**ABOUT THE MATCHUP:** The Lobos will face Fairleigh Dickinson in their season opener on Saturday, Nov. 12. The two squads have yet to face off in the history of the two programs.

UNM enters Saturday's season opener coming off of two dominating exhibition victories. The Lobos took on Fort Lewis in their first exhibition outing, claiming a 101-48 victory before taking down Eastern New Mexico 89-70 in their final exhibition matchup. Junior Cherise Beynon led the Lobos with 20 points in the first game, followed by freshman Mykiel Burleson who wracked up 14. In the game against ENMU, it was Burleson who paced the Lobos with 19 points, followed by Beynon with 18.

The Knights are coming off of their only exhibition game of the season against Seton Hill on Sat. Nov. 5. FDU claimed a 64-51 victory in the matchup.

# NEW MEXICO GAME NOTES

## SCOUTING FDU

The Knights were voted to finish ninth in the North-east Conference Preseason Poll after finishing with an 8-10 conference record last season.

In the Knights' exhibition matchup vs. Seton Hill, freshman Lauren Francillon led FDU with a double-double in her first career outing while senior Brianna Thomas tallied 14 points en route to their 64-51 win.

## LOBOS STARTING STRONG

The Lobos kick off the season coming off of two exhibition wins for the second-straight season. UNM posted 101 points in its first game against Fort Lewis before following it up with an 89-70 victory over Eastern New Mexico.

## FAMILIAR FACES

Despite the distance between The University of New Mexico and Fairleigh Dickinson University, there is a familiar face that will be visiting The Pit this weekend. Knight sophomore Natalie Zamora hails from Albuquerque where she played at St. Pius X High School. Not only is Zamora from Albuquerque, but she and Lobo guard Laneah Bryan competed on the same club team, the New Mexico Falcons, with both of their fathers coaching the squad.

## ABOUT THE 2016-17 LOBOS

The 2016-17 edition of the New Mexico women's basketball team is going to have a much different look as the Lobos are under new direction with new head coach Mike Bradbury. The Lobos will show off a new style of play, speeding the game up with the dribble drive and shooting those outside threes.

The Lobos return seven lettermen from last year's squad including First Team All-Mountain West selection Cherise Beynon and All-Freshman Team selection Jaisa Nunn. The Lobos will add in six new faces, including three freshmen and three transfers (only one transfer will play this season).

## ADDITION BY ADDITION

The Lobos welcome in six new faces to the program -- all coming from experienced backgrounds of basketball. The three freshman were rated as the top recruiting class in the Mountain West. Three transfers come in to the program. Only one will be eligible to play this season.

## PRESEASON MOUNTAIN WEST HONORS

Junior **Cherise Beynon** was named to the 2016-17 Mountain West Preseason All-Conference Team following her stellar sophomore campaign while freshman **Mykiel Burleson** was named Mountain West Preseason Freshman of the Year. As a team, the Lobos were selected to finish sixth in the league.

## THERE'S NO PLACE LIKE HOME

Two years ago, "The Pit" went underconstruction with the name of the arena. It is still identified as "The Pit" but has a few more letters added to it, as the name of the arena is now WisePies Arena aka The Pit. "The Pit" is nationally recognized as one of the top basketball venues. Need more evidence? How about Sports Illustrated ranking it as one of the top 20 sporting venues, of any sport, in the world for the 20th century. The Pit is truly a special place, and it has created an unparalleled environment for the New Mexico women's basketball program. The Lobos have led the Mountain West in attendance every year of the conference's existence since the 1999-00 season. During that same span, the program has ranked in the top 20 nationally in attendance in each of those years.

## STUDENT-ATHLETE SPIRIT

Academic excellence has become the norm for the New Mexico women's basketball. The Lobos are regularly taking home Mountain West Academic all-conference and Scholar-Athlete awards, but they shine in national academic rankings as well. For six of the last eight seasons, and eight of the last 11 seasons, UNM has finished in the WBCA's Academic Top 25 rankings.

## LOBOS FROM NEAR AND FAR

The Lobo women's basketball roster has a mixture of athletes from near and far on its 2016-17 roster. The Lobos have players from nine different states and one from another country. The Lobos are combined with players from Texas, Florida, Utah, Nevada, New Mexico, Minnesota, Wisconsin and Washington. The Lobos have one player from overseas in senior transfer Richelle van der Kiejl from The Netherlands.
