#### NORTH FLORIDA ATHLETIC COMMUNICATIONS

The North Florida Athletic Communications Office is located on the second floor of UNF Arena in Room 2004. Entering the arena through the front entrance, the office can be accessed by the main stairway or through the arena elevator, which is located on the far left wall of the arena's main lobby.

#### CREDENTIAL REQUESTS

The North Florida Athletic Communications Office will issue credentials to **WORKING** press only. All passes will be left at the Will Call table in UNF Arena.

#### VISITING RADIO

All visiting radio crews **MUST** request credentials through their school's sports information director. Please make arrangements well in advance so necessary arrangements can be made.

#### PHOTOGRAPHERS

Only photographers shooting for accredited media outlets or for North Florida Athletic Communications will be allowed to shoot home events from courtside. No photographers are permitted along the team benches, in the team areas or in front of the courtside press row tables. Flash photography is allowed only from the upper level of UNF Arena.

#### POST-MATCH INTERVIEWS

Following a 10-minute "cooling off" period, a postmatch press conference will take place on the court. The North Florida Athletic Communications staff will poll the media prior to the end of the match to determine which players will be made available after the match. The visiting coach and players will be made available outside their locker room. Pre-game interviews are NOT allowed.

#### INTERVIEUS

Most practices are open to the media and public. However, there may be instances when all or parts of practice are closed. Daily practices typically run 2-4:45 p.m. at UNF Arena, but practice times are subject to change. Contact the Athletic Communications Office for practice times and to set up any interviews with North Florida players and coaches.

#### LRST TIME OUT

It may have been the inaugural intercollegiate event hosted by Georgia Southern at their newly consolidated Armstrong Alumni arena in Savannah, Ga., but the night ended as the first win on the season for the Ospreys and first-year head coach Kristen Wright. UNF (1-6) brought down the Eagles, 3-1, receiving double-digits in kills from three players in the win Tuesday, September 4.

#### **NO PUSHOVERS**

The Ospreys have seen strong opposition. UNF has already faced one ranked opponent (No. 15 Colorado) and two more squads (Wyoming and Tennessee) that have received votes. Last weekend the Navy and Gray joined Michigan State as the only other team to take a set from the 6-0 Lady Vols this season.

#### FAMILIAR & UNFAMILIAR

North Florida faces an old Atlantic Sun foe in USC Upstate and one that they've never battled in New Mexico. The Ospreys are 35-9 against the Spartans and 0-2 against the Paladins of Furman. This will be the second of three Mountain West opponents on the slate for UNF this year.

#### **LEADING WITH YOUTH**

North Florida's 16-player squad features eight returners and eight newcomers, including two transfers with previous experience at the collegiate level. Seven newcomers have seen experience thus far, and UNF has played an average of over 12 players per contest this season.

#### HOW MAY I ASSIST YOU?

Senior setter Madilyn McCarty has been a consistent cog to the Osprey attack, generating 1,446 assists over the past two years and change ... As a freshman McCarty had a standout year with the Winthrop Eagles, dishing out 1,229 assists ... If you take into account her time at Winthrop, McCarty would be fifth all-time in helpers at UNF ... the Springfield, Ill. native dished out 54 assists at Georgia Southern Tuesday, September 4, just two short of her career best.

#### TWO-FOR-TWO

Junior middle blocker Taryn Griffey has earned all-tournament honors at the Rumble in the Rockies and at the Rocky Top Invitational. Griffey eclipsed 400 career kills last weekend and currently has a team-high 98 kills via a .363 hitting percentage.

#### SHE'S BACK!

The Ospreys will be excited to have redshirtsophomore Gabby O'Connell back on the court after missing all of the 2017 campaign with a medical redshirt ushered on by a preseason injury. The Gainesville, Fla., native has posted back-to-back double-doubles, including a 16 kill, 10 dig outing against Georgia Southern September 4.

2016 accolades: ASUN-record five freshman of the week laurels; ASUN Freshman of the Year award; ASUN All-Conference Second Team O'Connell passed 400 kills for her young career against Indiana State last Friday.

#### SOLID SOLIMAR

Freshman outside hitter Solimar Cestero has already had three matches with double-digit kills, including two with 15. She is one of two Ospreys from Puerto Rico, joined by first-year Charyari Ramos.

#### TAKING THE REIGNS

UNF head coach Kristen Wright took over as Director of Volleyball in December of 2017 Helped propel the Ospreys to its most wins in conference play during the beach volleyball season. Wright touts a successful four-year stint leading the indoor and beach volleyball programs at Miracosta College (Oceanside, Callif.) to five conference titles and a state championship in her most recent stop.

#### **WRIGHT'S WORDS**

"Our goal is to have a balanced attack and hit a high efficiency, and last night [at Georgia Southern] Madilyn made a huge step forward in creating those one-on-ones...this weekend is an opportunity to get better and share with our community and our school and show what we are about."

# KRISTEN WRIGHT HEAD COACH & DIRECTOR OF VOLLEYBALL FIRST SEASON (INDOOR) | SAN DIEGO 'O6

Kristen Wright was named the head volleyball coach for the UNF Indoor and Beach Volleyball programs in December of 2017.

#### AN IMMEDIATE INFLUENCE

During her first year with the beach program, Wright led the Ospreys to the Atlantic Sun Conference Final before falling to top-seed Stetson. UNF finished with a 19-12 record while going 8-3 in league play for its most wins in ASUN competition since 2013. The pairs of Courtney Millar and Carina Hoff as well as Taryn Griffey and Chaney Howard secured First-Team All-ASUN Conference accolades, while Casey Justice was slotted onto the all-freshman squad. Griffey also excelled in the classroom, posting a 3.94 grade point average to all-academic team. The Ospreys also had two ASUN pairs of the week to round out the honors during Wright's first beach campaign. The Ospreys closed the regular season winning 12 of their final 16 matches which included a pair of wins over ASUN foes Jacksonville and FGCU.

