#5 THINGS

1. UTEP is off to a start of at least 5-0 for the fifth time in school history, four of which have come under head coach Keitha Adams.
2. Ten different Miners have earned at least 10.0 minutes per game, but no one is receiving more than 30.0 mpg.
3. Miner back-ups are outscoring the opposition by a count of 144-57 (28.8 ppg-11.4 ppg).
4. All five victories have been by double figures, which makes this year's team and the 2013-14 edition of the Miners the only ones in program history to achieve that feat at the onset of the campaign.
5. UTEP has led for 168:06 out of a possible 200:00 minutes on the year.

THE OPENING ACT

- Undefeated UTEP will play host to I-25 rival New Mexico with a special tipoff time of 4:15 p.m. at the Don Haskins Center Wednesday. The Miners (5-0) will be looking to wrap up the program's second-longest homestand to start the year style against the Lobos (4-2).

- All area schools are invited to attend the game for free but they must contact the UTEP marketing office (915-747-6065) to take advantage of the promotion. Fans are encouraged to make it an evening of Miner hoops by cheering on the women vs. UNM at 4:15 p.m. and then heading up I-10 to support the men's team inside the Pan-American Center at New Mexico State at 7 p.m.

- UTEP is off to a start of at least 5-0 for the fifth time in school history, four of which have come under head coach Keitha Adams.

- The Miners previously did so in 2013-14 (9-0), 2012-13 (5-0), 2011-12 (10-0) and 1996-97 (7-0).

- All five victories have been by double figures, which makes this year's team and the 2013-14 edition of the Miners the only ones in program history to achieve that feat at the onset of the campaign.

- UTEP is one of two C-USA programs (Marshall the other) to be unbeaten on the year.

- The game will be broadcast on 600 ESPN El Paso, KR0D-AM Radio with **Steve Kaplowitz** (play-by-play) and **Traci Miller** (color) on the call. There will be a live stream on UTEPAthletics (subscription based). Fans can also get updates by following @UTEPWBB on Twitter.

NEW FORMAT

- NCAA women's basketball games will be played in four 10-minute quarters for the '15-16 season.

- Teams will now reach the bonus and shoot two free throws on the fifth team foul in each quarter. In the four-quarter format, team fouls reset to zero at the start of each quarter.

- Teams now have four timeouts (three 30s, one 60), three which carry over to the second half. They will be able to advance the ball to the frontcourt after a timeout with less than 59.9 seconds in 4Q.

- There are seven media timeouts (four under five minutes in quarter/first called), two intermission media timeouts (after first and third quarters) and the first team-called timeout during the second half.

Bands or amplified music may now play during any dead ball.

INSIDE THE SERIES

- New Mexico leads the series, 31-16, including a 72-57 victory last year in Albuquerque.


- The Miners are 4-2 against the Lobos since 2007-08

- The two programs faced off at least once per year from 1974-75 through 1986-87.

GETTING TO KNOW NEW MEXICO

Overall: 4-2 Home: 4-1 Road 0-1 Neutral 0-0

- New Mexico returned four starters and 11 letter winners from last year's team (21-13, 14-4 Mountain West) that earned a bid to the WBI. It marked the first postseason appearance at the school since 2008-09 while the 14 league wins were a school record.
- Downed Houston Baptist, 65-57, in its season opener before falling at NM State, 78-59, on Nov. 17.
- Regrouped to win three straight contests (all by double figures) but that streak was stopped in a 78-69 home loss to Duquesne on Nov. 28. The loss vs. Duquesne also snapped a 16-game home unbeaten streak.
- The match-up at UTEP will be the second road game on the season for the Lobos.
- Balanced offensive attack with six players contributing at least 7.0 points per game, including a pair in double figures in Khadijah Shumpert (12.8 ppg) and Cherise Beynon (10.0 ppg).
- Shumpert is the top rebounder (6.8 rpg) followed by Jaisa Nunn (6.0 rpg).
- UNM has crushed the opposition on the glass (43.8-35.8), thanks to 15.8 offensive boards/game.
- Connecting on 41.6 percent (157-377) from the floor, including 33.7 percent (30-of-89) from distance.
- Registered eight appearances in the NAIA Tournament before beginning a transition back to DI athletics. The program has earned eight bids into the NCAA Tournament while competing in the WNIT five times.
- The University of New Mexico, located in Albuquerque, is the largest state school in New Mexico. It was founded in 1899. Notable alumni include Gary Berntsen (Former CIA Senior Operations Officer), Antoine Predock (Renowned architect who designed Petco Park, and Brian Urlacher (former All-Pro LB for Chicago Bears).

