ABOUT THE MATCHUP: The Lobos will face San Jose State Saturday Jan. 23 at 2 p.m. This will be just the sixth matchup in all-time history between the two teams. The Lobos lead the all-time series 5-0, claiming their fifth straight win over the Spartans last year in San Jose 64-62. This will be the fourth matchup under head coach Yvonne Sanchez. She leads the series over third year Spartan coach Jaime Craighead 3-0.

ABOUT SAN JOSE STATE: The Spartans are currently 6-12 on the season and sit in fourth place of the Mountain West with a 4-3 record. They are coming off a heartbreaking 78-75 loss to Boise State Wednesday. On the season, they are shooting 39 percent from the field and 32 percent from the three-point line. They give up 77.9 points per game to their opponents but they average 75.1 ppg. They average 40.3 rebounds per game and 16.7 turnovers per game. In conference, they have wins over Wyoming, San Diego State, Air Force and Utah State.

They have really relied on guard Dezz Ramos, as she averages 19.4 ppg. She is shooting 43 percent from the field and 41 percent from the three. Nyre Harris is third on the team in scoring at 9.8 ppg. Riana Byrd will see time off the bench, scoring 9.4 ppg and leading the Spartans in rebounding at 7.0 rpg. Myzhanique Ladd leads the team in shooting with a 51 percent from the field.

SHUMPERT JUST 10 POINTS AWAY

With her 13 points against Wyoming last week, Shumpert is now just 10 points away from reaching 1,000 career points. She has a total of 990 in her career. This goal could be reachable against SJSU as she averages 14.4 ppg. Against Nevada on Dec. 30, Lobo senior Khadijah Shumpert hit her first career milestone, bringing down her 500th career rebound. Before the game with Nevada, she need just five rebounds and she did just that. Shumpert will be the 14th player in Lobo history to get to 1,000 points and 500 rebounds and the 20th player to reach 1,000 career points. The last Lobo to join that list of 1,000/500 was Sara Halasz (2008-14). Halasz finished with 1,061 points and 557 rebounds. Bryce Owens is the other senior that is inching closer towards the 1,000 point club. She now has 807 points in her career which is 193 points away from joining the list. The last Lobo to join the 1,000 point club was Antiesha Brown (2012-15). Brown finished her career with 1,120 points.

KELLER STEPS UP ON DEFENSE

Kianna Keller is known for her size and blocking skills. Over the last couple games she has really stepped on defense for the Lobos. Even though she hasn't scored much, she has helped her team on the other side of the court, getting defensive stops. She picked up two more blocks against Wyoming last week to bring her career total to 98, which is sixth in UNM history on the all-time list. This season she has passed up three former Lobos in Abby Garchek (1995-98), Jessica Kielpinski (2007-11) and Val Kast (2000-10). She is now seven away from being tied for fifth all time with Dionne Marsh (2005-08). The all-time leader is Jordan Adams (2000-03) with 344.

LOBOS FALL TO WYOMING ON THE ROAD

New Mexico didn't quite have the best of night on the road in Laramie, Wyo. They fell to the Cowgirls 66-48. Khadijah Shumpert led the way with 13 points. She was 4-for-5 from the field and 5-for-5 from the free throw line. Cherise Beynon picked up 12 points as she finished with a career-high of 26 attempts. She was 5-for-26 from the field and 2-for-7 from three points range. The Lobos shot just 28 percent from the field and 22 percent from three-point range but they did have a good night at the free throw line, shooting 73 percent.

LOBOS HAVE BIG OFFENSE NIGHT IN WIN OVER UNLV

New Mexico got a much-needed victory Wednesday night against UNLV, using offense that they haven't seen come together in a while. They shot 42 percent from the field, 33 percent from the three and 78 percent from the free throw line. The Lobos had four players in double-figures for the first time this season. Senior Khadijah Shumpert went off for 18 points. Senior Bryce Owens tied a season-high with 15 points and sophomore Cherise Beynon finished with 13 points. Junior Whitney Johnson picked up 11 points, going 5-for-7 after going 0-for-5 against Utah State last week.

DEFENSE SHUT DOWN UNLV

It wasn't just the offense that picked up the UNLV victory for the Lobos. Tough and consistent defense held off UNLV from scoring. The Lobos had a great defensive fourth quarter, only allowing UNLV to score 10 points. UNLV only scored five times in the final quarter coming at the 7:55 mark, 4:20 mark, 1:56 mark, 1:20 mark and with 44 seconds left in the game. Sophomore Kenya Pye finished with a great defensive game. She did not score a point for the Lobos but stepped up big on the defensive side of the game.

