

- Birmingham coached the Lobos to their first two MW Tournament Championships in 2011 and 2012. The Lobos also shared the regular-season crown in both 2012 and 2014, and won the league by a record seven games in 2013.
- Attained highest RPI in UNM history (No. 19) in 2010 and its highest ranking ever (No. 13 by *Baseball America*) in 2013.
- Earned his 1,000th collegiate victory with a 19-5 victory at Air Force on April 6, 2013.
- Coached his 1,500th collegiate game on Thursday, May 23, 2013, in the Mountain West Tournament against Nevada.
- The NMJC Thunderbirds won the 2005 NJCAA National Championship and were the national runners-up in 2007.
- Birmingham set the foundations for the programs at College of the Southwest (1988-89) and NMJC (1990-2007).
- Birmingham began his coaching career at Las Cruces Mayfield High School where the Trojans won the 4A championship in 1981 and had three No. 1 rankings through 1983.

HOME, SWEET HOME

On March 24, 2013, the UNM baseball team moved into its new old home. After spending most of the previous nine seasons at Isotopes Park, the Lobos returned to a newly renovated Santa Ana Star Field with astounding success. After losing two of their first five games in their new home park, the Lobos finished the season with 11 straight wins at home to post a 14-2 record at Santa Ana Star Field.

SCOUTING NEW MEXICO STATE ... The Aggies are much improved from a year ago as they are now 25-18 on the season, and 13-5 in the Western Athletic Conference. After losing last week to the Lobos in Albuquerque, the Aggies returned to WAC play to sweep Sacramento State over the weekend.

Offensively, Austin *Botello* leads the way with a .345 average, and he is one of four Aggies with 30 or more RBI, joining Dan Hetzel (team leading 41), after driving in 35 this season. Three regulars have averages above .300, including hitter Daniel Johnson, who leads with eight home runs and five triples.

UNM won't see any of NMSU's regular hurlers in weekend starters Kyle Branish, Marcel Renteria or Matthew McHugh.

THE SERIES WITH NEW MEXICO STATE ... The Lobos and Aggies do know a little something about each other. The meeting Tuesday will be the 241st meeting between the two programs, and the Lobos lead the all-time series 157-83, although it was New Mexico State who took the opening game of the four being played this season, losing 9-6 in a neutral site game in El Paso. The next meeting took place in Roswell, where the Lobos took care of business, 3-2. Last week, the Lobos took a 2-1 series lead with a 10-4 win in Albuquerque. Overall, the Lobos have a winning record in Las Cruces at 60-47.

LAST TIME OUT FOR UNM ... In a game where hits were scarce and run were moreso, a pair of hit batters did UNM in. The No. 27 Arizona State Sun Devils got a walk-off single from Andrew Shaps with one out in the ninth to drive in Colby Woodmansee who was hit by a pitch to give ASU a 1-0 win.

The loss gave the series sweep to Arizona State and dropped UNM to 30-16, and the Lobos have now lost four of their last five. Arizona State improved to 26-15.

The loss put a damper on a brilliant performance on the hill by Colton Thomson, who allowed just three hits and no walks with seven strikeouts in seven shutout innings. He only had one tough inning, the seventh, when ASU got runners on first and third with one out. However, Thomson fielded a safety squeeze, looking the runner back and getting the out at first. He then struck out Jeremy McCuin to strand two in scoring position.

He gave way to Victor Sanchez, who threw a perfect eighth inning, but he hit Woodmansee with his first pitch of the ninth. After getting a strikeout on a sacrifice attempt, he then hit Brian Serven to move Woodmansee into scoring position. Alex Estrella then came in and allowed a sharp single to right by Shaps. Andre Vigil's throw was just up the line, allowing Woodmansee to just get in under the tag and win it.

The Lobos and Sun Devils combined for just seven hits, and it marked UNM's first shutout loss this season. UNM got three hits, two from Luis Gonzalez and a bloop double by Vigil that everyone lost in the sun.