GOING BACK IN TIME

(at UTEP 67, Idaho State 54)

- Junior **Jenzel Nash** poured in a career-high 26 points to help propel UTEP past Idaho State, 67-54, in the championship game of the Fifth-Annual UTEP Thanksgiving Classic on Nov. 28.
- The Miners nailed 11 three pointers (tied eighth all time), including four by Nash-who was named the tournament's MVP- while also harassing the Bengals into 22 turnovers.
- UTEP committed a season-low nine turnovers and held a 17-8 advantage in points off giveaways.
- **Cameasha Turner** (12 points) and **Starr Breedlove** (11 points) joined Nash in double figures for scoring while **Lulu McKinney** came off the bench to tally seven points.
- Nash was 8-of-15 from the floor, including 4-of-6 from three-point range, while making all six free throws. She also grabbed seven rebounds, recorded five steals and dished out four assists in 29 minutes.
- Breedlove was named to the All-Tournament team, along with Nash.

THE RUNDOWN ON UTEP'S 2015-16 SEASON

Overall: 5-0 Home: 5-0 Road 0-0 Neutral 0-0

- Bolted to a 5-0 start on the year while sporting a +18.8 (77.6-58.8) scoring margin.
- Led for 168:06 out of a possible 200:00 minutes on the year.
- Posted wire-to-wire win against Houston Baptist (11/15) while never trailing by more than three points in respective victories against Northern Arizona (11/17), Hampton (11/22) and Idaho State (11/28).
- The biggest deficit on the season (six points) came against UC Riverside (11/27). UTEP trailed 13-7 with 3:32 to play in the first quarter but went on to win by double figures (68-57).
- Has not trailed at any point during second-half action this year.
- Outscoring foes on average, 42.1-31.2, in the second half.
- Has a positive scoring margin in all four quarters, with the third quarter being its best at +6.8 (23.2-16.4).
- **Jenzel Nash** (16.6 ppg), **Starr Breedlove** (12.5 ppg), **Cameasha Turner** (12.0) and **Sparkle Taylor** (9.4 ppg) pace UTEP's attack (77.6 ppg) but four other Miners contribute between 4.0-5.8 ppg. It's a similar story when it comes to the glass, with six Miners securing between 3.0-6.6 rpg. Nash tops the list at 6.6 rpg.
- Holding foes to 58.8 points per game and forcing 24.2 turnovers per game.
- No Miner opponent has scored more than 66 points, and each one has made 22+ turnovers.
- Ten Miners are earning at least 10.0 minutes per game but no one receiving more than 30.0 mpg.
- Miner back-ups are outscoring the opposition by a count of 144-57 (28.8 ppg-11.4 ppg).

WHAT'S TRENDING

- Nailed 11 three pointers (tied eighth all time at school) on 32 attempts (tied second all time) in the win against Idaho State on Nov. 28. Had made 15-of-63 combined in the first four contests.
- Made only nine turnovers vs. ISU after averaging 19.8 giveaways in the initial four games of the year.
- Forced 20+ turnovers in all five games, the longest such streak to start a year since 1996-97 (six). The only other longer sequences at the onset of the year came in 1994-95 (nine) and 1983-84 (10).
- Made 10+ free throws and connected on better than 70 percent from the line in the first five games for the second time in program history. The 2005-06 squad also achieved the feat.
- Improved every game in defending the three-point shot. HBU hit 35.7 percent (5-of-15) in the opener on Nov. 15 followed by NAU's 31.3 percent (5-of-16) on Nov. 17. Hampton finished at 30.8 percent (4-of-13) on Nov. 22, UC Riverside was held to 29.4 percent (5-of-17) on Nov. 27 while Idaho State was limited to 27.3 percent (3-of-11).

THE BASIC FACTS ON UTEP

- UTEP is 515-620 in its 42nd season as a women's basketball program, including 5-0 this year.
- Five 20+ win seasons (all since 2006-07), including three straight (2012-14) for the first time at school.
- Two regular-season league championships (2008 & 2012) & one league tourney title (2012).
- Became first C-USA women's team to go 16-0 while claiming initial league title in 2008.
- Finished 15-1 in 2012 & won C-USA tournament.
- Own C-USA single-season record for winning streak at 23, which was set in 2007-08.
- Made three postseason appearances, including the 2014 WNIT where it earned runner-up honors.
- Appeared in 2008 (at-large bid, #7 seed) and 2012 NCAA Tournament (automatic bid, #13 seed).
- Faced #4 seed and #12 in polls Penn State in the 2012 NCAA First Round. The game was tied at the half (39-39) before Penn State pulled away for the 85-77 victory (3/18/12).
- Beat #10 seed Western Kentucky, 92-60 (3/22/08) in the first round of '08 "Big Dance."
- Bowed out with 88-54 loss at two-seed & #4 seed and eventual national-runner up Stanford.
- The University of Texas at El Paso (founded in 1914) recently enjoyed a centennial celebration.