BEYNON TIES CAREER-HIGH IN ROAD LOSS TO UTAH STATE

Cherise Beynon led the way for the Lobos against Utah State on Jan. 9, tying a career-high of 21 points. She went 7-for-16 from the field, a career-high 4-for-7 from the three and a perfect 3-for-3 from the free throw line. She finished with three rebounds, one assist, one turnover, one block and one steal in a team-high 35 minutes of play. The

21 points wasn't enough to keep Utah State away as the Lobos fell 72-56 in Logan. Beynon is leading the Lobos in conference play, averaging 17.3 ppg and 6.3 rpg. she is shooting 36 percent from the field and 40 percent from the three.

LOBOS FALL IN DOUBLE OT TO FRESNO STATE

On Saturday, the Lobos fell to Fresno State 69-65 in double overtime. This was the first double overtime game since the 2010 season. Cherise Beynon tied the game in regulation with a free throw to send the game into overtime. The two teams went point-for-point for the full five minutes in the first overtime. The Lobos got into a foul situation, losing senior Khadijah Shumpert with four minutes left in the second overtime. Fresno State made its free throws and continued to score on offense to claim the victory.

THE RETURN OF EMILY LINES

Freshman Emily Lines has returned back to action after missing games from Nov. 27 to Dec. 30 due to an injury in her foot. She returned to action on Dec. 30, playing two minutes in the Nevada game. She played a total of six minutes, scoring four points against Fresno State Saturday. Lines is known for her shooting beyond the arc. She had a season-high of 14 points against New Mexico State on Nov. 17, scoring 10 points in the final quarter.

LOBOS AGAINST OPPONENTS

UNM is outscoring their opponents by 5.7 points. The Lobos are averaging 65.4 points per game to their opponents 59.7. They are also shooting better from the field. The Lobos have a 39.1 shooting percentage to their opponents 35.3 percent. Another category the Lobos are above their opponents is rebounding. The Lobos are averaging 42.2 rebounds per game to their opponents 37.1 which is a +5.2 rebounding margin. The Lobos also have a 0.9 assist to turnover ratio to their opponents 0.6.

LOBOS OPEN CONFERENCE WITH WIN OVER NEVADA

On Dec. 30, the Lobos opened Mountain West conference action with a 51-47 win over Nevada which was the first time since the 2008-09 season that the Lobos opened up conference play with a win. The last time the Lobos won their conference opener was Jan. 7, 2009, beating UNLV 75-49.

GUARDS STEP UP

The Lobos were down a few bodies against Nevada on Dec. 30 but the Lobos' guards stepped up for the team to help secure the victory. Sophomore Cherise Beynon stepped up for the Lobos in the scoring column, leading the squad with 14 points and six rebounds. Senior Bryce Owens was second on the team with 13 points. She brought down a team-best seven rebounds. Sophomore Laneah Bryan finished with a career-high seven assists of the Lobos' eight for the game.

CHRISTMAS BREAK

After the second and final Rio Grande Rivalry with New Mexico

State, the Lobos had 10 days off until the game with Nevada. The Lobos went home for five days, returning to Albuquerque on Dec. 26 for a night practice. The Lobos practiced Sunday, Monday, Tuesday and will take on Nevada on Wednesday, Dec. 30 in Reno, Nevada.

LOBOS HEAD INTO CONFERENCE WITH WINNING RECORD

The Lobos head into conference action with a winning record for the first time since the Lobos went 8-4 in the 2012-13 season. The 7-4 nonconference record this season is the exact opposite from last year's record, heading into conference play. The Lobos were 4-7 a year ago before facing Fresno State in their first MW game of the 2014-15 season. The Lobos have won three of their last four, including wins over SMU (Dec. 5), Pepperdine (Dec. 12) and Minnesota (Dec. 16).

LOBOS FALL IN SECOND AND FINAL RIO GRANDE RIVALRY

The Lobos fell 52-47 to New Mexico State in their final nonconference game on Dec. 20. The Lobos had the lead until the start of the second half, when New Mexico State went on a run and held the Lobos to just three points in the third quarter. Those three points came off of free throws. That was the lowest points the Lobos have scored in a quarter this season.

BOVERO STEPS UP

Against New Mexico State on Dec. 20, sophomore guard Jayda Bovero stepped up for the Lobos, scoring a career-high nine points. Those nine points helped the Lobos keep in the game. She was 4-for-7 from the free throw line and 2-for-4 from the field.

