


All interviews with Lobo coaches and studentathletes must be arranged through Frank Mercogliano and Eugene Canal in the UNM Athletics Media Relations office.

- Four straight NCAA regionals appearances (2010-13), first postseason berths for UNM since 1962
- Birmingham coached the Lobos to their first two MW Tournament Championships in 2011 and 2012. The Lobos also shared the regular-season crown in both 2012 and 2014, and won the league by a record seven games in 2013.
- Attained highest RPI in UNM history (No. 19) in 2010 and its highest ranking ever (No. 13 by Baseball America) in 2013.
- Earned his 1,000th collegiate victory with a 19-5 victory at Air Force on April 6, 2013.



- The NMJC Thunderbirds won the 2005 NJCAA National Championship and were the national runners-up in 2007.
- Birmingham set the foundations for the programs at College of the Southwest (1988-89) and NMJC (1990-2007).
- Birmingham began his coaching career at Las Cruces Mayfield High School where the Trojans won the 4A championship in 1981 and had three No. 1 rankings through 1983.

HOME, SWEET HOME

On March 24, 2013, the UNM baseball team moved into its new old home. After spending most of the previous nine seasons at Isotopes Park, the Lobos returned to a newly renovated Santa Ana Star Field with astounding success. After losing two of their first five games in their new home park, the Lobos finished the season with 11 straight wins at home to post a 14-2 record at Santa Ana Star Field.

SCOUTING SAN DIEGO STATE ... The San Diego State Aztecs are off to a 4-14 start. At home, the Aztecs have amassed three victories, coming once against Fresno State and twice against Northwestern. The Aztecs are 1-4 in conference, despite averaging 8.5 runs per game against MW teams.

The Aztecs are led by Alan Trejo, who is batting a team-best .385 with 13 runs scored, also a team-best. Justin Wylie is leading the squad with 15 RBI.

The Aztecs are expected to throw Alex Purpora to open the series on Thursday. Purpora has a 5.91 ERA over 10.2 innings pitched.

SCOUTING SACRAMENTO STATE ... The Sacramento State Hornets enter their weekend series against North Dakota with an 11-8 record. Their home slate against North Dakota is their opening series in Western Athletic Conference play. The Hornets are 5-2 at their home venue.

Freshman Matt Smith has been a sensation for Sacramento State, batting .426 in his first 47 at bats. He has four doubles and a team-best 12 RBI.

On the mound, Sam Long leads Sacramento State with 17 strikeouts over 25.2 innings pitched.

STAJDUHAR ON FIRE ... New Mexico infielder Carl Stajduhar has been on a tear recently, hitting an even .500 in his last nine games. He is slugging .972 during that span as well. His multiple home run game at Texas Tech was a first for the Lobos since Luis Gonzalez at Wichita State on April, 25, 2015.

WHAT FIVE STRAIGHT ROAD WINS GET YOU ... New Mexico went 5-0 last week, including two wins over Grand Canyon, who are in the RPI Top 100. Those two wins helped jump the Lobos' RPI 93 spots from 189 to 96. That jump of 85 places was easily the largest jump by any team in the NCAA.

Fresno State has the league's best RPI at 69, followed by Air Force at 88, UNM at 96, UNM 168, Nevada 200, San Jose

ATTENDANCE UPDATE ... Through six home games the Lobos are averaging 960 fans, which is 73rd in the country.

DUREE-ABLE... Taylor Duree pitched 1.1 innings against Texas Tech on Tuesday, and that was his 70th career appearance. He is the second pitcher to reach 70 appearances at New Mexico and is now in second place all alone on the UNM career appearances list.

He is now two spots ahead of David Steinberg (not the Canadian comedian, but that would have been amazing) with 69 appearances (Steinberg played from 1979-82). He is now five appearances away from tying Joe Coleman for first on the UNM career list. Here is the top 10:

BULLPEN DOMINANCE ... The UNM bullpen has been outstanding at protecting leads during the last several seasons. If UNM is leading after eight innings? Forget it. The Lobos haven't lost when leading after eight in 93 straight games, a streak that dates back to March 24, 2013.

PLEASE, COME BACK SOON ... UNM's sweep of San Jose State was the first home conference sweep of an opponent since last May, when UNM swept...San Jose State.

THE MANGHATTAN PROJECT ... It didn't take long for Lobo freshman Jared Mang to receive a nickname. Half a game, maybe? During UNM's opener on Feb. 19 at Hawai'i, TV broadcaster Sam Spangler, himself an Albuquerque native, coined the nickname "Manghattan Project" for the Los Alamos, N.M. native. Los Alamos of course was home of the laboratory for the Manhattan Project, and Mang, a two-time Gatorade State Player of the Year, has prodigious power. Mang lived up to the nickname in his first collegiate series by smashing two home runs against the Rainbow Warriors.

WE'RE GOING STREAKING! WE'RE GOING UP TO THE QUAD AND TO THE GYMNASIUM ... Chris DeVito picked up two hits in the Lobos' game Tuesday at Texas Tech, extending his hitting streak to 18 straight games.

Over that 18-game hitting streak, DeVito has eight multi-hit games, including a 5-for-5 game against Hawai'i. He also has reached base safely in all 20 games this season.

