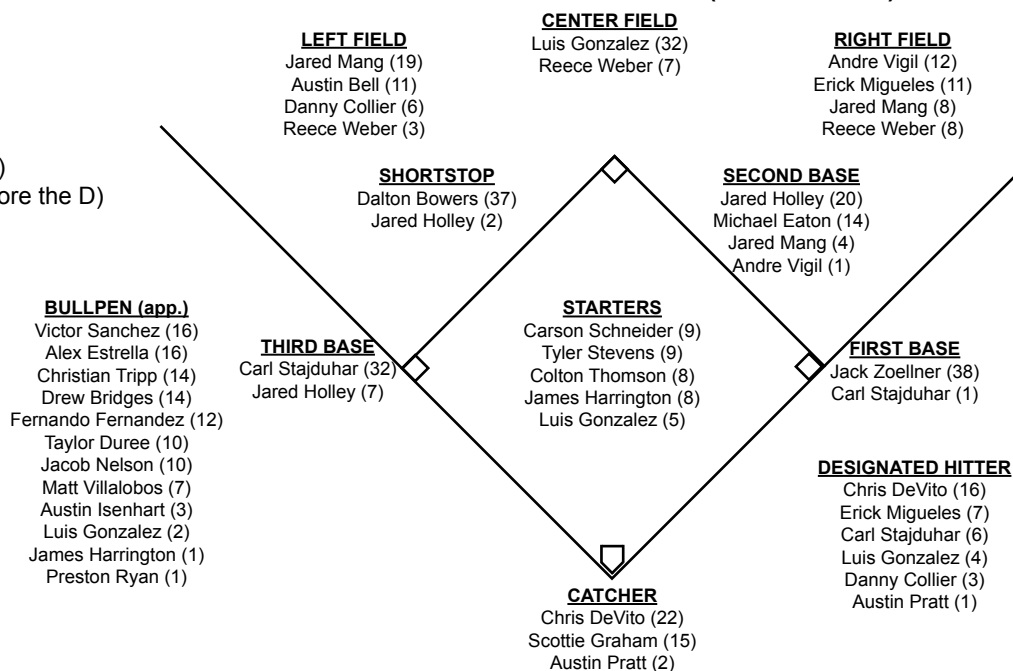

### Career Notes

- Four straight NCAA regionals appearances (2010-13), first postseason berths for UNM since 1962
- Birmingham coached the Lobos to their first two MW Tournament Championships in 2011 and 2012. The Lobos also shared the regular-season crown in both 2012 and 2014, and won the league by a record seven games in 2013.
- Attained highest RPI in UNM history (No. 19) in 2010 and its highest ranking ever (No. 13 by *Baseball America*) in 2013.
- Earned his 1,000th collegiate victory with a 19-5 victory at Air Force on April 6, 2013.
- Coached his 1,500th collegiate game on Thursday, May 23, 2013, in the Mountain West Tournament against Nevada.
- The NMJC Thunderbirds won the 2005 NJCAA National Championship and were the national runners-up in 2007.
- Birmingham set the foundations for the programs at College of the Southwest (1988-89) and NMJC (1990-2007).
- Birmingham began his coaching career at Las Cruces Mayfield High School where the Trojans won the 4A championship in 1981 and had three No. 1 rankings through 1983.

## HOME, SWEET HOME

On March 24, 2013, the UNM baseball team moved into its new old home. After spending most of the previous nine seasons at Isotopes Park, the Lobos returned to a newly renovated Santa Ana Star Field with astounding success. After losing two of their first five games in their new home park, the Lobos finished the season with 11 straight wins at home to post a 14-2 record at Santa Ana Star Field.

**SCOUTING SAN DIEGO STATE ...** The Aztecs enter the weekend with an 11-23 record overall and a 4-8 record in the Mountain West. Despite the record, they have skewed closer to .500 as of late, with a 5-5 record in their last 10 games.

San Diego State is led by Alan Trejo, who holds a team-best .333 batting average with 48 hits. Along with Justin Wylie, he leads the Aztecs with 20 RBI while scoring 22 runs. Wylie holds the team lead in runs scored at 23.

Harrison Pyatt is expected to start this weekend, and despite going 0-3 on the year, holds an ERA of 3.69. He has struck out 34 batters on the season to only 17 walks. Chris Collins and Cody Thompson are also expected to start, with a 3.18 ERA and 6.34 ERA, respectively.

**THE SERIES WITH SAN DIEGO STATE ...** In a series that dates back to April 15, 1960, the Aztecs lead the series 73-109, with this weekend's games marking the fourth, fifth and sixth times the teams will meet this year. While New Mexico trails overall, UNM leads the series in Albuquerque 38-35. In fact, the Lobos have not lost a three-game series against San Diego State since 2004. Since their last series loss, the Lobos have gone 18-6 against the Aztecs in Albuquerque.