BIG WIN OVER BIG TEN MINNESOTA

New Mexico claimed a dominating 72-43 win over Big Ten Minnesota to move to 7-3 in the season on Dec. 16. The Lobos stopped one of the top scoring duos in the country and limited Minnesota's three-point advantage to just five three's on the game. Minnesota was averaging 10.7 three's per game heading into that match up with the Lobos. The Lobos put together one of their top performances of the season at the three-point line. The Lobos sunk eight three pointers in the first half, which was the third time this season that the Lobos had eight three's in a game.

SHINING IN HER HOME STATE

Senior forward Khadijah Shumpert has been the rock of the Lobo squad this season. She had a dominating performance against Minnesota in her home state, going off for a career-tying 27 points. That is her second game in a row with 20 or more points and her fourth for the season. Shumpert is leading the team with 15.4 ppg and 7.0 rpg. She is shooting a team-best 58 percent from the field and 72 percent from the free throw line.

NEW MEXICO GAME NOTES

LOBOS FIRST ROAD WIN ON SANCHEZ'S BIRTHDAY

On Dec. 5, New Mexico claimed its fifth victory of the season, defeating SMU 63-58 on head coach Yvonne Sanchez's birthday. The Lobos are now 3-1 on her birthday since she became a part of the UNM women's basketball program. It was the Lobos' first road win of the season and it was the first nonconference road win of the season since the 2012-13 season when they beat New Mexico State in Pan American Center on Dec. 18, 2012 68-44.

SHUMPERT GETS SECOND DOUBLE-DOUBLE

For the second time this season, senior forward Khadijah Shumpert recorded a double-double, collecting 20 points and 10 rebounds in the 70-62 loss against UTEP on Dec. 5. She was 7-for-10 from the field and 6-for-8 from the free throw line. She brought down five offensive and five defensive boards. Her first double-double came on Nov. 21 against Sac State. She had 21 points and 10 rebounds. Last season, the Lobos only had three double-doubles and Shumpert had two of those three.

LOBOS FALL TO UTEP

On Wednesday, the Lobos struggled to guard the three-point line against the Miners, falling 70-62 in El Paso. The Lobos and the Miners were even on shooting at 42 percent but the Miners shot 50 percent (12-24) from the three which made the difference in the game. Besides Shumpert's double-double, Cherise Beynon scored 13 points which was second on the team. She also dished out four assists. Laneah Bryan dished out a career-high five assists.

GETTING BETTER AT THE LINE

At the start of the season, the Lobos struggled at the free throw line, shooting under 70 percent. The Lobos goal is to shoot 75 percent or better. The last three of four games the Lobos have done a better job at the line as they have been in the 70 percent area. They are currently shooting 63 percent from the line with Beynon leading the way with a 71 shooting percentage.

UNM FALLS IN THANKSGIVING TOURNAMENT

The Lobos played well on Friday, Nov. 27 against Southern Utah to claim a 70-48 win over the Thunderbirds. That win gave the Lobos the chance to win the tournament for the first time since the 2008-09 season. But a tough Duquesne team got in the way of the Lobos. The Lobos fell on Saturday, Nov. 28 to the Dukes 78-69, making it the seventh straight year the Lobos have not won their own tournament.

THE WISEPIES ARENA STREAK ENDS

The WisePies Arena streak extends came to an end on Saturday, Nov. 28 after suffering the 78-69 loss to Duquesne. Prior to the loss, the Lobos had won 16 straight games in WisePies Arena which dated back to Dec. 18, 2014 when the Lobos beat Cal Poly 84-68.

SHUMPERT EARNS ALL-TOURNEY HONORS

Senior forward Khadijah Shumpert led the Lobos in the UNM Thanksgiving Tournament, averaging 18.5 ppg to earn all-tournament honors. She recorded 14 points against Southern Utah, shooting 5-for-10 from the field. On Saturday, she put together a career performance, scoring a career-high 23 points. She was 7-for-15 from the field and 9-for-10 from the free throw line. She brought down six rebounds to go along with two steals.

NLI SHOW ON ROOT SPORTS

ROOT Sports featured the women's basketball NLI show. That took place during the 30-minute break between the men's and women's games Friday Nov. 13. Coach Sanchez and Lobo play-by-play announcer Josh Suchon talked about the four signees and previewed the 2015-16 season. The Lobos welcome in Brittany Panetti from Katy, Texas, Hannah Sjerven from Rogers, Minn., Mykiel Burleson from Pflugerville, Texas and Sammie Woodward from Racine, Wisc. This recruiting class was ranked the top class in the Mountain West, which is the second year in a row the Lobos have earned that ranking.

