NEW MEXICO NOTES

THE LAST TIME OUT

The Lobos are coming off another weekend on the road - this time against a pair of Big Sky schools in Weber State and Idaho State. UNM tied with Weber State 0-0 on Friday (Sept. 2) in Ogden, Utah, and used a Claire Lynch goal in the 86th minute to beat Idaho State 4-3 on Sunday (Sept. 4) in Pocatello, Idaho.

🏲 🏲 FIRST-TIME MEETING WITH ANTELOPES

Friday marks the first time the Lobos will face Grand Canyon University. The Antelopes enter the contest on a two-game winning streak after dropping their first four contests of the season. GCU defeated Northern Arizona 5-0 on Friday for their first win of 2016 before edging Northern Colorado 1-0 on Sunday - with both wins coming at home. Milla Benedetti, Rachel Mina and Madison Cox are pacing the Antelopes with two goals apiece while Blakely Fraasch has seen every minute for GCU at goalkeeper with a 1.49 goals against average.

NAU LUMBERJACKS

MEETING NO. 10 FOR LOBOS. LUMBERJACKS

When UNM and Northern Arizona meet Sunday, it will be the 10th time the two schools have faced each other with the Lobos holding a 6-2-1 edge in the series. However, it will be the first time the two teams have met since Sept. 25, 2009, when the Lumberjacks

won 2-1. The Lobos last defeated the Lumberjacks in 2007, a 1-0 win in Flagstaff. NAU enters this weekend 1-4 on the season, having lost three straight. The Lumberjacks' lone win this season came at home against New Mexico State, 1-0. NAU has scored four goals this season with no player scoring more than one.

IRWIN SHINES VERSUS BENGALS

In the victory over Idaho State, UNM senior Maddie Irwin scored twice on back-to-back headers less than four minutes apart in the first half to turn a 1-1 tie into a 3-1 advantage for the Lobos. Irwin then set up the game-winning goal when she headed a ball to Claire Lynch in the 86th minute who then one-timed it in for the game winner. Irwin is the first player with multiple goals in a non-conference match for the Lobos since Ruth Bruciaga had a hat trick against New Mexico State on Sept. 19, 2014. Also, Irwin has three of her eight career goals against Idaho State as she scored in last season's 4-1 win over the Bengals in Albuquerque.

FIRST TIME IN A LONG TIME ... 3 GOALS ALLOWED \$ WIN

Sunday's 4-3 victory over Idaho State marked the first time in 19 years the Lobos allowed three goals and won a game. The last time the Lobos allowed three goals and won a contest was Oct. 5, 1997, when UNM defeated Oklahoma 5-3. It's the second time in program history the Lobos have allowed three goals and won.

LOBOS USING THEIR HEADS

During their 4-3 victory over Idaho State, the Lobos scored their first three goals all via headers - and within five minutes of each other to turn a 1-0 deficit into a 3-1 lead.

Lynch approaching lobo all-time top 10 in goals

Claire Lynch's goal Sunday was the 11th of her career and has her approaching the program's all-time top-10 list for goals. She's one goal behind the No. 10 spot, occupied by Michelle Nowfel (1999-02), and three behind being tied for the No. 7 spot with a trio of former Lobos (Lindsey Guice, Zaneta Wyne and Dani Rangel).

LOCAL TALENT A STRONG INFLUENCE ON 2016 ROSTER

The 2016 Lobos will have plenty of home-grown talent on the roster as 14 players are from New Mexico. Ten of those players are from the Albuquerque area while two are from Farmington and one each are from Carlsbad and Tucumcari. It's not only the players that have New Mexico ties as head coach Heather Dyche is an Albuquerque Eldorado High School graduate and assistant coach Paul Maestas is a Lobo grad and a former high school, state-title winning coach at Eldorado High School.

Lobos' muñoz plays for mexico u20 team

UNM sophomore Jennifer Muñoz spent this past summer trying out, making and eventually starting for Mexico's U20 Women's National Team. Muñoz started 19 games last season for the Lobos, tallying one assist in 1,566 minutes of play.

CHAVEZ NAMED 2015-16 LOBO CLUB STUDENT-ATHLETE OF YEAR

Defender Emily Chavez earned the prestigious honor of being named the Lobo Club Student-Athlete of the Year for 2015-16. Chavez, who earned All-Mountain West honorable mention and Mountain West All-Academic honors last season, became the third player in MW history to win both an offensive and defensive player of the week honors in her career. The junior from La Cueva High School in Albuquerque has started 38 games in her two-plus years for the Lobos and has three goals and three assists.

Another Stellar Year in the classroom

The University of New Mexico women's soccer program maintained a strong academic record during the 2015-16 school year, posting a spring GPA of 3.46. The program has posted an astounding 12 straight semesters of having a team GPA of 3.4 or higher. In the fall, the Lobos reached a GPA of 3.59. The high standard for the women's soccer program has been recognized over the years, with the 2015 season marking the 10th straight year in which the Lobos earned Academic All-District honors. In 2015, a pair of seniors, Cassie Ulrich from Rio Rancho, N.M. and Alyssa Coonrod from Albuquerque, N.M., were named to the 2015 CoSIDA/Academic All-District VII Team.

DYCHE ASSISTS U.S. SOCCER DURING OLYMPICS

Head coach Heather Dyche traveled to Brazil this summer to assist the U.S. Women's National team during the 2016 Summer Olympics. Dyche scouted and analyzed opponents for the USWNT. Dyche has a history of working with U.S. Soccer, helping with youth national teams, and is a national instructor on the U.S. Soccer educational staff.

unm racks up another double digit win season

For the sixth time in seven years, UNM put together a 10-plus win season in 2015 by going 10-8-2. Also for the 10th time in 11 seasons, the Lobos finished above .500 on the season. In Mountain West play, UNM has had eight consecutive .500-or-better seasons and own a 40-16-10 mark over that stretch (.681).

HOME FIELD ADVANTAGE

The UNM Soccer Complex is a great home field advantage, and the records support that. New Mexico is 101-64-24 all-time in home matches, good for a .598 home winning percentage. A large factor is the Lobos' success at home is the dedicated crowds of Lobo fans at matches. New Mexico is the perennial leader in the Mountain West in attendance while consistently ranking in the top 25 nationally.