#### COMING FROM CALIFORNIA - INITIATING SUCCESS AT MIRACOSTA COLLEGE

Wright arrived in Jacksonville following a four-years of success (2014-17) leading the indoor and beach volleyball programs at MiraCosta College in Oceanside, Calif. She initiated the start of both programs and led the Spartans to five conference championships and a state title in beach volleyball, tallying a dominant 80-28 career record. Under her tutelage, the Spartans generated one all-American, two all-state, three all-region,back-to-back players of the year and one beach duo of the year. The personal accolades also came in for Wright as she was named conference coach of the year two times rose to the prestigious AVCA Top 30 Coaches under Thirty Award list in 2012.

#### HIGH SCHOOL DYNASTY

Wright was no stranger to winning before joining MiraCosta, touting over a decade of consistency at the high school ranks. She led Tri-City Christian to eight consecutive CIF San Diego Section Championships, five So-Cal Regional Championships and also earned a state runner-up finish. Wright also had a stop at Sante Fe Christian where she assisted in guiding her team to a California State Championship, SoCal Regional title and a league championship.

All told in 13 years as a head coach, Wright's teams have won a championship in 12, earning multiple titles in one season on several occasions. A staple of California prep volleyball, Wright has coached seven CIF Players of the Year, three San Diego Union-Tribune Scholar Athletes of the Year and a pair of all-American selections. In 2016, Wright was recognized for her high school coaching career with an induction into the San Diego Breitbard Coaching Hall of Fame in 2016.


#### STANDOUT WITH SAN DIEGO

The west coast native began to build a name for herself in the volleyball world as a four-year letterwinner with the San Diego Toreros. As a student-athlete, Wright earned AVCA All-American and All-Region honors while also being selected to three All-West Coast Conference squads. Wright earned her bachelor's degree in history from San Diego in 2006 and just recently completed her master's degree from Asuza Pacific in June 2018.

She is married to Doug Wright, and the couple are the parents of children: Bradyn and Kylee.

#### WRIGHT'S WORDS

"My family and I are thrilled to join the UNF family. I am eager to work with our staff and student-athletes as we build a championship program in indoor and beach. I am well prepared and have outstanding experience in running a program that has both indoor and beach and our goal is to be the best mid-major school in the country that sponsors both. To become a championship program, it requires vision, hard work, and buy-in from everyone. We have to know where we want to go as a program and put in the time and work necessary to get there. You can build a championship culture and still have tight knit relationships on the team. Bringing a vision to fruition is what I've always done, and I plan to do it again at UNF."

# SKYLAR LOPAS ASSISTANT COACH | THIRD SEASON (WARNER '13)

Skylar Lopas enters his third season with the North Florida volleyball program.

Lopas joins the Ospreys after a two-year stint as the volunteer assistant coach at the University of Michigan. He worked with the middle blockers as well as breaking down opponents and scouting reports. Lopas helped the Wolverines improve their RPI by 17 points and boost their win total by seven. While in Michigan, he also served as a director of the Ann Arbor location of Legacy Volleyball Club.

Prior to working with Michigan, Lopas spent time at Bishop Moore Catholic High School in Orlando, where he was the assistant coach of the varsity men's volleyball team. He also coached the Orlando Gold Volleyball club team since October 2013. Lopas was the head coach of the 18-year-old squad and the assistant to the 14U team.

He also was a varsity assistant coach for the women's team and a substitute teacher at Freedom High School in Orlando in the fall of 2013.



## **KEYIN INLOW**

#### **ASSISTANT COACH | FIRST SERSON (TEXAS '16)**

Kevin Inlow was named the assistant coach for the UNF Indoor Volleyball program in January of 2018.

Inlow joins the Ospreys after spending the previous six seasons working as a manager and graduate assistant at the University of Texas, where he was a part of five NCAA Final Four appearances and three NCAA Finals.

During his time in Austin, Inlow worked with DataVolley and DataVideo, while also working on statistics and video for the Longhorns. He was involved in all the travel and team meetings, and was in charge of running the Longhorns volleyball camps for three summers.

He also worked as an assistant coach on the USA Volleyball junior national team during the summer of 2017. The team won gold in the Pan American Cup U20 event. Inlow also worked as a volunteer for the women's national team during the 2015 campaign.

## EMILY STRACK

# DIRECTOR OF VOLLEYBALL OPERATIONS FIRST SEASON (INDOOR) | NORTH FLORIDA '14

Emily Strack enters her first season as the University of North Florida Director of Volleyball Operations after a standout collegiate career for the Ospreys and one year as the assistant coach for the UNF Beach Volleyball program.

The Fort Lauderdale native's first dose of coaching at UNF came as after joining as the volunteer beach coach for the 2016 ASUN Champion squad. A point of Osprey history, Strack touts the title as the first beach signee for UNF when it became a sport in 2010.

Strack competed on the 2010 - 2013 indoor and outdoor program and won the 2011, 2012, and 2013 ASUN championship titles. Overall, Strack concluded with a 30-8 overall record in three seasons on the sand and helped push UNF to the ASUN Tournament finals in indoor play as a setter in 2012.

A first-team all-conference pick in 2011, 2012 and 2013, Strack also touts the experience of playing in the 2011 AVCA National Championship with Dagnijia Medina, placing ninth overall.