ABOUT THE 2015-16 LOBOS

The 2015-16 edition of the New Mexico women's basketball team is an experienced group that adds three exciting freshmen to the mix. The Lobos return 11 letterwinners to the squad which includes the return of Whitney Johnson, who has been away from the team on a Mormon Mission in Mexico. With the loss of Antiesha Brown, the Lobos will look to four returning starters with the leadership of three seniors, Alexa Chavez, Bryce Owens and Khadijah Shumpert.

The Lobos have a nonconference schedule that starts out with seven of their first eight games at home. The nonconference schedule is highlighted by games with SMU, Minnesota, Nicholls State, Sacramento State, UTEP, Pepperdine, Houston Baptist and our home Thanksgiving tournament, welcoming in North Carolina A&T, Southern Utah and Duquesne.

ONE FOR THE BOOKS

Last year's season was one for the books, as the 2014-15 Lobos finished with a school-record 14 conference wins, winning 13 straight at home for the first time since 2004-05 and went undefeated at home in conference play for the first time since 2005-06. Sanchez earned Mountain West Coach of the Year honors. The Lobos advanced to the finals of the Mountain West Tournament for the second time in four years and hosted two games in the WBI, the team's first postseason appearance since 2009-10.

ADDITION BY ADDITION

The Lobos welcome three freshmen — all coming from experienced backgrounds of basketball. The three freshmen gave the Lobos their BlueStar Top 50 recruiting class honorable mention, making them the only program in the Mountain West to earn that distinction.

THERE'S NO PLACE LIKE HOME

Last year, "The Pit" went underconstruction with the name of the arena. It is still identified as "The Pit" but has a few more letters added to it, as the name of the arena is now WisePies Arena aka The Pit. "The Pit" is nationally recognized as one of the top basketball venues. Need more evidence? How about Sports Illustrated ranking it as one of the top 20 sporting venues, of any sport, in the world for the 20th century. The Pit is truly a special place, and it has created an unparalleled environment for the New Mexico women's basketball program. The Lobos have led the Mountain West in attendance every year of the conference's existence since the 1999-00 season. During that same span, the program has ranked in the top 20 nationally in attendance in each of those years.

ALBUQUERQUE'S OWN

When head coach Yvonne Sanchez calls Albuquerque her home, she really means it. Sanchez enters her fifth season at the helm of the Lobo program after spending the previous 11 seasons as an assistant on staff under coach Don Flanagan. However, Yvonne Sanchez and basketball in Albuquerque go back over a quarter of a century. Sanchez was a prep stand-out for Flanagan at Eldorado High School in Albuquerque in the 1980s. Sanchez earned Mountain West Coach of the Year after finishing second in the MW with a 14-4 record.

STUDENT-ATHLETE SPIRIT

Academic excellence has become the norm for the New Mexico women's basketball. The Lobos are regularly taking home Mountain West Academic all-conference and Scholar-Athlete awards, but they shine in national academic rankings as well. For six of the last eight seasons, and eight of the last 11 seasons, UNM has finished in the WBCA's Academic Top 25 rankings.

MOUNTAIN WEST MEDIA POLL

The Rio Grande rivalry is a series between UNM and NMSU that encompasses athletic teams for both programs. It began with the 2007-08 school year. The teams' will match up this season on November 17 in La Cruces and December 20 in Albuquerque.

STAFF OF ENCHANTMENT

In addition to coach Yvonne Sanchez's New Mexico roots, the UNM staff has several other connections to the Land of Enchantment.

Assistant coach Amy Beggin is a 2010 graduate of UNM and just one of 17 Lobo players to score 1,000 points during her collegiate career. She became the program's video coordinator in 2011 and worked her way up to director of operations and now assistant coach, where she is in her second season.

Jourdan Erskine replaced Beggin as the team's director of operations. Erskine played for the Lobos from 2009-13 and was a team captain her senior year. Erskine was the team's video coordinator before she was promoted to director of operations.

Vera Jo Bustos took over the video coordinator position, who was a standout New Mexico prep player at West Las Vegas High School. She is the school's all-time leader in points, rebounds, assists, steals and games started.

Former All-America and Olympic athlete Carla Garrett became the program's strength coach in the summer of 2015. She is originally from Santa Fe, New Mexico and played high school basketball against head coach Yvonne Sanchez.
