QUICK HITS

- Texas rose to No. 1 in the Softball America poll on March 3, marking the first time the Longhorns have topped any national softball poll since April 5, 2006, a span of almost 14 years.
- Texas has had loads of success this season against ranked teams, posting a 5-1 mark in those match-ups with wins over No. 1 UCLA, No. 2 Washington, No. 10/9 Louisiana, No. 12 Tennessee and No. 13/11 Michigan.
- Her nickname's "LB" but she ought to change it to "2B!" Junior utility player **Lauren Burke** currently leads the Big 12 & ranks **SECOND IN NCAA DIVISION I** in doubles (12) while rating eighth in the nation in doubles-per-game (0.60).
- In all three of Texas' defeats this season, the Longhorns have lost by just one run while managing to put the tying run on base in the seventh inning.
- Freshman pitcher **Courtney Day** has been a revelation so far in her first season, hitting .354 with a team-leading five HR's while going 4-0 in the circle with a squad-best 1.18 ERA. She posted her first career two-HR game in the loss to Fresno State (2/29).
- With 10 K's against Boise State (3/1), senior pitcher **Miranda Elish** struck out 10-or-more batters in a game for the 24th time in her All-American career (13th time at Texas and third time in 2020).
- Texas has trailed at some point in 10 games this season and **rallied back to win seven of those**: Wichita State (trailed in 1st), Texas A&M-CC (1st), Utah (7th), North Texas (7th), Lipscomb (2nd), UCLA (1st) and Boise State (4th).
- So far in 2020, Texas is 18-2 when out-hitting its opponent, 14-2 when scoring first and 9-2 when scoring in the first inning.
- With the 1-0 win over Michigan on Feb. 29 at the Judi Garman Classic, 11th-year head coach **Mike White** picked up his **500TH CAREER WIN**. With a .792 career winning percentage, White currently rates as the **third-winningest active coach in NCAA Division I softball** behind only Florida's Tim Walton (.796) and Arizona's Mike Candraea (.794).
- Texas' 174 runs scored over its first 23 games are the most in any season in program history. The previous high after the initial 23 contests was 159 runs by the 2012 Longhorns squad.
- Watch out for Texas with two outs in an inning. So far through 23 games, the Burnt Orange & White are batting .404 (82-of-203) with 66 two-out RBIs (**40% of the team's total RBIs have come with two outs this season**). Junior third baseman **Mary Iakopo** leads the team with eight two-out RBIs while 16 Longhorns own at least one two-out RBI.
- Junior second baseman **Janae Jefferson** is off to another hot start with the bat, currently rating **first in the Big 12** in total hits (32 - fourth in NCAA Division I as of 3/2), batting average (.516 - 14th in NCAA Division I), on-base percentage (.587 - 12th in NCAA Division I) and runs scored-per-game (1.13 - 33rd in NCAA Division I).
- The Longhorns have been strong this season with runners in scoring position, hitting .412 (94-of-228) in such instances. Junior third baseman **Mary Iakopo** leads the team with 11 hits, while senior pitcher/utility **Miranda Elish** (.533, 8-of-15) owns the highest average of any regular with at least 10 at-bats with RISP.
- Look out for Texas during the fourth inning as the Longhorns have now outscored opponents in the frame, **51-5**. Overall, UT has scored 29% of its total runs in the fourth inning this season.
- With 52 doubles through 23 games (2.26 doubles-per-game), the Longhorns are well ahead of the pace needed to break the school single-season mark of 91 doubles set by the 2019 team. Maintaining its current pace over the next 33 games, Texas would finish a 56-game regular-season schedule with approximately 127 doubles. **UT RANKED FIRST IN NCAA DIVISION I IN TOTAL DOUBLES & SECOND IN DOUBLES-PER-GAME (3/2).**
- Junior second baseman and two-time All-American **Janae Jefferson** currently ranks as the **school's career leader in batting average at .416 (well ahead of Lexy Bennett at .385)**, while rating second all-time in on-base percentage (.471). The Humble, Texas, native is also closing in on the 200-hit mark with 186 total hits through her first two+ seasons in the Burnt Orange & White.
- Softball America listed four Longhorns in their 2020 Top 100 National Player Rankings: No. 30 **Janae Jefferson**, No. 32 **Miranda Elish**, No. 36 **Shea O'Leary** and No. 47 **Mary Iakopo**.