Overall over the streak DeVito is 31-for-73, a .424 average. He is slugging .733over that span, and he has 27 RBIs.

SANTA ANA STAR FIELD ... The Lobos have a new name for their old home in 2016. On Dec. 11, 2015, it was announced that the home of Lobo Baseball (formerly Lobo Field) would now be known as Santa Ana Star Field

after a 10-year, \$1 million naming gift from Tamaya Enterprises.

THAT PESKY NINTH AND ELEVENTH

The Lobos are outscoring or tied with their opponents in every inning this season, except the ninth and eleventh innings. UNM's best inning is the third, when the Lobos have put up 26 runs, and allowed just 12.

HIT ME BABY ONE MORE TIME ...

Despite standing just 5-foot-8 and being the shortest player in each of his four years on the Lobos, Jared Holley has become a baseball magnet. He was hit once during UNM's series with San Jose State, which moved his career total to 32. That is the second most in UNM history, just six behind the leader, Joe Salas.

LOBOS TABBED CO-FAVORITES BY MW COACHES ... The University of New Mexico baseball team was picked as co-favorites in the Mountain West by the conference's coaches. The Lobos received three first-place votes and 32 points overall to tie atop the standings with San Diego State. Junior outfielder Danny Collier, sophomore third baseman Carl Stajduhar and junior first baseman Jack Zoellner were named to the preseason All-Mountain West Team.

This is the fourth straight season the Lobos have been picked as at least co-favorites in the conference.

"It shows you the quality of our program and where we're going," UNM head coach Ray Birmingham said. "In the end, though, it's meaningless. You still have to play the games."

Air Force and Fresno State finished tied for third with 24 points, and the Bulldogs received the final first-place vote. UNLV (15) was picked fifth, just ahead of last year's regular season champion, Nevada (14). San José State finished seventh with six points.

Collier is one of just three players to repeat on the Preseason All-Conference Team, joined by junior outfielder Tyler Jones of Air Force and junior utility player Trenton Brooks of Nevada. Collier, who was the MW 2014 Freshman of the Year and a First Team All-MW performer last season, is a career .349 hitter.

PRESEASON HONORS ... Coming off a Freshman All-America season, sophomore infielder Carl Stajduhar has been named a Preseason All-American by both Louisville Slugger and College Sports Madness.

Junior left-hander Carson Schneider, meanwhile, was named the 260th best college prospect for the 2016 MLB Draft by D1Baseball.com.

BIRMINGHAM ELECTED TO NM SPORTS HALL OF FAME ... UNM head coach Ray Birmingham was elected to his third Hall of Fame this offseason when the New Mexico Sports Hall of Fame opened its doors for him. The official induction ceremony is April 3. He was previously elected to the NJCAA Hall of Fame in 2011 and the Lea County (N.M.) Hall of Fame in 2012.

NEXT FRESHMAN UP ... Five years running now the Lobos have produced a Freshman All-American, including a record three in 2015. It started with DJ Peterson and his NCAA-freshman record 32 doubles in 2011. Then Rvan Padilla hit .353 and helped UNM to Mountain West regular-season and tournament titles in 2012. In 2013 Sam Haggerty was honored after being named Co-MW Freshman of the Year and leading UNM with 49 walks. Last season Danny Collier followed in Haggerty's footsteps in earning MW Freshman of the Year honors and hitting .353 despite being limited by hamstring and heel problems. Last season Carl Stajduhar, Cory Voss and Tyler Stevens all earned the honor, with Stevens becoming the first pitcher in program history to be named a Freshman All-American.

So who's next up for the Lobos? UNM has several intriguing possibilities including two-time New Mexico Gatorade High School Player of the Year Jared Mang. Austin Bell, Andrew Pratt and Austin Treadwell, each of whom hails from Albuquerque, should all receive ample playing time to make their case.

The opportunities will be there for all 12 of the Lobos' freshmen, and one thing is for sure: whoever is playing well will get his chance to be a Freshman All-American.

LOBOS DRAFTED ... The New Mexico baseball program has had 91 studentathletes in its history drafted by Major League Baseball including a schoolrecord seven in the 2013 draft. DJ Peterson led the way by becoming the highest draft pick in school history when the Seattle Mariners selected him with the 12th overall pick. Sam Wolff (sixth round - Texas Rangers) and Mitch Garver (ninth round - Minnesota Twins) gave UNM a trio of picks in the first 10 rounds. Alex Allbritton (21st round -Los Angeles Angels of Anaheim), Will Mathis (25th round - Seattle Mariners), Jake McCasland (26th round - San Francisco Giants) and Josh Melendez (37th round - Houston Astros) completed the record-setting draft for UNM. Last season left-handed pitcher Toller Boardman and second baseman Sam Haggerty were selected in the MLB Draft.

During Birmingham's tenure at UNM, New Mexico has had 23 players drafted and 26 have played professional baseball.

30-WIN SEASONS ... The Lobos are averaging 34 wins per year in the eight years under Ray Birmingham. UNM only reached that number eight times before the Birmingham era. The Lobos' run from 2012-14 (three straight 37-win seasons) was the most wins UNM has recorded in a three-year period. In 2010, New Mexico had the third most wins in program history. The Lobos are currently in the midst of the most successful eight-year stretch in program history (272 wins).
