NEW MEXICO NOTES

THE LAST TIME OUT

The Lobos are coming off a 1-0-1 appearance at the NAU Mountain Classic in Flagstaff, Arizona, where they defeated Grand Canyon University 2-0 Friday and tied with host Northern Arizona 0-0 Sunday to improve their unbeaten streak to five games (3-0-2). It's the longest unbeaten streak for the Lobos since 2012 when UNM ran off six straight games without a loss. The longest unbeaten streak in Lobo history is 11 set in 2011.

UNBLEMISHED IN RIO GRANDE RIVALRY

The Lobos are a perfect 6-0 versus in-state foe New Mexico State and have outscored the Aggies 12-1 in those contests. However, four of the six games were 1-0 victories for UNM - including a pair of overtime victories (2012 and 2013). NMSU started women's soccer in 2009 (UNM and NMSU didn't play for the first time until 2010).

A TRUE LAND OF ENCHANTMENT MATCHUP

There are a combined 31 players from New Mexico on the Lobos' and Aggies' rosters - 14 for UNM and 17 for NMSU. Even some of the coaches have New Mexico ties with Lobo head coach Heather Dyche an Albuquerque native (graduated from Eldorado High School) and first-year Lobo assistant coach Paul Maestas is a University of New Mexico graduate and coached Albuquerque's Eldorado High School to a state championship. In a twist, Maestas' daughter - Valerie Maestas - is a freshman on the NMSU women's team.

AGGIES HEAD INTO RIO GRANDE AFTER KEY ROAD WIN

NMSU enters Friday's Rio Grande Rivalry matchup coming off of a 3-0 victory at Idaho State on Sunday - a team UNM defeated 4-3 in Pocatello, Idaho, earlier this season. The Aggies got all three goals from Aileen Galicia - giving the sophomore a team-best five on the season as she has scored all but two of NMSU's seven goals this season.

BACK-TO-BACK CLEAN SHEETS

The Lobos have shut out their last two opponents and have a 234-minute scoreless streak going heading into Friday's matchup with New Mexico State. UNM goalkeeper Tayler Hammack has played 218 minutes of that streak with Emily Johnson playing the other 16 minutes (during the Lobos' 2-0 win over Grand Canyon on Friday). It's the first time UNM has had back-to-back shutouts in non-conference play since 2010.

IRWIN TIED FOR MW LEAD IN GOALS

Senior midfielder Maddie Irwin and her four goals this season (she added another Friday against Grand Canyon) are tied for the Mountain West lead with Clara Richter of Colorado College and Michaela Morris of UNLV. Irwin's nine points is tied for third - just a point behind first place.

HAMMACK NOT JUST HANGING AROUND

UNM goalkeeper Tayler Hammack has been busy early in the season as the junior leads the Mountain West with 32 saves (4.57 per game). Her two shutouts this season is tied for third in the conference. Hammack has played all but 16 minutes this season at keeper for the Lobos.

FIRST TIME IN A LONG TIME ... 3 GOALS ALLOWED & WIN

The Lobos' 4-3 victory over Idaho State on Sept. 4 marked the first time in 19 years the Lobos allowed three goals and won a game. The last time the Lobos allowed three goals and won a contest was Oct. 5, 1997, when UNM defeated Oklahoma 5-3. It's the second time in program history the Lobos have allowed three goals and won.

LYNCH APPROACHING LOBO ALL-TIME TOP 10 IN GOALS

Claire Lynch's 11 career goals has her approaching the program's all-time top-10 list. She's one goal behind the No. 10 spot, occupied by Michelle Nowfel (1999-02), and three behind being tied for the No. 7 spot with a trio of former Lobos (Lindsey Guice, Zaneta Wyne and Dani Rangel).

LOBOS' MUÑOZ PLAYS FOR MEXICO U20 TEAM

UNM sophomore Jennifer Muñoz spent this past summer trying out, making and eventually starting for Mexico's U20 Women's National Team. Muñoz started 19 games last season for the Lobos, tallying one assist in 1,566 minutes of play.

CHAVEZ NAMED 2015-16 LOBO CLUB STUDENT-ATHLETE OF YEAR

Defender Emily Chavez earned the prestigious honor of being named the Lobo Club Student-Athlete of the Year for 2015-16. Chavez, who earned All-Mountain West honorable mention and Mountain West All-Academic honors last season, became the third player in MW history to win both an offensive and defensive player of the week honors in her career.

ANOTHER STELLAR YEAR IN THE CLASSROOM

The University of New Mexico women's soccer program maintained a strong academic record during the 2015-16 school year, posting a spring GPA of 3.46. The program has posted an astounding 12 straight semesters of having a team GPA of 3.4 or higher. In the fall, the Lobos reached a GPA of 3.59. The high standard for the women's soccer program has been recognized over the years, with the 2015 season marking the 10th straight year in which the Lobos earned Academic All-District honors. In 2015, a pair of seniors, Cassie Ulrich from Rio Rancho, N.M. and Alyssa Coonrod from Albuquerque, N.M., were named to the 2015 CoSIDA/Academic All-District VII Team.

DYCHE ASSISTS U.S. SOCCER DURING OLYMPICS

Head coach Heather Dyche traveled to Brazil this summer to assist the U.S. Women's National team during the 2016 Summer Olympics. Dyche scouted and analyzed opponents for the USWNT. Dyche has a history of working with U.S. Soccer, helping with youth national teams, and is a national instructor on the U.S. Soccer educational staff.

UNM RACKS UP ANOTHER DOUBLE-DIGIT WIN SEASON

For the sixth time in seven years, UNM put together a 10-plus win season in 2015 by going 10-8-2. Also for the 10th time in 11 seasons, the Lobos finished above .500 on the season. In Mountain West play, UNM has had eight consecutive .500-or-better seasons and own a 40-16-10 mark over that stretch (.681).