UNM should have scored in the first, but couldn't capitalize on a golden opportunity in the first inning. Luis Gonzalez tripled to open the game, but UNM couldn't plate him. Jared Holley popped up to second on the first pitch, and the Chris DeVito grounded back to the pitcher. Carl Stajduhar was intentionally walked, bringing up Vigil, who flew out to right. That set up the pitcher's duel to follow.

UNM couldn't solve the riddle of Zach Dixon and Eder Erives. Dixon threw the first 2.2 innings, allowing both Gonzalez hits. Erives went the final 6.1 innings, allowing just the sun double by Vigil. Both ASU pitchers walked three as UNM left eight runners on.

DUREE-ABLE... Taylor Duree made two appearances this past weekend against Arizona State, giving him a program-record 76 career appearances as a Lobo. He is the second pitcher to reach 70 appearances at New Mexico and has passed Joe Coleman for the school record

AND NMSU MAKES THREE ... For the third time in his career, and second this season, Carl Stajduhar hit two home runs in a game. Stajduhar hit a solo shot in the first and a two-run bomb in the sixth. The two put him in the team lead for home runs with 13, and he is just four behind the sophomore record, set by D.J. Peterson in 2012.

HOW MANY HALL OF FAMES CAN ONE GUY GET INTO? ... Apparently if you are Ray Birmingham, the answer is three.

After the UNLV series that Sunday night, New Mexico's all-time leader in collegiate coaching wins was inducted into the New Mexico Athletics Hall of Fame. It's the third hall of fame he has been inducted into, along with the Lea County Hall of Fame and National Junior College Athletic Association Hall of Fame.

AND THAT MAKES SEVEN ... Despite a one-run loss Sunday, the Lobos took their last Mountain West series against San Diego State. For the season, UNM has now won all seven conference series meetings (SJSU twice, San Diego State twice, Nevada, Fresno State and UNLV).

That is in stark contrast to how UNM finished the 2015 season, when UNM lost two of its final three Mountain West series.

PROOF IT'S GOOD ... UNM's 30-16 record is good for a .652 winning percentage, which would be fourth all-time in school history.

LOBOS TABBED CO-FAVORITES BY MW COACHES ... The University of New Mexico baseball team was picked as co-favorites in the Mountain West by the conference's coaches. The Lobos received three first-place votes and 32 points overall to tie atop the standings with San Diego State. Junior outfielder Danny Collier, sophomore third baseman Carl Stajduhar and junior first baseman Jack Zoellner were named to the preseason All-Mountain West Team.

This is the fourth straight season the Lobos have been picked as at least co-favorites in the conference.

"It shows you the quality of our program and where we're going," UNM head coach Ray Birmingham said. "In the end, though, it's meaningless. You still have to play the games."

Air Force and Fresno State finished tied for third with 24 points, and the Bulldogs received the final first-place vote. UNLV (15) was picked fifth, just ahead of last year's regular season champion, Nevada (14). San José State finished seventh with six points.

Collier is one of just three players to repeat on the Preseason All-Conference Team, joined by junior outfielder Tyler Jones of Air Force and junior utility player Trenton Brooks of Nevada. Collier, who was the MW 2014 Freshman of the Year and a First Team All-MW performer last season, is a career .349 hitter.

Stajduhar is one of just two sophomores on the preseason team. A 2015 Second Team All-MW player, he set a new UNM freshman record for RBIs with 53 on his way to a pair of Freshman All-America honors. He led the Lobos in hits (75), doubles (21), home runs (nine) and total bases (127). This year he has already been named a Preseason All-American by both College Sports Madness and Collegiate Baseball Newspaper.

Zoellner is UNM's leading returning hitter after posting a .352 average last season en route to Second Team All-MW honors. A career .330/.434/.492 hitter, he was also named to the Mountain West All-Tournament Team last year after hitting .450 (9-for-20) with nine runs, eight RBIs, four doubles and two home runs in the conference tournament in May.