GAME NOTES

VERSUS OUR LONGHORN INVITE OPPONENTS

The Longhorns have faced just two of this weekend's three opponents before. UT is 5-0 against New Mexico, including a perfect 3-0 mark in Austin, with the last meeting coming back on April 1, 2012. Texas is 12-0 all-time against Texas Southern (11-0 in Austin) and went 2-0 against the Lady Tigers in last season's Longhorn Invitational. The Horns will be matching up against Liberty for the first time.

RIDING HOT STREAKS

A pair of Longhorns have absolutely been on fire at the plate over the last 12 games. Junior second baseman **Janae Jefferson** has reached safely in all 12 contests while junior utility player **Lauren Burke** has reached safely in 11-of-12 games. Burke - .513 (20-39), 12 runs, nine 2B, 2 HR, 12 RBIs

BEST OF THE BIG 12

TEXAS swept the March 3 weekly league awards as junior utility player **Lauren Burke** was named the Big 12 Conference Player of the Week while sophomore pitcher **Shea O'Leary** was tabbed as the Big 12 Conference Pitcher of the Week. Burke hit .458 over a seven-game stretch, including five doubles and two huge HR's, to help knock off No. 1 UCLA & No. 2 Washington in back-to-back games. O'Leary went 2-0 with victories over No. 10/9 Louisiana and No. 13/11 Michigan (complete-game shutout).

It's always been important for Texas to take advantage of the McCombs Field magic. Last year was no different under then-first-year head coach **Mike White** as the Longhorns went 27-6 in registering the fifth-most home wins in school history. **UT has 30 home games**

on the slate in 2020 and has already opened at 12-2.

SEASON OPENERS = WINS

Texas owns an **INCREDIBLE** season-opening winning streak dating all the way back to the initial varsity season for the program in 1997. **The Longhorns have won ALL 24 of their season openers, including high-profile wins over No. 3 UCLA (2007), Florida State (2009), No. 20 DePaul (2010), Louisville (2011) and No. 17 LSU (2014).** During that stretch, Texas has registered 15 shutouts and outscored its opponents by a combined total of 161-13. The streak grew during the 202 season as UT knocked off Wichita State at the Texas Classic, 10-2 (6 inn.).

WHAT AN OPENING WEEKEND!

Texas wasted no time showing what it's capable of this season during its home-hosted Texas Classic (Feb. 6-9). Take a look at some of the incredible stats that came from that event:

- Outscored its opponents 78-8. The 78 runs were the most over the first six games of a season in school history
- Hit .486 as a team with 19 doubles, three triples, seven HR's, 25 walks, 74 RBIs and a 1.365 OPS
- Scored in 19-of-27 total team at-bats and totaled at least three runs in an inning 15 times
- Averaged 13 runs-per-game & 2.9 runs-per-inning
- Six straight run-rule wins for the first time in school history
- 17 different Longhorns had at least one hit & 17 different Longhorns had at least one RBI

TOP 50-LEVEL NATIONAL TALENTS!

Texas senior pitcher **Miranda Elish**, junior catcher/third baseman **Mary Iakopo** and sophomore pitcher **Shea O'Leary** have been included as three of 50 student-athletes named to the prestigious USA Softball National Collegiate Player of the Year Watch List. **Elish was a top 25 finalist for the award at Oregon in 2018 and made the watch list for 2019.** The award will be presented on May 26. Texas is one of only two softball programs (UCLA) in the nation to have secured the honor more than twice as former Longhorns pitching legend Cat Osterman earned the trophy in 2003, 2005 and 2006.

DAUNTING SCHEDULE AHEAD

Texas is certainly challenging itself schedule-wise during the upcoming 2020 campaign with **27 total games against 17 teams that reached the 2019 NCAA Field of 64** (Alabama, Oklahoma, Oklahoma State, Ole Miss, Tennessee, UCLA, Washington, Houston, Lipscomb, Boise State, BYU, Louisiana-Lafayette, Colorado State, North Dakota State, Texas Tech, Michigan and Weber State). Along the way, the Longhorns **will face five of last season's Women's College World Series participants in Alabama, Oklahoma, Oklahoma State, UCLA & Washington.** UT will also battle seven NCAA Super Regional qualifiers (Alabama, Oklahoma, Oklahoma State, Ole Miss, Tennessee, UCLA & Washington).

