### **Career Notes**

- Four straight NCAA regionals appearances (2010-13), first postseason berths for UNM since 1962
- Birmingham coached the Lobos to their first two MW Tournament Championships in 2011 and 2012. The Lobos also shared the regular-season crown in both 2012 and 2014, and won the league by a record seven games in 2013.
- Attained highest RPI in UNM history (No. 19) in 2010 and its highest ranking ever (No. 13 by Baseball America) in 2013.
- Earned his 1,000th collegiate victory with a 19-5 victory at Air Force on April 6, 2013.
- Coached his 1,500th collegiate game on Thursday, May 23, 2013, in the Mountain West Tournament against Nevada.
- The NMJC Thunderbirds won the 2005 NJCAA National Championship and were the national runners-up in 2007.
- Birmingham set the foundations for the programs at College of the Southwest (1988-89) and NMJC (1990-2007).
- Birmingham began his coaching career at Las Cruces Mayfield High School where the Trojans won the 4A championship in 1981 and had three No. 1 rankings through 1983.

### HOME, SWEET HOME

On March 24, 2013, the UNM baseball team moved into its new old home. After spending most of the previous nine seasons at Isotopes Park, the Lobos returned to a newly renovated Santa Ana Star Field with astounding success. After losing two of their first five games in their new home park, the Lobos finished the season with 11 straight wins at home to post a 14-2 record at Santa Ana Star Field.

**SCOUTING NEW MEXICO STATE** ... The Aggies are much improved from a year ago as they are now 22-17 on the season, and 10-5 in the Western Athletic Conference. After a streak of seven wins in eight games, the Aggies have gone 5-5 over the last 10 games.

Offensively, Austin *Botello* leads the way with a .375 average, and he is one of two Aggies with 30 or more RBI, joining Dan Hetzel (team leading 37), after driving in 35 this season. Four regulars have averages above .300, , including second leading hitter Daniel Johnson, who leads with four home runs and five triples.

UNM won't see any of NMSU's regular hurlers in weekend starters Kyle Branish, Marcel Renteria or Matthew McHugh.

THE SERIES WITH NEW MEXICO STATE ... The Lobos and Aggies do know a little something about each other. The meeting Tuesday will be the 240th meeting between the two programs, and the Lobos lead the all-time series 156-83, although it was New Mexico State who took the opening game of the four being played this season, losing 9-6 in a neutral site game in El Paso. The last meeting took place in Roswell, where the Lobos took care of business, 3-2. In Albuquerque, the Lobos have been dominant. New Mexico holds a record of 75-29 over the Aggies, good for a winning percentage of .721

**STAJDUHAR PLAYER OF THE WEEK** ... Carl Stajduhar earned his third overall and second consecutive Mountain West Player of the Week Award, marking the fifth time in 10 weeks a UNM position player was named Player of the Week.

For the second week in a row, Stajduhar was a no doubt selection, increasing his averages from the previous award-winning week. He batted .500 over five games had multiple hits in four of five contests. During that span, he slugged .950 and reached base at a .600 clip, good for an OPS of 1.550.

Overall, he had two home runs and four extra base hits, going for the cycle over five games. He drove in a team-best 10 runs. He scored in four out of five games, good for five runs scored.

On Tuesday against No. 7 Texas Tech, he hit a game-tying home run in the fourth inning. His best stretch came from Friday to Saturday, where he went 6-for-9 with a whopping eight RBI.

LAST TIME OUT FOR UNM ... The University of New Mexico baseball team (29-13, 16-5 MW) nearly completed a six-run comeback but ultimately lost the series finale against the San Diego State Aztecs (12-25, 5-10 MW) Sunday, 10-9. The Lobos took the overall weekend series, 2-1.

The Lobos trailed 9-3 heading into the bottom of the eighth inning and had not put together a multiple run rally in an inning to that point. However, the Lobos scored six runs over the last two frames, but do to a run in the top of the ninth, finished a run shy of the Aztecs.

"That's who we are," stated head coach Ray Birmingham. "We have a lot of clutch hitting. It's never over for us, offensively. To tell you the truth, it's just hard to have to score 10 runs a game. We have to do a better job of pitching."

Erick Migueles came up big late for the Lobos and finished the day 2-for-4 with four RBI and a run scored on a three-run blast in the eighth. Andre Vigil also had a big day, going 2-for-4 with two

The Lobos held the lead briefly after they scored the first run in the second inning. Jack Zoellner hit a one-out single to reach base. In the following at bat, Andre Vigil slipped a double down the right field line to score the base runner.

In the top of the third, a pair of errors helped the Aztecs start the first of two four-run rallies. Down, 4-1, the Lobos left bases loaded in back-to-back innings without scoring. However, after the Aztecs posted another run, they would finally poke one through in the fifth. Chris DeVito hit a leadoff double straight to centerfield and advanced to third on a hit from Carl Stajduhar. Pitcher Matt Villalobos came in to pinch hit for DeVito, and was plated on a Migueles hit through the right side.

In the sixth, the Lobos posted their third run. Jared Holley reached base on a seven-pitch walk and was moved into scoring position on a bunt single from Reece Weber. In the following at bat, Holley advanced to third but was able to take home plate on a fielding error. The Lobos were within two runs of the Aztecs, but San Diego State posted four runs in another error-aided side in the seventh.

Down six in the eighth, the Lobo offense showed that no lead is insurmountable, nearly erasing the deficit in one frame. Luis Gonzalez and Stajduhar reached base to start the rally on a single and walk respectively. With two outs on the board, Migueles created instant offense with his three-run bomb past right centerfield.

With the bases cleared, the Lobos kept it going when Vigil was hit by a pitch. He immediately scored when Michael Eaton smacked a triple to left centerfield. Scottie Graham reached base on balls to put the tying run on base, but the Lobos could not get him across.

The Aztecs put an insurance run on the board in the ninth, pushing their lead to 10-7. The Lobos nearly completed the six-run comeback in the final side. Gonzalez hit a leadoff single to right centerfield before Holley was hit by a pitch. Stajduhar picked up his first RBI of the day on a single to left field and represented the tying run on first base. With two outs, Andre Vigil blasted a ball up the middle, plating Holley and putting pinch runner Jacob Westerman on third base. With the tying run 90 feet away, the final play of the game came on a grounder to third, ending what had shaped up to be an incredible comeback.

Starter Colton Thomson (6-2) was the pitcher of record for the Lobos, allowing two earned runs and seven hits. He struck out three Aztecs over six innings. The bullpen gave up just two earned runs combined over the last three frames.

FRESHMAN MILESTONE ... Over the weekend against San Diego State, the Lobos saw a talented freshman hit a big milestone. Erick Migueles, whose displayed solid power, finally put one over the fence for a three-run bomb Sunday against the Aztecs. It was his first career home run.

IT'S OVER AFTER EIGHT ... The UNM bullpen has been outstanding at protecting leads during the last several seasons. If UNM is leading after eight innings? Forget it. The Lobos haven't lost when leading after eight in 107 straight games, a streak that dates back to March 24, 2013.

THE MANGHATTAN PROJECT ... It didn't take long for Lobo freshman Jared Mang to receive a nickname. Half a game, maybe? During UNM's opener on Feb. 19 at Hawai'i, TV broadcaster Sam Spangler, himself an Albuquerque native, coined the nickname "Manghattan Project" for the Los Alamos, N.M. native.
