TAKING ON THE AGGIES

Tuesday marks the 243rd meeting between New Mexico and New Mexico State (the most games UNM has played against any single opponent) with the Lobos holding a 158-84 record against their in-state foes. The Lobos won three of four matchups against the Aggies last season with the lone loss coming in El Paso while winning in Roswell, Albuquerque and Las Cruces. Also of note, the teams played a pair of one-run contests last season with UNM coming out on top of both those, 3-2. The Lobos have won seven of their last nine against NMSU - though New Mexico had dropped nine of their previous 10 to the Aggies before this recent stretch that started in 2013.

ABOUT NEW MEXICO STATE

New Mexico State is coming off a turnaround 2016 campaign - going from 11-38-1 in 2015 to 34-23 last season. This season, NMSU is off to a 9-5 start after taking three of four from Yale over the weekend. The Aggies' losses have come to Bryant (2), nationally ranked Texas Tech, Arizona State and Yale (on Friday - NMSU won the final three games of the series). NMSU and New Mexico have played one common opponent in Texas Tech with the Aggies losing 16-1 and the Lobos losing 7-2 (both games were in Lubbock).



- Birmingham coached the Lobos to their first three MW Tournament Championships in 2011-12 and 2016. The Lobos also shared the regular-season crown in both 2012 and 2014, and won the league by a record seven games in 2013.
- Attained highest RPI in UNM history (No. 19) in 2010 and its highest ranking ever (No. 13 by *Baseball America*) in 2013.
- Earned his 1,000th collegiate victory with a 19-5 victory at Air Force on April 6, 2013.
- Coached his 1,500th collegiate game on Thursday, May 23, 2013, in the Mountain West Tournament against Nevada.
- Guided New Mexico Junior College to the 2005 NJCAA National Championship and were the national runner-up in 2007.
- Birmingham set the foundations for the programs at College of the Southwest (1988-89) and NMJC (1990-2007).
- Birmingham began his coaching career at Las Cruces Mayfield High School where the Trojans won the 4A championship in 1981 and had three No. 1 rankings through 1983.

HOME, SWEET HOME

On March 24, 2013, the UNM baseball team moved into its new old home. After spending most of the previous nine seasons at Isotopes Park, the Lobos returned to a newly renovated Santa Ana Star Field with astounding success. After losing two of their first five games in their new home park, the Lobos finished the season with 11 straight wins at home to post a 14-2 record at Santa Ana Star Field.

LAST TIME OUT FOR UNM ... The Lobos are coming off an explosive series against Air Force in which they swept the Falcons while scoring a combined 59 runs on 68 hits in the three-game set in Colorado.

The Lobos opened the series Friday with a 19-5 victory over Air Force. Six UNM players had multiple hits in a contest where the Lobos scored in eight of the nine innings. Jack Zoellner led the way by going 4-for-6 with a home run, double and three RBI while Andre Gregory was 3-for-6 with two doubles and four RBI. Tyler Stevens got the win, going 7.2 innings and giving up five runs on eight hits with nine strikeouts and one walk (he shut out Air Force through the first six innings as the Lobos built a 14-0 advantage).

The second game of the series Saturday was a wild contest that saw a combined 27 runs scored in the first three innings (Air Force led 15-12) before Justin Slaten entered in relief for the Lobos and limited the Falcons to just one run over the final 4.2 innings to pick up his first collegiate win. The freshman got the victory thanks to the Lobos exploding for eight runs in the ninth inning to pull away for a 24-16 victory. Eight of the nine Lobo starters had multiple hits with Stajduhar tying a career high with five RBI as he went 4-for-6 with a home run and two doubles. Danny Collier set a career high with five runs scored for New Mexico.

In game three, the Lobos found themselves down 7-4 heading into the eighth inning before another eight-run outburst helped UNM pull away from the Falcons for an eventual 16-7 victory. Zoellner again exploded, going 5-for-5 with a home run and four RBI while Luis Gonzalez went 4-for-5 with three doubles, an RBI and four runs. Drew Gillespie picked up his first career victory in relief for the Lobos.

Overall for the series, the Lobos hit .496 in the series as Gonzalez (.786), Mang (.700), Zoellner (.588) and Stajduhar (.563) all hit above .500 in the three-game set.

Leading the way for NMSU are a trio of hitters above the .400 mark in average in Austin Botello (.464), Marcus Still (.426) and Joey Ortiz (.404).

Botello has a pair of home runs and is tied with Tristen Carranza for the team lead in RBI with 21 while he's second on the team in doubles with six. Carranza leads the team with four home runs.

Overall, NMSU has eight players who have made at least 10 starts for them this season hitting above .333.

The Aggie pitching staff is sporting a 5.23 ERA on the season. Tuesday's starter Chris Kucko is 0-0 with a 5.40 ERA in two games (one start) this season as he's given up six hits and two runs in 3.1 innings of work with a pair of strikeouts.

Out of the bullpen NMSU closer Ruger Rodriguez hasn't given up a run and just one hit in 3.2 innings of work with a pair of saves and six strikeouts in four appearances.

IN-STATE TALENT ON THE FIELD TUESDAY ...

New Mexico and NMSU both have in-state talent on their rosters as the Lobos feature 13 players from the Land of Enchantment while the Aggies have four.