**LAST TIME OUT FOR UNM ...** If you are only going to lead once, make sure it's at the end. That's exactly what the New Mexico Lobos did as a pair of local products teamed up in the bottom of the 10th inning to walk-off No. 7 Texas Tech 6-5. Andre Vigil lined a one out single and on a hit and run, scored on a short double by Dalton Bowers to give UNM a win in a game it never led until the end.

The win pushed UNM to 27-12 overall and ended Texas Tech's 10-game winning streak. The Red Raider dropped to 30-10, and the win gives UNM a win over a top-10 RPI team as Texas Tech entered the game at No. 10 in the latest RPI.

Just getting the game to extra innings was a chore, as starter James Harrington lasted just four innings, allowing four runs. UNM was down 4-0 in the third when the comeback began. Luis Gonzalez walked, stole second and scored on a single by the blazing hot Jared Holley, cutting the lead to 4-1. Texas

Tech pushed it back to 5-1 with a pair of back-to-back back doubles with one out off of Christian Tripp. However, from that moment on, Tripp and five other relievers (Jacob Nelson, Taylor Duree, Drew Bridges, Fernando Fernandez and Alex Estrella) combined to throw 5.2 innings of no-hit relief.

Down 5-1, UNM made a game of it in the bottom of the fifth, chasing starter Ty Damron with a pair of runs. Bowers walked, Gonzalez had a bunt single and Holley doubled to make it 5-2. Chris DeVito grounded out to make it 5-3 and that's where it stayed until UNM put up single tallies in the eighth, ninth and tenth innings.

In the eighth, pinch hitter Erick Migueles worked a four-pitch walk, and then with Reece Weber running, Andrew Pratt singled. UNM got the break it needed when Trey Ochoa, who had just come into the game short, bobbled a routine grounder for an error. That led to an unearned run when Bowers beat out a potential double play ball for a run-scoring force out to make it 5-4.

In the ninth with Pitcher of the Year candidate Hayden Howard in for the save, Chris DeVito doubled with one out. DeVito, who was named to the Golden Spikes Midseason Watch List about 30 minutes prior to that at bat, was lifted for a pinch runner in Austin Bell. Carl Stajduhar grounded out, leaving it up to Michael Eaton, playing his first game since March 19, almost exactly a month.

UNM then escaped a bases loaded jam in the 10th when Alex Estrella walked two and hit a batter, but Tech couldn't cash in. UNM did instead. With one out, Vigil drilled a single past a diving Michael Davis at third, and then on a 1-1 pitch, he took off for second. Bowers lined a clean ball into the vacated hole and with the right fielder shaded towards the line, Bowers stretched for a double. When the throw from Steven Smith missed the cutoff man, Vigil, running all the way, scored to give UNM the win.

Estrella picked up the win for UNM, improving to 2-1 on the season. UNM now readies for an important conference battle as the Lobos will take on San Diego State. The first place Lobos look to win their seventh consecutive series starting on Friday at 6 p.m. at Santa Ana Star Field. Games will continue Saturday at 2 and Sunday at 1. All fans should enter the parking areas and stadium on the south side instead of the usual WisePies Arena lot entrance due to the set-up for the Gathering of Nations event.

**NEW MEXICO KIDS WIN IT ...**Three New Mexico kids were the heroes in UNM's walk off victory over #7 Texas Tech. Andre Vigil and Dalton Bowers graduated from Valcano Vista HS and Mike Eaton is from Sandia Prep.

**STAJDUHAR PLAYER OF THE**

**WEEK ...** Carl Stajduhar earned his second Mountain West Player of the Week Award, marking the fourth time in nine weeks a UNM position player was named Player of the Week.

Carl extended his hitting streak to eight, and he had a hit and an RBI in all five games last week, hitting .429 on 9-for-21 batting with a home run and a double, along with three sacrifice flies.

**HOW MANY HALL OF FAMES CAN ONE GUY GET INTO?** ... Apparently if you are Ray Birmingham, the answer is three.

After the UNLV series on Sunday night, New Mexico's all-time leader in collegiate coaching wins was inducted into the New Mexico Athletics Hall of Fame. It's the third hall of fame he has been inducted into, along with the Lea County Hall of Fame and National Junior College Athletic Association Hall of Fame.

**AND THAT MAKES SIX ...** UNM had to come from down a game to do it, but the Lobos picked up a series win against San Jose State, winning the final two games 6-2 and 10-3 after losing the opener 9-8. For the season, UNM has now won all six conference series meetings (SJSU twice, San Diego State, Nevada, Fresno State and UNLV).

That is in stark contrast to how UNM finished the 2015 season, when UNM lost two of its final three Mountain West series.

### SCHNEIDER IS ONLY ALLOWED TO FACE CONFERENCE OPPONENTS NOT NAMED SAN JOSE STATE ...

Carson Schneider has been awesome all season long, going 6-1 with a 3.76 ERA was 33 strikeouts and just eight walks in 64.2 innings with two complete games.

**THE MANGHATTAN PROJECT ...** It didn't take long for Lobo freshman Jared Mang to receive a nickname. Half a game, maybe?