- Notable alumni include former ABC News Chief White House Correspondent **Sam Donaldson**, well-respected NFL referee **Ed Hochuli**, former NASA astronaut **Danny Olivias** engineer & **Dennis Poon**, who designed Taipei 101 & some of the tallest buildings in the world..

THE ADAMS FILE

- UTEP is under the direction of 15th-year head coach **Keitha Adams**.
- Adams is a two-time C- USA Coach of the Year ('08 and '12) is UTEP's all-time win leader at 252-181.
- Overall she stands at 379-218 in her 20th year as a collegiate head coach, making her one of two active C-USA coaches with 300+ career collegiate wins.
- All five 20+ win seasons and six of the seven with 18+ have been during her tenure.
- She is responsible for all three postseason bids (NCAA in 2008 and 2012; WNIT 2014) and all three league championships (2008 C-USA regular season; 2012 C-USA regular season and conference tournament) in school history.
- Twenty of the 23 major individual career records at the school are held by players from her era.
- Posted at least 16 wins in nine seasons; there were three such campaigns in program's first 27 years.
- More than 100 games above .500 (211-107) since joining Conference USA prior to the 2005-06 season.
- 115-156 was best record for 10-year stretch before her arrival.
- Earned votes in top-25 poll in 2011-12, 2012-13 and 2013-14 and six times overall.
- Never achieved feat before Adams' era.
- Nationally ranked for final six weeks of '2007-08.
- UTEP has compiled 49 months with a winning percentage of .500 or better under Adams compared to just 20 with a losing record in what is now her 15th year on the job. Eight of those 20 came in her first two years.
- Coached 20 players who have gone on to play professionally, including '08 WNBA draft picks **Izabela Piekarska** & **Natasha Lacy**.
- Impacted the international game at the highest level, with **Noni Wharemate** representing New Zealand at '08 Olympic Games.
- Every player who has exhausted her eligibility at UTEP during her tenure has graduated.

WHAT A DIFFERENCE A YEAR MAKES

- Heading into the start of the '14-15 season, UTEP was faced with the daunting task of replacing the most successful senior class (**Kayla Thornton**, **Kristine Vitola** and **Kelli Willingham**) in program history. That task was made even harder with anticipated leaders **Jenzel Nash** and **Chrishauna Parker** missing the 2014-15 season.
- The result was a young UTEP squad going through some growing pains on the way to finishing at 12-16, which marked the program's first losing season since 2005-06 (14-16).
- Things are looking up in 2015-16, with Nash and Parker back in the fold. Overall 10 letter winners return, including three starters, and six newcomers (including redshirt senior transfer Starr Breedlove) set to be in the mix.
- From a pure statistical standpoint, the Miners have plenty back, evidenced by the chart below.

THIRD-BEST IN TEXAS SINCE '06-07

- The Miners have the third-most wins among all DI programs in Texas since 2006-07.
- Recent national champions & 2014 NCAA Elite 8 participants Baylor (286-44) and Texas A&M (244-77) lead the way while UTEP (197-92) has a firm grip on third. Texas (183-119) is fourth followed by Lamar (178-113), TCU (173-119-sixth), Stephen F. Austin (165-121-seventh), Prairie View A&M (164-131-eighth), SMU (159-126-ninth) and Texas Tech (155-139-10th) round out the top 10.

SPECIAL RUN

- 97-38 since the start of '11-12 season (5-0 this year), with 65 double-digit wins.
- Qualified for postseason play in two of the four campaigns. Posted 5-1 record en route to earning runner-up honors at the 2014 WNIT while landing an at-large bid to the 2012 NCAA Tournament after winning both the 2012 C-USA regular season and tournament title
- Enjoyed 13 separate winning streaks of at least three games.
- Contrast that with one three-game losing skid & one six-game setback streak.

CHECK THE STATS

- 3-0 on year and 190-59 under **Keitha Adams** when keeping foes to less than 40 percent from the floor.
- 5-0 on season and 191-41 under Adams when leading at the break.
- 3-0 on year and 179-50 under Adams when making better than 40% from the floor.
- 3-0 on season and 169-58 under Adams when winning the rebounding battle.
- 3-0 on year and 134-34 under Adams when allowing less than 60 points.
- 3-0 on year and 84-12 under Adams when opposition has more turnovers than field goals.
- 1-0 on season and 71-4 under Adams with 80+ points.
- 65-3 when recording at least 20 assists during the Adams era.