LOBOS COME IN AT NO. 3 IN FIRST RPI RELEASED ...

UNM boasts one of the toughest non-conference schedules in the country and a 7-3 start with that schedule has the Lobos at No. 3 in the first RPI released Sunday night by the NCAA.

UNM sits only behind Arizona and Michigan State in the national rankings and are just ahead of No. 4 Baylor and No. 5 TCU (ranked No. 1 in all of the human polls).

RUNS & HITS GALORE ...

UNM's big weekend at Air Force included a 24-16 win over that saw rarified numbers produced - even for the Lobos.

The 24 runs were the most for the Lobos since defeating Coppin State 29-3 on April 18, 2010, and their 28 hits was the most since racking up 29 in that same game.

The Lobos were still seven runs off their program record of 31 set against Air Force on April 17, 2004, and four hits off their program record of 32 set against Fresno State on April 1, 1999.

NOT ONE, NOT TWO, NOT THREE, NOT FOUR, BUT ...

UNM junior Danny Collier did something a Lobo hasn't done in nearly seven years as he scored five runs during Saturday's 24-16 victory over Air Force.

He's the first Lobo to score five runs in a game since Justin Howard scored six

against Coppin State on April 18, 2010.

GONZALEZ'S BIG WEEK LEADS TO MW PLAYER OF THE WEEK (Feb. 20-26) ... For the second week in a row to start the season the Lobos have earned the Mountain West Player of the Week as Luis Gonzalez was selected for the honor.

The junior outfielder hit .727 (8-for-11) with a home run, two doubles, two RBI, two stolen bases and three runs on the road against No. 23 Dallas Baptist. He also drew five walks and reached base 13 of his 16 plate appearances, including reaching base in 11 of his final 12.

RUN SCORING STREAK FOR VIGIL ... Andre Vigil started a nice streak for himself to start the 2017 campaign as the senior scored a run in each of the Lobos' first six games.

Overall, he has scored 13 runs and already has doubled his career home run total entering the season with two blasts early in 2017.

ZOELLNER TABBED MW PLAYER OF THE WEEK (Feb. 13-19) ... Jack Zoellner was the story of the weekend against Binghamton for the Lobos at the plate as the senior went 6-for-12 with three home runs, a double, eight RBI and five runs to earn Mountain West Player of the Week honors.

Zoellner's three home runs and six RBI in the Feb. 18 win over Binghamton were both career highs. This is the first time Zoellner has been selected for this honor.

INNING TO REMEMBER ... Freshman Beau Capanna had an inning to remember against Binghamton in his collegiate debut Feb. 19.

In his first plate appearance as a Lobo in the third inning, Capanna singled, stole second base and eventually scored. As the Lobos kept putting together hits for what would be a seven-run inning, Capanna came up again and hit an RBI single - and stole another base.

When the damage was done in the third inning, Capanna went 2-for-2 with two

stolen bases, a run and an RBI. Not a bad debut to say the least.

MOUNTAIN WEST FAVORITES ... The Lobos are the favorites in the Mountain West according to the conference's preseason coaches' poll.

The defending Mountain West Tournament champion Lobos, who went 39-23 and reached the NCAA postseason for the fifth time in seven seasons in 2016, picked up four first-place votes and edged Fresno State (which had three first-place votes) by a point for the top spot in the preseason poll (each program voted, but could not vote for themselves). Following UNM and Fresno State was Nevada and San Diego State in third and fourth, respectively, Air Force and UNLV tied for fifth and San Jose State seventh.

TO BE THE BEST, YOU GOT TO PLAY THE BEST

... The Lobos take on arguably one of the toughest non-conference schedules in the country in 2017 with five NCAA postseason opponents - including two College World Series participants - and a combined winning percentage of almost .600 between the Lobos' 10 non-conference foes.

UNM faces CWS teams Texas Tech (lost on the road 7-2 on Feb. 28 - also play in Lubbock April 11; at home April 25-26) and Oklahoma State (on the road March 14-15) along with fellow 2016 NCAA postseason teams Cal State Fullerton (on the road March 17-19), Dallas Baptist (the Lobos took one of three from the No. 23 Patriots, losing the rubber match in extra innings) and Binghamton (a team the Lobos swept already Feb. 17-19 by a combined score of 29-12).

Four of those teams finished in the top 30 of the NCBWA's final rankings in No. 4 Oklahoma State, No. 5 Texas Tech, No. 24 Dallas Baptist and No. 29 Cal State Fullerton.

Of the Lobos' 26 non-conference games, 21 are against teams that finished above .500 last season with 15 against NCAA postseason qualifiers. All 10 teams on the Lobos' non-conference schedule finished with 25 or more victories.

Along with taking on five NCAA postseason teams, the Lobos face a Missouri State team (at home April 13-15) that finished 38-21 in 2016 and lost in the 12th inning of the Missouri Valley Conference Tournament championship game to Dallas Baptist.

UNM faces in-state foe New Mexico State (34-23 last season) three times in three locations - March 7 in El Paso at Southwest University Park, March 28 (6:30 p.m.) at New Mexico State and May 2 (6:30 p.m.) at Santa Ana Star Field in Albuquerque.




