Neal used a 13-man rotation and showed a variety of lineups. On Wednesday against Loyola-Chicago, Neal used 15 players and allowed Adam Cumber, Connor Joy and Michael Nesbitt to make their debuts in WisePies Arena. Joy, a manager for three seasons, made a 3-pointer in his first possession that received a roaring ovation from the Lobo bench.
