- The Aggies currently lead the overall series 24-11 vs the Lobos.

Post-game Notes:

- New Mexico's two-point deficit marks the smallest point differential in a loss this season.
 - The next closest matchup came on Dec. 11 against Colorado and was three points.
- Four Lobos finished in double figures including: Carlton Bragg (18), Anthony Mathis (16), Vance Jackson (13) and Makuach Maluach (12).
- The Lobos blocked five shots from the Aggies. This is the sixth time UNM has blocked five or more shots in a game this season.
- The ball was turned over 11 times by the Lobos which is the lowest turnover total in a game since January 8, 2019 against UNLV (11).
- UNM held Utah State 11 points below their scoring average (79.1 ppg).
- The Aggies went 9-for-18 from behind the arc. This is the 16th time this season an opponent made less than 10 three-pointers in a game against UNM.
- The Lobos held one of Utah State's leading scorers, Neemias Queta, to just eight points, three points under his average (11.0 ppg).
- Redshirt-sophomore Keith McGee posted a new career-high three steals.
 - McGee had all three of the Lobos' steals.
- Carlton Bragg's 18 points sets a new career high for the redshirt-junior.
 - Bragg set a new career high of field goals attempted at 13.
 - Bragg was 6-for-7 from the free-throw line which sets a new career high for free-throws made and attempted.
 - This was the second time this season that Bragg was the leading scorer for the Lobos.