She is also 14th for starts (74), 17th in steals (111), 18th in three-pointers made (61), 19th for three-pointers attempted (199), 20th in minutes played (2102) and free-throws made (186), 23rd for games played (96) and 30th in field goals made (235).
- Juniors **Jenzel Nash** (637-34th) and **Sparkle Taylor** (524-43rd) are both members of the 500+ point club. Nash is also 24th for free throws made (171) and steals (92).

- UTEP will play its first road game of the year when it battles I-10 rival NM State at 2 p.m. MT Saturday.

CLIFFNOTES ON THE '15-16 SEASON

(at UTEP 68, UCR 57, 11/27/15)

- UTEP flexed its defensive muscle while also showing off its depth in a 68-57 victory against visiting UC Riverside in its opening game of the Fifth-Annual Thanksgiving Classic on Nov. 27.
- The Miners forced 22 turnovers, won the boards (46-33) and held the Highlanders to 34.5 percent.
- UTEP overcame a sluggish start to finish at 40.0 percent (26-of-65) from the floor.
- It featured a balanced attack, with six different players scoring at least nine points. **Cameasha Turner** led the way with 11 followed by 10 points from **Starr Breedlove**, **Daeshianna McCants**, **Chrishauna Parker** and **Sparkle Taylor** tallied nine points while **Jenzel Nash** pitched in eight.
- Breedlove also recorded a career-high six assists while **Tamara Seda** set a career high in boards (five).
- Points in the paint (40-20), points off turnovers (23-14) and second-chance points (15-4) all favored UTEP.

(at UTEP 78, Hampton 66, 11/22/15)

- UTEP used a huge second half to cruise past Hampton, 78-54, on Nov. 22. The Miners outscored the Lady Pirates 52-30 after the break with **Jenzel Nash** and **Starr Breedlove** leading the charge.
- Nash scored 21 of her game-high 23 points (two short of career high) in the second half while Breedlove followed suit by tallying 20 of her personal-best 22 points in the timeframe.
- **Chrishauna Parker** overcame early foul issues to add eight points, six of which were in the second half. **Daeshianna McCants**, **Lulu McKinney** and **Cameasha Turner** each pitched in five points.
- The Miners shot 48.2 percent (27-of-56) from the floor, aided significantly by a sizzling 64.1 percent (18-of-28) during the sensational second half. Hampton was limited to 31.1 percent (19-of-61).
- UTEP's 2-2-1 press gave Hampton fits, which committed 22 turnovers that led to 25 Miner points.

(at UTEP 77, Northern Arizona 66, 11/17/15)

- UTEP forced 22 turnovers while also taking care of business at the free-throw line to hold off upset-minded Northern Arizona, 77-66, on Nov. 17.
- UTEP relied on a balanced attack with four different players (**Sparkle Taylor**-15 points, **Jenzel Nash**-15 points, **Starr Breedlove**-13 points and **Cameasha Turner**-12 points) reaching double figures in scoring while junior **Tamara Seda** pitched in eight. The Miners overcame a slow shooting start to finish at 38.8 percent (26-of-67) from the floor, including 46.7 percent (14-of-30) over the final 20 minutes.
- Visiting NAU also had a balanced approach on offense with five players tallying 10 or more points.
- The Lumberjacks actually finished with a better overall shooting percentage than the Miners, nailing 41.7 percent (25-of-60) from the floor but they were doomed due to difficulties at the line. NAU was a paltry 47.8 percent (11-of-23) from the free-throw line, compared to UTEP's solid effort of 70.0 percent (21-of-30).
- The Miners' press also played a factor, converting the aforementioned 22 turnovers into 16 points. Second-chance points (18-8), points in the paint (42-30) and bench points (28-19) all favored UTEP as well.

(at UTEP 98, Houston Baptist 63, 11/15/15)

- UTEP bolted out to a 28-4 lead over the first seven minutes of the game and never looked back on the way to routing Houston Baptist, 98-63, in its season opener on Nov. 15.
- The 98 points are the most ever in a campaign lidlifter while ranking ninth all time at the school
- UTEP held HBU to 32.7 percent (17-of-52) from the floor.
- HBU committed 33 turnovers (which were converted into 33 points) and rank tied for the eighth most in a tilt by an opposing team.
- UTEP won the boards, 36-34, with seven different players grabbing three or more.