MCCOMBS FIELD IS EVOLVING!

Texas softball's McCombs Field complex is undergoing a major expansion project as the Longhorns are in the process of adding a Player Development Center & Pitching Lab down the left field line. The approximately \$8 million-dollar, 10,000-plus square foot project will feature indoor batting cages and pitching mounds. It will provide Longhorn student-athletes with a brand new locker room, player's lounge, team meeting room and nutrition station. The center will incorporate an upgraded training room, which will include hydro pools, as well as an office suite and locker rooms for coaches and staff.

UT has also upgraded the videoboard by adding a 24'4"-by-42'4" screen in center. That replaced the old videoboard that measured 11'-by-34'.

M.I.R.A.C.L.E

M.I.R.A.C.L.E serves as a motto of sorts for the Longhorns in 2020. **It's an acronym for the words Mission, Intent, Respect, Attitude, Confidence, Leadership and Effort.** Seven words for the Texas squad to focus on everyday in practice, the classroom and in life.

LOADS OF PRODUCTION RETURNING

UT is returning 11 student-athletes that earned playing time in at least 41 games last season (eight of those started at least 37 match-ups) and 14 letter winners that combined to total 82% of the runs, 90% of the hits, 93% of the doubles, 88% of the HR's, 89% of the RBIs, 86% of the walks and 74% of the stolen bases. From a pitching standpoint, Texas returns 80% of the pitching wins, 75% of the starts, 91% of the complete games, 89% of the solo shutouts, 78% of the innings pitched and 74% of the strikeouts.

Included among the returnees are a trio of 2019 Softball America All-Americans in senior pitcher **Miranda Elish** (18-10, 1.81 ERA, 29 starts, 20 complete games, 11 solo shutouts, 226 K's, 185.1 IP), junior second baseman **Janae Jefferson** (.408 avg., 80 hits, six doubles, 11 walks, 10 steals, 23 RBIs) and sophomore pitcher **Shea O'Leary** (14-3, NCAA Division I-leading 0.65 ERA, 14 starts, four solo shutouts, 65 K's, 97.2 IP). Award winners from 2019 also returning are NFCA All-Central Region junior catcher/third baseman **Mary Iakopo** (.356 avg., 57 hits, five doubles, 11 HR's, 29 walks,

43 RBIs) and All-Big 12 senior outfielder **Kaitlyn Washington** (.297 avg., 47 hits, 14 doubles, four HR's, 36 RBIs).

AND THE BIG 12 PRESEASON SURVEY...SAYS!

Texas was chosen to finish second in the annual Big 12 Conference preseason poll as voted by the league's coaches. UT has now been picked to finish in the Big 12 Conference's top three for 10 consecutive seasons.

Defending league champion Oklahoma earned the top spot for the 11th time in the last 12 seasons after receiving six of the seven possible first-place votes (coaches couldn't vote for their own team) and 36 total points. Texas was second with 29 points, while Oklahoma State picked up the remaining first-place vote to hold down third spot with 27 points. Texas Tech (20 points), Baylor (15 points), Iowa State (13 points) and Kansas (seven points) rounded out positions four through seven in the preseason league standings.

OUR VERSION OF 'MAYHEM'

Texas redshirt senior center fielder **Reagan Hathaway** earned the nickname "Mayhem" last season, just like the guy from the Allstate commercials. You see, Reagan has a tendency to go all-out, running into walls, breaking her knee brace over and over, tripping over her shoelaces, just causing pure Mayhem on a daily basis. The new coaching staff gave it to her after one of their first practices together in 2019 as Reagan crashed into the wall to make a catch despite returning from an injury that kept her out for part of 2017 and the majority of the 2018 seasons. Reagan actually has the word "Mayhem" tattooed on the inside of her left arm.

TURN ON THE TUBE TO SEE TEXAS IN 2020

As usual, there will be plenty of chances to see Texas softball play on television in 2020, **31 in all**. Longhorn Network, the 24/7 home for UT athletics, will broadcast 28 Texas home softball games this season while FSN will show UT's April 25 home game against Oklahoma State. FSN has picked up the April 22 home contest versus Baylor, while ESPN will broadcast the March 22 match-up at Oklahoma.
