

POST-GAME NOTES: NEW MEXICO 89, RICE 90

Streaks, Trends and In-Game Notes

- The Lobos have now had two 20-assist games in a row.
- Egor Koulechov scored 32 points tonight, a new high against the Lobos this year.
- First loss of the year for the Lobos after leading at halftime.
- The Lobos committed more turnovers than their opponent for the fourth time this season, they are 3-1 in that span.
- After shooting 51% from the field tonight the Lobos suffered their first loss when shooting 50% or better (3-1).
- The Lobos suffered their first loss of the season at home tonight (6-1).
- The Lobos are now 3-2 when scoring 80+ points this season.

RS-Junior Forward Tim Williams

- This was Williams' eighth double-digit scoring game and the Lobos are 6-2 in that span.
- Williams was the Lobos' leading rebounder for the fifth time this season, the Lobos fall to 2-3 when that is the case.

RS-Sophomore Guard Elijah Brown

- Led the Lobos in scoring with 21 points off 5-of-13 shooting and 3-of-9 from 3-point range.
- This is Brown's fourth consecutive 20 point game.
- Brown was 8-for-9 from the free throw line.

Junior Center Obij Aget

- Set a new career high with five blocks. He recorded four in a game five times in his career.

Sophomore Guard/Forward Sam Logwood

- Tied his career high in steals with two tonight.

RS-Sophomore Guard Cullen Neal

- Led the Lobos in assists for the second consecutive game. He is averaging eight over the last two games.
- This was Neal's eighth double-digit scoring effort this season (5-3), and 19th of his career (16-3).
