

POSTGAME NOTES: NEW MEXICO 84, AIR FORCE 55

In-Game Notes

- UNM is 12-8 and 5-2 in the Mountain West.
- This was the 79th meeting between the two teams, the Lobos now lead the series 57-21.
- Air Force has not won a game inside WisePies Arena since Feb. 10, 2007.
- UNM has won 16 out of the last 19 games in the series.
- Shooting 63 percent from the field tonight will help improve UNM's lead in FG% in the MW, before tonight the Lobos were averaging 47.4 percent from the field in conference play.
- This was the Lobos' second consecutive game scoring between 80-89.
- UNM won by 20+ points for the first time since facing Loyola-Chicago on 11/18/15.
- The Lobos shot 63 percent from the field tonight, it's the first time that UNM has accomplished that since shooting 61.7 percent against Loyola-Chicago.
- The Lobos are now 12-2 when leading at the half this season.
- When outrebounding their opponents, UNM is now 11-4 on the year.
- When the UNM bench outscores their opponent, the Lobos are now 6-2.
- When playing inside WisePies Arena, UNM is now 9-2.
- The team improves to 4-2 this month.
- UNM is 6-2 on the year when scoring 80+ points.

RS-Junior Tim Williams

- Earned his second consecutive double-double and his fifth on the season.
- This was Williams' 17th double-digit scoring effort, the team is 11-6 in that span.
- It was also his fifth 10+ rebounding game this season.

RS-Sophomore Elijah Brown

- This was Brown's 19th double-digit scoring effort on the year.

RS-Sophomore Cullen Neal

- Lead the team in assists for the 15th time this season; the team is 10-5 in that span.

Sophomore Xavier Adams

- Season high in rebounds with five.
- Tied a season and career high in points with 14 (5-6).

Freshman Anthony Mathis

- Set a new career high in points with 16.
- New career highs in FT attempts and makes, going 5-for-5.
- Career high in minutes with 15.

Senior Michael Nesbitt

- First field goal as a Lobo.
